## AROUND THE ACC

• **BOSTON COLLEGE:** BC's 89 points in the season opener vs. Fairfield was the highest single-game scoring total of the Earl Grant era (third season).

• **CLEMSON:** Per StatsPerform research, Clemson boasts the third-most points per game (2022-23 season) on its roster heading into 2023-24. Clemson returns 52.1 ppg and added 48.0 ppg from its transfer class (four). The 100.1 ppg is third behind TCU (103.7) and Arkansas (103.3).

• **DUKE:** Sophomore C Kyle Filipowski's 25 points were the most by a Duke player in a season opener since RJ Barrett and Zion Williamson scored 31 and 28, respectively, against Kentucky in the 2018-19 season.

• **FLORIDA STATE:** FSU opens its season Friday. The Seminoles return five of their top seven scorers from last season, led by senior Darin Green Jr., who averaged a career-high 13.4 ppg and hit a team-leading 91 3-point field goals.

• **GEORGIA TECH:** Junior G Miles Kelly has reached double figures in points in 10 straight games dating back to last Feb. 11 at Wake Forest (9 pts). With his 27 points against Howard, he has averaged 21.0 points over that stretch.

• **LOUISVILLE:** Redshirt sophomore G/F Mike James tallied a career-high 25 points and 10 rebounds for his first career double-double against UMBC. James' 25 points were the most by a Cardinal in a season opener since Montrezl Harrell had 30 against Minnesota in 2014.

• **MIAMI:** The Hurricanes eclipsed the 100-point mark for just the fourth time in the last 10 years on Monday. Miami's 101 points against NJIT were the most in a season opener since 2007-08 (104 against Florida Southern).

• **NORTH CAROLINA:** Freshman G Elliot Cadeau led UNC Heels with six assists on Monday. It was the most assists by a freshman in a UNC debut since Bobby Frasor recorded seven against Gardner-Webb in 2005.

• **NC STATE:** Junior F Mohamed Diarra had a career game in his NC State debut on Monday. The transfer from Missouri had a career high in rebounds (14) and also scored 10 points to record his first career double-double. He also tied his career high with three blocks.

• **NOTRE DAME:** Freshman PG Markus Burton scored 29 points his debut Monday, the most ever in a Notre Dame freshman debut, topping the previous mark of 27 set by Laphonso Ellis in 1988.

• **PITT:** Freshman Carlton Carrington finished with 18 points, 12 rebounds, and 10 assists in the season-opening win over NC A&T to become the first D-I player to record a triple-double in his debut since Notre Dame's Chris Thomas vs. New Hampshire on Nov. 16, 2001.

• **SYRACUSE:** Sophomore G Judah Mintz has started strong, averaging 23.0 ppg and shooting 42.9% from 3-point range through two games. He scored 26 Wednesday in the win over Canisius.

• **VIRGINIA:** G Reece Beekman had 16 points and seven assists, with no turnovers, in the season opener. He holds the second-best assist-to-turnover ratio in league history (3.34) and has led the ACC in that category in each of the last two seasons.

• **VIRGINIA TECH:** PG Sean Pedulla dished out a career-high 10 assists in the season-opening win. He posted a double-double with a 15-point effort.

• **WAKE FOREST:** Junior G Cameron Hildreth exploded for a career-high 33 points to kick off the season on Monday, adding six rebounds and a game-high five assists.

## ACC QUICK HITS

• The 71st season of ACC Men's Basketball began Monday.

• ACC teams are 16-0 through four days of action. The ACC enters Friday as the only conference yet to lose a game this season.

• Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the preseason polls. Duke (2), Miami (13) and North Carolina (19) are ranked in the preseason Associated Press poll, while Duke (3), Miami (13) and UNC (21) hold spots in the preseason USA Today Coaches poll.

• Six members of the 2023 All-ACC Team are back for the 2023-24 season: UNC's Armando Bacot (first team), Duke's Kyle Filipowski and Pitt's Blake Hinson (second) and Clemson's PJ Hall, Miami's Norchad Omier and Virginia's Reece Beekman (third). Bacot is a three-time All-ACC honoree.

• Following a vote of the league's media, Duke was chosen as the preseason favorite to win the 2024 ACC Championship. The Blue Devils were followed in the poll by Miami, North Carolina, Virginia and Clemson.

• The league welcomes a trio of new head coaches this season: Damon Stoudamire (GT), Micah Shrewsberry (ND) and Adrian Autry (Syracuse).

• Duke's Kyle Filipowski was named the Preseason ACC Player of the Year, while UNC's Elliot Cadeau was tabbed Preseason Rookie of the Year.

## ACC REFEREES SALUTE JOHN W. ADAMS

The ACC applauds men's basketball referees across the country for their tribute to John W. Adams, former NCAA National Coordinator of Officials, who passed away in September following a battle with cancer.

During the month of November, to honor Adams' life and legacy, men's college basketball officials will wear a burgundy and white wristband with the initials JWA.

The ACC's group of basketball officials spearheaded the initiative to honor Adams and chose burgundy and white, which are the colors that represent the fight against throat and neck cancer.

