





*Regular Season Practice Access

- The Browns have won their last eight home games on Thursday night, including two wins against the Steelers during that span. The Browns are 9-2 all-time at home on Thursday night. Overall, the team has won its last six games on Thursday night and owns an 11-8 all-time record on Thursday.
- In Week 11, QB Jameis Winston threw for 395 yards with two touchdowns, zero interceptions and a 106.7 rating. His 395 passing yards were the seventh-most by a Brown in a single game. In the first quarter, he connected with WR Jerry Jeudy for an 89-yard touchdown. It was a career-long pass for Winston and tied for the fourth longest pass play in Browns history. Jeudy finished the game with six receptions for 142 yards and a touchdown.
- CB Denzel Ward was a part of two takeaways last week. He recorded four tackles, one interception, two passes defended, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery. It was his first interception of the season and 16th of his career. He is leading the NFL this season with 17 passes defended, four more than the player in second. His 17 passes defended are the most by a Brown after the first 11 weeks of a season. He is the only NFL player to record at least one pass defended in every game this season. He is also the only NFL player to record at least 10 passes defended in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24). Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is first in the NFL with 93 passes defended.
- TE David Njoku recorded nine receptions last week and passed RB Greg Pruitt for the third-most receptions in Browns history with 326. Njoku (326) now trails WR Gary Collins (331) and TE Ozzie Newsome on the list. Njoku has recorded at least five receptions in each of the past five games.
- DE Myles Garrett is leading the team with seven sacks this season. He is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 95.5 in 110 career games.
- S Rodney McLeod Jr. has scored two touchdowns this season. He returned a blocked field goal 50-yards for a touchdown at Philadelphia (10/13). It was the Browns first blocked field goal returned for a touchdown since Leigh Bodden on Nov. 13, 2005. He also returned a fumble 25-yards for a score at Las Vegas (9/29).
- P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with 12 punts inside the 10-yard line and is tied for second in the league with 23 inside the 20-yard line. His 51.4 punt average ranks fourth in the league.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The Browns look to improve to 10-2 at home on Thursday night. The team has won its last six Thursday night games and have won the past eight at home.

RB NICK CHUBB

- One rushing score shy of 50 for his career.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- Six catches from passing Gary Collins (331) for the second most by a Brown.
- Aims for sixth consecutive game with five-or-more catches.
- Aims for ninth home game in a row with four-or-more catches.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Four and a half sacks away from 100 in career.
- Two and a half sacks from passing Mario Williams (97.5) for sole possession of second-most sacks by a number one pick.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Looking for 11th consecutive game with a pass breakup. Ward is the only player in the league with at least one pass breakup in 11 games this season.
- Ward is one game away from tying Joe Haden (28) for top of the Browns' all-time list of games with multiple pass breakups (27).
- Needs one interception to extend accomplishment as the only player in NFL with at least 10 pass deflections and two interceptions in first seven seasons.

IN LOVING MEMORY OF JIM DONOVAN



1956-2024

On Saturday, Oct. 26, Jim Donovan, "The Voice of the Cleveland Browns," passed away at the age of 68 after battling chronic lymphocytic leukemia. Donovan served as the radio voice of the Browns for 25 seasons, starting with the team's return in 1999.

"He touched the lives of our fans each and every Sunday with his love for the Browns and his brilliance at his craft," said Dee and Jimmy Haslam. "He will be greatly missed, but he cemented a legacy that will live on forever."

Over the course of his storied career, Donovan had signature calls that highlighted his career and are permanently etched in Browns lore. Donovan was inducted into the 2024 Class of Browns Legends on Sept. 22.

BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with “Browns Give Back” that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **SOCIAL JUSTICE**.

PLAY LIKE A GIRL!

Bridgestone, the Cleveland Browns and nonprofit organization Play Like a Girl!® welcomed local high school girls flag football teams for a Field Day.

High school players ran flag football drills with Browns QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson and took part in a panel discussion featuring female leaders from the three organizers. Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.



HALLOWEEN FASHION SHOW

The Cleveland Browns hosted the annual Halloween Fashion Show to benefit kids served by The Littlest Heroes and University Hospitals Rainbow Babies & Children's, in celebration of Crucial Catch. Browns players paired up with a child battling cancer to walk down the runway in their spookiest Halloween costumes.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

MEIJER GYM CLASS TAKEOVER

On Tuesday, November 12, the Cleveland Browns and T Lorenzo Thompson hosted a Gym Class Takeover presented by Meijer at Brooklyn School as a celebration for students having a strong commitment to school attendance.

Meijer, the presenting partner for the Gym Class Takeover, donated \$2,500 to the Cleveland Metropolitan School District, a SITG! Attendance Network school district.

The Browns Flag-In Schools program is officially in 165 elementary schools across Northeast and Central Ohio.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

STEELERS HEAD COACH MIKE TOMLIN



Mike Tomlin was appointed the 16th head coach of the Steelers franchise on Jan. 22, 2007. He began his NFL coaching career with the Buccaneers serving as DBs coach from 2001-2005, helping win Super Bowl XXXVII with them in 2002. He started out his coaching career at the collegiate level with VMI in 1995 (WRs coach), Memphis in 1996 (Grad asst.), Arkansas State in 1998 (DBs coach) and Cincinnati from 1999-2000 (DBs coach). Tomlin spent time as part of the Vikings organization in 2006 (DC). During his tenure with the Steelers, Tomlin led them to a Super Bowl XLIII championship headlined by 1st team All-Pro safety, Troy Polamalu and Linebacker James Harrison. He also led them to an appearance in Super Bowl XLV in 2010. Tomlin played football at College of William and Mary (1991-95). Currently holds the record for most consecutive non-losing seasons to begin a coaching career with 17.





HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
