WHAT'S GOIN' ON: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their six-game series against the Biloxi Shuckers, Double-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, on Saturday night.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Blue Wahoos combined for a one-hit shutout of the Shuckers on Friday, collecting a 4-0 win...Eury Pérez earned his first Double-A win, striking out a career-high 12 batters over 5.0 one-hit innings...only a Gabe Holt double in the third inning prevented a no-hitter...Josh Simpson, Andrew Nardi and Eli Villalobos combined for 4.0 hitless innings of relief...the 18 total strikeouts for the pitching staff were the most since the Blue Wahoos struck out 19 Rocket City batters on May 22, 2021...Ray-Patrick Didder had three hits, including his second homer of the year...Paul McIntosh singled, drew a pair of walks, and became the first Blue Wahoos baserunner to steal two bases.

LA KABRA: Eury Pérez's 12 strikeouts on Friday were the most for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jake Eder fanned 12 M-Braves batters on May 6, 2021...the single-game record belongs to Tony Cingrani, who struck out 15 Jackson Generals batters over 8.0 innings on June 27, 2012... second place belongs to Luis Castillo, who struck out 13 Mississippi batters on June 13, 2017...other 12-strikeout games belong to Cody Reed on August 5, 2015 at Jacksonville and Bailey Ober on August 21, 2019 vs. Mississippi.
 BICE, BICE, BABY: The Blue Wahoos activated right-handed pitcher Dylan Bice from the injured list on Thursday, bringing their roster back to

a full 28 players...Bice, acquired in the minor league portion of the Rule 5 Draft from the Rangers organization prior to the 2021 season, went 5-3 with a 3.13 ERA in 54.2 relief innings for the Blue Wahoos last year...he led the team in relief innings, and was fourth in the Double-A South.

**A CROMULENT START:** Josh Simpson turned in 2.0 more hitless innings of relief on Friday night, bringing his season totals to 11.1 scoreless innings of three-hit baseball...he has struck out 24 while walking only 4, and has held opponents to a .086 average.

**TICK, TOCK:** The Blue Wahoos played Wednesday's game in 2:05, their fastest game time of the year, and played a brisk 2:26 on Friday...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season, the last coming April 16 at Rocket City in 3:05...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement in the second week of the season.

**ENCARNA-SEE YA, GONE:** Jerar Encarnacion added another hit on Friday to bring his batting average to .a league-leading 360...his 27 hits are also most in the circuit...he is tied with Mississippi's Drew Lugbauer for third in the league in homers with six, behind only Tennessee's Nelson Velazquez with 7 and Rocket City's Trey Cabbage with 8...he batted .500/.571/.929 (21-for-42) with 5 home runs and 10 RBI in an 11-game hitting streak from April 12-23.

WE'RE GOING TO JACKSON (EVENTUALLY): The Blue Wahoos embarked on a 12-game road trip Tuesday, visiting Biloxi and Mississippi for the first time this season...they were swept by the Shuckers in three games on Opening Weekend...it is the first of two 12-game road trips this season, with the second coming August 30-September 11 to Chattanooga and Tennessee.

**ROBERSON RETURNS:** The Blue Wahoos activated right-handed pitcher Josh Roberson from the injured list on Tuesday, and he made his first apperance on the mound on Thursday...he had been on a rehab assignment with Class-A Jupiter to start the season, allowing 5 ER in 4.0 innings with 6 walks and 8 strikeouts over four relief appearances...Roberson played at four different affiliates in 2021, but saw most of his time in Pensacola going 1-1 with an 8.10 ERA in 26.2 relief innings.

**REAPING AND HOEING:** Bryan Hoeing was added to the MLB Pipeline Marlins Top 30 list at #30 last week after the graduation of Cody Poteet... Hoeing has delivered the longest start in the Southern League so far, and leads the circuit in ERA at 0.48...he struck out 10 batters on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City on April 15 were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

**MAC ATTACK**: The Double-A debut for catcher Paul McIntosh is off to a great start, with a .327 average through 15 games that is fifth in the Southern League...he is also third in OBP and sixth in OPS...he has homered twice, including in his first at-bat on Opening Day, and added the club's first triple four days later...undrafted last season after a stellar collegiate career at West Virginia, McIntosh was signed by the Marlins and led Low-A Jupiter with a 1.021 OPS after joining the team.

**SHUCKIN' AROUND:** The Blue Wahoos and Shuckers will play each other 30 times this season, with 15 games in each city...the Shuckers swept the three-game series in Pensacola on Opening Weekend, though the Blue Wahoos had the tying or winning run at the plate in the final inning of each game...the Blue Wahoos are 76-72 all-time against the Shuckers entering this series...they next meet May 31-June 5 in Pensacola.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Cole Sands, who appeared in one game for the Blue Wahoos in 2019, was added to the Twins active roster on Saturday and is poised to make his MLB debut...Jimmy Herget, who played for the Blue Wahoos in 2017, got some swings and misses in an Angels uniform on Friday that made the rounds on baseball Twitter...right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran made the Twins' Opening Day roster as a reliever and became the 104th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB...Duran pitched for the Blue Wahoos in 2019 in the team's lone year as a Twins affiliate.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Zach McCambley makes his fourth start of the 2022 season on Saturday night against Biloxi.

**LAST TIME OUT:** McCambley struggled last Saturday against Montgomery, cruising through the first two innings but allowing 6 runs on only two hits in the third...he departed trailing 6-3 and took the loss in a 7-6 defeat...Jordan Qsar hit a three-run triple with two outs to cap the inning.

**AGAINST THE SHUCKERS:** McCambley faced Biloxi on opening weekend, allowing 4 runs, 2 earned, over 5.0 innings in a game the Blue Wahoos lost 6-5...he allowed a two-run homer to Felix Valerio...he faced the Shuckers three times last year, going 0-2 with a 5.93 ERA in 13.2 innings and 7 home runs allowed.

**IN THE PIPELINE:** McCambley entered 2022 as the #15 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline, and the fifth-ranked RHP...their grades place the following value on his pitches (on a 20-80 scouting scale): FB 55, CV 65, CH 45, Control 50, Overall 45.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, McCambley began the 2021 campaign at High-A Beloit...he went 2-4 with a 3.79 ERA in 11 starts, earning a promotion to Pensacola on July 7...he was leading the High-A Central with 73 strikeouts at the time of his promotion...he ranked third in the Marlins farm system in strikeouts over the course of the full season.

**DRAFT DAY:** McCambley was Miami's 3rd round selection (75th overall) in the shortened 2020 Draft...he played three seasons at Coastal Carolina, going 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA across 25.0 innings in the COVID-shortened 2022 NCAA season...he watched the Draft telecast from his dad's bar and grill in Myrtle Beach.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING: "Some scouts thought McCambley had the best curveball in the 2020 Draft, a low-80s bender with high spin rates that dives at the plate and grades as a plus-plus weapon at times." - MLB Pipeline.