Adams' contributions and service to the game were immense. He took over as National Coordinator during a challenging period and implemented the "freedom of movement" initiative. Adams also served as Coordinator of Officials in the Horizon League, where he mentored and promoted many officials at the NCAA Division 1 level.

• Filipowski was a unanimous selection to the Preseason All-ACC First Team, and he was joined by UNC's Armando Bacot, Clemson's PJ Hall, Virginia's Reece Beekman and Miami's Norchad Omier.

• Filipowski and Bacot were named Preseason All-Americans by the Associated Press. The ACC was the only league to have multiple players on the team.

• Pitt freshman G Carlton Carrington finished with 18 points, 12 rebounds, and 10 assists in the season-opening win over NC A&T to become the first D-I player to record a triple-double in his debut since Notre Dame's Chris Thomas vs. New Hampshire on Nov. 16, 2001. He joins GT's Dennis Scott (1987) as the only ACC freshmen to record a triple-double in the first game.

• With his double-double in the season opener, UNC graduate C/F Armando Bacot moved into sole possession of third place in double-doubles in ACC history with 69. He trails Wake Forest's Tim Duncan (87, 1994-97) and Virginia's Ralph Sampson (84, 1980-83).

• The inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge runs Nov. 28-29. The 14-game event replaces the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, which ran for 24 seasons.

• The ACC is 21-10 in the NCAA Tournament in the last two seasons, best of any major conference. ACC teams have made three Men's Final Four appearances in the last two seasons, matching the total of all other major conferences combined.

• Miami claimed its first Men's Final Four berth in 2023. The Hurricanes were the fifth different ACC program to reach the Men's Final Four since 2015 (Duke, North Carolina, Virginia, Syracuse). That is the most schools of any league in that span.

• Making its first Men's Final Four appearance, Miami was the 49th ACC team to reach the national semifinals. Twelve of the 15 current ACC schools have reached at least one Men's Final Four.

• Miami also earned its first ACC regular-season crown since the 2012-13 season (second overall). Virginia captured its sixth ACC regular-season title in the last 10 years and 11th in program history.

• No. 4 seed Duke earned its league-best 22nd ACC Championship on March 11, capped by a 59-49 win over No. 2 seed Virginia in Greensboro, N.C. Then-freshman Kyle Filipowski was named the tournament MVP.

• Miami's Jim Larrañaga (seventh, 726), Florida State's Leonard Hamilton (14th, 604), Virginia's Tony Bennett (40th, 411) and Clemson's Brad Brownell (41st, 409) rank among the active leaders in wins as a head coach.

• FSU's Leonard Hamilton earned his 600th career win on Jan. 7 as well as his 400th at FSU. He joined Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (1,129), UNC's Dean Smith (879), UNC's Roy Williams (485) and Maryland's Gary Williams (461) as the only coaches to win 400 games as an ACC head coach.

• Virginia's Tony Bennett (eighth, .722) and Wake Forest's Steve Forbes (22nd, .684) rank among the top 25 nationally in active career win percentage (min. five years).

• 77 alumni from ACC programs made 2023-24 Opening Day NBA rosters. That is the most of any conference. Every ACC program had at least one former player on an NBA Opening Day roster. Duke led all ACC schools with 25 alumni on NBA rosters, while UNC and Virginia had nine and Florida State had eight.

• The ACC is represented on 29 of the 30 NBA Opening night rosters, with the Brooklyn Nets boasting the most former players from ACC schools with six.

• For the fifth straight season, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

## NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

### All-Time Success

- Current league members have won more than 25,000 games and have had 826 NBA Draft picks, including 285 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including 10 schools with 1,500 or more victories.
- The ACC features four of the eight winningest programs in NCAA history: North Carolina (3rd), Duke (4th), Syracuse (6th) and Notre Dame (8th).
- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 53 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 21% of the nation's consensus All-Americans (53 of 251).

### NCAA Tournament Success

- Teams currently in the ACC have combined to win three of the last eight NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 22 crowns and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- With 664 wins among its 15 current members, the ACC is the all-time winningest conference in the NCAA Tournament. The ACC also has the highest NCAA Tournament winning percentage (.616).
- The ACC is 99-52 (.656) in NCAA Tournament play over the last eight tournaments (2015-19, '21-23). The 99 wins are 23 more than any other conference.
- Since 1985, nearly half of the ACC teams which earned NCAA Tournament bids have reached the Sweet 16 (101 of 209).
- Miami competed in first NCAA Men's Final Four in 2023, becoming the 12th active ACC program to reach the national semifinals. The Hurricanes ousted three of the region's top four seeds in earning a Final Four berth.

### Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final Associated Press poll in 61 of the last 63 seasons.
- ACC teams have been ranked No. 1 in the AP poll 300 times – by far the most of any conference.

### ACC and the NBA

- The ACC led all conferences with 77 alumni on 2023 NBA Opening Night rosters. That is the most of any conference. Every ACC program had at least one former player on an Opening Night roster.
- On 2023 Opening Night rosters, 29 of the 30 NBA teams had at least one player from an ACC program.
- Duke led all ACC programs with 25, while North Carolina and Virginia had nine and Florida State had eight.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had multiple first-round picks in each of the past 15 NBA Drafts. In that span, the ACC leads all conferences in first-round (84) and overall selections (135).
