SIX SELECTIONS IN 2013 NFL DRAFTDENVER BRONCOS

The 78th NFL Draft will start Thursday, April 25, at 6 p.m. MDT, as the Broncos look to improve upon a stretch from 2005-12 in which 57-of-61 (93.4%) draftees have made Denver's active roster at some point with the club.

The Denver Broncos enter the 2013 NFL Draft with six selections and are set to pick in the 28th slot of each round (with the exception of the sixth) due to their 2012 record and playoff advancement.

Overall, Denver is set to make one selection on Thursday, April 25, two picks on Friday, April 26, and three choices on Saturday, April 27.

ALL SEVEN 2012 DRAFT PICKS MAKE ACTIVE ROSTER

For just the second time in Broncos history, every draft pick made Denver's 53-man roster out of training camp.

The only other season in which every draft choice made Denver's initial roster was in 2007 when the Broncos made just four selections.

BRONCOS KICK OFF DRAFT WITH NO. 28 PICK

Denver's first selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 28, a position it has selected at once in its history, taking Clemson **DT Trevor Pryce** in 1997.

Pryce played 121 regular-season games (114 starts) for Denver from 1997-2005 and finished his Broncos career ranked sixth in team history with 64.0 sacks. He went on to play five more NFL seasons with Baltimore (2006-10) and the N.Y. Jets (2010) before his retirement.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 28th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 28 during this time were Central Michigan **T Joe Staley** (S.F., 2007), a two-time Pro Bowl selection for the 49ers, and Ohio State **CB Chris Gamble** (Car., 2004), who retired this offseason as the Panthers' all-time interception leader (27).

The 28th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Florida State **LB Derrick Brooks** (T.B., 1995), an 11-time Pro Bowl selection and 2002 NFL Defensive Player of the Year, and Texas A&M-Kingsville **DB Darrell Green** (Was., 1983), a seven-time Pro Bowl choice who was inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 2008.

BRONCOS IN THE FIRST ROUND

The Broncos have selected 38 players in the first round since the inception of the common draft in 1967.

On 10 occasions (1968-69, '80, '84, '86, '90, 1994-95, 2005 and '12), Denver did not select a player in the first round. In 2011, the Broncos selected **LB Von Miller**, who, after being the highest player drafted in franchise history, earned the Associated Press' Defensive Rookie of the Year honor.

Florida and Tennessee have produced the most players (4) selected by the Broncos in the first round of the draft, followed by Georgia, Miami (Fla.), Nebraska, San Jose State, Southern California and Syracuse with two apiece.

BRONCOS AT NO. 58 (SECOND ROUND)

Denver's second selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 58, a position it has selected at four times in its history, taking Texas A&M **DE Montae Reagor** in 1999, Arkansas State **LB Bill Phillips** in 1972, West Virginia **RB Garrett Ford** in 1968 and Ohio State **T Mike Current** in 1967.

Reagor played 44 regular-season games (1 start) for the Broncos from 1999-2002 before finishing his NFL career with Indianapolis (2003-06) and Philadelphia (2007). Ford played 14 games (3 starts) as a rookie in 1968, his only season with the club. Current played 188 games (105 starts) for Denver from 1967-75 and was selected to the 1969 AFL All-Star Game.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 58th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 58 during this time was Houston **T Sebastian Vollmer** (N.E., 2009), a second-team All-Pro for the Patriots in 2010.

The 58th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Colorado **S Michael Lewis** (Phi., 2002), a 2004 All-Pro selection for the Eagles, Tennessee **RB Travis Henry** (Buf., 2001), a 2002 Pro Bowl performer for the Bills and Wake Forest **WR Ricky Proehl**, a two-time Super Bowl Champion who totaled 669 career receptions for 8,878 yards and 54 touchdowns.

BRONCOS AT NO. 90 (THIRD ROUND)

Denver's third selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 90, a position it has never selected at in its history.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 90th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 90 during this time were Cal Poly **LB Jordan Beck** (Atl., 2005), who played 11 games for the Broncos during the 2007 season, and Virginia **QB Matt Schaub** (Atl., 2004), who made the Pro Bowl during the 2009 and 2012 seasons with Houston.

The 90th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Virginia Tech **WR Antonio Freeman** (G.B., 1995), a 1998 All-Pro selection and a member of the Packers Hall of Fame, and Winston-Salem **WR Yancey Thigpen** (S.D., 1991), a two-time Pro Bowler who played for San Diego (1991), Pittsburgh (1992-97) and Tennessee (1998-2000).

