**WHAT'S GOIN' ON:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Montgomery Biscuits, Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays, on Thursday night.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Blue Wahoos earned their first home win of the season on Wednesday night, defeating the Biscuits 6-4...after falling behind 4-1, Pensacola scored the final five runs of the game...Jerar Encarnacion hit a game-tying two-run double in the sixth and the eventual game-winning two-run homer in the eighth...Cody Mincey allowed three runs over 5.0 innings in his start...Josh Simpson earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, giving him 7.0 scoreless innings to start the season...Griffin Conine added an RBI triple, the team's second three-bagger of the season.

**PARTY IN THE BACK:** Tonight is the first "Mullet Thursday" of the 2022 season...the Blue Wahoos will become the Pensacola Mullets every Thursday home game, with special jerseys and caps...the logo features a mullet (the fish) sporting a mullet (the hairstyle).

**ENCARNACION, IN THE FLESH:** Jerar Encarnacion is red hot at the plate, batting .500 (14-for-28) in seven games since April 13...he has four homers on the season, tying him with Rocket City's Aaron Whitefield for the league lead, and all have come in that span...his .348 season average ranks sixth in the league, and his 9 RBI are tied for fourth.

**GREAT WHITE NORTH:** The Blue Wahoos made a pair of roster moves prior to Tuesday's game, adding catcher J.D. Osborne from Triple-A Jacksonville and sending catcher Jose Estrada down to High-A Beloit...Estrada spent the first nine games of the season on the Pensacola roster but did not appear in a game...Osborne went 1-for-4 with the Jumbo Shrimp, and was 0-for-2 as the DH in his 2022 Wahoos debut on Tuesday...Osborne split time between Jacksonville and Pensacola last season, and also spent time representing Team Canada in the WBSC Olympic qualifiers.

**MAC ATTACK:** The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .417 average through nine games to lead the Southern League...he also leads in OPS, and is third in OBP and SLG...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple four days later...undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

**REAPING AND HOEING:** Bryan Hoeing has delivered the two longest starts in the Southern League through two weeks...he struck out 10 batters on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...last Sunday his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

**TICK, TOCK:** The Blue Wahoos played their fastest game of the season on Wednesday, beating the Biscuits 6-4 in 2:24...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season...last Sunday against Rocket City, the two teams played 11 innings in 2:48...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement last week.

**BUTTERED BISCUITS:** The Blue Wahoos and Biscuits will play each other 30 times this season...three series will be played in Pensacola, with two in Montgomery...they next play May 17-22 in Montgomery...last season, the Blue Wahoos went 13-11 against the Biscuits with an 8-4 record at home...Pensacola held the season series 64-62 entering this week's games.

**HEY, NINETEEN:** Rising prospect Eury Pérez celebrated his 19th birthday last Friday as the Blue Wahoos starting pitcher...he was the team's Opening Day starter as an 18 year old...he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Braves RHP Jackson Stephens was added to the major league roster last week, marking his first time in MLB since breaking in with the Reds in 2017 and 2018...Stephens pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2016...earlier this season, Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB.

**A LOOK BACK:** In their first year as a Marlins affiliate, the Blue Wahoos played to a 57-54 record in 2021...their 3.51 team ERA was the best in the Double-A South, but their .212 batting average was the lowest in the league...four players were named Postseason All-Stars: Max Meyer (RHP), Jake Eder (LHP), Colton Hock (RP) and Peyton Burdick (OF)...Burdick's 23 home runs marked a franchise single-season record.

**FEELING BRAND NEW:** Blue Wahoos stadium received several upgrades prior to the 2022 season, most notably the replacement of natural grass with FieldTurf and the addition of LED lights to ensure the facility continues to meet MLB standards...the FieldTurf, installed and completed in March, is of a similar composition to the fields at LoanDepot Park in Miami and ABC Supply Stadium in High-A Beloit...it is the only artificial playing surface in the Southern League...also new in 2022: The Pepsi Pirate Ship Deck in right-center field.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Will Stewart makes his third appearance, and second start, of the 2022 season in Thursday's game against Montgomery.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Stewart made his first start of the season last Thursday at Rocket City, taking a no-decision in a 5-3 win...he allowed one run on 5 hits over 4.0 innings...three of the five hits against him never left the infield...he left in a 1-1 tie before Paul McIntosh delivered a game-tying two-run double in the sixth and Griffin Conine brought home the go-ahead run on a sacrifice fly.

**AGAINST THE BISCUITS:** Stewart faced Montgomery five times last season, going 0-2 with a 5.66 ERA (13 ER in 20.2 IP)...he struggled against them at Blue Wahoos Stadium, allowing 9 ER in 8.1 innings at his home ballpark.

**LAST YEAR:** Stewart pitched the entire 2021 season in Pensacola, going 5-8 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 starts...he coaxed 14 double plays, second-most in the Double-A South...he fell one out shy of his third straight 100-inning season, finishing at 99.2 IP.

**TRADING POST:** Stewart arrived in the Marlins organization in the February 2019 trade that sent J.T. Realmuto to the Phillies...Stewart was part of the return that included Jorge Alfaro, Sixto Sanchez and cash considerations.

**TARGET PRACTICE:** Stewart hit 25 batters last season with the Blue Wahoos, the most for any Marlins minor league pitcher in franchise history...he has hit 1 batter so far this season.

**HUNTSVILLE STAR:** Stewart attended Hazel Green High School, approximately 24 miles northeast of Toyota Field, home of the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Stewart was originally selected by the Phillies in the 20th round of the 2015 Draft...favorite movie is The Great Gatsby and his favorite TV show is Lucifer...says his secret talent is having two black belts...started a foundation in memory of his godmother that helps combat Stage IV metastatic breast cancer.
