Seahawks 17, Broncos 16

Monday, Sept. 12, 2022 • 5:15 p.m. PDT • Lumen Field • Seattle

WEATHER: Sunny, 74°, Wind E 6 mph • TIME: 2:57 • ATTENDANCE: 68,965

The Denver Broncos and new Head Coach Nathaniel Hackett opened the season on the road at Seattle, taking on the Seahawks on *Monday Night Football*.

Brand new quarterback Russell Wilson made his Broncos debut against his old team and put up impressive stats in a hostile environment, completing 29-of-42 passes (69.0%) for 340 yards with one score for a 101.3 passer rating.

Wide receiver Jerry Jeudy had an impressive day for Denver, catching four of Wilson's passes for 102 yards, the third 100-yard receiving game of his career to this point. Jeudy's highlight came in the second half, grabbing a ball from a Seahawks' defender and turning it into a 67-yard touchdown reception in the second quarter.

On defense, safety Justin Simmons and inside linebacker Alex Singleton led the charge in tackles with each registering nine on the day. Outside linebacker Bradley Chubb also made his presence known to Seattle, sacking Seahawks quarterback Geno Smith twice in the fourth quarter, including a strip-sack, for his fifth-career multi-sack game.

The Seahawks got on the board early, taking the opening drive down the length of the field and was capped off by a 38-yard pass from Smith to tight end Will Dissly to grab the 7-0 lead.

Denver would respond right back with a scoring drive of their own, going 77 yards in nine plays and was wrapped up by a field goal by kicker Brandon McManus to make the score 7-3.

It looked as though Seattle was about to extend their lead on their second drive of the game, but the Broncos defense stood up to the challenge, denying the Seahawks on a fourth down and one from the Denver seven-yard line.

Seattle would convert on their next opportunity to score points though, kicking a field goal on their first possession of the second quarter to make the score 10-3.

It would not take too long for Denver to respond, driving 75 yards on three plays to tie the game after Wilson connected with Jeudy on a 67-yard pass for the score.

Seattle responded right back again, going 75 yards on seven plays to give themselves the lead again, this time at 17-10. A field goal at the end of the half by Denver would cut the lead to 17-13 at half.

The second half got off to a rough start for the Broncos, who would fumble twice at the goal line for Seattle, both of which proved to be costly at the end.

Denver's defense stepped it up in the second half though to keep the Broncos in the game, allowing only 34 total yards in the final two quarters.

The game would come down to the last play of the game, as McManus, who was 3-of-3 to this point, would miss the 64-yard attempt with 0:15 remaining in the game, sealing the win for Seattle.

Broncos 16, Texans 9

Sunday, Sept. 18, 2022 • 2:25 p.m. MDT • Empower Field at Mile High • Denver

WEATHER: Sunny, 77°, Wind N 11 mph • TIME: 3:04 • ATTENDANCE: 76,191

The Broncos fought hard in their home opener to pick up their first win of the season and first win in Head Coach Nathaniel Hackett's career, defeating the Texans 16-9.

In a defensive struggle throughout most of the first part of the game, Denver opened it up in the fourth quarter, scoring 10 unanswered points after entering the final frame trailing by 3.

WR Courtland Sutton was the headline for the offense, totaling 122 receiving yards, the second-most in his career at the time, on seven catches (17.4 avg.). TE Eric Saubert caught the game-winning touchdown pass from QB Russell Wilson in the fourth quarter for the second score of his career while RB Javonte Williams broke the 1,000-yard rushing mark for his career with his 75-yard game.

DE Dre'Mont Jones led the defensive effort, posting his fifth-career multi-sack game while OLB Randy Gregory got in on the action, posting a strip-sack of his own late in the fourth quarter. Denver did not allow a touchdown in the game, marking the first time that has happened since Week 3 of last season vs. NYJ (9/26/21). The defense also held Houston to 2-of-13 (15.4%) on third down in the game.

K Brandon McManus went 3-for-3 on the day, getting him over the 200 career field goals made mark and making him the ninth active kicker at the time to reach that mark and second in Broncos history.

The game would get off to a slow start as both teams would fail to convert on any points on the first few drives, but Denver would get on the board first with a McManus 20-yard field goal.

Houston would return the favor, making a 40-yard kick of their own when they got the ball. The Texans took a 6-3 lead on their next drive after K Ka'imi Fairbairn nailed another attempt from 44 yards.

The Broncos would get on the board right before the half to tie the game as McManus would hit from 24 yards with 0:23 remaining in the half.

While Denver got off on the wrong foot in the second half after a LB Christian Kirksey interception, Wilson would be on point the rest of the game, going 8-of-11 for 126 yards with 1 touchdown to help lead the team to the win.

Houston would only manage another field goal after starting in Denver territory and the defenses for both teams would keep the offenses in check for the remainder of the quarter.

It would not take long for the Broncos to get back in front at the start of the fourth quarter, as Wilson found Saubert for the 22-yard score, which would prove to be the game-winning touchdown.

McManus ended the scoring on Denver's next drive, hitting from 50 yards to wrap a 12-play, 54-yard drive that took up 6:12.

