BRONCOS SET TO MAKE SEVEN SELECTIONS IN 2012 NFL DRAFT



The Denver Broncos enter the 2012 NFL Draft with seven selections, including four of their own picks and three others acquired via trade.

The 77th NFL Draft will start Thursday, April 26, at 6 p.m. MDT, as the Broncos look to improve upon a stretch from 2005-11 in which 50-of-54 (93.0%) draftees have made Denver's active roster at some point with the club.

Denver owns the 25th pick in each of the first three rounds of the draft due to its 2011 record and playoff advancement.

Three of the Broncos' final four selections were acquired by way of trades, as Denver obtained a fifth rounder from St. Louis for WR **Brandon Lloyd** and selections in the fourth and sixth rounds from the N.Y. Jets in exchange for QB **Tim Tebow**.

Overall, Denver is set to make one selection on Thursday, April 26, two picks on Friday, April 27, and four choices on Saturday, April 28.

Media Parking & Check-In: Media parking is in the front lot, located off Broncos Parkway. Media will enter the building through the Broncos' press room, where they will be issued a credential for the weekend. ***The building will be open for media at 12 p.m. on Thursday, 10 a.m. on Friday and 9 a.m. on Saturday.***

Press Conferences: Executive Vice President of Football Operations **John Elway** will hold a pre-draft news conference on Monday, April 23, at 11 a.m. MDT. Head coach **John Fox** will meet the press at the conclusion of each day of the draft, including in a post-draft news conference with Elway and General Manager **Brian Xanders** on Saturday, April 28. Monday's media availability will take place in the press room of the club's training facility. All other media availability sessions will take place in the media center.

Draft Pick Media Availability: Conference calls with Broncos draft picks will take place immediately after the player is selected in the media center. As in years past, there will be a mult box available for television and radio stations. The club's first and second day picks will conduct a press conferences in the media center the day following their selection.

Meals: Food will be served for working press on all three days of the NFL Draft in the inner-lobby area of the Broncos' training facility. Dinner will be served on Thursday and Friday while breakfast and lunch will be served on Saturday. ***Please note that only drinks will be allowed into the media center.***

Internet: The Broncos' press room and media center room are equipped with a wireless Internet network (Orange and Blue).

TV Live Shots: Television stations may set up live shots in their usual location in front of the building. Stations wishing to conduct live shots from the media center must contact the Broncos' public relations department to make arrangements for parking a truck north of the building.

NOTES ON THE BRONCOS' 2012 NFL DRAFT

Denver owns seven selections in the 2012 NFL Draft and is set to make its first pick of the day at No. 25 overall, which marks the franchise's 39th first-round pick (common draft)... The club owns four original picks in the draft along with three selections acquired via trade... Denver's 2011 draft class combined to play 100 games (52 starts) in the regular season, as eight of the nine draftees made the active roster... Aided by college free-agent CB **Chris Harris**, Denver's rookie class ranked second in the NFL in 2011 in average playtime (44.9% of offensive/defensive snaps)... Denver's first-round selection in 2011, LB **Von Miller** from Texas A&M University (No. 2 overall), joined LB **Mike Croel** (1991) as the only players in franchise history to be named the Associated Press' Defensive Rookie of the Year... S **Rahim Moore**, who was selected in the second round (45th overall) in the 2011 NFL Draft, played 15 games (7 starts)... T **Orlando Franklin**, who was taken one pick after Moore (No. 46), became just the sixth rookie offensive lineman in franchise history to start every regular-season game and the first to do so at the right tackle position... LB **Nate Irving** (Rd. 3, 67th overall) played all 16 regular-season games and both playoff contests for the Broncos as a rookie in 2011... S **Quinton Carter** (Rd. 4, 108th overall) played all 16 regular-season games (10 starts) as well as opening both playoff games for the club... TE **Virgil Green** (Rd. 7, 204th overall) became the lowest-drafted player by the Broncos to play at least 15 games as a rookie since 1984.

Rd. 1 (25th overall)

The Broncos' first-round pick (25th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft is their own selection.

Rd. 2 (57th overall)

The Broncos' second-round pick (57th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft is their own selection.

Rd. 3 (87th overall)

The Broncos' third-round pick (87th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft is their own selection.

