**Today's Game:** The San Jose Giants play game two of a three-game series against the Stockton Ports today at Banner Island Ballpark. Jose Marte (0-0, 0.00 ERA) is slated to get the ball for the Giants. The 11:10 AM first pitch is the earliest scheduled start time for a San Jose game this season.

**Offense Erupts:** The Giants erupted for season-high totals of 10 runs and 11 hits in last night's series-opening 10-1 victory over Stockton. San Jose had scored only three runs in their previous 24 innings before yesterday. The #4 through #7 hitters in the Giants lineup (Joey Bart, Jean Angomas, John Riley & David Villar) combined to drive in all 10 runs last night. San Jose went 7-for-15 with runners in scoring position.

**On The Mound:** Through five games this season, the San Jose pitching staff owns a .178 opponents batting average – tied for the lowest mark in the California League (Stockton). The Giants hurlers have 64 strikeouts in 45 2/3 innings.

**San Francisco Affiliation:** This year marks the 32nd season as an affiliate of the San Francisco Giants – the longest current partnership in the California League. Since their inception in 1988, the San Jose Giants have won six league championships (1998, 2001, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2010), 11 North Division titles and qualified for the playoffs 22 times (in 31 seasons).

**Excite Ballpark:** The San Jose Giants have announced a three-year naming rights agreement with newly re-branded Excite Credit Union. Fans will now walk through the gates of Excite Ballpark, Home of the San Jose Giants. The naming rights deal highlights an expanded partnership between the two organizations. The 77-year old ballpark is now outfitted with new Excite Credit Union and Excite Ballpark signage all throughout the venue while the organizations are also partnering to enhance the fan experience with new promotions and community outreach programs.

**Returning Players:** 10 players on the opening day roster have prior experience in San Jose: LHP Caleb Baragar, LHP John Gavin, OF Bryce Johnson, LHP Joey Marciano, RHP DJ Myers, C/INF John Riley, RHP Frank Rubio, RHP John Russell, RHP Carlos Sano and RHP Raffi Vizcaino.

**Bart, Ramos Highlight Newcomers:** Catcher Joey Bart and outfielder Heliot Ramos highlight the 15 newcomers on San Jose's roster. *MLB.com* currently rates Bart the #1 prospect in the San Francisco organization and the top catching prospect in baseball. Bart was the second overall pick in the 2018 draft. Ramos, San Francisco's first round selection in 2017 (19th overall pick), is ranked the #2 prospect in the system according to *MLB.com*. At 19 years old, Ramos is the youngest player on San Jose's roster.

**2018 Review:** The Giants finished the 2018 season with a 59-81 overall record. It marked the second consecutive year that San Jose owned the worst record in the California League (62-78 in 2017). For the first time in team history, the Giants posted a sub-.500 overall record for a third straight season. San Jose went 34-36 in the first half and 25-45 in the second half last year.

**Pro Career:** 2019 marks the fourth season of his professional career ... Pitched for the Giants' Dominican Summer League affiliate in 2016 (1.89 ERA in five starts) ... Spent the majority of the 2017 season with the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes (Short-Season) ... Owned a 2-5 record and a 5.33 ERA in 14 starts.

**Signed:** Originally signed with the San Francisco Giants in 2015 as a 19-year old out of the Dominican Republic.

## #46 Jean Angomas (.263, 0 HR, 3 RBI, 2 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 4 games

- \* Outfielder is in his seventh professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2012 at age 17.
- \* Spent his third consecutive season with Augusta (A) in 2018.
- \* Was limited to just 22 games with Augusta last year ... Batted .254 with no home runs and 13 RBI's.
- \* Suffered a concussion on May 4 last year while playing LF – collided with CF Heliot Ramos and missed remainder of season.
- \* Batted .292 with one home run and 22 RBI's in 70 games for Augusta in 2017.

- \* Was an MiLB *Rawlings* Gold Glove Award winner last season (right field) ... Had 14 outfield assists.

- \* Attended Georgia Southern University ... Hit .292 during three-year collegiate career.

## #9 Joey Bart (.313, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 0 SB)

- \* Catcher is in his second professional season ... Selected in the 1st round (second overall pick) of the 2018 draft.
- \* Rated the #1 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com*.
- \* Tabbed the top catching prospect in baseball by *MLB.com* entering the 2019 season.
- \* Was a non-roster invitee to SF Giants major league camp this spring.
- \* Played for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2018 ... Hit .298 with 13 home runs and 39 RBI's in 45 games.
- \* Was named a midseason and postseason Northwest League All-Star ... Ranked third in the league in HR & fifth in RBI's.
- \* Attended Georgia Tech University ... Batted .321 with 30 home runs during three-year collegiate career.
- \* Was the ACC Player of the Year, First Team All-American & Johnny Bench Award winner as a junior in '18 (.359, 16 HR).

## #6 Orlando Garcia (.333, 0 HR, 2 RBI, 0 SB)

- \* Was second on the GreenJackets in hits (119), doubles (24), triples (8), home runs and RBI's.
- \* Played in the 2018 MLB Futures Game at Nationals Park.
- \* Hit .348 with six home runs in 35 games with the AZL Giants (Rookie) during the 2017 season.