The defense held steady to seal the win, including a strip-sack by Gregory which put Houston behind the sticks and put more pressure on Texans QB Davis Mills.

Another punt by the Broncos and three incompletions by Mills wrapped up the game and gave Denver their first win for the 2022 season.

Broncos 11, 49ers 10

On *Sunday Night Football*, the Broncos were able to pull out a nail-biter that came down to the final moments of the game, defeating San Francisco 11-10.

In a defensive gem of a game, Denver limited the 49ers to their lowest total yardage since the 2020 season, allowing only 267 yards (88 rush, 179 pass) while also forcing three total turnovers. The front seven also brought pressure all night, racking up four sacks for 32 yards in the contest.

ILB Josey Jewell made his return from injury and made an impact immediately, racking up nine total tackles (5 solo) along with one sack (10 yds.), two TFLs and one fumble recovery. OLB Randy Gregory, OLB Bradley Chubb and DL Mike Purcell also joined in, recording sacks of their own with Purcell forcing 49ers QB Jimmy Garoppolo out of the end zone by the safety.

Offensively, Denver posted its fourth consecutive game with at least 100 yards rushing, dating back to the season finale last year against Kansas City. WR Courtland Sutton also helped lead the offense, posting 97 yards on eight receptions (12.1 avg.).

P Corliss Waitman was the star on special teams, punting 10 times (47.6 gross / 43.6 net) and downing six punts inside of the 20-yard line, a franchise record.

In a game that was defined by its defense, both teams traded punts to begin the game before San Francisco got the early lead after Garoppolo found WR Brandon Aiyuk from three yards out. While the Broncos were unable to respond right away, the defense held its ground and prevented the 49ers from entering Denver territory for the rest of the quarter.

K Brandon McManus got the Broncos on the board in the second quarter, nailing a kick from 55 yards out to post the 34th 50+ yard field goal of his career to bring the score to 7-3. The defenses would hold firm after the score, keeping it to a 7-3 game to halftime.

A Denver punt gave San Francisco the ball at their own 43, but a bad snap that was fumbled was recovered by Jewell at the 50-yard line, giving the Broncos the ball.

Another punt, this time downed at the 49ers' 1-yard line, would lead to Purcell chasing Garoppolo out of the end zone and for the safety, bringing the game to a 7-5 score.

Denver would threaten again before the end of the frame, but a McManus 51-yard field goal attempt went wide right, keeping the score at 7-5.

San Francisco got their five-point lead back at the beginning of the quarter after K Robbie Gould nailed a field goal from 51 yards away.

After the teams traded punts again, Denver would sustain a drive, going 80 yards on 12 plays and was wrapped by RB Melvin Gordon III 1-yard touchdown run.

Denver's defense stood tall to close the game as ILB Jonas Griffith would intercept a pass and S Kareem Jackson would recover a fumble to ice the game.

The Denver Broncos fell to the Las Vegas Raiders in their first divisional matchup of the season by the score of 32-23.

Denver had another solid performance by WR Courtland Sutton, who surpassed 3,000 career receiving yards on the day after catching five passes for 52 yards (10.4 avg.) with a touchdown. WR Jerry Jeudy got in on the action as we, posting 53 yards on four receptions (13.3 avg.) with one touchdown.

QB Russell Wilson had a solid performance, posting a 124.9 passer rating after totaling 237 yards on 17-of-25 passing (68.0%) with two touchdowns. Wilson also ran the ball well, racking up a team-high 29 yards on four carries (7.3 avg.) with one touchdown.

Defensively, ILB Josey Jewell tallied a career-high-tying 14 tackles (7 solo) while DT D.J. Jones and CB K'Waun Williams were able to bring down QB Derek Carr behind the line of scrimmage. CB Pat Surtain continued his stellar start to the season, posting another two passes defended while tallying a career-high eight tackles (6 solo).

The Raiders got on the board early as they drove down the field on their opening possession, but were stopped in the red zone and held to only a field goal.

Both teams would trade punts before WR Montrell Washington, who would total 66 punt return yards on three returns, returned a punt from P AJ Cole 30 yards to set the Broncos up with good field position. Denver would take advantage, taking four plays to drive 34 yards and take the 7-3 lead after Wilson found Sutton in the back of the endzone.

The second quarter would see a barrage of scoring, starting with an answer by Las Vegas, traveling 75 yards and finished with a RB Josh Jacobs 10-yard run into the end zone.

K Brandon McManus answered right back for Denver, as he would hit from 28 yards out on the next drive to tie the game at 10.

The Raiders would retake the lead soon after though, as CB Amik Robertson would recover a fumble by RB Melvin Gordon III and take it 68 yards for the score, but a missed PAT by Daniel Carlson kept it to a six-point game.

Denver would answer on the next drive as the Broncos moved down the field, going 75 yards on five plays and led to Wilson finding Jeudy for the 20-yard score with 1:29 remaining in the half. A bad snap though on the point after prevented the Broncos from taking the lead and the score remained tied at 16.

The Raiders would get a field goal from Carlson at the end of the end of the half to retake the lead going into the intermission and would not look back. Las Vegas would get two more field goals the next half before Wilson drove the Broncos 6-plays, 75-yards and ran it in from three yards out to make it 25-23 with 7:16 left.

