TODAY'S GAME: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos play their fourth game of the week versus Biloxi on Saturday, May 10.

LAST NIGHT: The Wahoos and Shuckers did not play on Friday, May 8 due to inclement weather. Pensacola and Biloxi last played in a doubleheader on Thursday, May 8 following a weather postponement the day prior. Biloxi swept the twin bill by a combined score of 15-2. The Shuckers shut out Pensacola 10-0 in Game 1 behind RHP Coleman Crow (4.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and five extra-base hits to hand LHP Robby Snelling (2.0 IP, 7 R) his first loss of the year. In Game 2, Biloxi allowed a first-inning run but quickly shut down the Wahoos, who were held quiet by RHP Abdiel Mendoza (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER). The sweep marked the first time all season Pensacola has lost back-to-back games.

DOUBLEHEADER HISTORY: Following Thursday's doubleheader, the Wahoos are now 0-1-1 in doubleheaders and 1-3 overall in DH games. Thursday's loss in both games marked the first time since 9/12/24 that Pensacola had been swept in a twin bill (vs. MTG, 10-3 G1, 4-3 G2). The Biscuits swept two doubleheaders against the Wahoos in 2024, with the other coming April 13 at Riverwalk Stadium (2-0 G1, 6-0 G2).

WAHOOS SPLIT SERIES WITH BARONS: Pensacola fell 4-3 on Sunday at Regions Field to split its series 3-3 with Birmingham...result marked the first time in 2025 the Blue Wahoos have not won a series outright...Pensacola fell behind 4-0 after three innings via a pair of Barons two-run home runs (M. Camilletti, J. Gonzalez) against RHP Orlando Ortiz-Mayr. The Wahoos scored three runs in the top of the seventh inning, but stranded runners at third base in both the seventh and ninth innings en route to a defeat.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Blue Wahoos have the best record (19-11) and lowest ERA (2.87) in Double-A...their team ERA is third-lowest in MiLB, with only High-A Quad Cities (2.46) and High-A Hudson Valley (2.71) ahead.

APRIL POWERS: The Blue Wahoos finished April with the best record in Double-A at 16-7...it was their best month since going 11-4 in September 2023, and their best non-September month by winning percentage in team history.

THE DOCTOR IS IN: Right-handed pitcher M.D. Johnson joined the Blue Wahoos on Wednesday, April 30 from extended spring training, and worked a scoreless inning in game one of May 3's doubleheader...Johnson has been a mainstay in the Pensacola rotation since 2023, going 6-11 with a 4.92 ERA in 39 starts the past two seasons.

KING STINGS: Left-handed pitcher Justin King was placed on the injured list on Wednesday, April 30...King was 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA in four relief appearances for the Blue Wahoos this season, but left during April 26 game against Knoxville with an apparent lower body injury.

DALVY DIPS: Outfielder Dalvy Rosario was transferred to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday, May 6 as former Blue Wahoos first baseman Troy Johnston was placed on the paternity list...Rosario batted .118 in 10 games for the Blue Wahoos this season...Rosario hit two homers for the Jumbo Shrimp on May 3.

MACK, COME BACK!: Catcher Joe Mack was promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on April 22...Mack, the 2024 team MVP and a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove winner, was leading the Southern League in OPS (1.078) through the team's first 15 games.

RUNNING WILD: The Blue Wahoos lead the Southern League in stolen bases (54)...Marlins affiliates are stealing bases at record paces, with Triple-A Jacksonville ranking fourth in MiLB (87) and High-A Beloit tied for first place in MiLB with 95 steals...the Blue Wahoos' team record is 163 stolen bases in 2024, paced by Nasim Nuñez's single-season individual record of 52 bases.

ALUMNI REPORT: Left-handed pitcher Cade Gibson made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 20 with 2.1 scoreless innings...Gibson, 27, pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2024 and went 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 7 games (3 starts)...Gibson became the 145th former Blue Wahoo to make their MLB debut since 2012, and third so far in 2025 (RHP Luarbert Arias-MIA, LHP Patrick Monteverde-MIA).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Josh White is tied for the Southern League lead in wins (4), Dale Stanavich is tied for first in saves (5), Jacob Miller is fifth in ERA (2.63), and Robby Snelling is fourth in strikeouts (35).

IN THE PIPELINE: Pensacola has 5 players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: Left-handed pitcher Robby Snelling (#8), outfielder Kemp Alderman (#11), left-handed pitcher Dax Fulton (#14), infielder Jared Serna (#16) and right-handed pitcher Josh Ekness (#28).

MILESTONE METER: Cody Morissette: 27 HR (5th; next Johnston w/ 28), 101 RBI (6th; next Aquino w/ 111), 101 R (9th, next Aquino w/ 103), 24 SB (10th, next Sasaki w/ 25); Luis Palacios: 20 wins (1st in Blue Wahoos history); 260.1 IP (3rd; next Corcino w/ 288.0); Zach McCambley: 246 strikeouts (3rd; next Stephenson w/ 247); Evan Fitterer: 15 career wins (5th; next Smith w/ 16), 227.1 IP (T-6th, next Adleman w/ 229.0); Shane Sasaki: 29 stolen bases (7th; next Marsee w/ 32).

UP NEXT: The Blue Wahoos return home on May 13 to begin a two-week homestand with a six game series versus the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

TODAY'S START: Dax Fulton makes his fifth start of 2025 on Saturday at Biloxi.

LAST TIME OUT: Fulton last pitched on May 3 at Birmingham in Game 1 of a doubleheader... took loss (3.0 IP, 2 H 2 ER 3 BB 4 K)...first loss of season...third time in four starts walking 3 batters...departed trailing 2-0, Wahoos lost 4-0.

AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: Fulton has faced Biloxi once in 2025...pitched on Sunday, April 6 during Opening Weekend...took no-decision in return to professional mound for the first time since 5/11/23...3.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 2 K...allowed Luke Adams' first career Double-A hit, an RBI single in T3...departed with game tied 3-3, Wahoos won 8-4.

IN THE PIPELINE: Fulton enters the 2025 season ranked as the No. 14 prospect in the Marlins' organization, per MLB Pipeline...on 20-80 scale, arsenal grades as follows: Fastball 55, Curveball 60, Slider 60, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 45...his profile reads: "has always exhibited tremendous feel for spin, long featuring a plus downer curveball and adding a slightly harder slider...uses his 6-7 frame to create plenty of extension, and he has the athleticism to repeat his mechanics."

2023 SEASON: In 2023, Fulton began a season at the Double-A level for the first time...season debut was April 7 versus Montgomery (4.1 IP, 1 ER)...pitched to a 6.45 ERA across 5 starts in April, but posted 2.53 ERA in two starts in May prior to placement on injury list...posted 2-4 record with 5.18 ERA in 7 appearances (6 starts) and 33.0 IP during 2023.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name is Daxton James Fulton...selected by Marlins in 2nd round (40th) of 2020 Draft out of Mustang High School (Oklahoma City, OK)... injured his elbow at the US 18-and-under trials in August 2019 and had Tommy John surgery a month later...missed senior season, but signed for \$2.4 million in draft, a record that still stands for a prep pitcher who missed senior year due to injury...plays guitar and has done so together with current teammate Evan Fitterer.
