**TODAY'S GAME:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their six-game series against the Tennessee Smokies, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on Thursday night.

**MONTEVERDE, MORISSETTE STRETCH STREAK TO 10:** The Blue Wahoos defeated the Tennessee Smokies 7-4 on Wednesday night to extend their winning streak to 10 games...Patrick Monteverde earned his league-leading fifth win, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings and striking out eight batters...Cody Morissette hit a two-run homer in a 1-for-4 night...Nasim Nuñez was 1-for-2 with an RBI single, three walks, and two stolen bases...Will Banfield was 2-for-4.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** The Blue Wahoos have won 10 in a row and 18 of their past 19 games, with only an 8-0 loss to Mississippi on May 5 separating an eight-game winning streak with their active 10-game streak...this is their first 10-game winning streak in team history...their previous long was eight games, accomplished three times including their streak earlier this season...the longest winning streak in Southern League history is 16, held by the Montgomery Rebels (DET) from July 3-26, 1968...among the 16 consecutive wins were a pair of no-hitters from James Brown...Jim Leyland played for the 1968 Rebels...since the Blue Wahoos entered the Southern League in 2012, the longest winning streak is 11 (Birmingham, 2013, Jacksonville 2013, Chattanooga 2014)...they are outscoring opponents 123-60 in that stretch, with three shutout wins and a 5-0 record in one-run games.

**FIRST PLACE PENSACOLA:** The Blue Wahoos are in first place in the South Division, 5.0 games ahead of the Biloxi Shuckers with 34 to go in the first half...last year, the Blue Wahoos took control of first place on May 15 in their 31st game, eventually winning the first half title by 2.5 games...they never held first place in the second half of the 2022 season, finishing 8.0 games back of Montgomery.

**WATCH THE THRONE:** The Tennessee Smokies come to town for a six-game series in a rematch of last year's SLCS...the Blue Wahoos beat the Smokies 2 games to 1 to win the Southern League Championship...the Blue Wahoos travel to Tennessee for the final series of the first half June 20-25...the Blue Wahoos went 9-3 against the Smokies last year, are 2-0 this year, and are 47-46 all-time.

**THE THRILL OF VICTOR-Y:** Victor Mesa Jr. was named Southern League Player of the Week on Monday...Mesa was 7-for-22 with two doubles, two homers and 11 RBI in Pensacola's sweep of Birmingham last week.

**ROSTER REMIX:** Left-handed pitcher Jefry Yan and third baseman Joe Rizzo were promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday...Yan pitched to a 3.24 ERA in 13 games, going 4-for-4 in save opportunities and striking out 31 batters in 16.2 innings...Rizzo batted .228 with three homers and 21 RBI, one shy of the team lead...taking their place are pitchers Jonathan Bermudez and Zach Willeman from the FCL Marlins and third baseman Yorman Martínez from High-A Beloit.

**CLEAN SWEEP:** Sunday, the Blue Wahoos completed only the second six-game series sweep in franchise history...the first came May 10-15, 2022 vs. Rocket City.

**IT'S EURY TIME:** Former Blue Wahoo Eury Pérez made his second major league start in Miami this afternoon, allowing one run over 5.0 innings while striking out six to earn his first win in a 5-3 victory over the Nationals...on April 12, the 20-year-old became the fourth former Blue Wahoo to make his MLB debut this year (Jeff Lindgren-MIA, George Soriano-MIA, Drew Maggi-PIT), and the 124th all-time.

**STARTING STARS:** The Blue Wahoos starting staff has been outstanding in their past 19 games...they are 10-0 with 26 earned runs in 103.1 innings, good for a 2.26 ERA.

**BECKONING BENNETT:** Bennett Hostetler hit a first-inning grand slam for his first Double-A hit last Thursday after an 0-for-8 start to his Blue Wahoos career...the infielder-turned-catcher had been playing with High-A Beloit, batting .129 in nine games...an 18th round selection in the 2021 Draft out of North Dakota State, he spent the entire 2022 season with the Sky Carp and split time between catcher and DH.

**MONTH-AVERDE:** Patrick Monteverde earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month honors for April...he allowed only one earned run over 26.0 innings and led the league in ERA (0.35), strikeouts (38) and WHIP (0.54)...all four of his starts were "quality starts" of at least 6.0 innings.

**TRIPLES ARE BEST:** The Blue Wahoos have had a flurry of 11 triples to start the 2023 season: Three from Troy Johnston, two from Victor Mesa Jr. and José Devers, and one each from Griffin Conine, J.D. Orr, Dane Myers and Nasim Nuñez...the 11 triples are the most in the Southern League...the Blue Wahoos hit only 15 triples last season.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** The Blue Wahoos are leading the Southern League in the following categories: H (Mesa, 39), 2B (Mesa, 11), BB (Nuñez, 31), XBH (Mesa, 18), W (Monteverde, 5), SO (Monteverde, 57), G (Reynolds, 17), SV (Reynolds, 6), IP (Monteverde, 42.0) and BAA (Monteverde, .130).

**IN THE PIPELINE:** The Blue Wahoos have eight players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: LHP Dax Fulton (#4), OF Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), IF Cody Morissette (#20), SS Nasim Nuñez (#21), RHP Sean Reynolds (#25), RHP Evan Fitterer (#27), 1B Troy Johnston (#29) and LHP Patrick Monteverde (#30)...LHP Jake Eder (#5) and C Paul McIntosh (#28) are currently on the injured list.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Jonathan Bermudez makes his Marlins organizational debut on Thursday against Tennessee

**FISHY BUSINESS:** Bermudez was signed by the Marlins April 26 and assigned to the Blue Wahoos on May 16 after working in extended spring training...he was released by the Giants organization on March 27.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bermudez's last appearance came with Triple-A Sacramento in the Giants system on September 26, 2022...he allowed three runs in 4.0 innings to the Las Vegas Aviators in an 8-3 loss.

**AGAINST THE SMOKIES:** Bermudez has never faced the Smokies or pitched in the Southern League.

**PR PROFESSIONAL:** Bermudez was on the roster of Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic, but did not appear in a game.

**BERMUDEZ SHORTS:** Bermudez was originally selected by the Astros in the 23rd round of the 2018 Draft out of Jose Felipe Zayas HS in Coamo, Puerto Rico...spent entire 2022 season at Triple-A...claimed by Giants off waivers on August 23, 2022 from the Astros organization...between Triple-A Sugar Land in Astros organization and Triple-A Sacramento in Giants organization, went 2-7 with a 9.00 ERA in 81.0 innings...made 24 appearances, 19 starts...prior to joining Blue Wahoos, last pitched at Double-A for Corpus Christi in the Astros organization in 2019 and 2021.