The Raiders would ice the game on their next drive though, as a 5:14 drive would be ended by another Jacobs score to make it 32-23, giving Denver its second loss on the season.

The Denver Broncos fell to the Indianapolis Colts in overtime by the score of 12-9 on *Thursday Night Football*.

The defense stepped up in a big way, allowing only 200 or fewer net yards passing in their fifth straight game of the season, the first time a Denver team has accomplished that in as long of a stretch since the 2010 season. The Broncos also posted six sacks in the game, the most by the team since vs. Mia. (11/22/20).

OLB Bradley Chubb posted 2.5 sacks for 13.5 yards in the game, his second multi-sack game of the season and the sixth of his career to bring his season total to 5.5. S Caden Sterns also had a career game, intercepting two of QB Matt Ryan's passes for 25 yards to notch his first career multi-interception game. OLB Baron Browning also notched his first sacks of his career, totaling 1.5 sacks for 13.5 yards.

WR Courtland Sutton led the offense again, recording 74 yards on five catches (14.8 avg.) and had a game-high 51-yard catch from QB Russell Wilson in the third quarter.

Denver got on the board early in the game, as the defense would force a three-and-out and the offense would start at their own 36-yard line. Wilson would help guide the offense down the field, going 49 yards in 10 plays to set up a K Brandon McManus 33-yard field goal to go up 3-0.

That would prove to be the only score of the quarter as both teams would trade punts for the remainder of the frame.

Denver would strike again early in the second quarter though as Wilson would again help lead the offense down the field in 10 plays, going 40 yards to set up McManus from 44 yards out to extend the Broncos lead to six.

Both teams would struggle for field position again for most of the half until the Colts were able to break through and go 52 yards to set up K Chase McLaughlin from 52 yards out to cut the deficit in half right before the break.

The third quarter started the same as the Colts would tie the game with another field goal after forcing Denver to punt on its first possession.

The Broncos would answer right back with a field goal to make it 9-6 after Sterns intercepted Ryan for the second time of the game on the Colts' 27-yard line.

Indianapolis would go on and tie the game late in the fourth quarter after traveling 67 yards on 10 plays to kick the field goal with 0:08 seconds remaining.

The Colts would kick one last field goal in overtime before Denver would storm down the field and get to the Indianapolis five-yard line. The fourth-down attempt by the Broncos would be broken up, giving the Colts the win.

The Denver Bronco's lost in overtime in the second straight game, this time falling to the Los Angeles Chargers 19-16 on Monday Night Football.

The Broncos defense led the way once again, holding Chargers QB Justin Herbert to his second-lowest passer rating (66.3) in his career and prevented him from throwing a touchdown pass for just the second time in his career.

OLB Baron Browning again led the charge for Denver, posting a sack and an interception of Herbert, becoming the first Bronco since OLB Von Miller did so in 2018. ILB Alex Singleton also had a career game, totaling 21 tackles (19 solo), the most in team history and by in the NFL since Kwon Alexander in 2016. DE Matt Henningsen also had a noteworthy game, posting his first sack of his career.

Denver got off to a fast start, forcing a Chargers' punt on their first possession and then taking their first drive 46 yards in eight plays to set up a K Brandon McManus field goal. After another punt, the Broncos drove 84 yards on seven plays and ended when QB Russell Wilson found TE Greg Dulcich for the 39-yard score.

That score signified Dulcich's first in the NFL and marked him as just the third Broncos TE to tally a receiving touchdown in his NFL debut.

Los Angeles would answer right back, getting 10 unanswered points of their own as the second quarter began, but Denver would not finish the half without an answer. With five second remaining in the half, McManus nailed a 51-yard field goal, the 37th-career 50+-yard field goal in his career.

The xChargers would answer back early in the second half, as K Dustin Hopkins would nail the 31-yard attempt to even the scoring again early in the second half.

Both teams would remain that way until early in the fourth quarter, when a pass by Herbert was intercepted by Browning and brought to the Chargers' 30-yard line. The Broncos would not be able to capitalize on the good field position though, as three plays later they would attempt and get the 48-yard field goal by McManus.

Los Angeles would waste no time though evening the score again, this time going 58 yards on 10 plays to set up a 35-yard field goal attempt by Hopkins, that he would nail through the uprights.

Both teams were unable to get anything going through the remainder of the regulation time, forcing overtime.

In OT, Denver and Los Angeles went back and forth until a fumbled punt by WR Montrell Washington set up the Chargers at the Denver 28.

The Chargers took advantage of their opportunity, setting up Hopkins for the 39-yard game-winning field goal to give Los Angeles the win.

The Broncos fell for the fourth-straight game, this time by the score of 16-9 against the New York Jets.

The defense again stood tall for Denver, allowing only 10 first downs all game, the fewest allowed in a game by the Broncos since allowing six vs. NYJ (12/1/17).

Denver also limited Jets' QB Zach Wilson to 105 net yards passing, the fourth-fewest allowed in a single game since 2017. The defense also prevented an opponent from passing for over 225 yards in the seventh-straight game, the longest such streak by a Denver team since 2009.

