HAPPY OPENING DAY!: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos begin the 2022 season tonight as they welcome in the Biloxi Shuckers for a three-game series.

A LOOK BACK: In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

FEELING BRAND NEW: Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

TEENAGE DREAM: Eury Pérez makes his Double-A debut tonight as the starting pitcher for the Blue Wahoos...at 18 years old, he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...the only other 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team was shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Alex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

FAMILIAR FACES: 13 of the 28 members of the Blue Wahoos roster played for Pensacola in 2021...among position players, Santiago Chávez, Griffin Conine, Jerar Encarnacion, Devin Hairston, Bubba Hollins and Victor Victor Mesa return...on the pitching staff, Colton Hock, Zack Leban, Anthony Maldonado, Zach McCambley, Andrew Nardi, Will Stewart and Jefry Yan return.

WELCOME BACK, SOUTHERN LEAGUE: After one season as the Double-A South, the "Southern League" moniker returns for 2022...the Mississippi Braves defeated the Montgomery Biscuits 3-2 in a best-of-five series to capture the Double-A South Championship...the restored Southern League retains the history of its various iterations dating back to 1885, though its modern era began in 1964.

THE BIG TEN (YEARS): 2022 marks the 10th season of Blue Wahoos baseball, and the 10th anniversary of the first season in 2012...a special commemorative logo, featuring the iconic Pensacola Beach water tower, is part of the team's branding this season.

SMOKE ON THE WATER: Kevin "Smoke" Randel leads the Blue Wahoos in his second year as manager...it is his seventh season managing in the Marlins system, and his third at the Double-A level after leading Jacksonville in 2019...Scott Seabol returns as hitting coach, with new coaching additions in Daye Eiland (pitching coach) and Frank Moore (defensive coach).

SHUCKING AROUND: Tonight marks the first of 30 matchups between the Blue Wahoos and Shuckers...there will be 15 games at Blue Wahoos Stadium, and 15 games at MGM Park in Biloxi...the Blue Wahoos are 76-69 all-time against Biloxi, including an 18-12 mark last season.

WHEELING AND DEALING: Since breaking minor league camp last weekend, the Marlins made a pair of trades that impacted their Double-A roster...LHP Antonio Velez was sent to Baltimore in exchange for relievers Tanner Scott and Cole Sulser on Sunday night...on Wednesday, the Marlins traded catcher Alex Jackson to the Brewers in exchange for infielder Hayden Cantrelle and pitcher Alexis Ramírez.

ALUMNI REPORT: Twins RHP Jhoan Duran is poised to become the next Blue Wahoos alumnus to play in MLB, as he has made the club's Opening Day roster as a reliever...the Twins are hosting the Mariners this afternoon...he would be the 104th player to advance to the major leagues through Pensacola...on Thursday night, former Blue Wahoo Tyler Mahle earned the win as his Reds beat the defending champion Braves 6-3.

HONK, HONK: Tonight marks the on-field debut of the High-A Beloit Sky Carp, also owned by Quint and Rishy Studer...the team operated as the Beloit Snappers from 1995 to 2021, and moved into ABC Supply Stadium late last season...the Sky Carp play their first home game on Tuesday.

A TRADITION UNLIKE ANY OTHER: Blue Wahoos minority owner Bubba Watson has season tickets behind home plate, but they will be used by someone else this weekend...Watson, a two-time Masters champion in 2012 and 2014, is back in Augusta this weekend for the Masters Tournament...an opening round of +1 on Thursday was followed by a +1 today, putting him at +2 overall.

LEAGUE OF NATIONS: The Blue Wahoos are represented by 28 players from six different countries...there are 20 players from the United States, 4 players from the Dominican Republic, and 1 each from México, Venezuela, Aruba and Cuba.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Blue Wahoos make their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama next week to take on the Angels affiliate Rocket City Trash Pandas...the series, like the vast majority this season, will run Tuesday through Sunday...the Blue Wahoos return home for a six-game set against the Rays affiliate Montgomery Biscuits on Tuesday, April 19.

TONIGHT'S START: Eury Pérez makes his Double-A debut on Opening Day against Biloxi.

BEST IN CLASS: Pérez is ranked the top prospect in the Marlins organization according to Baseball America, and the #4 prospect according to MLB Pipeline...BA ranks his fastball as the best in the system.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, Pérez split 2021 between Low-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit...he made 20 starts in total (15 in Jupiter, 5 in Beloit), going 3-5 with a 1.96 ERA...he struck out 108 batters in 78.0 innings...in Jupiter, he was 2-3 with a 1.51 ERA...his peripheral numbers were even better after an August 17 promotion to Beloit, lowering his WHIP from 0.95 to 0.73 and his opponent average from .163 to .145, but his ERA jumped up to 2.86 with the Snappers after his final appearance of the season in which he allowed 4 runs in 4.0 innings.

YOUNG GUN: Pérez is the first teenager in the 10-year history of the Blue Wahoos franchise, and just the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team (Edgar Renteria, Portland, 1995)...the last teenagers to play for a Marlins Double-A team were Mike (nee Giancarlo) Stanton and Matt Dominguez for the Jacksonville Suns in 2009.

AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: Pérez has never faced the Shuckers, but he did face the Brewers' High-A team in Wisonsin last September 4...he took the loss, allowing 2 ER on a pair of solo homers in 3.1 IP...one homer was hit by Felix Valerio, who now plays for Biloxi...Joey Weimer was 0-for-2, Ashton McGee was 0-for-1, Freddy Zamora was 0-for-1 and Nick Kahle was 0-for-1.

HOT STUFF: Because Pérez hails from the Dominican Republic and did not move from the Florida State League to the Midwest League until August in his first professional season, he has never pitched in anything resembling cold weather...His start in Appleton, Wisconsin against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers on September 4, with a balmy 66 degrees at first pitch, marks his coolest environment.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name: Eury Rafael Pérez (pronounced PAIR-ez)...greatest accomplishment was completing school...takes regular English classes provided by Marlins...favorite movie is Rápido y Furioso (Fast and Furious)...favorite pitcher growing up was Pedro Martinez...pregame meal is arroz carnes (meat and rice)...on Twitter @Eury Perez9.
