**WHAT'S GOIN' ON:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Mississippi Braves, Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, on Wednesday evening.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Blue Wahoos fell 3-2 to the M-Braves in their series opener on Tuesday...Ray-Patrick Didder, playing against his former team, went 3-for-4 with a home run to account for three of Pensacola's five hits...George Soriano had his longest start of the season, completing 5.0 innings of three-run ball, but took his first loss...Anthony Maldonado, Jefry Yan and Josh Simpson combined for 3.0 scoreless, one-hit innings of relief.

**A CROMULENT START:** Josh Simpson turned in another hitless, scoreless inning of relief on Tuesday, bringing his season totals to 12.1 scoreless innings of three-hit baseball...he has struck out 25 while walking only 4, and has held opponents to a .079 average.

**TICK, TOCK:** The Blue Wahoos played Tuesday's series opener against Mississippi in 2:10, just five minutes shy of their season-low 2:05 last Wednesday at Biloxi...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season, the last coming April 16 at Rocket City in 3:05...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement in the second week of the season.

**NOT THROWING AWAY HIS SHOT:** Tuesday in Baltimore, former Blue Wahoo and current Twin Jose Miranda collected an RBI double for his first big league hit...Miranda, who played in one regular season game and five postseason games for the Blue Wahoos in 2019, is the cousin of "Hamilton" creator Lin-Manuel Miranda...right-handed pitcher Cole Sands, who appeared in one game for the Blue Wahoos in 2019, debuted for the Twins last Sunday...right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran, who also played for Pensacola in 2019, made Minnesota's Opening Day roster as a reliever and earned his first career save on Monday night.

**HOEING ON UP:** Bryan Hoeing was promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday after a stellar first month of the season...in his first four starts at the Double-A level, the Marlins' #30 prospect according to MLB Pipeline was 2-1 with a miniscule 0.35 ERA...he led the league with 25.2 innings at the time of his promotion, and allowed only one earned run during that time...he struck out 10 batters in his Blue Wahoos debut on April 8 against Biloxi, tying a career high over 5.2 innings...his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City on April 15 were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

**LA KABRA:** Eury Pérez was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday after a nearly perfect start on Friday at Biloxi...he struck out 12 batters over 5.0 one-hit innings, the most for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jake Eder fanned 12 M-Braves batters on May 6, 2021...the single-game record belongs to Tony Cingrani, who struck out 15 Jackson Generals batters over 8.0 innings on June 27, 2012...second place belongs to Luis Castillo, who struck out 13 Mississippi batters on June 13, 2017...other 12-strikeout games belong to Cody Reed on August 5, 2015 at Jacksonville and Bailey Ober on August 21, 2019 vs. Mississippi.

**LINDY HOPS OVER:** The Blue Wahoos received right-handed pitcher Jeff Lindgren down from Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday to take the rotation spot of Bryan Hoeing...Lindgren, who went 6-8 with a 3.82 ERA in 106.0 innings for the Blue Wahoos last year, was 1-1 with a 7.64 ERA in his first taste of Triple-A to start the season.

**APRIL SHOWERS:** The Blue Wahoos finished the month of April with an 8-12 record, 4.0 games back of first-place Biloxi in the South Division...their 84 runs scored and .677 OPS were last in the league...their team ERA of 3.63, however, was second-best behind only Biloxi's 3.12...the 223 strikeouts from their pitching staff were also second-most in the league, and 95.0 innings from starting pitchers were most in the circuit...their relievers pitched to a 3.02 ERA, lowest in the league.

**BICE, BICE, BABY:** The Blue Wahoos activated right-handed pitcher Dylan Bice from the injured list on Thursday, and put him in Saturday's game for his 2022 debut...Bice, acquired in the minor league portion of the Rule 5 Draft from the Rangers organization prior to the 2021 season, went 5-3 with a 3.13 ERA in 54.2 relief innings for the Blue Wahoos last year...he led the team in relief innings, and was fourth in the Double-A South.

**ENCARNA-SEE YA, GONE:** Jerar Encarnacion is batting .341, fourth-best in the league...his 28 hits are also second-most in the circuit...he is tied for fourth in the league in homers with six...he batted .500/.571/.929 (21-for-42) with 5 home runs and 10 RBI in an 11-game hitting streak from April 12-23.

**WE'RE GOING TO JACKSON (EVENTUALLY):** The Blue Wahoos embarked on a 12-game road trip last Tuesday, splitting a six-game series with Biloxi before this week's six-game series against the M-Braves...it is the first of two 12-game road trips this season, with the second coming August 30-September 11 to Chattanooga and Tennessee.

**MMM...BRAVES:** The Blue Wahoos and M-Braves will play each other 30 times this season, with 18 games coming in Mississippi and 12 games in Pensacola...the teams next meet at Blue Wahoos Stadium May 24-29...last season, the Blue Wahoos were 11-14 against Mississippi...the M-Braves went on to win the Double-A South Championship, just weeks before their major league affiliate won the World Series.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Cody Mincey makes his fourth Double-A appearance in game two against Mississippi.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Mincey has gone 5.0 innings in each of his first three Double-A starts, including last Wednesday at Biloxi...he allowed a two-run homer to Joey Wiemer in the first inning, and it proved to be the only runs of the game...Mincey allowed a career-high 6 hits, though none scored after the home run.

**AGAINST THE BRAVES:** Mincey has never faced the Braves, or an Atlanta affiliate.

**LAST YEAR:** Mincey was signed by the Marlins last July 17 out of the independent American Association, where he pitched to a 1.13 ERA in 40.0 innings for the Kansas City Monarchs...he was assigned to High-A Beloit, where he continued to dominate with a 1.35 ERA in 33.1 relief innings.

**DOWN UNDER:** Mincey played for the Melbourne Aces of the Australian Baseball League in the 2019-20 winter, pitching in six games...he appeared in another four postseason games as the Aces won the Claxton Shield, the ABL's championship.

**I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE:** Mincey played this past winter in both the Venezuelan Winter League (Aguilas del Zulia) and the Dominican Winter League (Gigantes del Cibao)...in the 2020-21 offseason, he pitched in the Mexican Pacific Winter League (Charros de Jalisco) and the Colombian team in the Caribbean Series...in independent baseball, he pitched for the Windy City ThunderBolts (2017), the River City Rascals (2017-18), the Long Island Ducks (2019) and the Kansas City Monarchs (2021).

**COLLEGE DAYS:** Mincey began his collegiate career at Spartanburg Methodist College in Spartanburg, SC, where he helped lead SMC to the 2013 JUCO World Series...he transferred to South Carolina and pitched to a 3.59 ERA in two seasons, graduating in 2015 with a psychology degree.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Mincey has served as a physical education teacher and athletic director at the high school level in the offseason in his home state of South Carolina...he supports the Make-A-Wish Foundation...on Twitter @codymincey5...favorite TV show is Golf Now...favorite player growing up was Mariano Rivera.
