WHAT'S GOIN' ON: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos begin a six-game series against the Mississippi Braves, Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, on Tuesday evening.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Blue Wahoos salvaged a series split against the Biloxi Shuckers on Sunday afternoon, winning 4-1...Bryan Hoeing delivered 7.0 scoreless innings to earn his second win...the Shuckers were held to just three hits and one unearned run...Griffin Conine hit his third home run of the season...Eli Villalobos picked up his first save with a perfect ninth inning.

**HOEING ON UP:** Bryan Hoeing was promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday after a stellar first month of the season...in his first four starts at the Double-A level, the Marlins' #30 prospect according to MLB Pipeline was 2-1 with a miniscule 0.35 ERA...he led the league with 25.2 innings at the time of his promotion, and allowed only one earned run during that time...he struck out 10 batters in his Blue Wahoos debut on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City on April 15 were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

LA KABRA: Eury Pérez was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday after a nearly perfect start on Friday at Biloxi...he struck out 12 batters over 5.0 one-hit innings, the most for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jake Eder fanned 12 M-Braves batters on May 6, 2021...the single-game record belongs to Tony Cingrani, who struck out 15 Jackson Generals batters over 8.0 innings on June 27, 2012...second place belongs to Luis Castillo, who struck out 13 Mississippi batters on June 13, 2017...other 12-strikeout games belong to Cody Reed on August 5, 2015 at Jacksonville and Bailey Ober on August 21, 2019 vs. Mississippi.

**LINDY HOPS OVER:** The Blue Wahoos received right-handed pitcher Jeff Lindgren down from Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday to take the rotation spot of Bryan Hoeing...Lindgren, who went 6-8 with a 3.82 ERA in 106.0 innings for the Blue Wahoos last year, was 1-1 with a 7.64 ERA in his first taste of Triple-A to start the season.

**APRIL SHOWERS:** The Blue Wahoos finished the month of April with an 8-12 record, 4.0 games back of first-place Biloxi in the South Division... their 84 runs scored and .677 OPS were last in the league...their team ERA of 3.63, however, was second-best behind only Biloxi's 3.12... the 223 strikeouts from their pitching staff were also second-most in the league, and 95.0 innings from starting pitchers were most in the circuit...their relievers pitched to a 3.02 ERA, lowest in the league.

**BICE, BICE, BABY:** The Blue Wahoos activated right-handed pitcher Dylan Bice from the injured list on Thursday, and put him in Saturday's game for his 2022 debut...Bice, acquired in the minor league portion of the Rule 5 Draft from the Rangers organization prior to the 2021 season, went 5-3 with a 3.13 ERA in 54.2 relief innings for the Blue Wahoos last year...he led the team in relief innings, and was fourth in the Double-A South.

**A CROMULENT START:** Josh Simpson turned in 2.0 more hitless innings of relief on Friday night, bringing his season totals to 11.1 scoreless innings of three-hit baseball...he has struck out 24 while walking only 4, and has held opponents to a .086 average.

**TICK, TOCK:** The Blue Wahoos played last Wednesday's game in 2:05, their fastest game time of the year, and played a brisk 2:18 on Sunday...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season, the last coming April 16 at Rocket City in 3:05... experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement in the second week of the season.

**ENCARNA-SEE YA, GONE:** Jerar Encarnacion is batting .341, fourth-best in the league...his 28 hits are also second-most in the circuit...he is tied for fourth in the league in homers with six...he batted .500/.571/.929 (21-for-42) with 5 home runs and 10 RBI in an 11-game hitting streak from April 12-23.

**WE'RE GOING TO JACKSON (EVENTUALLY):** The Blue Wahoos embarked on a 12-game road trip last Tuesday, splitting a six-game series with Biloxi before this week's six-game series against the M-Braves...it is the first of two 12-game road trips this season, with the second coming August 30-September 11 to Chattanooga and Tennessee.

MMM...BRAVES: The Blue Wahoos and M-Braves will play each other 30 times this season, with 18 games coming in Mississippi and 12 games in Pensacola...the teams next meet at Blue Wahoos Stadium May 24-29...last season, the Blue Wahoos were 11-14 against Mississippi...the M-Braves went on to win the Double-A South Championship, just weeks before their major league affiliate won the World Series.

**ALUMNI REPORT:** Two former Blue Wahoos made their MLB debuts in the past week...Cole Sands, who appeared in one game for the Blue Wahoos in 2019, was added to the Twins active roster on Saturday and debuted on Sunday to become the 105th Blue Wahoos alumnus to play in MLB...on Monday, Jose Miranda, who played in one regular season game and five postseason games for the Blue Wahoos in 2019, debuted for the Twins as their starting third baseman...right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran, who also played for Pensacola in 2019, made Minnesota's Opening Day roster as a reliever and earned his first career save on Monday night.

**TONIGHT'S START:** George Soriano makes his fourth Double-A start in the series opener against Mississippi.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Soriano allowed three runs over 3.1 innings last Tuesday at Biloxi, with all three runs coming on one hit in the first inning...Soriano tied a career high with six walks...he left trailing 3-2, but the Blue Wahoos scored four unearned runs in the ninth to win it 7-4.

AGAINST THE M-BRAVES: Soriano has never faced Mississippi or a Braves affiliate.

**LAST YEAR:** Soriano began the 2021 season with Low-A Jupiter before a promotion to High-A Beloit on June 29...he went 7-1 with a 3.43 ERA in 18 starts between the two levels...his 114 strikeouts in 89.1 innings were fourth-most for any Marlins minor leaguer...he struck out 10 batters on three occasions, including back-to-back starts August 14 and August 22.

IN THE PIPELINE: Soriano is currently ranked the #27 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline, up from #28 at the start of the season... according to his scouting report, "He must refine his control and command, though he did a better job of throwing strikes following his promotion to High-A...how well he can locate his pitches will determine whether he can fit in the back half of a rotation vs. maxing out as a middle reliever."

**PRE-PANDEMIC:** Soriano spent the entire 2019 season at Low-A Clinton, played 2018 in the GCL and missed the 2017 season due to injury.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Warm-up music is Tú No Metes Cabra (I'm Not Afraid of You) by Bad Bunny...favorite movie is G.I. Joe...on Twitter @G\_Soriano1124...favorite actor is Will Smith...if he could have a superpower, he would have super speed...favorite player growing up was Alfonso Soriano, who shares his last name and is also from San Pedro de Macoris...says his secret talent is telling the truth all the time...favorite pregame meal is arroz pollo habichuelas y aguacate (rice, chicken and beans with avocado).
