TODAY'S GAME: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos wrap up their series against the Birmingham Barons, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, on Sunday afternoon.

BLUE WAHOOS HANG ON TO BEAT BARONS: The Blue Wahoos continued their winning ways on Saturday night, beating Birmingham 6-5 for their seventh straight win...Victor Mesa hit a go-ahead three-run double in the fifth, and Griffin Conine added an RBI double in the sixth in what turned out to be the game-winner...Luis Palacios allowed five runs in 5.0+ innings in his season debut, earning the win...Austin Roberts and Brady Puckett contributed 2.2 innings of scoreless relief before Jefry Yan earned a four-out save by stranding two runners in the eighth and two more in the ninth.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: The Blue Wahoos have won seven in a row and 15 of their past 16 games, with only an 8-0 loss to Mississippi on May 5 separating an eight-game winning streak that tied a franchise record and an active seven-game winning streak...this is only their sixth winning streak of 7 or more games, and second already this season...they are outscoring opponents 98-46 in that stretch, with three shutout wins and a 5-0 record in one-run games.

CLEAN SWEEP: The Blue Wahoos have swept only one six-game series in franchise history: May 10-15, 2022 vs. Rocket City...it marked the first six games of a seven-game winning streak...in the finale, the Blue Wahoos came back to win 6-5 on a walk-off single from Victor Victor Mesa to cap a four-run ninth inning.

IT'S EURY TIME: Former Blue Wahoo Eury Pérez made his major league debut Friday in Miami against the Cincinnati Reds, striking out seven and allowing two runs in 4.2 innings and taking a no-decision as the Marlins fell 7-4...the 20-year-old became the fourth former Blue Wahoo to make his MLB debut this year (Jeff Lindgren-MIA, George Soriano-MIA, Drew Maggi-PIT), and the 124th all-time.

FIRST PLACE PENSACOLA: The Blue Wahoos have been in sole control of first place in the South Division since last Saturday, their 26th game of the season...they currently lead Biloxi by 2.0 games after the Shuckers lost to Rocket City yesterday...last year, the Blue Wahoos took control of first place on May 15 in their 31st game, eventually winning the first half title by 2.5 games...they never held first place in the second half of the 2022 season, finishing 8.0 games back of Montgomery.

STARTING STARS: The Blue Wahoos starting staff has been outstanding in their past 16 games...they are 9-0 with 17 earned runs in 87.1 innings, good for a 1.75 ERA.

ABOUT THE BARONS: The Blue Wahoos make the first of two trips to Birmingham, with another three-game series coming after the All-Star Break July 14-16...they dropped four of six to the Barons in Pensacola April 18-23...they are 7-4 against them so far in 2023, and 75-58 all-time.

ROSTER REMIX: As Eury Pérez had his contract selected by Miami on Friday to make his major league debut, the Blue Wahoos received right-handed pitcher Jake Walters from Triple-A Jacksonville...Walters started Friday night's 5-1 win over Birmingham, allowing only an unearned run over 4.0 innings in his Blue Wahoos debut.

BECKONING BENNETT: Bennett Hostetler hit a first-inning grand slam for his first Double-A hit on Thursday after an 0-for-8 start to his Blue Wahoos career...the infielder-turned-catcher had been playing with High-A Beloit, batting .129 in nine games...an 18th round selection in the 2021 Draft out of North Dakota State, he spent the entire 2022 season with the Sky Carp and split time between catcher and DH.

MONTH-AVERDE: Patrick Monteverde earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month honors for April...he allowed only one earned run over 26.0 innings and led the league in ERA (0.35), strikeouts (38) and WHIP (0.54)...all four of his starts were "quality starts" of at least 6.0 innings.

TRIPLES ARE BEST: The Blue Wahoos have had a flurry of 11 triples to start the 2023 season: Three from Troy Johnston, two from Victor Mesa Jr. and José Devers, and one each from Griffin Conine, J.D. Orr, Dane Myers and Nasim Núñez...the 11 triples are the most in the Southern League...the Blue Wahoos hit only 15 triples last season.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Blue Wahoos are leading the Southern League in the following categories: H (Mesa, 37), 2B (Mesa, 11), XBH (Johnston, 17), W (Monteverde, 4), G (Reynolds, 15), SV (Reynolds, 5), IP (Monteverde, 37.0) BAA (Monteverde, .131) and WHIP (Monteverde, 0.70).

LONG LIVE THE KING: Griffin Conine has homered three times this year, and 40 times in his Blue Wahoos career, to become Pensacola's franchise home run leader...with his first homer this year he passed Aristedes Aquino, who hit 37 between 2017 and 2018...Conine's 24 home runs in 2022 surpassed Peyton Burdick's previous single-season franchise mark of 23 set in 2021...with 74 RBI in 2022, Conine also surpassed Travis Mattair's single-season franchise RBI record of 69 set in 2014.

IN THE PIPELINE: The Blue Wahoos have eight players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: LHP Dax Fulton (#4), OF Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), IF Cody Morissette (#20), SS Nasim Núñez (#21), RHP Sean Reynolds (#25), RHP Evan Fitterer (#27), 1B Troy Johnston (#29) and LHP Patrick Monteverde (#30)...LHP Jake Eder (#5) and C Paul McIntosh (#28) are currently on the injured list.

TONIGHT'S START: Evan Fitterer makes his fourth Double-A start on Sunday against the Barons.

LAST TIME OUT: Fitterer earned his third win in as many Double-A starts in Tuesday's series opener against the Barons...he allowed two runs on four hits over 6.0 innings in a 4-2 victory...the only runs came on an Alsander Womack two-run homer in the third, snapping his scoreless innings streak at 13.0.

AGAINST THE BARONS: Fitterer had never faced Birmingham before Tuesday.

IN THE PIPELINE: Fitterer is currently ranked the #27 prospect in the Marlins organization, per MLB Pipeline...his pitches receive the following grades: FB 50, SL 50, CV 50, CH 50, Control 45, Overall 40...his scouting report reads: "Fastball usually ranges from 92-95 mph with natural sink and cut, and it stands out more for its ability to generate weak contact than for missing bats...best secondary pitch is a sinking low-80s changeup that helped him have more success against left-handers than right-handers in 2022...has some feel for spinning the ball, though his upper-70s curveball and low-80s slider can blend together at times.

HONK, HONK: Fitterer began the 2023 season in High-A Beloit, making three starts and going 2-1 with a 2.87 ERA in 15.2 innings...he struck out 18 and walked 12...he was promoted to Pensacola on April 25.

LAST YEAR: Fitterer spent the entire 2022 season with High-A Beloit, leading the Sky Carp in starts with 22...he was 4-7 with a 4.28 ERA in a career-high 107.1 innings...he pitched to an extreme ground ball rate of 55% after pitching to a 65% rate in 2021.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name: Evan Otto Fitterer...missed significant time in 2021 due to back and shoulder injuries...selected in the 5th round of the 2019 Draft out of Aliso Niguel HS in Southern California, also the alma mater of Marlins manager Skip Schumaker...in Draft evaluations, compared to "Kyle Hendricks with better stuff"...was committed to UCLA before signing with Miami...is an avid guitarist and helped teach 2022 Beloit roommate Dax Fulton to play.
