#### Gabe Kapler >>> Manager

The Giants welcome a new skipper this season, as Gabe Kapler takes the helm following the retirement of Bruce Bochy. Kapler is the 17th manager in San Francisco history—here are some quick facts about the California native.

- 1. Kapler's career included playing for six Major League teams and Japan's Yomiuri Giants.
- 2. His first gig as professional manager was in 2007, when he took a one-year sabbatical from playing to lead the Greenville Drive, the Single-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. Kapler went on to play three more seasons in the Major Leagues.
- 3. Kapler's understanding of advanced analytics and sabermetrics led to a front office job with the Dodgers, a manager's position with the Phillies and a spot as an on-camera analyst on the cable program MLB Whiparound.
- 4. A history buff, Kapler asked Bay Area reporters for recommendations of San Francisco's most interesting history books during the Giants' FanFest weekend in February.
- 5. Kapler lists Metallica's "Motorbreath" as one of his top 10 songs, so he's likely looking forward to the Giants' annual Metallica Night at Oracle Park.



### YAZ HE CAN



Mike Yastrzemski made a strong first impression with the Giants last season, his first in the Major Leagues. Acquired in a trade with the Orioles just before the start of the 2019 season, Yastrzemski made his debut in May, then hit 21 homers in just 107 games. In September, Yaz dazzled generations of fans with a monster home run during a series at Boston's Fenway Park, where his grandfather Carl played during his Hall of Fame career.

**The Gamer:** You grew up in a baseball family. Do you remember your first trip to a Major League ballpark?

Yastrzemski: I went to Fenway Park all the time, as far back as I can remember. I actually missed my first high school baseball game because [Red Sox outfielder] Dwight Evans had doubleparked behind us at Fenway and we couldn't get out. My coach laughed about that excuse.

**The Gamer:** How much attention did you pay to the San Francisco Giants while growing up?

Yastrzemski: Oh, I was very aware of the Giants. I was paying attention to Barry Bonds going for the home run record. I followed them closely—they were always an exciting team.

**The Gamer:** This is the first season in which you are looking forward to spending Opening Day on a Major League roster. How does that feel?

Yastrzemski: It's definitely a big deal. I have been thinking about how much comes down to little moments that define your life. For me, that day I was traded to the Giants was one of those



moments. I remember being so excited when I found out I had been traded; it was exciting to look forward to something new. It's really cool to see how that moment has worked out.

**The Gamer:** There are a lot of changes with the 2020 Giants. How do you feel about your role with the team this season?

Yastrzemski: We have had a lot of great organization here—it's been exciting to hear Gabe Kapler talk about his expectations for the team and for the season. For me, I am just looking forward to playing. I want to be in the lineup every day. I hope to play as many games as I can, and for the team to win as many games as we can.

**The Gamer:** How will the change in dimensions due to the bullpens in centerfield affect the way the Oracle Park plays?

Yastrzemski: I don't know yet. It will be interesting. But what is so unique about our ballpark is the weather—the weather is different every day and that has more impact than the outfield fences. They didn't move them in all that much, and the wind still blows in from right field.

The Gamer: You got to play at Fenway Park last season, when the Giants had an Interleague series in Boston. What are your memories about sharing those moments with your grandfather, friends and family?

Yastrzemski: It was a crazy experience, being able to play in that ballpark. Every kid growing up near Boston dreams of playing in Fenway Park. It was magical—especially being able to catch a first pitch from my grandfather and hit a home run. I don't even remember running the bases, except that I was aware that people were cheering. I thought it was funny that people were excited for an opposing player to hit a home run against the Red Sox.

The Gamer: Your teammate Dereck Rodríguez [son of Hall of Fame catcher

Ivan Rodríguez] also has a Hall of Famer in his family. Have you talked with him about that unique experience?

Yastrzemski: We have talked less about the family connection than just about the experiences we were able to have as kids at the ballpark. We were both at Fenway Park for the All-Star Game in 1999. It was fun to reminisce about how exciting that was. His seats were a lot better than mine were; I was way out in the grandstand.

The Gamer: Tell me about the custom scooter you posted a picture of on Instagram.

Yastrzemski: The company that made it is Phat Scooters, and they do an awesome job. They wanted to do a little story for me about my family legacy, so they have an image of my grandfather's statue on there, they have Vanderbilt University on there and some pictures of San Francisco. It's really cool.

The Gamer: Now that you've gotten to play in San Francisco a bit, what do you think of Giants fans?

Yastrzemski: They're fantastic! The Giants fans just love their team. They are intense and loud, and you want to make them proud. You couldn't ask for a better crowd to play for.

I also love the city of San Francisco, especially the people here. Everyone is laid-back and friendly. There are a ton of good restaurants to go to. It's so eclectic and unique; there's no other city quite like it. (