DE Dre'Mont Jones had a stellar game, posting his second multi-sack game of the season and sixth of his career when he took down Wilson on back-to-back plays. OLB Nik Bonitto also got on the board, posting his first sack of his career with the help of DL Mike Purcell.

With QB Russell Wilson out with an injury, QB Brett Rypien took over the reins, finishing the game 24-of-46 passing for 225 yards and one interception (56.9 rat.).

WR Jerry Jeudy broke out, racking up 96 yards on seven receptions (13.7 avg.), including a 45 yard catch in the second quarter.

The Jets got on the board first after Denver forced a pair of three-and-outs to start the game. RB Brecee Hall carried the ball 62 yards on New York's third possession to take the early 7-0 lead.

Denver answered right back on their next possession, taking the ball 75 yards on 13 plays and wrapped up when RB Latavius Murray scored from two yards out for his first score as a Bronco. A missed PAT though would keep Denver down by the score of 7-6.

After both defenses forced punts by both teams, Denver got the ball back with 9:42 remaining in the half. The Broncos were able to drive down the field, going 73 yards in 11 plays to set up a 44-yard field goal by K Brandon McManus to take their first lead of the day.

The Jets would answer right back though, going 48 yards in 10 plays to get a field goal of their own and take the 10-9 lead into the half.

The third quarter proved to be more of the defensive struggle seen in the first half as both teams prevented the other from getting to the other side of the field until an interception by Jets' S Lamarcus Joyner have New York's ball on Denver's 37.

The Jets were able to grab two more field goals in the fourth quarter to stretch the lead to 16-9, but allowed the Broncos a shot to get back into the game with a score. Denver gave the ball over on down with just under two minutes left.

The defense forced a Jets three-and-out to get the ball with 1:30 remaining, but the offense could not convert on the last drive and gave the ball back after a turnover on downs, sealing New York's win.

The Broncos returned to London, England for the first time since 2010 and picked up their first win in a regular-season international game, beating the Jacksonville Jaguars 21-17.

Its third game in team history at historic Wembley Stadium, Denver was able to get back on track and in the win column as the offense found its rhythm in the second half.

QB Russell Wilson was able get the offense rolling, going 18-of-30 for 252 yards with a touchdown while rookie TE Greg Dulcich had his best game to date, bringing in 87 yards on four catches. Dulcich's 87 yards are the fourth-most by a Bronco rookie tight end in a single game at the time.

RB Latavius Murray and RB Melvin Gordon III both reached the endzone in the game as well, with Murray's being his second score in London in 2022 on his second team this season.

DE Dre'Mont Jones tallied seven tackles (5 solo), a sack (6 yds.) and three TFLs in the match while OLB Nik Bonitto got a sack in his second-consecutive game, becoming the first Bronco rookie to go so since OLB Bradley Chubb in 2018.

The game did not start out well for the offense, as they would would not be able to pick up a first down on the first three possessions.

Jacksonville took advantage that CB Tyson Campbell picked off Wilson on the second drive of the game, leading to the first score of the game. Lawrence found TE Evan Engram, taking the early 7-0 lead.

The Jaguars were threatening to take a 14-0 lead with the ball on the Denver one yardline, but S Justin Simmons came up big with the pick to stop the bleeding.

Jacksonville would still get a field goal the next drive to go up 10-0, but Denver swung the momentum with the next drive as it would drive 75 plays in 11 yards and finished with a quick pitch from Wilson to WR Jerry Jeudy, who ran six yards for the score.

On their first possession in the second half, the Broncos were pinned at their two yardline, but Dulcich would be the star of the drive. The rookie tight end would get 78 yards through the air and Gordon would find the endzone from one yard out to give Denver its first lead of the game.

Both team would trade punts until late in the fourth quarter until a short field would help Jacksonville again for their second touchdown, this time coming from RB Travis Etienne.

The Broncos answered right back with the help of a 47-yard connection between Wilson and WR KJ Hamler. Denver would take advantage and score with 1:47 left with a Murray two-yard run.

The Jaguars still had time, but that would be quickly extinguished when CB K'Waun Williams intercepted Lawrence and helped ice the game for Denver.

The Broncos returned from the bye week, traveling to Nashville and losing another close game, this time to the Titans by the score of 17-10.

The defense, despite missing some key players, still put together a tremendous effort, keeping Titans star RB Derrick Henry to 53 yards on 19 carries (2.8) while limiting eighth-ranked rushing offense in the NFL to a total of 63 rushing yards on 23 attempts (2.7 avg.).

ILB Josey Jewell led the way with a team-high nine tackles (6 solo) while newly acquired OLB Jacob Martin made his Broncos debut in a big way, sacking Titans QB Ryan Tannehill for 11 yards.

The defense also posted eight passes defended, the second most this season, and recovered a fumble when DL Mike Purcell jumped on the loose ball.

Offensively, WR Jalen Virgil made his NFL debut and made a mark, catching his first career pass for 66 yard and the score. The touchdown marked the longest touchdown by a Bronco in his NFL debut since WR Rick Upchurch's 90-yard score in 1975.

The game got off to a slow start as both defenses imposed their will on the other team and preventing the other team from crossing midfield in the first quarter except for four plays.