GRADISHAR SET TO ANNOUNCE SECOND-DAY PICKS

Denver Broncos Ring of Fame **LB Randy Gradishar**, the club's all-time leading tackler and seven-time Pro Bowler, will announce the team's second- and third-round draft choices live from Radio City Music Hall in New York City on Friday, April 26.

Gradishar played 10 seasons (1974-83) for the Broncos and never missed a game as the heart and soul of the famed "Orange Crush" defense. In 145 career regular-season contests (134 starts), he

totaled 2,049 tackles—a average of 205 tackles per season—and set a franchise record by leading the club in that category for nine consecutive years (1975-83). He also accounted for 33 turnovers (20 INTs, 13 FR) during his career to tie for the fourth most by an NFL linebacker during that span.

In addition to his seven Pro Bowl selections, Gradishar is the only Bronco to be named NFL Defensive Player of the Year, earning the honor in 1978 after accumulating 286 tackles (190 solo), four interceptions and two fumble recoveries. He helped the franchise make its first four playoff appearances (1977-79, '83) while leading Denver to consecutive division titles (1977-78) and an appearance in Super Bowl XII during the 1977 season.

Currently a Senior Committee candidate for the Pro Football Hall of Fame, Gradishar was a finalist for the Hall of Fame in 2003 and '08 and a semifinalist from 2005-07. During his 10-year career, his seven Pro Bowls were surpassed only by Hall of Fame linebacker Jack Lambert.

Additionally, his 145 consecutive regular-season games played from 1974-83 were matched only by Hall of Fame linebacker Ted Hendricks.

BRONCOS AT NO. 125 (FOURTH ROUND)

Denver's fourth selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 125, a position it has selected at twice in its history, taking Harding **DB Bruce Baldwin** in 1983 and Florida State **T Ken Lanier** in 1981.

Lanier played 177 regular-season games (165 starts) for the Broncos from 1981-94 and ranks second in club history in consecutive games played (166, 1981-92).

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 125th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 125 during this time was Louisiana-Lafayette **CB Ike Taylor** (Pit., 2003), currently an 11th-year veteran with the Steelers.

The 125th overall pick in the NFL Draft also produced Purdue **DB Cris Dishman** (Hou., 1988), a two-time Pro Bowler who played for Houston (1988-96), Washington (1997-98), Kansas City (1999) and Minnesota (2000).

BRONCOS AT NO. 161 (FIFTH ROUND)

Denver's fifth selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 161, a position it has selected at twice in its history, taking North Dakota **G Chris Kuper** in 2006 and Purdue **WR Mark Jackson** in 1986.

Kuper is in his eighth year with the Broncos having started 78-of-86 regular-season games for the club as the longest-tenured offensive player currently with the team. Jackson played 100 regular-season games (68 starts) with Denver from 1986-92 and totaled 276 receptions for 4,746 yards (17.2 avg.) and 24 touchdowns.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 161st overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 161 during this time was Stanford **DE Amon Gordon** (Cle., 2004), who started four games for the Broncos during the 2007 season.

BRONCOS AT NO. 234 (SEVENTH ROUND)

Denver's sixth and final selection in the 2013 NFL Draft comes at No. 234, a position it has selected at once in its history, taking Washington **DE Rusty Olsen** in 1981.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 234th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 234 during this time was Virginia Tech **G Will Montgomery** (Car., 2006), who has started 47-of 74 regular-season games played for Carolina (2006), the N.Y. Jets (2007) and Washington (2009-12).

PRO BOWL BRONCOS DRAFTED

The Broncos have selected 39 players in the NFL Draft who have gone on to earn a total of 110 Pro Bowl berths for the team since that game was first played during the 1970 season.

The team has had particular success drafting Pro Bowl players in late rounds, choosing nine future Pro Bowl selections in rounds five and later. These late-round steals for Denver include **TE Shannon Sharpe** (Rd. 7, '90), **LB Karl Mecklenburg** (Rd. 12, '83), **C Tom Nalen** (Rd. 7, '94) and **RB Terrell Davis** (Rd. 6, '95). Additionally, nine Broncos draft classes have produced multiple players who earned Pro Bowl recognition for the club.

The University of Colorado has produced a high of 14 Denver picks while four Broncos selections have come from Colorado State University. Air Force along with Colorado College and the University of Denver, which both no longer have football teams, each have accounted for one Denver draft choice.

The last in-state player selected by the Broncos in the NFL Draft was CSU **QB Bradlee Van Pelt**, chosen by the team in the seventh round (250th overall) of the 2004 NFL Draft. It has been 30 years since Denver has picked a University of Colorado player in the NFL Draft, a span that began after the Broncos' selection of CU **NT Laval Short** in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 1980 NFL Draft.
