TODAY'S GAME: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos play their second and third games of the week at Biloxi following yesterday's postponement.

LAST NIGHT: Pensacola and Biloxi did not play Wednesday due to a weather postponement...on Tuesday, Pensacola earned its fifth win in seven series openers with a 6-1 victory at Biloxi on Tuesday, May 6. The Wahoos grabbed a first-inning run and never trailed in the contest. Pensacola set a new season-high with 12 hits and saw Josh Zamora become the second player of the season to tally four hits in a game. RHP Jacob Miller earned the win with 1 ER over a season-high 7.0 IP.

DOUBLEHEADER HISTORY: The Blue Wahoos have played one prior doubleheader so far this year. On Saturday, May 3, Pensacola played a twin bill at Birmingham following a weather postponement on May 2. The Wahoos and Barons split the two games, with Birmingham winning Game 1 (4-0) and Pensacola winning Game 2 (4-1).

WAHOOS SPLIT SERIES WITH BARONS: Pensacola fell 4-3 on Sunday at Regions Field to split its series 3-3 with Birmingham...result marked the first time in 2025 the Blue Wahoos have not won a series outright...Pensacola fell behind 4-0 after three innings via a pair of Barons two-run home runs (M. Camilletti, J. Gonzalez) against RHP Orlando Ortiz-Mayr. The Wahoos scored three runs in the top of the seventh inning, but stranded runners at third base in both the seventh and ninth innings en route to a defeat.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Blue Wahoos have the best record (19-9) and lowest ERA (2.61) in Double-A...their team ERA is second-lowest in MiLB, with only High-A Quad Cities (2.31) producing better results and only High-A Hudson Valley (2.87) and Double-A Erie (2.99) below 3.00.

APRIL POWERS: The Blue Wahoos finished April with the best record in Double-A at 16-7...it was their best month since going 11-4 in September 2023, and their best non-September month by winning percentage in team history.

THE DOCTOR IS IN: Right-handed pitcher M.D. Johnson joined the Blue Wahoos on Wednesday from extended spring training, and worked a scoreless inning in game one of Saturday's doubleheader...Johnson has been a mainstay in the Pensacola rotation since 2023, going 6-11 with a 4.92 ERA in 39 starts the past two seasons.

KING STINGS: Left-handed pitcher Justin King was placed on the injured list on Wednesday...King was 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA in four relief appearances for the Blue Wahoos this season, but left Saturday's game against Knoxville with an apparent lower body injury.

DALVY DIPS: Outfielder Dalvy Rosario was transferred to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday as former Blue Wahoos first baseman Troy Johnston was placed on the paternity list...Rosario batted .118 in 10 games for the Blue Wahoos this season...Rosario hit two homers for the Jumbo Shrimp on Saturday night.

MACK, COME BACK!: Catcher Joe Mack was promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on April 22...Mack, the 2024 team MVP and a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove winner, was leading the Southern League in OPS (1.078) through the team's first 15 games.

BURGEONING BERGIN: Right-handed pitcher Jesse Bergin joined the Blue Wahoos last week, and earned the save on Thursday and Saturday in his first two Double-A appearances...he made 5 appearances for the High-A Beloit Sky Carp, going 1-0 with a 2.00 ERA...he struck out 16 batters in 9.0 innings.

RUNNING WILD: The Blue Wahoos lead the Southern League in stolen bases (54)...Marlins affiliates are stealing bases at record paces, with Triple-A Jacksonville and High-A Beloit tied for third place in MiLB with 87 steals apiece...the Blue Wahoos' team record is 163 stolen bases in 2024, paced by Nasim Nuñez's single-season individual record of 52 bases.

HOLD STEADY: The Blue Wahoos have made only 13 roster moves so far this season...they made 21 roster moves in the month of April in 2024.

ALUMNI REPORT: Left-handed pitcher Cade Gibson made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 20 with 2.1 scoreless innings...Gibson, 27, pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2024 and went 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 7 games (3 starts)...Gibson became the 145th former Blue Wahoo to make their MLB debut since 2012, and third so far in 2025 (RHP Lumarbert Arias-MIA, LHP Patrick Monteverde-MIA).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Josh White is tied for the Southern League lead in wins (4), Dale Stanavich leads in saves (5), Evan Fitterer is second in ERA (1.82), and Robby Snelling is fifth in strikeouts (33).

IN THE PIPELINE: Pensacola has 5 players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: Left-handed pitcher Robby Snelling (#8), outfielder Kemp Alderman (#11), left-handed pitcher Dax Fulton (#14), infielder Jared Serna (#16) and right-handed pitcher Josh Eknese (#28).

MILESTONE METER: Cody Morissette: 27 HR (5th; next Johnston w/ 28), 101 RBI (6th; next Aquino w/ 111), 101 R (9th; next Aquino w/ 103), 24 SB (10th; next Sasaki w/ 25); Luis Palacios: 20 wins (1st in Blue Wahoos history); 260.1 IP (3rd; next Corcino w/ 288.0); Zach McCambley: 244 strikeouts (3rd; next Stephenson w/ 247); Evan Fitterer: 15 career wins (5th; next Smith w/ 16), 226.2 IP (T-6th; next Adleman w/ 229.0); Shane Sasaki: 29 stolen bases (7th; next Marsee w/ 32).