Denver finally broke things open midway through the second quarter, as QB Russell Wilson looked left and found Virgil wide open, hitting him in stride as Virgil took it 66 yards to give the Broncos the 7-0 lead.

After a three and out by the Titans offense, Denver drove the field once again but had to settle for a K Brandon McManus field goal after going 41 yards in nine plays to take a 10-0 lead.

The Titans would not be denied before the end of the half though, as Tennessee drove 75 yards in 13 plays in 2:11 and ended with a Tannehill pass to WR Nick Westbrook-Ikhine in the corner of the endzone to make the score 10-7 at half.

The Titans would strike again with some trickery midway through the third quarter as Tennessee would try a flea flicker and hit Westbrook-Ikhine again, this time for a 63-yard score to take the 14-10 lead with 5:25 remaining in the third frame.

The fourth quarter began with the more stout defensive efforts on both sides. On Tennessee's first possession of the frame, DL Mike Purcell jumped on the loose football to give Denver the ball back.

Tennessee would still get a field goal the next drive, making it a seven-point game with 3:02 left to play.

Denver would not be able to capitalize on their final drive though, getting to the Titans' 20 yard line before an interception by CB Terrance Mitchell on fourth down ended the comeback by Denver.

Raiders 22, Broncos 16

Denver fell in their third AFC West game of the season and to the Raiders for the second time in 2022, losing 22-16 in overtime at Empower Field at Mile High.

The Broncos offensively were led by QB Russell Wilson, who finished the game throwing 24-of-31 for 247 yards (99.8 rtg.). His 77.4 completion percentage was the highest as a Bronco this season.

WR Courtland Sutton also posted a solid game, finishing with 80 yards on five catches (16.0 avg.). RB Latavius Murray found the endzone again, marking his third this season and third since joining the Broncos.

Defensively, ILB Josey Jewel and ILB Alex Singleton led the way, finishing tied for a team-high 11 tackles each while Jewel also notched a nine-yard sack of Raiders QB Derek Carr and a pass defended. CB Damarri Mathis, DL DeShawn Williams and DT D.J. Jones also got in on the action, tallying a pass defended each. The game got off to a good start for Denver as they forced the Raiders to punt of their first possession.

The Broncos' offense then made an early statement, going 92 yards on their first drive to take the early 7-0 lead after a 32-yard connection between Wilson and WR Kendall Hinton set up a one-yard score by Murray with 6:22 remaining in the opening frame.

After a K Daniel Carlson field goal miss from 46 yards, Denver extended their lead on a K Brandon McManus 48-yard kick, which capped off an eight-play, 34-yard drive.

The Raiders would not go quietly though, as Las Vegas would answer back on the next drive, going 75 yards on eight plays and ended when Carr found Raiders WR Davante Adams for the 31-yard score.

The Broncos would try to extend their lead again, but a field goal attempt by McManus at the end of the half would be blocked and the teams entered the break with Denver up 10-7.

The Broncos would go three-and-out on their first possession of the second half and Las Vegas would tie the game with a Carlson kick from 52 yards out.

That is how the third quarter would end, but not before Denver would help set up a McManus 52-yard kick to retake the lead on the first play of the final quarter.

The Raiders would tie the game with another field goal with 7:11 remaining, but another McManus field goal would retake the three-point lead with 3:34 left.

After a pair of punts, Las Vegas took their final drive 71-yards and tied the game with a field goal with 16 second left.

Las Vegas would win the coin toss in overtime and take advantage, only needing three plays to go 67 yards and end with another Adams touchdown from 35 yards out to give Las Vegas the 22-16 win.

Denver hit the road for their first of a back-to-back game road trip on the east coast, falling to the Carolina Panthers by the score of 10-23 in Charlotte.

S Justin Simmons led the way for the Broncos in the game, totaling nine total tackles (4 solo) in the game while ILB Josey Jewell forced a fumble and CB Pat Surtain II tallied a pass defended.

Overall, Denver allowed fewer than 200 passing yards total in the game, the eighth time they have done so in the season. That mark ties the Dallas Cowboys for the most such games at this point in 2022.

Offensively, QB Russell Wilson notched his 300th career passing touchdown, finding WR Brandon Johnson in the end zone for his first career NFL receiving score.

Wilson became just the fifth active NFL QB to reach 300 career passing scores and the seventh-fastest to reach that milestone in NFL history.

The first quarter got off to a slow start as both offenses were forced to punt on their first two possessions of the game.

That changed on Carolina's third possession, where they were able to break through with the help of a couple of long plays from WR D.J. Moore and RB D'Onta Foreman. QB Sam Darnold found Moore in the back of the end zone for the score, giving Carolina the lead.

The Broncos were able to answer back with a drive of their own to bring the score to 7-3 after a muffed punt by Carolina that was recovered by S Delarrin Turner-Yell gave Denver another shot.

Carolina answered with a field goal of their own though on their next drive and the teams would trade punts before going into half-time with the score 10-3.

After a Broncos punt, Carolina was able to drive down the field to extend their lead to 17-3 after Moore caught another long pass and set up a one-yard run by Darnold.

