MATCH STORYLINES

ROCKY START

Despite showing much of its potential early on in the season, it hasn't been the desired start to the season for El Paso. Locomotive so far have only managed to pick up one point in its four matches, scoring only once and conceding four times (1.00 goal against average).

Should El Paso fail to win its match against New Mexico United, it would go down as the worst start to a season after five matches. As it stands, Locomotive's worst recorded start was in 2022, when El Paso lost its first four matches before picking up a 5-0 win in its fifth match against Monterey Bay F.C.

Looking back, Locomotive don't usually have the strongest starts to its seasons, especially in the month of March. Across 13 matches played in March, El Paso are 2-7-4 and a -5 GD (18 GF, 23 GA).

Historically, things for Locomotive begin to turn around in April, in which Los Locos are 6-3-2 and post a +8 GD (17 GF, 9 GA). With El Paso kicking off its April against New Mexico United, the hope is that history can remain on its side for this encounter.

UNDEFEATED STREAK AT ISOTOPES PARK

El Paso are undefeated in its last four meetings against New Mexico at Isotopes Park, registering wins in its last two visits.

For New Mexico, they'll be wanting to provide its supporters the first win against El Paso at Isotopes Park since the 3-0 result in the inaugural 2019 season.

As for Locomotive, they'll come into the match in desperate need of a win. The possibility of continuing the undefeated streak with a third consecutive win at their rival's stadium could be the confidence boost Los Locos need to kickstart its 2024 campaign.

MORENO RETURNS TO THE LAB

One player that all eyes will be on is Locomotive forward **Amando Moreno**, who returns to his old stomping grounds at New Mexico United.

The El Salvador international spent four seasons with the Black and Yellow, notching a total of 24 goals and 11 assists during his time with the club. In addition to his many goal contributions, his flashy, fun style of play and beloved personality towards the fans made him a crowd-favorite amongst New Mexico supporters.

So when it was announced last November that Moreno would be switching allegiances to join Locomotive in 2024, the shock reaction across the league, especially from New Mexico fans, came as no surprise. As one fan commented on Instagram when the initial announcement was made: "Not even Judas was as big of a traitor."

Moreno did state in an interview for Locomotive's preseason series "Sound The Horn" that New Mexico still holds a dear place in his heart. However, that the

chapter of his life and career was now in the past and it was time to fully focus on his next steps in El Paso. There's no doubt everyone will be watching to see what Moreno will do in his first match back in New Mexico.

A CHANCE TO LEAD THE SERIES

As if the Derby Del Camino Real wasn't spicy enough already, the match on Saturday presents both teams an opportunity to take the lead in the league series.

Across 14 matches played in the regular season, the series record is split 4-4-6. A win for either side would put them ahead in league meetings.

The goals scored do stand slightly in New Mexico's favor. In all regular season meetings, El Paso has found the back of the net 15 times against New Mexico whereas New Mexico did so on 18 occasions.

Note: The overall series record stands at 4-4-7, when El Paso and New Mexico drew 1-1 after extra time in the 2020 Western Conference Playoffs. El Paso would win the penalty shootout 5-3.

FIESTY BATTLES

Feelings and emotions amongst those on the field in the Derby Del Camino Real get intense, and it's not uncommon to see multiple players on each side get their names jotted down for bookings.

Across all regular season meetings, El Paso players have gone down in the referee book 40 times for yellow cards and two straight reds. New Mexico's squad has been booked with yellows 35 times and two red cards (one straight) in matches against El Paso.

Of active players on both squads, no player has historically received more bookings than Daniel Bruce, **Amando Moreno**, and **Yuma** (3).

DERBY OG'S

Yuma (ELP) and Daniel Bruce (NM) are the only two players across both squads to have stuck around since their respective clubs' inaugural seasons in 2019. As the only Locomotive to remain since that first season, Yuma has played all but one of the Derby Del Camino Real matches (he missed the match on March 19, 2022 due to injury).

Those who have been around since 2020 include **Eder Borelli** (ELP), **Amando Morneo** (NM) and Kalen Ryden (NM).

FINALLY, SOME REST

Bringing it back to El Paso's season so far, Los Locos got a much needed break last week after starting its season in brutal fashion, contesting four league matches and a friendly against Liga MX sister club FC Juarez in a span of two weeks.

