**ON THE ROAD:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos play their first road game of the season on Tuesday night as they open up a six-game series against the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

**SUNDAY SCARIES:** The Blue Wahoos were swept in their opening series against Biloxi, falling 3-1 to the Shuckers on Sunday afternoon...Bryan Hoeing struck out 10 batters over 5.2 dominant innings in his Double-A debut, but fell victim to defensive miscues behind him to take the loss...all three runs scored by the Shuckers were unearned, with one run in the first and two more in the fifth...the Blue Wahoos' only run came on a solo homer in the fourth inning from Paul McIntosh, who has now homered in each of his first two Double-A games...the Blue Wahoos loaded the bases with one out in the bottom of the ninth, but Victor Victor Mesa grounded into a game-ending double play.

**LIFT-OFF:** The Blue Wahoos are making their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama to take on the Trash Pandas...Rocket City visits Pensacola for a six-game series May 10-15...the Blue Wahoos went 6-2 against the Trash Pandas last season, with a 5-1 record at home and a 1-1 mark at Toyota Field...the final four games of the series at Rocket City were cancelled.

**WINNING TIME:** Though the Blue Wahoos are winless on the season, they have had plenty of late-game chances to win a game...on Friday, the Blue Wahoos tied the game in the 8th, 9th and 10th before losing 13-11 in 11 innings...Victor Victor Mesa's game-ending flyout with the bases loaded was caught at the warning track...in Saturday's 6-5 loss, they got a runner to third base with no outs in the eighth and ninth innings but were unable to convert...they are 2-for-17 with men in scoring position in the eighth inning or later, with only Hayden Cantrelle's game-tying double in the 10th inning of Friday's game bringing home a run.

**LIVE BALL ERA:** Though it came in a defeat, the Blue Wahoos' 11 runs on Friday matched their 2021 season high...they scored 11 runs twice last season, July 13 against Chattanooga in an 11-3 win and on August 1 in an 11-3 win over Mississippi...on the other hand, their 13 runs allowed were the most in a game since June 9 of last year when they fell 16-3 to the Lookouts.

**MOBILE MEMORIES:** The current Rocket City Trash Pandas moved from Mobile, Alabama after the 2019 season...the Mobile BayBears played at Hank Aaron Stadium from 1997 to 2019, and were Pensacola's closest geographic rival for the first 8 years of Blue Wahoos baseball...counting their years as the BayBears, the Blue Wahoos are 83-85 against the Trash Pandas franchise.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to reach the major leagues when he entered in relief of Friday's game against Seattle...Duran turned in 2.0 scoreless innings in a 2-1 loss, hitting 100 mph with his fastball and garnering online attention for his "splinker" pitch...he also closed out Monday night's 4-0 win with a perfect ninth inning.

**A LOOK BACK:** In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

**FEELING BRAND NEW:** Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

**TEENAGE DREAM:** Eury Pérez made his Double-A debut Friday as the starting pitcher for the Blue Wahoos...at 18 years old, he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...the only other 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team was shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Alex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

**SMOKE ON THE WATER:** Kevin "Smoke" Randel leads the Blue Wahoos in his second year as manager...it is his seventh season managing in the Marlins system, and his third at the Double-A level after leading Jacksonville in 2019...Scott Seabol returns as hitting coach, with new coaching additions in Dave Eiland (pitching coach) and Frank Moore (defensive coach).

WHEELING AND DEALING: Since breaking minor league camp, the Marlins made a pair of trades that impacted their Double-A roster...LHP Antonio Velez was sent to Baltimore in exchange for relievers Tanner Scott and Cole Sulser...last Wednesday, the Marlins traded catcher Alex Jackson to the Brewers in exchange for infielder Hayden Cantrelle and pitcher Alexis Ramírez.

**A TRADITION UNLIKE ANY OTHER:** Blue Wahoos minority owner Bubba Watson has season tickets behind home plate, but they were used by someone else this past weekend...Watson, a two-time Masters champion in 2012 and 2014, was back in Augusta for the Masters Tournament... an opening round of +1 on Thursday was followed by a +1 Friday, a +6 Saturday, and -1 Sunday, finishing +7 overall for a T-39 finish.

**TONIGHT'S START:** George Soriano makes his Double-A debut in the series opener at Rocket City.

**LAST YEAR:** Soriano began the 2021 season with Low-A Jupiter before a promotion to High-A Beloint on June 29...he went 7-1 with a 3.43 ERA in 18 starts between the two levels...his 114 strikeouts in 89.1 innings were fourth-most for any Marlins minor leaguer...he struck out 10 batters on three occasions, including back-to-back starts August 14 and August 22.

**IN THE PIPELINE:** Soriano is currently ranked the #28 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline...according to his scouting report, "He must refine his control and command, though he did a better job of throwing strikes following his promotion to High-A...how well he can locate his pitches will determine whether he can fit in the back half of a rotation vs. maxing out as a middle reliever."

**PRE-PANDEMIC:** Soriano spent the entire 2019 season at Low-A Clinton, played 2018 in the GCL and missed the 2017 season due to injury.

**AGAINST THE TRASH PANDAS:** Soriano has never faced the Trash Pandas...his only prior experience against an Angels affiliate came on June 9, 2019 when his Clinton LumberKings faced the Burlington Bees...he allowed 2 runs in 4.2 innings, taking a no-decision in a 4-3 loss...Kevin Maitan is the only player from that game on the Trash Pandas roster...he went 1-for-2 with a single and a walk in the game.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Warm-up music is Tú No Metes Cabra (I'm Not Afraid of You) by Bad Bunny...favorite movie is G.I. Joe...on Twitter @G\_Soriano1124...favorite actor is Will Smith...if he could have a superpower, he would have super speed...favorite player growing up was Alfonso Soriano, who shares his last name and is also from San Pedro de Macoris...says his secret talent is telling the truth all the time...favorite pregame meal is arroz pollo habichuelas y aguacate (rice, chicken and beans with avocado).