Rd. 4 (108th overall)

The Broncos' first of two fourth-round picks (108th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft was acquired from the N.Y. Jets on March 26, 2012, along with a sixth-round pick in the 2012 NFL Draft in exchange for QB **Tim Tebow**.

Rd. 4 (120th overall)

The Broncos' second of two fourth-round picks (120th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft is their own selection.

Rd. 5 (137th overall)

The Broncos' fifth-round pick (137th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft was acquired from St. Louis on Oct. 17, 2011 in exchange for WR **Brandon Lloyd**.

Rd. 6 (189th overall)

The Broncos' sixth-round pick (189th overall) in the 2012 NFL Draft was acquired from the N.Y. Jets on March 26, 2012, along with a fourth-round pick in the 2012 NFL Draft in exchange for QB **Tim Tebow**.

BRONCOS KICK OFF DRAFT WITH NO. 25 PICK

Denver's first selection in the 2012 NFL Draft comes at No. 25, a position it has selected at twice in its history, taking a pair of quarterbacks in UCLA QB **Tommy Maddox** in 1992 and Florida QB **Tim Tebow** in 2010.

Maddox played 29 games (4 starts) for the Broncos from 1992-93 as QB **John Elway's** backup and as the club's primary holder. He went on to play 94 career regular-season games (36 starts) in the NFL with Denver, L.A. Rams (1994), N.Y. Giants (1995) and Pittsburgh (2001-05).

Tebow played 23 games (14 starts) in two seasons with Denver and led the Broncos to an AFC West Division title in 2011. He was traded to the N.Y. Jets on March 26, 2011 for two selections in this year's draft.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 25th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 25 during this time is Miami LB **Jon Beason** (Car., 2007), a

three-time Pro Bowl selection who was chosen by the Panthers when **John Fox** was head coach of the club.

The 25th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Louisville **Ted Washington** (S.F., 1991), a four-time Pro Bowl selection and Nebraska C **Dave Rimington** (Cin., 1983), name-sake of the Rimington Trophy, awarded annually to the nation's top collegiate center.

BRONCOS AT NO. 57 (SECOND ROUND)

Denver's second pick in the 2012 NFL Draft comes at No. 57, a position which it has never chosen.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 57th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 57 during this time was Miami WR **Devin Hester** (Chi., 2006), a three-time Pro Bowl selection and a member of the NFL 2000s All-Decade Team as a returner.

The 57th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Colorado LB **Ted Johnson** (N.E., 1995), an three-time Super Bowl Champion with the Patriots, and Nicholls State WR **Mark Carrier** (T.B., 1987), a Pro Bowl selection in 1989.

BRONCOS AT NO. 87 (THIRD ROUND)

Denver's third-round selection in the 2012 NFL Draft is scheduled to occur at the 87th overall pick, a position which Denver has chosen at three times in its history. Most recently, the Broncos used the pick to select Minnesota WR **Eric Decker** (2010), who has played 30 games (13 starts) for the club during the last two seasons. Denver also picked Iowa State DE **Reggie Hayward** (2001) and Alcorn State CB **Cleo Johnson** (1971) with the No. 87 overall selection.

The 87th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Memphis CB **Mike McKenzie** (G.B., 1999), who played 138 games (131 starts) in 11 seasons for the Packers and Saints, and California-Riverside WR **Butch Johnson** (Dal., 1976), who played 10 NFL seasons, including his final two campaigns (1984-85) with the Broncos.

BRONCOS AT NO. 108 (FOURTH ROUND)

Denver's first of two fourth-round choices in the 2012 NFL Draft comes at No. 108, a selection which it acquired from the N.Y. Jets on March 26, 2012, along with a sixth-rounder in 2012 for QB **Tim Tebow**. The Broncos have selected at that position three times in their history, choosing Oklahoma S **Quinton Carter** in 2011, Bowling Green C **Kory Lichtensteiger** in 2008 and Oklahoma RB **Quintin Griffin** in 2003.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 108th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 108 during this time were Utah DT **Paul Soliai** (Mia., 2007), who was named to the Pro Bowl in 2011, and East Carolina QB **David Garrard** (Jac., 2002), who is entering his 10th NFL season in 2012.

