**ON THE ROAD:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos look to build on their first win of the year as they continue their six-game series against the Rocket City Trash Pandas on Wednesday night.

**WELCOME BACK, JUNIOR:** The Blue Wahoos rallied late on Tuesday for their first win of the season, topping the Trash Pandas 4-3...Luis Aviles Jr. hit a go-ahead solo homer to lead off the top of the ninth against his former team...Paul McIntosh went 3-for-4 with two RBI and a game-tying triple in the seventh...George Soriano struck out six batters over 4.0 innings in his Double-A debut, allowing three runs but none earned...after allowing RBI hits to Anthony Mulrine and Aaron Whitefield in the second inning, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff worked hitless ball the rest of the way...Colton Hock, last year's Double-A South saves leader, pitched a hitless ninth to lock down his first save of the season.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .667 average through three games to leade the Southern League...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple on Tuesday... undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

**CRITICAL ERROR:** Despite allowing 13 runs in the first game of the season, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff has recovered nicely to pitch to a 3.32 ERA that is second-best in the Southern League...they haven't allowed an earned run since Saturday, with their last six runs coming across because of errors...14 of their 28 runs allowed have been unearned runs, the most in the league...the defense's 8 errors are secondmost in the league to Biloxi's 11.

**LIFT-OFF:** The Blue Wahoos are making their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama to take on the Trash Pandas...Rocket City visits Pensacola for a six-game series May 10-15...the Blue Wahoos went 6-2 against the Trash Pandas last season, with a 5-1 record at home and a 1-1 mark at Toyota Field...the final four games of the series at Rocket City were cancelled.

**WINNING TIME:** Though the Blue Wahoos are 1-3, they have had plenty of late-game chances...on Friday, the Blue Wahoos tied the game in the 8th, 9th and 10th before losing 13-11 in 11 innings...Victor Victor Mesa's game-ending flyout with the bases loaded was caught at the warning track...in Saturday's 6-5 loss, they got a runner to third base with no outs in the eighth and ninth innings but were unable to convert... they loaded the bases in the ninth inning of Sunday's 3-1 loss, and finally broke through on Tuesday with two runs in the seventh and a Luis Aviles Jr. go-ahead solo homer in the ninth to win 4-3.

LIVE BALL ERA: Though it came in a defeat, the Blue Wahoos' 11 runs last Friday matched their 2021 season high...they scored 11 runs twice last season, July 13 against Chattanooga in an 11-3 win and on August 1 in an 11-3 win over Mississippi...on the other hand, their 13 runs allowed were the most in a game since June 9 of last year when they fell 16-3 to the Lookouts.

**MOBILE MEMORIES:** The current Rocket City Trash Pandas moved from Mobile, Alabama after the 2019 season...the Mobile BayBears played at Hank Aaron Stadium from 1997 to 2019, and were Pensacola's closest geographic rival for the first 8 years of Blue Wahoos baseball...counting their years as the BayBears, the Blue Wahoos are 83-85 against the Trash Pandas franchise.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to reach the major leagues when he entered in relief of last Friday's game against Seattle...Duran turned in 2.0 scoreless innings in a 2-1 loss, hitting 100 mph with his fastball and garnering online attention for his "splinker" pitch...he also closed out Monday night's 4-0 win with a perfect ninth inning.

**A LOOK BACK:** In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

**FEELING BRAND NEW:** Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

**TEENAGE DREAM:** Eury Pérez made his Double-A debut Friday as the starting pitcher for the Blue Wahoos...at 18 years old, he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...the only other 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team was shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Alex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

**SMOKE ON THE WATER:** Kevin "Smoke" Randel leads the Blue Wahoos in his second year as manager...it is his seventh season managing in the Marlins system, and his third at the Double-A level after leading Jacksonville in 2019...Scott Seabol returns as hitting coach, with new coaching additions in Dave Eiland (pitching coach) and Frank Moore (defensive coach).

**TONIGHT'S START:** Cody Mincey makes his Double-A debut in game two at Rocket City.

**LAST YEAR:** Mincey was signed by the Marlins last July 17 out of the independent American Association, where he pitched to a 1.13 ERA in 40.0 innings for the Kansas City Monarchs...he was assigned to High-A Beloit, where he continued to dominate with a 1.35 ERA in 33.1 relief innings.

**DOWN UNDER:** Mincey played for the Melbourne Aces of the Australian Baseball League in the 2019-20 winter, pitching in six games and allowing one earned run in 7.0 innings...he appeared in another four postseason games as the Aces won the Claxton Shield, the ABL's championship...the Aces swept Aaron Whitefield's Adelaide Giants in the best-of-three Championship Series.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE: Mincey played this past winter in both the Venezuelan Winter League (Aguilas del Zulia) and the Dominican Winter League (Gigantes del Cibao)...in the 2020-21 offseason, he pitched in the Mexican Pacific Winter League (Charros de Jalisco) and the Colombian team in the Caribbean Series...in independent baseball, he pitched for the Windy City ThunderBolts (2017), the River City Rascals (2017-18), the Long Island Ducks (2019) and the Kansas City Monarchs (2021)

**AGAINST THE TRASH PANDAS:** Mincey has never faced the Trash Pandas, or an Angels affiliate at any level.

**COLLEGE DAYS:** Mincey began his collegiate career at Spartanburg Methodist College in Spartanburg, SC, where he helped lead SMC to the 2013 JUCO World Series...he transferred to South Carolina and pitched to a 3.59 ERA in two seasons, graduating in 2015 with a psychology degree.
