LAST TIME OUT: The Trash Pandas blew a 6-1 lead in falling to the Tennessee Smokies 7-6 Sunday evening. Rocket City used the long ball to race to an early lead. Rightfielder Izzy Wilson ripped a two-run homer in the first and centerfielder Torii Hunter Jr. went to straightaway center on a three-run shot in the fourth. Mixed in was an RBI single from David MacKinnon in the third. However, Tennessee came back by scoring one in the fourth, then four more in the sixth off of Trash Pandas reliever Adrian Almeida. The four-run outburst came on only two hits as Almeida also walked two batters as well. Fellow reliever Keith Rogalla suffered the loss after allowing the winning run in the eighth. After the fourth, the Trash Pandas offense mustered only three hits and left 11 men on base for the game. Wilson, shortstop Ray-Patrick Diddy, and second baseman Gavin Cecchini each had two hits to pace the Rocket City attack.

BASEBALL RETURNS: The Rocket City home opener on May 11 marked the first professional baseball game in North Alabama since May 25, 2015, when the Biloxi Shuckers temporarily called Joe Davis Stadium home while their new stadium was being built. That day, the Shuckers beat the Birmingham Barons 7-2. Previously, the Huntsville Stars called Joe Davis Stadium home from 1985-2014 and finished with an overall record of 2,112-2,099 (.502). The Trash Pandas were originally scheduled to begin play in April 2020, but the season was canceled due to the pandemic. May 11 was also 978 days since the name Rocket City Trash Pandas was name was unveiled to the public on September 5, 2018.

RETURN OF THE MAC: On 5/30, the Angels promoted leading hitter Michael Stefania to AAA after he started the season batting .345. On the same day, first baseman David MacKinnon returned to lineup after resting the last seven days to repair a sore shoulder he suffered while trying to backhand a groundball on 5/21. With Stefania gone, MacKinnon becomes Rocket City's most consistent hitter. At .331 for the season, MacKinnon has hits in 37 of the 43 games he has played in and saw a 12-game hitting streak come to an end on 6/4. He also has a flare for the dramatic. Not known as a homerun hitter, two of MacKinnon's bombs were especially memorable. He hit a walk-off grand-slam to end a 13-inning marathon against Tennessee on 5/16, he then hit a three-run shot in his return against Birmingham on 5/29. He followed that by providing the game-winning RBI on a single against Tennessee in the eighth inning on 6/9. The University of Hartford alum currently leads the league in batting average (.331), on-base percentage (.415), on-base plus slugging (.949), doubles (15), and fourth in hits (54), and second in slugging (.534). He was named Double-A South Player of the Month of June after hitting .377 that month.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City nickname by launching 76 homers, which is second in all of AA. 12 of those dingers came in the first Tennessee series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Third baseman Mitch Nay and rightfielder Izzy Wilson each lead the way with 13, which is tied for first in AA-South. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Outfielder Orlando Martinez sits behind both Nay and Wilson at 10, while designated hitter Ibandel Isabel clocks in with nine.

PANDAS POUNCE AT HOME: Toyota Field has become quite the launching pad for the Trash Pandas. Of the 76 homers hit on season, Rocket City has blasted 39 of them at home. After hitting 12 in the first series against Tennessee, the Trash Pandas hit 18 dingers during an 11-game homestand against Chattanooga and Birmingham. In fact, the home team had at least one homer in 10 of the 11 games.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP Chris Rodriguez will take the hill for the Trash Pandas for his third start as he continues to develop into what the Angels hope will be a starting pitcher. Rodriguez is the first Trash Pandas player to have already played with the big-league club after he was sent to Rocket City on 6/20. While with the Angels, Rodriguez compiled a 2-0 record with a 3.66 ERA in 20 appearances. On 6/25, he tossed 1.2 innings of scoreless ball at Chattanooga and struck out two in a no-decision. He followed that with 2.2 scoreless frames on 6/30 against Tennessee on two hits and three strikeouts. Before this season, Rodriguez had not pitched above A-ball and had appeared in only three games since 2017 as back issues sidelined him for 2018 and the pandemic crushed his 2020 campaign.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: The Trash Pandas' active roster features four of the Angels' Top 30 prospects (according to MLB.com): left-handed pitcher Reid Detmers (Angels' No. 2, No. 57 in all of baseball), right-handed pitcher Oliver Ortega (No. 14), outfielder Orlando Martinez (No. 16), and right-handed pitcher Aaron Hernandez (No. 22).

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunatics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2021

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE RODRIGUEZ FILE: RHP **Chris Rodriguez** will make his Double-A debut after being optioned to Rocket City by the Los Angeles Angels on June 21. He's spent his entire career in the Angels' system after being drafted in the 4th round in 2016. After spending the 2020 season at the Alternate Training Site in Long Beach, he began the 2021 season in the Angels bullpen and made his MLB debut against the White Sox on April 2, throwing 2.0 scoreless innings with two hits, one walk, and three strikeouts. He earned his first two MLB wins in back-to-back outings on April 25 at Houston and April 28 at Texas. On May 6, he was placed on the IL with right shoulder inflammation and returned on June 3 after rehabbing with Triple-A Salt Lake. He is the first player in Trash Pandas history to have previously played for the team's parent club, the Los Angeles Angels. In his Rocket City debut on June 25 at Chattanooga, he made his first start of the year and kept the Lookouts off the board for 1.1 innings. He did the same and doubled his outing length with 2.2 scoreless innings at Tennessee on June 30.

VS. MONTGOMERY: Making his third Double-A start, Rodriguez will face the Biscuits for the first time in his career tonight at Toyota Field.

MORE NOTES

BACK INJURY: Did not allow a run across three starts for High-A Inland Empire in 2019 and recorded 13 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .188 average (6-for-32). After his third start of the season on April 19 vs. Lake Elsinore, he was placed on the IL and missed the rest of the season. He later underwent surgery to repair a stress fracture in his back. He also missed the entire 2018 season due to a stress reaction in his lower back.

ALL-STAR: In 2017, Rodriguez was named a Pioneer League Mid-Season All-Star for Rookie-Level Orem, the first All-Star selection of his professional career. In the All-Star Game against the Northwest League All-Stars on August 1, 2017 at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro, Oregon, he threw a scoreless bottom of the third inning. Former Trash Pandas pitcher Packy Naughton also appeared in that game for the Pioneer League All-Stars.

HIGH SCHOOL NOTES: Graduated from Monsignor Edward Pace High School (Miami Gardens, FL) in 2016. The school has also produced two-time All-Star pitcher Gio Gonzalez. Rodriguez won a state championship during sophomore year of high school at Mater Academy Charter (Hialeah Gardens, FL). He signed a letter of intent to attend Jacksonville University but chose to sign with the Angels out of high school.