BRONCOS AT NO. 120 (FOURTH ROUND)

Denver's second of two fourth-round choices in the 2012 NFL Draft comes at No. 120. The Broncos have selected at this position once before in club history, picking California P **Nick Harris** (2001), who is entering his 11th NFL season despite not making Denver's 53-man roster out of training camp as a rookie.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 120th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 120 during this time were Georgia DT **Geno Atkins** (Cin., 2010), a 2011 Pro Bowl selection, and Central Florida CB **Asante Samuel** (N.E., 2003), a four-time Pro Bowler.

The 189th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Colorado State DE **Sean Moran** (Buf, 1996), who played eight NFL seasons with the Bills, Rams and 49ers.

BRONCOS AT NO. 137 (FIFTH ROUND)

Denver's fifth-round selection in the 2012 NFL Draft is the 137th overall selection. The pick was acquired from St. Louis on Oct. 17, 2011 in exchange for WR **Brandon Lloyd**. The Broncos have selected at that position twice in club history, taking Oklahoma State CB **Perrish Cox** with that choice in 2010, and picking Boise State CB **Frank Robinson** at that spot in 1992.

Below is a look at the last 10 players selected with the 137th overall pick in the NFL Draft. Among the players selected at No. 137 during this time was Alabama FB **Le'Ron McClain** (Bal., 2007), a two-time Pro Bowl selection.

BRONCOS AT NO. 188 (SIXTH ROUND)

Denver's sixth-round selection in the 2012 NFL Draft is the 188th overall selection. The pick was acquired from the N.Y. Jets on March 26, 2012, along with a fourth-rounder in 2012 for QB **Tim Tebow**. Denver has selected at that position twice in club history, taking North Carolina State LB **Ray Phillips** with that pick in 1986, and choosing Baylor P **Luke Prestridge** at that spot in 1979.

The 188th overall pick in the NFL Draft also has produced Alabama-Birmingham S **Izell Reese** (Buf, 1996), who played seven NFL seasons, including a one-year stint as a 15-game starter for Denver in 2002.

BRONCOS IN THE FIRST ROUND

The Broncos have selected 38 players in the first round since the inception of the common draft in 1967.

On nine occasions (1968-69, '80, '84, '86, '90, 1994-95 and 2005), Denver has not selected a player in the first round. In 2011, the Broncos selected LB **Von Miller**, who, after being the highest player drafted in franchise history, earned the Associated Press' Defensive Rookie of the Year honor.

Florida and Tennessee have produced the most players (4) selected by the Broncos in the first round of the draft, followed by Georgia, Miami (Fla.), Nebraska, San Jose State, Southern California and Syracuse with two apiece.

Denver selected Florida DT **Marcus Thomas** with the 121st overall pick while Minnesota took Oklahoma LB **Rufus Alexander** with the 176th pick and Florida International WR **Chandler Williams** at No. 233.

Denver selected Vanderbilt QB **Jay Cutler** with the 11th overall pick while St. Louis selected Clemson CB **Tye Hill** with the 15th overall pick and LSU DT **Claude Wroten** with the 68th overall choice.

Also that day, Denver traded a second-round pick (37th overall) to Green Bay in exchange for WR **Javon Walker**. Green Bay later traded that pick to Atlanta, which selected Virginia Tech CB **Jimmy Williams**.

2003 NFL DRAFT (4/27): The Broncos traded a fourth-round pick (120th overall) in the 2003 NFL Draft to New England for a fourth-round pick (128th overall) and a fifth-round pick (157th overall) in the 2003 NFL Draft. BRONCOS AND IN-STATE PICKS

The Broncos have selected 21 players in the NFL Draft from schools in the state of Colorado. The University of Colorado has produced a high of 14 Denver picks while four Broncos selections have come from Colorado State University. Air Force along with Colorado College and the University of Denver, which both no longer have football teams, each have accounted for one Denver draft choice.

The last in-state player selected by the Broncos in the NFL Draft was CSU QB **Bradlee Van Pelt**, chosen by the team in the seventh round (250th overall) of the 2004 NFL Draft. It has been 30 years since Denver has picked a University of Colorado player in the NFL Draft, a span that began after the Broncos' selection of CU NT **Laval Short** in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 1980 NFL Draft.
