WHAT'S GOIN' ON: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Mississippi Braves, Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, on Saturday evening.

LAST TIME OUT: The Blue Wahoos won their first extra-inning game on Friday night, defeating the M-Braves 6-4 in 11 innings...they scored four runs in the top of the 11th, highlighted by RBI doubles from Paul McIntosh and Hayden Cantrelle and an RBI single from Cobie Fletcher-Vance...starter Eury Pérez had the longest outing of his professional career, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.2 innings while striking out six...the Blue Wahoos struck out a season-high 19 times, with 11 coming in the first four innings against Mississippi starter Alan Rangel.

BUGGIN' OUT: The Marlins transferred right-handed pitcher Parker Bugg to Triple-A Jacksonville on Saturday, where he began the season... Bugg went 1-1 with a 4.00 ERA in four relief appearances for the Blue Wahoos, striking out 11 and walking 12 in 9.0 innings.

ROYCE DA 1-1: Former Blue Wahoos infielder Royce Lewis made his big league debut for the Minnesota Twins on Friday, hitting a single in his fourth at-bat for his first major league hit...Lewis, who was the top overall pick in the 2017 Draft, batted .231 with 2 home runs and 14 RBI in 33 games with the Blue Wahoos in 2019, their only season as a Twins affiliate...Lewis became the 107th Blue Wahoos alumnus to debut in MLB, and the fourth this season...infielder Jose Miranda (2019), right-handed pitcher Cole Sands (2019) and right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran (2019) have also made it to the big leagues this year, all with the Twins.

HEY, NINETEEN: Eury Pérez, the reigning Southern League Pitcher of the Week, made his fifth Double-A start on Friday...the 19-year-old, named the Marlins' top prospect according to Baseball America, struck out six more batters over a career-high 5.2 innings...his 36 strikeouts are third-most in the Southern League this season.

HIT BULLPEN, WIN STEAK: The Blue Wahoos bullpen has been dominant so far this year, with an earned run average (2.68), WHIP (1.06), opponent batting average (.164) and K/9 (13.1) all tops at the Double-A level...their opponent average and WHIP are both best in MiLB...they have been used sparingly, with their 100.2 relief innings the fewest in the Southern League.

OUT TO MARKET: Catcher Jan Mercado joined the Blue Wahoos roster on Thursday as catcher Santiago Chávez was placed on Miami's taxi squad...Chávez batted .093 (4-for-43) in 13 games, hitting one home run and throwing out 5 of 11 base stealers...Mercado batted .261 with one home run and six RBI in eight games for the Class-A Jupiter Hammerheads...Mercado split the 2021 season between Jupiter and High-A Beloit.

A CROMULENT START: Josh Simpson turned in another 1.1 scoreless innings of relief on Friday, bringing his season totals to 13.2 scoreless innings of three-hit baseball...he has struck out 27 while walking only 6, and has held opponents to a .071 average.

TICK, TOCK: Friday's 11-inning game took 3:30, just the fourth three-hour game of the year and the first since April 16...they have played only two nine-inning games longer than three hours this season...experimental pitch clock rules enacted by MLB in the minors began strict enforcement in the second week of the season.

HOEING ON UP: Bryan Hoeing was promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday after a stellar first month of the season and debuts for the Jumbo Shrimp in Memphis on Saturday...in his first four starts at the Double-A level, the Marlins' #30 prospect according to MLB Pipeline was 2-1 with a miniscule 0.35 ERA...he led the league with 25.2 innings at the time of his promotion, and allowed only one earned run during that time...he struck out 10 batters in his Blue Wahoos debut on April 8 against Biloxi...his 7.1 scoreless innings at Rocket City on April 15 were the longest start for a Blue Wahoos pitcher since Jhoan Duran in August 2019.

LINDY HOPS OVER: The Blue Wahoos received right-handed pitcher Jeff Lindgren down from Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday to take the rotation spot of Bryan Hoeing...Lindgren, who went 6-8 with a 3.82 ERA in 106.0 innings for the Blue Wahoos last year, was 1-1 with a 7.64 ERA in his first taste of Triple-A to start the season...Lindgren is slated to make his 2022 Blue Wahoos debut on Sunday afternoon.

APRIL SHOWERS: The Blue Wahoos finished the month of April with an 8-12 record, 4.0 games back of first-place Biloxi in the South Division... their 84 runs scored and .677 OPS were last in the league...their team ERA of 3.63, however, was second-best behind only Biloxi's 3.12... the 223 strikeouts from their pitching staff were also second-most in the league, and 95.0 innings from starting pitchers were most in the circuit...their relievers pitched to a 3.02 ERA, lowest in the league.

ENCARNA-SEE YA, GONE: Jerar Encarnacion is batting .330, fifth-best in the league...his 31 hits are also tied for third-most in the circuit... he is tied for fifth in the league in homers with six...he batted .500/.571/.929 (21-for-42) with 5 home runs and 10 RBI in an 11-game hitting streak from April 12-23.

MMM...BRAVES: The Blue Wahoos and M-Braves will play each other 30 times this season, with 18 games coming in Mississippi and 12 games in Pensacola...the teams next meet at Blue Wahoos Stadium May 24-29...last season, the Blue Wahoos were 11-14 against Mississippi...the M-Braves went on to win the Double-A South Championship, just weeks before their major league affiliate won the World Series.

TONIGHT'S START: Zach McCambley makes his fifth start of the 2022 season on Saturday night against Mississippi.

LAST TIME OUT: McCambley took the loss last Saturday at Biloxi, allowing three runs, two earned, over 5.0 innings in a 9-1 defeat...he allowed an unearned run in the third and a go-ahead two-run homer to Cam Devanney in the fifth inning before departing with a 3-1 deficit.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: McCambley faced Mississippi twice last season, going 0-2 while allowing 10 earned runs in 8.0 innings...he allowed three home runs and seven walks in his two starts.

IN THE PIPELINE: McCambley entered 2022 as the #15 prospect in the Marlins organization according to MLB Pipeline, and the fifth-ranked RHP...their grades place the following value on his pitches (on a 20-80 scouting scale): FB 55, CV 65, CH 45, Control 50, Overall 45.

LAST YEAR: In his first professional season, McCambley began the 2021 campaign at High-A Beloit...he went 2-4 with a 3.79 ERA in 11 starts, earning a promotion to Pensacola on July 7...he was leading the High-A Central with 73 strikeouts at the time of his promotion...he ranked third in the Marlins farm system in strikeouts over the course of the full season.

DRAFT DAY: McCambley was Miami's 3rd round selection (75th overall) in the shortened 2020 Draft...he played three seasons at Coastal Carolina, going 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA across 25.0 innings in the COVID-shortened 2022 NCAA season...he watched the Draft telecast from his dad's bar and grill in Myrtle Beach.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING: "Some scouts thought McCambley had the best curveball in the 2020 Draft, a low-80s bender with high spin rates that dives at the plate and grades as a plus-plus weapon at times." - MLB Pipeline.
