SEATTLE MARINERS EXPAND RELATIONSHIP WITH NINTENDO WITH TEAM'S FIRST-EVER JERSEY SLEEVE PARTNERSHIP

Mariners partner since 1992, Nintendo will now be featured on uniforms starting Opening Day

SEATTLE, Wash. – The **Seattle Mariners** announced today that **Nintendo of America Inc.** has expanded upon their long-standing relationship with the club, becoming the team's first-ever official jersey sleeve partner.

Nintendo will be featured on the Mariners jersey sleeve for all regular season and postseason games. The mark will debut on the Mariners jerseys on Opening Day, March 27 vs. the A's at T-Mobile Park.
