WHAT'S GOIN' ON: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos begin a six-game series against the Biloxi Shuckers, Double-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, on Tuesday night.

A LOOK BACK: The Blue Wahoos got another dominant start from Bryan Hoeing on Sunday afternoon, defeating the Montgomery Biscuits 4-1 to secure a series split...Hoeing allowed one earned run, his first of the season, over 5.2 innings to earn his first Double-A win...Luis Aviles Jr. opened up the scoring with an RBI double in the second inning...Santiago Chávez snapped an 0-for-19 skid with an RBI single two batters later...Troy Johnston and Griffin Conine each had their first three-hit games of the season, collecting back-to-back RBI hits in the fifth...Josh Simpson, Andrew Nardi and Colton Hock combined to strike out 8 batters over 3.1 scoreless innings of relief.

WE'RE GOING TO JACKSON (EVENTUALLY): The Blue Wahoos embarked on a 12-game road trip today, visiting Biloxi and Mississippi for the first time this season...they were swept by the Shuckers in three games on Opening Weekend...it is the first of two 12-game road trips this season, with the second coming August 30-September 11 to Chattanooga and Tennessee.

ROBERSON RETURNS: The Blue Wahoos activated right-handed pitcher Josh Roberson from the injured list on Tuesday...he had been on a rehab assignment with Class-A Jupiter to start the season, allowing 5 ER in 4.0 innings with 6 walks and 8 strikeouts over four relief appearances...Roberson played at four different affiliates in 2021, but saw most of his time in Pensacola going 1-1 with an 8.10 ERA in 26.2 relief innings.

REAPING AND HOEING: Bryan Hoeing was added to the MLB Pipeline Marlins Top 30 list at #30 last Friday after the graduation of Cody Poteet... Hoeing has delivered the longest start in the Southern League so far, and leads the circuit in ERA at 0.48...he struck out 10 batters on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City on April 15 were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

ENCARNA-SEE YA, GONE: Jerar Encarnacion saw an 11-game hitting streak come to a close on Sunday with an 0-for-4 afternoon...he batted .500/.571/.929 (21-for-42) with 5 home runs and 10 RBI from April 12-23...his five homers on the season tie him with two others for the league lead...his .367 season average ranks third in the league, and his 22 hits are most in the league.

3K RESOLUTION: Former Marlins farmhand Miguel Cabrera picked up his 3000th career hit on Saturday with the Detroit Tigers...Cabrera played in the Southern League for the Carolina Mudcats in 2003 before joining Florida's World Series-winning roster later in the season...the Mudcats franchise relocated to Pensacola for the 2012 season, though a new Mudcats team was established in the Carolina League and took on the old team's historical record.

GREAT WHITE NORTH: The Blue Wahoos made a pair of roster moves last week, adding catcher J.D. Osborne from Triple-A Jacksonville and sending catcher Jose Estrada down to High-A Beloit on April 19...Estrada spent the first nine games of the season on the Pensacola roster but did not appear in a game...Osborne went 1-for-4 with the Jumbo Shrimp...Osborne split time between Jacksonville and Pensacola last season, and also spent time representing Team Canada in the WBSC Olympic qualifiers.

MAC ATTACK: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh couldn't have gone much better, with a .367 average through 12 games that is fourth in Southern League...he is also fourth in OBP, fifth in OPS, and sixth in SLG...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple four days later...undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

TICK, TOCK: The Blue Wahoos played every game last week in less than 3 hours, including a season-low 2:20 last Friday...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season, the last coming April 16 at Rocket City in 3:05...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement last week.

SHUCKIN' AROUND: The Blue Wahoos and Shuckers will play each other 30 times this season, with 15 games in each city...the Shuckers swept the three-game series in Pensacola on Opening Weekend, though the Blue Wahoos had the tying or winning run at the plate in the final inning of each game...the Blue Wahoos are 76-72 all-time against the Shuckers entering this series...they next meet May 31-June 5 in Pensacola.

HEY, NINETEEN: 19-year-old Eury Pérez is Pensacola's Friday night starter...he was the team's Opening Day starter as an 18 year old...he is the first teenager to play for the Blue Wahoos in franchise history and the first to play for a Marlins Double-A club since Giancarlo Stanton and Matt Dominguez played for the Jacksonville Suns as 19-year-olds in 2009...he became the second 18-year-old to play for a Marlins Double-A team, the first being shortstop Edgar Rentería with the Portland Sea Dogs in 1995...the only other Marlins teenagers to play at the Double-A level are Miguel Cabrera (19, Carolina, 2003), Adrián González (19, Portland, 2002) and Álex González (19, Portland, 1996), all of whom were position players.

ALUMNI REPORT: Right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran made the Twins' Opening Day roster as a reliever and became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB...Duran pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2019 in the team's lone year as a Twins affiliate.

TONIGHT'S START: George Soriano makes his third Double-A start in the series opener against Biloxi.

LAST TIME OUT: Soriano allowed one run on five hits over 4.0 innings last Tuesday against Montgomery, leaving in a 1-1 tie...the Biscuits won the game 5-1... in addition to five hits, Soriano hit a batter, walked two, issued a wild pitch and balked...the first two innings ended with double plays, one a ground ball and the other a play at the plate on a fly ball.

AGAINST THE SHUCKERS: Soriano has never faced Biloxi, though he has history against many players from his time in the Midwest League...of note, Thomas Dillard is 3-for-7 with 1 RBI and 3 strikeouts, and Garrett Mitchell is 2-for-2.

LAST YEAR: Soriano began the 2021 season with Low-A Jupiter before a promotion to High-A Beloit on June 29...he went 7-1 with a 3.43 ERA in 18 starts between the two levels...his 114 strikeouts in 89.1 innings were fourth-most for any Marlins minor leaguer...he struck out 10 batters on three occasions, including back-to-back starts August 14 and August 22.

IN THE PIPELINE: Soriano is currently ranked the #27 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline, up from #28 at the start of the season... according to his scouting report, "He must refine his control and command, though he did a better job of throwing strikes following his promotion to High-A...how well he can locate his pitches will determine whether he can fit in the back half of a rotation vs. maxing out as a middle reliever."

PRE-PANDEMIC: Soriano spent the entire 2019 season at Low-A Clinton, played 2018 in the GCL and missed the 2017 season due to injury.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Warm-up music is Tú No Metes Cabra (I'm Not Afraid of You) by Bad Bunny...favorite movie is G.I. Joe...on Twitter @G_Soriano1124...favorite actor is Will Smith...if he could have a superpower, he would have super speed...favorite player growing up was Alfonso Soriano, who shares his last name and is also from San Pedro de Macoris...says his secret talent is telling the truth all the time...favorite pregame meal is arroz pollo habichuelas y aguacate (rice, chicken and beans with avocado).