Denver was unable to answer back the remainder of the quarter, allowing Carolina to take a larger lead, kicking a field goal to make it 20-3 then recovering a fumble on the ensuing kickoff that led to another field goal.

Denver was able to then get on the score sheet again, driving77 yards on 14 plays in 5:40 in the fourth quarter and was completed when Wilson found Johnson in the end zone for the score. Johnson became the third Broncos rookie to post their first receiving score, joining WR Jalen Virgil and TE Greg Dulcich.

The Broncos were able to recover the onside kick, but that would not prove to be enough as Carolina was able to stop them and seal the game at 23-10.

Ravens 10, Broncos 9

The Broncos finished their two-game road trip in Baltimore on a clear day, but were unable to hold off the Ravens at the very end of the game, falling 10-9.

Denver's defense came up with another stellar performance, preventing Baltimore from scoring until their last drive of the game. The defense also limited the Ravens to 3-of-13 (23.1%) on third down and notched four sacks and two takeaways.

Leading the defensive effort was S Justin Simmons, who came up with two picks while also forcing a fumble and making five tackles (2 solo).

ILB Alex Singleton and ILB Josey Jewell tied for the team high in tackles, getting 17 each. Singleton's 17 tackles got him to the century mark on the season, his third consecutive year with at least 100 tackles.

OLB Baron Browning and OLB Jonathon Cooper both posted sacks in the game while DL DeShawn Williams tied his career high with two sacks in the contest.

QB Russell Wilson posted his 86th career game with a 100-plus passer rating (102.3), finishing the game with 189 yards on 17-of-22 passing.

TE Greg Dulcich led all receivers, finishing with six catches for 85 yards (14.2 avg.) while WR Jerry Jeudy tallied 65 yards on four receptions (16.3 avg.).

Denver struck early in the game as they were able to take their opening possession 49 yards on 11 plays to help set up a Brandon McManus 52-yard field goal to take the 3-0 lead.

Baltimore would have to wait to respond as teams traded punts the remainder of the quarter, but the Ravens answered with a field goal of their own in the second frame with a K Justin Tucker 26-yard attempt.

McManus would get on the board again as a 41-yard kick went through the uprights with 0:42 remaining in the half and would end with a Broncos 6-3.

McManus would hit from 50-plus again, giving the Broncos a 9-3 lead in the third quarter. McManus' kick marked a new franchise record for most 50-plus yard field goals in Broncos' history (38), eclipsing the previous record held by Broncos Ring of Fame K Jason Elam (37).

The teams would not be able to do anything for most of the game until the very end as Simmons would intercept another pass in the end zone, but the Ravens would capitalize at the end when they drove 91 yards and scored to take the lead with 0:31 remaining in the game.

Denver tried to drive the field at the end for a field goal, but the 63-yard attempt fell short and ended the game.

Chiefs 34, Broncos 28

The Broncos fell behind early, but made a strong comeback attempt that ended up just short in the end as they fell to the Chiefs by the score of 34-28.

QB Russell Wilson finished the game with three passing scores to go along with 247 yards on 23-of-36 passing for a 100.1 passer rating. It was Wilson's second-consecutive game with a 100+ passer rating, the first such streak of his since 12/26/21-9/12/2 (4 games).

WR Jerry Jeudy also came up big in the game, notching his first multi-score game of his career and became the first Bronco player to record 3+ receiving touchdowns in a game since former Broncos WR Demaryius Thomas had three vs. Mia (11/23/14).

RB Marlon Mack posted a long touchdown catch, taking the screen from Wilson 66 yards to post his longest-career catch and the longest touchdown catch by a Broncos running back since former Broncos RB Kapri Bibbs' 69-yarder at Oak. (11/6/16).

ILB Josey Jewell picked off two passes from Chiefs QB Patrick Mahomes, becoming the first Broncos linebacker with multiple interceptions in a game since former Broncos LB Al Wilson has two at Stl. (9/4/00). Jewell also posted a team-high 10 tackles in the game, his second-straight game with double-digit tackles.

CB Pat Surtain II got his first pick of the season coming with less than two minutes left in the first half and led to a touchdown for the Broncos right before the half.

The game got off to a rough start for Denver as the Chiefs converted the first five scores of the game to take the 27-0 lead late in the first half.

After forcing the Chiefs to settle for two field goals to start the game, Mahomes made a highlight reel underhand pass for the first touchdown of the game to Chiefs RB Jerick McKinnon for 59 yards. McKinnon also took the ball 10 yards on a screen the next drive for the score.

Chiefs LB Willie Gay intercepted a Wilson pass and took it 47 yards for the touchdown, but then the Broncos began to mount their comeback.

Jewell intercepted a pass by Mahomes on the next Kansas City drive to help set up a 42-yard drive by Denver for the first touchdown, then Surtain added another pick to set up another score with nine seconds remaining in the half to make the score 27-14.

The Broncos opened up hot in the second half with Mack's 66-yard touchdown score, but both defenses would calm things down as both teams would punt on their next two drives.

A score by Chiefs WR JuJu Smith-Schuster seemed to put Kansas City ahead for good, but a late touchdown pass from Denver QB Brett Rypien to Jeudy made it a one score game.

