TODAY'S GAME: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their six-game series against the Tennessee Smokies, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on Friday night.

SMOKIES SNAP STREAK IN 5-4 LOSS: The Blue Wahoos fell 5-4 to the Tennessee Smokies on Thursday night, ending their franchise-record winning streak at 10...Jonathan Bermudez took the loss in his Blue Wahoos debut, allowing three runs, two earned, over 3.0+ innings... Bermudez walked five, and the Blue Wahoos pitching staff walked a season-high 10...after falling behind 5-0, the Blue Wahoos scored the final four runs of the game but fell just short...Griffin Conine hit a solo homer, his fourth of the year, to get the Blue Wahoos on the board in the fifth...Pensacola scored three in the seventh but Victor Mesa Jr.'s bid for a game-tying double was caught by right fielder Owen Caissie at the wall.

THE 'HOOS ARE HOT: The Blue Wahoos have won 18 of their past 20 games, with only an 8-0 loss to Mississippi on May 5 and a 5-4 loss to Tennessee on May 18 separating an eight-game winning streak and a franchise-record 10-game winning streak...their previous long was eight games, accomplished three times including their streak earlier this season...their 10-game streak was the longest in the Southern League since Biloxi had two 10-game streaks in 2019...they are outscoring opponents 127-65 in that stretch, with three shutout wins and a 5-1 record in one-run games.

FIRST PLACE PENSACOLA: The Blue Wahoos are in first place in the South Division, 5.0 games ahead of the Biloxi Shuckers with 33 to go in the first half...last year, the Blue Wahoos won the first half title by 2.5 games...they never held first place in the second half of the 2022 season, finishing 8.0 games back of Montgomery.

DAX RX: Pensacola's Opening Day starter, Dax Fulton, was placed on the injured list on Thursday...he left his previous appearance May 12 in Birmingham with an apparent injury...Miami's #4 prospect is 2-4 with a 5.18 ERA in 6 starts and one long relief appearance.

WATCH THE THRONE: The Tennessee Smokies come to town for a six-game series in a rematch of last year's SLCS...the Blue Wahoos beat the Smokies 2 games to 1 to win the Southern League Championship...the Blue Wahoos travel to Tennessee for the final series of the first half June 20-25...the Blue Wahoos went 9-3 against the Smokies last year, are 2-1 this year, and are 47-47 all-time.

THE THRILL OF VICTOR-Y: Victor Mesa Jr. was named Southern League Player of the Week on Monday...Mesa was 7-for-22 with two doubles, two homers and 11 RBI in Pensacola's sweep of Birmingham last week.

ROSTER REMIX: Left-handed pitcher Jefry Yan and third baseman Joe Rizzo were promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday...Yan pitched to a 3.24 ERA in 13 games, going 4-for-4 in save opportunities and striking out 31 batters in 16.2 innings...Rizzo batted .228 with three homers and 21 RBI, one shy of the team lead...taking their place are pitchers Jonathan Bermudez and Zach Willeman from the FCL Marlins and third baseman Ynmanol Mariñez from High-A Beloit.

CLEAN SWEEP: Sunday, the Blue Wahoos completed only the second six-game series sweep in franchise history...the first came May 10-15, 2022 vs. Rocket City.

IT'S EURY TIME: Former Blue Wahoo Eury Pérez made his second major league start in Miami on Thursday, allowing one run over 5.0 innings while striking out six to earn his first win in a 5-3 victory over the Nationals...on April 12, the 20-year-old became the fourth former Blue Wahoo to make his MLB debut this year (Jeff Lindgren-MIA, George Soriano-MIA, Drew Maggi-PIT), and the 124th all-time.

STARTING STARS: The Blue Wahoos starting staff has been outstanding in their past 20 games...they are 10-1 with 28 earned runs in 106.1 innings, good for a 2.37 ERA.

MONTH-AVERDE: Patrick Monteverde earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month honors for April...he allowed only one earned run over 26.0 innings and led the league in ERA (0.35), strikeouts (38) and WHIP (0.54)...all four of his starts were "quality starts" of at least 6.0 innings.

TRIPLES ARE BEST: The Blue Wahoos have had a flurry of 11 triples to start the 2023 season: Three from Troy Johnston, two from Victor Mesa Jr. and José Devers, and one each from Griffin Conine, J.D. Orr, Dane Myers and Nasim Nuñez...the 11 triples are the most in the Southern League...the Blue Wahoos hit only 15 triples last season.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Blue Wahoos are leading the Southern League in the following categories: AVG (Myers, .319), H (Mesa, 39), 2B (Mesa, 11), XBH (Mesa, 18), W (Monteverde, 5), SO (Monteverde, 57), G (Reynolds, 17), SV (Reynolds, 6), IP (Monteverde, 42.0) and BAA (Monteverde, .130).

IN THE PIPELINE: The Blue Wahoos have seven players on Miami's Top 30 Prospects list, per MLB Pipeline: OF Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), IF Cody Morissette (#20), SS Nasim Nuñez (#21), RHP Sean Reynolds (#25), RHP Evan Fitterer (#27), 1B Troy Johnston (#29) and LHP Patrick Monteverde (#30)...LHP Dax Fulton (#4), LHP Jake Eder (#5) and C Paul McIntosh (#28) are currently on the injured list.

TODAY'S START: Luis Palacios makes his second Blue Wahoos start of the season on Friday against Tennessee.

SHRIMPIN' AIN'T EASY: Palacios began the season with Triple-A Jacksonville, going 1-1 with a 5.28 ERA in three starts...he then went to High-A Beloit, making three starts for the Sky Carp and going 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA before he was transferred to Pensacola on May 9.

LAST TIME OUT: Palacios made his 2023 Blue Wahoos debut last Saturday in Birmingham, allowing five runs on seven hits over 5.0+ innings...he earned the win as the Blue Wahoos beat the Barons 6-5...Palacios led 6-2 going to the bottom of the sixth before allowing three singles, all of which came in to score.

AGAINST THE SMOKIES: Palacios faced Tennessee twice in 2022, making his Double-A debut on September 11 and starting Game One of the SLCS on ...in his regular season start, he allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in a 7-5, 10-inning win... Cole Roederer hit a two-run homer...in the SLCs, he took the loss while allowing four runs, two earned, over 3.0 innings in a 4-1 defeat...Nelson Maldonado hit a solo homer.

LAST YEAR: Palacios began the 2022 season with Class-A Jupiter, going 4-5 with a 4.03 ERA in 14 appearances (12 starts) before a July 22 promotion to High-A Beloit...he went 3-2 with a 4.85 ERA in seven starts for the Sky Carp before he was promoted once again to Pensacola on September 9...he made two regular season starts for the Blue Wahoos, going 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA, and also started Game One of the SLCS against Tennessee, taking the loss while allowing four runs, two earned, in 3.0 innings.

BACK IN THE DAY: Pitching in the GCL (now Complex League) in 2019, Palacios ranked second in all of MiLB in BB/9 (0.45) among pitchers with 40+ innings...he held the best cumulative ERA in the minors between 2017 and 2019 (min. 150 IP), posting a 1.49 mark over 150.2 innings in his first three pro seasons...he spent the entire 2021 season with Class-A Jupiter, going 5-6 with a 3.88 ERA.
