ON THE ROAD: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos play a game and a half on Thursday, completing last night's suspended game and playing a nineinning contest against the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY: Wednesday night's game was suspended in the bottom of the seventh inning with the score tied 3-3...Rocket City's Ryan Aguilar was batting with a full count against Josh Simpson with one out and the bases empty when the tarp was pulled...the Blue Wahoos scored the game's first run in the first inning as Hayden Cantrelle doubled and scored on a Jerar Encarnacion fielder's choice...Encarnacion hit a two-run homer in the fifth to take a 3-1 lead, but Aaron Whitefield answered back with a two-run homer of his own in the bottom half of the inning to tie the game 3-3...Cody Mincey completed 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut, striking out six and allowing three runs.

WELCOME BACK, JUNIOR: The Blue Wahoos rallied late on Tuesday for their first win of the season, topping the Trash Pandas 4-3...Luis Aviles Jr. hit a go-ahead solo homer to lead off the top of the ninth against his former team...Paul McIntosh went 3-for-4 with two RBI and a game-tying triple in the seventh...George Soriano struck out six batters over 4.0 innings in his Double-A debut, allowing three runs but none earned...after allowing RBI hits to Anthony Mulrine and Aaron Whitefield in the second inning, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff worked hitless ball the rest of the way...Colton Hock, last year's Double-A South saves leader, pitched a hitless ninth to lock down his first save of the season.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .667 average through three games to leade the Southern League...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple on Tuesday... undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

CRITICAL ERROR: Despite allowing 13 runs in the first game of the season, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff has recovered nicely to pitch to a 3.32 ERA that is second-best in the Southern League...they haven't allowed an earned run since Saturday, with their last six runs coming across because of errors...14 of their 28 runs allowed have been unearned runs, the most in the league...the defense's 8 errors are second-most in the league to Biloxi's 11.

LIFT-OFF: The Blue Wahoos are making their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama to take on the Trash Pandas...Rocket City visits Pensacola for a six-game series May 10-15...the Blue Wahoos went 6-2 against the Trash Pandas last season, with a 5-1 record at home and a 1-1 mark at Toyota Field...the final four games of the series at Rocket City were cancelled.

WINNING TIME: Though the Blue Wahoos are 1-3, they have had plenty of late-game chances...on Friday, the Blue Wahoos tied the game in the 8th, 9th and 10th before losing 13-11 in 11 innings...Victor Victor Mesa's game-ending flyout with the bases loaded was caught at the warning track...in Saturday's 6-5 loss, they got a runner to third base with no outs in the eighth and ninth innings but were unable to convert... they loaded the bases in the ninth inning of Sunday's 3-1 loss, and finally broke through on Tuesday with two runs in the seventh and a Luis Aviles Jr. go-ahead solo homer in the ninth to win 4-3.

MOBILE MEMORIES: The current Rocket City Trash Pandas moved from Mobile, Alabama after the 2019 season...the Mobile BayBears played at Hank Aaron Stadium from 1997 to 2019, and were Pensacola's closest geographic rival for the first 8 years of Blue Wahoos baseball...counting their years as the BayBears, the Blue Wahoos are 83-85 against the Trash Pandas franchise.

ALUMNI REPORT: Braves RHP Jackson Stephens was added to the major league roster on Wednesday, marking his first time in MLB since breaking in with the Reds in 2017 and 2018...Stephens pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2016...earlier this season, Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB.

A LOOK BACK: In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

FEELING BRAND NEW: Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

TEENAGE DREAM: Eury Pérez made his Double-A debut on Opening Day as the starting pitcher for the Blue Wahoos...celebrating his 19th birthday on Friday, he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

TONIGHT'S START: Will Stewart makes his second appearance, and first start, of the 2022 season in Thursday's game against Rocket City.

LAST TIME OUT: Stewart pitched in relief last Friday against Biloxi, coming on after Eury Pérez pitched 4.1 innings in his Opening Day nod...he entered with a 4-1 lead and two runners on base, and he allowed both runners to score...he departed in the seventh after allowing a three-run double to Freddy Zamora that gave the Shuckers an 8-5 lead...Zamora scored after he departed, giving Stewart six runs, five earned, with four walks over 2.0 innings...the Blue Wahoos rallied three times to tie the game, but lost 13-11 in 11 innings.

HUNTSVILLE STAR: Stewart's matchup against Rocket City is a bit of a homecoming... he attended Hazel Green High School, which is located in Madison County, approximately 24 miles away from Toyota Field.

LAST YEAR: Stewart pitched the entire 2021 season in Pensacola, going 5-8 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 starts...he coaxed 14 double plays, second-most in the Double-A South...he fell one out shy of his third straight 100-inning season, finishing at 99.2 IP.

TRADING POST: Stewart arrived in the Marlins organization in the February 2019 trade that sent J.T. Realmuto to the Phillies...Stewart was part of the return that included Jorge Alfaro, Sixto Sanchez and cash considerations.

AGAINST THE TRASH PANDAS: Stewart faced Rocket City last year in Pensacola on May 22...he allowed two runs, none earned, over 3.0 innings in a no-decision...he allowed three hits and walked three, but struck out seven...the Blue Wahoos won the game 6-2.

TARGET PRACTICE: Stewart hit 25 batters last season with the Blue Wahoos, the most for any Marlins minor league pitcher in franchise history...he has hit 1 batter so far this season.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Stewart was originally selected by the Phillies in the 20th round of the 2015 Draft...favorite movie is The Great Gatsby and his favorite TV show is Lucifer...says his secret talent is having two black belts...started a foundation in memory of his godmother that helps combat Stage IV metastatic breast cancer.