That would be it though, as Denver could not convert late to tie the game and Kansas City would take the close victory, 34-28.

Denver got back on the winning track after making a third-quarter comeback to defeat the Arizona Cardinals 24-15.

The Broncos defense held the Cardinals to only 13 first downs in the game and picked off Arizona three times, giving them their first back-to-back games with three interceptions since 2000.

Denver was also able to hold Arizona to 2-of-12 (16.7%) on third down.

The offense picked it up in the second half, scoring 21 unanswered points starting in the third quarter to help propel Denver to the win.

S Justin Simmons led the charge defensively, picking off another two passes in the game to give him five total this season. He became the only player in the NFL to pick off at least four passes in each of the last four years and became the first Bronco since Champ Bailey in 2006 to post multiple multi-pick games in a single season.

CB Pat Surtain II also go in on the action, making another interception in his second-straight game while ILB Josey Jewell made 10 tackles (5 solo) to lead the team.

QB Brett Rypien stepped in for an injured QB Russell Wilson and was able to throw for 197 yards on 12-of-26 passing with one touchdown and one interception (95.0 rtg.). His 80.8 completion percentage is tied for the ninth-highest in a single game by a Broncos signal caller.

RB Latavius Murray also had a career day, finishing with 130 rushing yards and a rushing score on 24 carries (5.4 avg.). His performance helped him eclipse 6,000 career rushing yards, becoming the sixth active RB to do so, and became the only player in the NFL with at least 500 rushing yards in each of the last eight years.

Denver got off to a quick start as they were able to take the opening kick down the field to set up K Brandon McManus' 39th career 50+-yard field goal to take the 3-0 lead.

The offense would not be able to get anything going the rest of the half though as Arizona would take the opportunity to get three field goals of their own to take the 9-3 lead early in the third quarter.

Denver would answer right back though, as they would take the next drive 80 yards to retake the lead off of a RB Marlon Mack 3-yard touchdown run to make it 10-9.

Denver would not take the foot off the gas as Murray would find the end zone from 10 yards out early in the fourth quarter and an interception by Simmons would set up a 3-yard touchdown pass from Rypien to TE Eric Tomlinson.

The Cardinals would answer with a score of their own, but a failed two-point conversion would keep it 24-15.

The Cardinals would take over just under the two-minute mark, but an interception by Surtain would close the book on any comeback and give Denver the win.

Denver fell on Christmas day to the Los Angeles Rams at SoFi Stadium by the score of 51-14.

The Broncos were not able to sustain much success on either side of the ball as the Rams were able to dictate much of the game to score the most points against Denver in 2022.

WR Jerry Jeudy had another outstanding performance, posting his fourth career 100-yard performance as he brought in six receptions for 117 yards (19.5 avg.).

WR Courtland Sutton also had a solid day on the outside, posting 64 yards on five receptions (12.8 avg.) while TE Greg Dulcich brought in the only touchdown for Denver to go along with 39 yards on four catches (9.8 avg.)

On the defensive side, ILB Alex Singleton had another stand-out performance, tallying his second 20+ tackle game of the season and of his career. He became the first NFL player since at least 1994 to post multiple games of 20+ tackles in a single season.

ILB Josey Jewell also posted double digit tackles for the seventh time of the season, tied for the ninth-most such games by an NFL player since at least 1994 in a player's first 11 games of a season.

The Rams got off to a quick start, going 38 yards in 11 plays to set up K Matt Gay for the 55-yard field goal and the 3-0 lead.

Denver gave the ball back after QB Russell Wilson was picked off by CB Cobie Durant, which helped set up a TE Tyler Higbee touchdown from QB Baker Mayfield to take the 10-0 lead.

After another interception, this time by LB Bobby Wagner, the Rams took a commanding 17-0 lead with a RB Cam Akers 2-yard touchdown score.

Denver was able to get on the board the next possession though, getting to the Rams' 36 yard line to set up a K Brandon McManus 54-yard field goal to make it 17-3.

The Rams would answer right back though, as Mayfield would find Higbee again, this time from seven yards out, to make the score 24-3 early in the second quarter.

After a punt by Denver, Los Angeles would score again from Akers, as he would find the end zone from two yards out to make the score 31-3.

McManus would get another field goal right before half, making the score 31-6 going into the break.

Los Angeles would get that back out of the break, intercepting a pass and helping set up a Matt Gay 30-yard field goal.

TE Greg Dulcich would find the end zone for the Broncos late in the fourth quarter and RB Latavius Murray would get the two point conversion, but another Akers score and a pick-six by Durant would keep the Rams in front and give Denver its 11th loss this season.

The Broncos went into GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium in Kansas City and almost knocked off the Chiefs on New Years Day, eventually falling 27-24.

QB Russell Wilson made history in the game, surpassing former NFL QB Randall Cunningham for the third-most rushing yards by an NFL quarterback (4,948) in league history. Wilson finished the game with four carries for 27 yards (6.8 avg.) and his third-career multi rushing score game with two.

In the air, Wilson finished with 222 yards and one touchdown on 27-of-38 passing for an 81.2 passer rating.

