WHAT'S GOIN' ON: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Montgomery Biscuits, Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays, on Friday night.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Blue Wahoos have won two games in a row for the first time this season after a 7-0 victory over Montgomery on Thursday night...it also marked the team's first shutout win of the year, as Will Stewart, Anthony Maldonado and Andrew Nardi combined to hold the Biscuits to four singles...after trading zeroes through six innings, Griffin Conine forced in the first run of the game on a bases-loaded walk and Cobie Fletcher-Vance followed up with a two-run double...the Blue Wahoos added four more runs in the eighth on only one hit, a Thomas Jones RBI single against Biscuits backup catcher Erik Ostberg.

**WOMEN IN SPORTS NIGHT:** Tonight the Blue Wahoos celebrate Women in Sports night, with three special guests coming to the ballpark who have Pensacola roots...two-time WNBA All-Star Michelle Snow, 1988 Olympic silver medalist swimmer Beth Barr, and three-time All-American gymnast Melissa Miller-Schubeck will speak pregame and throw out ceremonial first pitches...Snow led Pensacola High School to a state championship, became the third NCAA women's basketball player to dunk at Tennessee, and made the All-Star team in 2005 and 2006 in a 13-year WNBA career...as a 16-year-old at Booker T. Washington High School in Pensacola, Barr won silver in Seoul for swimming the backstroke leg of the 4x100-meter medley relay...Miller-Schubeck received national recognition as a gymnast for Tate High and was inducted into the University of Florida Hall of Fame after winning the SEC All-Around Championship in 1988 and 1989.

**HEY, NINETEEN:** Rising prospect Eury Pérez gets the start for the Blue Wahoos tonight, one week after celebrating his 19th birthday...he was the team's Opening Day starter as an 18 year old...he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

**ENCARNACION, IN THE FLESH:** Jerar Encarnacion is red hot at the plate, batting .484 (15-for-31) in eight games since April 13...he has four homers on the season, tying him with three others for the league lead, and all have come in that span...his .347 season average ranks seventh in the league, and his 9 RBI are tied for fourth.

**GREAT WHITE NORTH:** The Blue Wahoos made a pair of roster moves prior to Tuesday's game, adding catcher J.D. Osborne from Triple-A Jacksonville and sending catcher Jose Estrada down to High-A Beloit...Estrada spent the first nine games of the season on the Pensacola roster but did not appear in a game...Osborne went 1-for-4 with the Jumbo Shrimp, and was 0-for-2 as the DH in his 2022 Wahoos debut on Tuesday...Osborne split time between Jacksonville and Pensacola last season, and also spent time representing Team Canada in the WBSC Olympic qualifiers.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .395 average through 10 games that is second in Southern League...he is also second in OBP and OPS, and fourth in SLG...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple four days later...undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

**REAPING AND HOEING:** Bryan Hoeing has delivered the longest start in the Southern League through two weeks...he struck out 10 batters on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...last Sunday his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

**TICK, TOCK:** The Blue Wahoos have played their two fastest games of the season the past two nights, beating the Biscuits 6-4 in 2:24 on Thursday and completing a 7-0 shutout in 2:20 on Friday...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season... last Sunday against Rocket City, the two teams played 11 innings in 2:48...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement last week.

**BUTTERED BISCUITS:** The Blue Wahoos and Biscuits will play each other 30 times this season...three series will be played in Pensacola, with two in Montgomery...they next play May 17-22 in Montgomery...last season, the Blue Wahoos went 13-11 against the Biscuits with an 8-4 record at home...Pensacola held the season series 64-62 entering this week's games.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Braves RHP Jackson Stephens was added to the major league roster last week, marking his first time in MLB since breaking in with the Reds in 2017 and 2018...Stephens pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2016...earlier this season, Twins RHP Jhoan Duran became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Eury Pérez makes his third Double-A start on Friday against Montgomery.

**BEST IN CLASS:** Pérez is ranked the top prospect in the Marlins organization according to Baseball America, and the #4 prospect according to MLB Pipeline...BA ranks his fastball as the best in the system.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pérez took the loss last Friday at Rocket City, allowing 5 runs, 3 earned, over 3.2 innings...he allowed a two-run homer to Trey Cabbage in the first inning and an RBI double to Anthony Mulrine in the second, and left trailing 3-2 in the fourth with two runners on that later scored...he would have completed 4.0 innings if not for a throwing error he committed on a potential double play grounder... the Blue Wahoos lost the game 6-4.

AGAINST THE BISCUITS: Pérez has never faced Montgomery or a Rays affiliate.

**GRAND OPENING**: Pérez got the Opening Day nod for the Blue Wahoos on April 8 vs. Biloxi, taking a no-decision in a 13-11 loss...he allowed three runs over 4.1 innings, though two runs scored after his departure.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, Pérez split 2021 between Low-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit...he made 20 starts in total (15 in Jupiter, 5 in Beloit), going 3-5 with a 1.96 ERA...he struck out 108 batters in 78.0 innings...in Jupiter, he was 2-3 with a 1.51 ERA...his peripheral numbers were even better after an August 17 promotion to Beloit, lowering his WHIP from 0.95 to 0.73 and his opponent average from .163 to .145, but his ERA jumped up to 2.86 with the Snappers after his final appearance of the season in which he allowed 4 runs in 4.0 innings.

**YOUNG GUN:** Pérez is the first teenager in the 10-year history of the Blue Wahoos franchise, and was just the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team (Edgar Renteria, Portland, 1995)...the last teenagers to play for a Marlins Double-A team were Mike (nee Giancarlo) Stanton and Matt Dominguez for the Jacksonville Suns in 2009

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Full name: Eury Rafael Pérez (pronounced PAIR-ez)...greatest accomplishment was completing school...takes regular English classes provided by Marlins...favorite movie is Rápido y Furioso (Fast and Furious)...favorite pitcher growing up was Pedro Martinez...pregame meal is arroz carnes (meat and rice)...on Twitter @Eury\_Perez9.
