TODAY'S START: Jacob Miller makes his fifth start of the season on Tuesday at Biloxi.

LAST TIME OUT: Miller last pitched on April 29 at Birmingham...no-decision despite quality start (6.1 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 5 K)...season-high 6.1 IP...entered B7 with 2-0 lead, but allowed 2 R to tie game before exit...Wahoos eventually won 3-2.

AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: Miller has never faced the Shuckers in his career.

LAST YEAR: Miller began the 2024 season with High-A Beloit...made 16 starts for Sky Carp, posted 4.02 ERA across 80.2 IP...logged 1.82 ERA across four June starts...earned first career Double-A promotion on July 31, 2024...made Double-A debut on August 2 at Chattanooga in a game that had been postponed twice due to rain...allowed 4 ER in first Double-A start, but allowed just 4 ER combined in following four starts...posted 3.44 ERA in 7 starts with Pensacola...collective 3.85 ERA in 23 starts between High-A, Double-A in 2024.

SPLIT DECISION: Entering 2025, Miller has added a splitter to his pitch arsenal, replacing his straight changeup...during Media Day (4/2/25) interview, noted that the pitch got "uncomfortable takes" during Spring Training work and described its break having "a little knuckle on it."

IN THE PIPELINE: Miller was formerly ranked as Miami's #28 prospect in 2024, per MLB Pipeline...his prospect profile read: "Even when Miller sat at 91-95 mph with his fastball in high school, there were some concerns about its mild armside run and pedestrian metrics, and hitters teed off on his heater when it parked at 88-90 early in 2023...has switched to a sinker this year and it has operated in the low 90s with more life than his four-seamer...always has shown good feel spin, generating high RPMs and plenty of depth on an upper-70s curveball and a tighter mid-80s slider...high-three-quarters arm slot creates atypical angle and helps him stay on top of his curveball and slider, which he commands better than most youngsters."

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name Jacob Lee Miller...drafted by Marlins in 2nd round (46th) of 2022 Draft out of Liberty Union High School in Baltimore, OH...Gatorade's Ohio high school player of the year in 2022...signed for a \$1.7 million dollar bonus.
