ON THE ROAD: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Rocket City Trash Pandas on Friday night.

DOUBLE DIPPING: Wednesday night's game was suspended in the bottom of the seventh inning with the score tied 3-3, and completed on Thursday with the Trash Pandas winning 5-4...Braxton Martinez hit the game-winning home run in the bottom of the eighth...the Blue Wahoos exacted a measure of revenge in the regularly scheduled game, winning 5-3...Rocket City starter Brett Kerry struck out 11 of the first 13 men he faced, but his lone hit allowed was a solo homer to Cobie Fletcher-Vance in the fifth inning...Huntsville native Will Stewart scattered 5 hits and allowed one run over 4.0 innings...trailing 3-1 in the sixth, the Blue Wahoos tied the game on a two-run double from Paul McIntosh... Parker Bugg earned the win in relief in his Pensacola debut...Colton Hock earned his second save of the season, and second of the series.

HEY, NINETEEN: Rising prospect Eury Pérez celebrates his 19th birthday Friday as the Blue Wahoos starting pitcher...he was the team's Opening Day starter as an 18 year old...he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .579 average through three games to lead the Southern League...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple on Tuesday... undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

42: Major League Baseball celebrates Jackie Robinson Day every April 15, commemorating the breaking of the game's color barrier 75 years ago today...later this summer on June 19, as part of MiLB's "The Nine" initiative, the Blue Wahoos will wear uniforms celebrating Pensacola's own Chappie James, who became the first Black Four-Star general in the U.S. Armed Forces after an Air Force career as a fighter pilot.

CRITICAL ERROR: Despite allowing 13 runs in the first game of the season, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff has recovered nicely to pitch to a 3.60 ERA that is fourth-best in the Southern League...11 of their 33 runs allowed have been unearned runs, the most in the league...the defense's 10 errors are second-most in the league to Biloxi's 12.

LIFT-OFF: The Blue Wahoos are making their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama to take on the Trash Pandas...Rocket City visits Pensacola for a six-game series May 10-15...the Blue Wahoos went 6-2 against the Trash Pandas last season, with a 5-1 record at home and a 1-1 mark at Toyota Field...the final four games of the series at Rocket City last season were cancelled.

WINNING TIME: Though the Blue Wahoos are 2-4, they have brought the winning run to the plate in the ninth inning of all their losses...last Friday, the Blue Wahoos tied the game in the 8th, 9th and 10th before losing 13-11 in 11 innings...Victor Victor Mesa's game-ending flyout with the bases loaded was caught at the warning track...in Saturday's 6-5 loss, they got a runner to third base with no outs in the eighth and ninth innings but were unable to convert...they loaded the bases in the ninth inning of Sunday's 3-1 loss, and had the tying run on base in Wednesday's suspended game loss.

MOBILE MEMORIES: The current Rocket City Trash Pandas moved from Mobile, Alabama after the 2019 season...the Mobile BayBears played at Hank Aaron Stadium from 1997 to 2019, and were Pensacola's closest geographic rival for the first 8 years of Blue Wahoos baseball...counting their years as the BayBears, the Blue Wahoos are 83-85 against the Trash Pandas franchise.

ALUMNI REPORT: Braves RHP Jackson Stephens was added to the major league roster on Wednesday, marking his first time in MLB since breaking in with the Reds in 2017 and 2018...Stephens pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2016...earlier this season, Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB.

A LOOK BACK: In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

FEELING BRAND NEW: Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

SMOKE ON THE WATER: Kevin "Smoke" Randel leads the Blue Wahoos in his second year as manager...it is his seventh season managing in the Marlins system, and his third at the Double-A level after leading Jacksonville in 2019...Scott Seabol returns as hitting coach, with new coaching additions in Dave Eiland (pitching coach) and Frank Moore (defensive coach).

TONIGHT'S START: Eury Pérez makes his second Double-A start on his 19th birthday against the Trash Pandas.

BEST IN CLASS: Pérez is ranked the top prospect in the Marlins organization according to Baseball America, and the #4 prospect according to MLB Pipeline...BA ranks his fastball as the best in the system.

OPENING DAY: Pérez got the Opening Day nod for the Blue Wahoos on April 8 vs. Biloxi, taking a no-decision in a 13-11 loss...he allowed three runs over 4.1 innings, though two runs scored after his departure.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, Pérez split 2021 between Low-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit...he made 20 starts in total (15 in Jupiter, 5 in Beloit), going 3-5 with a 1.96 ERA...he struck out 108 batters in 78.0 innings...in Jupiter, he was 2-3 with a 1.51 ERA...his peripheral numbers were even better after an August 17 promotion to Beloit, lowering his WHIP from 0.95 to 0.73 and his opponent average from .163 to .145, but his ERA jumped up to 2.86 with the Snappers after his final appearance of the season in which he allowed 4 runs in 4.0 innings.

YOUNG GUN: Pérez is the first teenager in the 10-year history of the Blue Wahoos franchise, and was just the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team (Edgar Renteria, Portland, 1995)...the last teenagers to play for a Marlins Double-A team were Mike (nee Giancarlo) Stanton and Matt Dominguez for the Jacksonville Suns in 2009.

AGAINST THE TRASH PANDAS: Pérez has never faced the Trash Pandas or an Angels affiliate.

HOT STUFF: Because Pérez hails from the Dominican Republic and did not move from the Florida State League to the Midwest League until August in his first professional season, he has never pitched in anything resembling cold weather...His start in Appleton, Wisconsin against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers last September 4, with a balmy 66 degrees at first pitch, marks his coolest environment.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name: Eury Rafael Pérez (pronounced PAIR-ez)...greatest accomplishment was completing school...takes regular English classes provided by Marlins...favorite movie is Rápido y Furioso (Fast and Furious)...favorite pitcher growing up was Pedro Martinez...pregame meal is arroz carnes (meat and rice)...on Twitter @Eury_Perez9.