For any team, that congestion can take its toll on player fitness and wellbeing. The fatigue became particularly evident in its matches against Monterey Bay F.C. and Las Vegas Lights FC. Throw in the added factor that three players (**Jahmali Waite**,

Amando Moreno and **Jeremy Garay** were unavailable for Las Vegas because of international duty and you understand just how difficult the last few weeks have been for El Paso.

Coming into the match against New Mexico, Los Locos have now gotten much-needed time to recover physically and mentally, as well as additional time to scout New Mexico. The hope will be that the refresh time they got can provide Locomotive with an advantage ahead of this Derby matchup.

MISSING IN ACTION

Though most of the squad made it out of the brutal two-week stretch relatively healthy, El Paso did take one hit with the loss of defender **Brandan Craig**. The United States U-20 star was lining up to play a major role in the backline for El Paso but after going down early to injury against Louisville City FC, Locomotive's defensive plans had to shift.

2024 has also yet to see midfielder **Petar Petrovic** and forward **Joaquin Rivas** take the field, both having been out with injuries since the preseason.

STAUFFER CONTINUES TO SHINE

There's no doubt that defender **Lucas Stauffer** has been one of the positives for Locomotive so far in 2024. The speedy and technical wing-back has been critical to Clarhaut's preferred style of play, neutralizing threats and triggering transitions up top from the backline.

Offensively, Stauffer leads Los Locos in shots (9) and chances created (8). He also leads in tackles (13) and tackles won (7), demonstrating his top level ability to play up and down the flank. For Stauffer, it's just a matter of converting those opportunities into goals and/or assists.

A QUICK LOOK AT NEW MEXICO

New Mexico United will enter Saturday's Derby high on confidence after putting up a dominant defensive display in a 1-0 win against rivals Phoenix Rising FC, turning around a lackluster 4-0 loss performance against Charleston Battery the week prior.

The Black and Yellow will look to string together a second-straight win, the first time they would do so this season, to continue its scale up the table.

New Mexico currently sit 4th in the West with a 2-1-1 record. Three different players have found the back of the net for New Mexico to start the season: Dayonn Harris, Greg Hurst and Talen Maples.

Goalkeeper Alexandros Tambakis sits joint-fifth in the league in saves with 15 and joint-first in clean sheets with 2.

NOTABLE QUOTES

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON THE BYE WEEK AFTER A TOUGH START TO 2024

"It was nice, we were able to train finally. We haven't been able to train in two weeks during that stretch of games because it was more about recovery. It was nice to take a look and reflect and look at things that we need to work on and improve to put that into practice onto the field. It was good for me as a coach and it was good for the players to get their bodies fresh for the New Mexico match."

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON EARLY OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES

"Just concentration level. We've talked to our forwards and having Amando back from international duty changes a lot of things. You saw what Justin Dhillon can bring when he's fresh and getting more out of our wingbacks. There's certain areas that we talked about where we need to be more dangerous but like I've said before, we're very close and it's about staying on course and we feel comfortable in what we're doing right now. Now it's about getting the points out of our performances."

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON THE DERBY DEL CAMINO REAL

"We know it's a rivalry match, we had them here in preseason and saw the intensity. We expect that this Saturday in Albuquerque, so we'll put a good match plan together. We've had a chance as a staff to really watch them play, which has been more difficult given the prior weeks with the schedule congestion. We'll be prepared and ready to go to take three points in Albuquerque. That's the goal and that's the objective. This is a big game for us and I think that if we get a good and positive result against New Mexico, we saw what happened last year.

[Context: Following the poor start to the 2023 season, in which Locomotive lost its first three matches, El Paso upset Louisville City FC 3-0 to record its first win of the year and kicked off a club record 12-match unbeaten run.]

AMANDO MORENO ON SHAKING OFF THE ROUGH START

"The start isn't what we wanted. We're all competitors, we want to win every game. There's a lot of good things we can take away from those games though and learn from those. Only getting one point in four games, it's hard but we face it like men, we go straight forward and on Saturday, I know we're going to have a good performance."