TODAY'S START: Robby Snelling makes his sixth start of the year on Thursday at Biloxi.

LAST TIME OUT: Snelling last pitched on April 30 at Birmingham...facing White Sox No. 1 prospect Noah Schultz, took loss (3.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 4 BB, 4 K)...4 BB tied Blue Wahoos career-high, 3.2 IP was shortest start with Pensacola and shortest since July 24, 2024 with San Antonio (at Midland, 3.0 IP)...departed game trailing 3-2, Wahoos lost 4-2.

AGAINST THE BARONS: Snelling has faced Biloxi once in his career...faced Shuckers on Opening Day on April 4, 2025...earned win (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).

FORMER MISSION: Snelling was acquired, along with infielder Graham Pauley, right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur and infielder Jay Beshears, in a July 30 trade that sent relievers Tanner Scott and Bryan Hoeing to the Padres...formerly pitched for the San Antonio Missions (SD Double-A) in the Texas League...final 4 starts of 2023 were with San Antonio, and had spent entirety of '24 season with Missions prior to July 30 trade.

IN THE PIPELINE: Snelling is currently ranked the #8 prospect in the Marlins organization, per MLB Pipeline...his profile reads: "Drew interest from college programs as both a pitcher and linebacker...his football background shows his aggressive mentality on the mound...fading changeup can elicit some ugly swings...best pitch is a low-80s slurve."

LAST YEAR: Snelling began the year with Double-A San Antonio within the Padres' organization...made 16 starts for Missions, posted 6.01 ERA prior to July 30 trade to Marlins...assigned to Double-A Pensacola following trade...made Blue Wahoos debut on August 4 at Chattanooga, took no-decision (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 K)...earned first Blue Wahoos win on 8/10 at Mississippi (5.0 IP, 0 R, 0 BB, 7 K)...posted season-high, Blue Wahoos career-high 9 Ks on 8/17 versus MTG...earned first career Triple-A promotion in September, made Triple-A debut on 9/20 versus Gwinnett...posted 5.15 ERA in 24 starts across three affiliates in 2024.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name Robert Matthew Snelling...originally drafted by Padres in Competitive Balance Round A (39th) of 2022 Draft out of McQueen High School (Reno, NV)...set Nevada state single-season strikeout record senior year of high school with 146 strikeouts in 62.1 IP...played outside linebacker for his dad in high school football, and committed to play both baseball and football at the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Padres.

TONIGHT'S START: Evan Fitterer makes his fifth start and sixth appearance on Thursday at Biloxi.

LAST TIME OUT: Fitterer last pitched on May 1 at Birmingham coming off April performance that earned SL Pitcher of the Month honors...took no-decision (4.0 IP, 3 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...season-highs in R, BB, and season-low 4.0 IP...departed trailing 3-1, Wahoos eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings.

AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: Fitterer has faced Biloxi once this year...earned win in Saturday start on Opening Weekend...5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 K...last season, faced Shuckers twice...combined 2.41 ERA (11.2 IP, 3 ER)...earned win in both starts (4/26/24, 5/30/24).

SCORELESS STREAK: In 2024, Fitterer worked 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings from April 19 through May 10...it was the ninth-longest scoreless streak in Blue Wahoos history.

SCOUT TALK: When Fitterer was a ranked prospect in the Marlins organization, his pitches received the following grades: FB 50, SL 50, CV 50, CH 50, Control 45, Overall 40...his MLB Pipeline scouting report read: "Fastball usually ranges from 92-95 mph with natural sink and cut, and it stands out more for its ability to generate weak contact than for missing bats...best secondary pitch is a sinking low-80s changeup that helped him have more success against left-handers than right-handers in 2022...has some feel for spinning the ball, though his upper-70s curveball and low-80s slider can blend together at times."

LAST YEAR: Fitterer began his 2024 season in Pensacola as the team's Opening Day starter...lengthy scoreless innings streak between April-May (see above), 3.41 ERA across five May starts...earned first career Triple-A promotion on June 25...made Triple-A debut on June 27 versus Nashville (5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R)...7.71 ERA across six Triple-A starts, re-assigned to Double-A on August 6 to finish year with Pensacola.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name: Evan Otto Fitterer...missed significant time in 2021 due to back and shoulder injuries...selected in the 5th round of the 2019 Draft out of Aliso Niguel HS in Southern California, also the alma mater of Marlins manager Skip Schumaker...in Draft evaluations, compared to "Kyle Hendricks with better stuff"...was committed to UCLA before signing with Miami...favorite movie is Shrek 2...favorite baseball player growing up was Zack Greinke...formerly wore number 17 as a nod to Master Chief John-117 in the video game Halo...is an avid guitarist and helped teach 2022 Beloit roommate Dax Fulton to play.
