**TODAY'S GAME:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Birmingham Barons, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, on Wednesday night.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Blue Wahoos fell 6-2 to the Barons on Tuesday...after scoring two runs in the first inning on a Kemp Alderman RBI single, the Blue Wahoos managed just three hits and no runs the rest of the night...Jacob Miller took the loss, allowing just one run through 5.0 innings but allowing three runs in his sixth and final frame...Josh White allowed two runs in 2.0 innings of relief.

**RETURN OF THE KING:** The Blue Wahoos activated left-handed pitcher Justin King from the injured list on Tuesday...King had been on the injured list since April 30...in four Double-A appearances this season, King is 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA.

**BORN A MCCAMBLIN' MAN:** Right-handed reliever Zach McCambley earned his first promotion to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday...he was the longest-tenured Blue Wahoos player, having pitched for the team since 2021, and was second in team history with 251 strikeouts...this season, McCambley was 1-0 with a 2.11 ERA in 11 appearances, striking out 31 batters in 21.1 innings.

**BARON BALL:** The Blue Wahoos are 93-69 all-time against the Barons, including 3-4 in 2025...the two teams split a six-game series at Regions Field April 29-May 4...the Barons make one more trip to Pensacola August 12-17.

**THE RACE IS ON:** There are 29 games remaining in the first half of the season...the Blue Wahoos are 1.0 game behind the Biloxi Shuckers for first place in the South Division, and the Shuckers have the head-to-head tiebreaker with a 5-4 edge in the season series...Montgomery is 1.5 games back of Pensacola, and 2.5 games back of Biloxi...the Blue Wahoos won the first half in 2022 and 2023, and were in contention in 2024 until the final day of the first half schedule.

**MAY? NO WAY:** The Blue Wahoos had the best April record in Double-A at 16-7, their best full month by winning percentage in team history...their 2.52 ERA was tied for the lowest in MiLB...in May, however, the Blue Wahoos are 7-10 with a team ERA of 4.24 that is the highest in the Southern League.

**HERE COMES TRIMBLE:** Outfielder Fenwick Trimble joined the Blue Wahoos from High-A Beloit on Tuesday...through five games, he is 4-for-17 with a homer, double, five walks and three RBI...Trimble, selected in the fourth round of the 2024 Draft, became the first member of Miami's 2024 Draft class to reach Pensacola...he began the season batting .290/.413/.430 with 1 home run and 14 RBI in 28 games for the Sky Carp.

**LANE TRAIN DERAILED:** Right-handed pitcher Lane Ramsey was placed on the injured list last Tuesday, retroactive to May 11...he was 0-1 with a 2.84 ERA in 12.2 innings for the Blue Wahoos.

**ROAD WOES:** The Blue Wahoos endured a 4-8 road trip in Birmingham and Biloxi April 29-May 11...it was their longest road trip of the season...the Blue Wahoos are 8-10 on the road, and are hitting .196 with a .566 team OPS away from Blue Wahoos Stadium...both figures rank worst in the Southern League.

**RUNNING WILD:** The Blue Wahoos are second in the Southern League in stolen bases (62)...Marlins affiliates are stealing bases at record paces, with High-A Beloit first in MiLB with 123 steals and Triple-A Jacksonville in fourth with 107...the Blue Wahoos' team record is 163 stolen bases in 2024, paced by Nasim Nuñez's single-season individual record of 52 bases.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Left-handed pitcher Cade Gibson made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 20 with 2.1 scoreless innings...Gibson, 27, pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2024 and went 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 7 games (3 starts)...Gibson became the 145th former Blue Wahoo to make their MLB debut since 2012, and third so far in 2025 (RHP Luarbert Arias-MIA, LHP Patrick Monteverde-MIA).

**LEAGUE LEADERBOARD:** Josh White is tied for the Southern League lead in wins (4), Dale Stanavich is tied for first in saves (6), Robby Snelling is tied for fifth in strikeouts (42) and Jacob Miller is fifth in ERA (2.82)...Jake Thompson is second in doubles (10).

