ON THE ROAD: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Rocket City Trash Pandas on Saturday night.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Blue Wahoos got six strikeouts from Eury Pérez on his 19th birthday, but fell 6-4 to the Trash Pandas on Friday night... Pérez took the loss, allowing 5 runs, 3 earned, over 3.2 innings...he allowed a two-run homer to Trey Cabbage in the first inning and an RBI double to Anthony Mulrine in the second...after making an errant throw on a would-be double play grounder in the fourth, he left with the bases loaded trailing 3-2...Aaron Whitefield greeted Anthony Maldonado with a two-run single that proved to be the game-winning hit...on the offensive front, Cobie Fletcher-Vance extended his hitting streak to 6 games with an RBI single and Thomas Jones hit a solo homer for his first Double-A hit in the ninth.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .579 average through five games to lead the Southern League...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple on Tuesday...undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

CRITICAL ERROR: Despite allowing 13 runs in the first game of the season, the Blue Wahoos pitching staff has recovered nicely to pitch to a 3.71 ERA that is fourth-best in the Southern League...13 of their 39 runs allowed have been unearned runs, the most in the league...the defense's 11 errors are second-most in the league to Biloxi's 13.

LIFT-OFF: The Blue Wahoos are making their first and only road trip to Madison, Alabama to take on the Trash Pandas...Rocket City visits Pensacola for a six-game series May 10-15...the Blue Wahoos went 6-2 against the Trash Pandas last season, with a 5-1 record at home and a 1-1 mark at Toyota Field...the final four games of the series at Rocket City last season were cancelled.

WINNING TIME: Though the Blue Wahoos are 2-5, they have brought the tying or winning run to the plate in the ninth inning of all their losses...last Friday, the Blue Wahoos tied the game in the 8th, 9th and 10th before losing 13-11 in 11 innings...Victor Victor Mesa's game-ending flyout with the bases loaded was caught at the warning track...in last Saturday's 6-5 loss, they got a runner to third base with no outs in the eighth and ninth innings but were unable to convert...they loaded the bases in the ninth inning of Sunday's 3-1 loss, and had the tying run on base in Wednesday's suspended game loss, before bringing the tying run to the plate on Friday.

MOBILE MEMORIES: The current Rocket City Trash Pandas moved from Mobile, Alabama after the 2019 season...the Mobile BayBears played at Hank Aaron Stadium from 1997 to 2019, and were Pensacola's closest geographic rival for the first 8 years of Blue Wahoos baseball...counting their years as the BayBears, the Blue Wahoos are 83-85 against the Trash Pandas franchise.

HEY, NINETEEN: Rising prospect Eury Pérez celebrated his 19th birthday Friday as the Blue Wahoos starting pitcher...he was the team's Opening Day starter as an 18 year old...he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

ALUMNI REPORT: Braves RHP Jackson Stephens was added to the major league roster on Wednesday, marking his first time in MLB since breaking in with the Reds in 2017 and 2018...Stephens pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2016...earlier this season, Twins RHP Johan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB.

A LOOK BACK: In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

FEELING BRAND NEW: Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

SMOKE ON THE WATER: Kevin "Smoke" Randel leads the Blue Wahoos in his second year as manager...it is his seventh season managing in the Marlins system, and his third at the Double-A level after leading Jacksonville in 2019...Scott Seabol returns as hitting coach, with new coaching additions in Dave Eiland (pitching coach) and Frank Moore (defensive coach).

WHEELING AND DEALING: Since breaking minor league camp, the Marlins made a pair of trades that impacted their Double-A roster...LHP Antonio Velez was sent to Baltimore in exchange for relievers Tanner Scott and Cole Sulser...last Wednesday, the Marlins traded catcher Alex Jackson to the Brewers in exchange for infielder Hayden Cantrelle and pitcher Alexis Ramírez.

TONIGHT'S START: Zach McCambley makes his second start of the 2022 season on Saturday night against Rocket City.

LAST TIME OUT: McCambley's first start of the season came last Saturday against Biloxi, in which he received a no-decision in a 6-5 loss...he pitched 5.0 innings, allowing 4 runs, 2 earned...after allowing a two-run homer to Felix Valerio in the second inning, an unearned run scored in the third thanks to a pickoff throw error and in the fourth thanks to a pair of errors from catcher Santiago Chávez...he left trailing 4-2 before the Blue Wahoos took a 5-4 lead to the ninth...Biloxi's Tristen Lutz hit a go-ahead homer in the ninth for a 6-5 final.

AGAINST THE TRASH PANDAS: McCambley has never faced the Trash Pandas or an Angels affiliate.

IN THE PIPELINE: McCambley enters 2022 as the #15 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline, and the fifth-ranked RHP...their grades place the following value on his pitches (on a 20-80 scouting scale): FB 55, CV 65, CH 45, Control 50, Overall 45.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, McCambley began the 2021 campaign at High-A Beloit...he went 2-4 with a 3.79 ERA in 11 starts, earning a promotion to Pensacola on July 7...he was leading the High-A Central with 73 strikeouts at the time of his promotion...he ranked third in the Marlins farm system in strikeouts over the course of the full season.

DRAFT DAY: McCambley was Miami's 3rd round selection (75th overall) in the shortened 2020 Draft...he played three seasons at Coastal Carolina, going 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA across 25.0 innings in the COVID-shortened 2022 NCAA season.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING: "Some scouts thought McCambley had the best curveball in the 2020 Draft, a low-80s bender with high spin rates that dives at the plate and grades as a plus-plus weapon at times." - MLB Pipeline.