TE Albert Okwuegbunam recorded his first touchdown on the season, pulling in a 25-yard pass from Wilson in the third quarter to go along with three catches for a team-high 45 yards (15.0 avg.).

Defensively, ILB Alex Singleton, ILB Josey Jewell and S Kareem Jackson led the charge with seven tackles each to lead the team in the category.

CB Lamar Jackson also totaled a career high two passes defended to go along with three solo tackles. S Justin Simmons kept his hot season going, picking off Chiefs QB Patrick Mahomes in the second quarter for a career-high sixth interception this season.

After forcing a Denver three-and-out on their first possession, the Chiefs took the ball down the field for the early score when Chiefs RB Isiah Pacheco took it in from five yards out. A bad snap though would prevent the point after, keeping the score at 6-0.

The Broncos would get on the board early in the second quarter though as a 14-play drive would set up a K Brandon McManus 49-yard field goal attempt to cut the Kansas City lead in half.

After a Simmons pick of Mahomes in the end zone, Denver caught a break as Singleton forced a fumble on Chiefs WR Kadarius Toney and was recovered by TE Eric Saubert. Wilson would take advantage of the situation and run the ball in from 16-yards out, breaking Cunningham's rushing mark in the process.

The Chiefs would answer right back though as Mahomes found Chiefs RB Jerick McKinnon for the six-yard receiving score to retake the six point lead. Kansas City would try to expand that lead going into half, but DL Eyioma Uwazurike blocked a Chiefs K Harrison Butler kick at the end of the half.

Okwuegbunam would get the lead back for the Broncos midway through the third quarter, catching the 25-yard pass from Wilson to take the 17-13 lead, but Kansas City got the lead back on the first play of the fourth quarter on a pass to Chiefs TE Blake Bell.

A Wilson interception set up a Chiefs field goal, but would get it back with a four-yard run for another score, making it 27-24.

The Broncos made a comeback attempt, but the fourth-down pass would be incomplete, giving Kansas City the win.

Broncos 31, Chargers 28

Sunday, Jan. 8, 2023 • 2:25 p.m. MST • Empower Field at Mile High • Denver

Denver finished the 2022 season on a strong note, getting their first AFC West win of the season after taking down the Los Angeles Chargers 31-28 at Empower Field at Mile High.

With the season finale win, Denver clinched its 500th regular-season win in franchise history and the 300th regular-season home win.

The offense had their best production of the season, totaling 471 total yards, including 205 yards on the ground. It was the most total yards by the Broncos since totaling 503 yards vs. S.D. (1/3/16) and the first 200-yard rushing performance since gaining 218 on the ground at Cin. (12/2/18).

QB Russell Wilson posted his 88th career 100+ passer rating game, completing 13-of-24 passes for 283 yards with three touchdowns and an interception. It was also Wilson's 95th career multi-passing touchdown game.

Wilson also connected on three passes of 50+ yards in the game, noting the first time a Denver signal caller has completed as many such passes in a game since at least 1994.

WR Jerry Jeudy was the recipient of two of those passes, marking the first time a Denver player had two receptions of 50+ yards since former Broncos WR Anthony Miller at K.C. (12/4/94).

Jeudy also notched his third 100-yard receiving game of the season and his fifth of his career with a career-high 154 yards. He also totaled 193 scrimmage yards, the most by a Bronco since former Broncos WR Emmanuel Sanders totaled 205 yards at Pit. (12/20/15).

RB Latavius Murray produced his 14th career 100-yard rushing game and second of the season, totaling 103 yards on 15 carries (6.9 avg.) with a touchdown. He also tied Chiefs RB Melvin Gordon III for the fourth-most career rushing scores (55) by an active running back.

S Justin Simmons forced two fumbles and made 10 tackles in the game, becoming the first Broncos safety with multiple forced fumbles in a game since Pro Football Hall of Fame S John Lynch at S.D. (12/31/05).

ILB Alex Singleton led the team in tackles with 11 (7 solo) to finish the season with the third-most defensive tackles (152) by a Bronco in a single season according to Press Box Stats and the most since former Broncos LB Michael Brooks (170, 1992).

Denver allowed a quick touchdown on the opening possession, but answered right back as Murray capped off a 13-play, 75-yard drive with a two-yard rushing score to tie it up at 7-7.

The Chargers would get the lead back though in the second quarter with QB Justin Herbert's second passing score of the game, but the Broncos would get points on the board with a 33-yard field goal from K Brandon McManus to make it 14-10.

A field goal from the Chargers with 0:31 seconds left in the half seemed to make it a 17-10 game going into the break, but a 57-yard connection between Wilson and Jeudy helped set up a three-yard score from Wilson to TE Eric Tomlinson to tie the game at 17 at the break.

The Broncos would score again on the opening possession of the second half and would not look back the rest of the game. RB Tyler Badie took the 24-yard pass from Wilson into the end zone, becoming the first Bronco running back since Colts RB Phillip Lindsay in 2018 to score in his first career game.

After a field goal by Los Angeles, WR Courtland Sutton caught his second touchdown of the season to put the game out of reach.

The Chargers made a late push with a score and two-point conversion, but would not be enough and keep the score at 31-28.