**IN THE PIPELINE:** Pensacola has 5 players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: Left-handed pitcher Robby Snelling (#3; #94 overall), outfielder Kemp Alderman (#11), left-handed pitcher Dax Fulton (#14), infielder Jared Serna (#15) and right-handed pitcher Josh Ekness (#27).

**MILESTONE METER:** Cody Morissette: 27 HR (5th; next Johnston w/ 28), 101 RBI (6th; next Aquino w/ 111), 101 R (9th, next Aquino w/ 103), 24 SB (T-10th, next Mesa/Greene w/ 26); Luis Palacios: 21 wins (1st in Blue Wahoos history); 265.2 IP (3rd; next Corcino w/ 288.0); Evan Fitterer: 15 career wins (5th; next Smith w/ 16), 231.1 IP (T-4th, next Palacios w/ 265.2); Shane Sasaki: 32 stolen bases (T-6th; next Ervin w/ 40).

**UP NEXT:** The Blue Wahoos make their first trip to Riverwalk Stadium next week when they play the Montgomery Biscuits, Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays, in a six-game series.

**TODAY'S START:** Robby Snelling makes his eighth start of the season on Wednesday, May 21.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Snelling last pitched on May 14 versus Rocket City in an Education Day start...took loss (4.0 IP, 6 H, 5 ER, 4 BB, 7 K)...third straight loss and third straight game with 4+ walks...third consecutive losing decision is second-longest streak in career (6 straight losses w/ Double-A San Antonio, 5/23-6/27/24)...Trash Pandas scored two runs in 33-pitch first...Snelling departed trailing 3-0 in T5, Wahoos lost 9-0.

**AGAINST THE BARONS:** Snelling has faced Birmingham once this year and twice in his career...combined 2.97 ERA (9.1 IP, 3 ER)...first appearance came 9/6/24 at Regions Field (5.2 IP, 4 H, 0 R)...latest appearance was April 30 at Birmingham, took loss (3.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER).

**FORMER MISSION:** Snelling was acquired, along with infielder Graham Pauley, right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur and infielder Jay Beshears, in a July 30 trade that sent relievers Tanner Scott and Bryan Hoeing to the Padres...formerly pitched for the San Antonio Missions (SD Double-A) in the Texas League...final 4 starts of 2023 were with San Antonio, and had spent entirety of '24 season with Missions prior to July 30 trade.

**IN THE PIPELINE:** Snelling is currently ranked the #8 prospect in the Marlins organization, per MLB Pipeline...his profile reads: "Drew interest from college programs as both a pitcher and linebacker...his football background shows his aggressive mentality on the mound...fading changeup can elicit some ugly swings...best pitch is a low-80s slurve."

**LAST YEAR:** Snelling began the year with Double-A San Antonio within the Padres' organization...made 16 starts for Missions, posted 6.01 ERA prior to July 30 trade to Marlins...assigned to Double-A Pensacola following trade...made Blue Wahoos debut on August 4 at Chattanooga, took no-decision (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 K)...earned first Blue Wahoos win on 8/10 at Mississippi (5.0 IP, 0 R, 0 BB, 7 K)...posted season-high, Blue Wahoos career-high 9 Ks on 8/17 versus MTG...earned first career Triple-A promotion in September, made Triple-A debut on 9/20 versus Gwinnett...posted 5.15 ERA in 24 starts across three affiliates in 2024.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Full name Robert Matthew Snelling...originally drafted by Padres in Competitive Balance Round A (39th) of 2022 Draft out of McQueen High School (Reno, NV)...set Nevada state single-season strikeout record senior year of high school with 146 strikeouts in 62.1 IP...played outside linebacker for his dad in high school football, and committed to play both baseball and football at the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Padres.