AMANDO MORENO ON RETURNING TO ISOTOPES PARK

"[Albuquerque] was a second home, I was there for four years. I'm never going to forget that, but on Saturday, that's our enemy. Those are our rivals and I'm going to do the best that I can. I've played there many times before, so it'll be a nice feeling to go back but I'm with El Paso now and that's how we're going to get the three points.



MATCH PREVIEW

QUICK HITS

PREVIOUS MATCH RECAP - El Paso lost 1-0 to Las Vegas Lights FC in its fourth match of the 2024 season, the Lights' first win in the Jose Bautista era. Despite yet another performance in which they dominated possession and chances, Los Locos were unable to create real opportunities of danger and struggled to break past the Vegas defense.

Adding to the misfortune was the way in which Vegas bagged its winner. Off a Fabien Garcia header, the ball hit the post before ricocheting off the diving legs of El Paso goalkeeper Javier Garcia. It was unfortunate for Garcia to have the goal go down as an own goal despite putting up a strong performance in his Locomotive league debut, in which he registered three saves (one which was nominated for Terminix Save of the Week - Week 2).

UP NEXT - Bitter rivals New Mexico United, who currently sit 4th in the West with a 2-1-1 record.

DERBY DEL CAMINO REAL - This will be the 15th overall edition of the Derby Del Camino Real, with the series currently split 4-4-7.

In regular season meetings, both sides have squared off 14 times (4-4-6).

Both have met in the postseason once, playing each other at Southwest University Park in 2020 for the Western Conference Semifinal. After both sides played out to a 1-1 draw at the end of extratime, El Paso won the penalty shootout 5-3 to advance to what was then its second consecutive Western Conference final.

UNDEFEATED STREAK AT ISOTOPES - El Paso arrive to Isotopes Park undefeated in its last four matches at the venue (2-0-2). In further detail, Locomotive have recorded two straight win in its last two visits at The Lab.

LAST MEETING - Both sides last met at Southwest University Park on July 1, 2023, with New Mexico's Santi Moar scoring a late goal in the 89' to win 1-0. It was El Paso's second straight loss to New Mexico at Southwest University Park.

FIRST MEETING - The inaugural Derby Del Camino Real took place on May 12, 2019 in El Paso, with the match ending in a hard-fought 2-2 draw. Jerome Kiesewetter scored both Locomotive goals whereas New Mexico found the back of the net through Sam Hamilton and Ryan Williams. The match also saw two players pick up straight reds: Yuma (ELP) and Santi Moar (NM).

That inaugural 2019 Derby would set the tone for what would become one of the league's most intense rivalries.

AMANDO RETURNS TO THE LAB - Locomotive forward Amando Moreno sparked a massive buzz around the league when he announced he signed for Locomotive ahead of the 2024 season.

The El Salvador international spent four seasons with the Black and Yellow, notching a total of 24 goals and 11 assists during his time with the club. In nine matches against El Paso, Moreno scored once and bagged three assists.

In addition to his many goal contributions, his flashy, fun style of play and beloved personality towards the fans made him a crowd-favorite amongst New Mexico supporters. It'll be his first match back at The Lab since switching allegiances and there's no doubt all eyes will be on him to see what he'll do against his former club.

A MUST-WIN - Locomotive's start to the 2024 season has been less than desirable, currently sitting 11th in the West with a 0-2-1 record and finding the back of the net just once. Every match is a must-win, especially Derby matches, but Saturday's match in New Mexico now holds greater implications for a Locomotive side in search of its first win this season to avoid the worst five-game start in club history.

YUMA NEARS MILESTONE - Though he has yet to make an appearance in 2024, defender Yuma will register his 100th league appearance the next time he steps into a match. He reached the 100 overall appearance milestone last season in the 3-0 away win against Louisville City FC.

The following Locos have more than 100+ league appearances: Eric Calvillo (111), Amando Moreno (111), Arun Basuljevic (112), Tumi Moshobane (115), Justin Dhillon (143), Elijah Martin (144), Nick Hinds (153), Joaquin Rivas (173) and Bolu Akinyode (219).

OPEN CUP REMATCH - Earlier this week, El Paso Locomotive FC found out its opponent for the storied Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup. Los Locos will return to Nebraska on Wednesday, April 17 for an Open Cup rematch against USL League One side Union Omaha in the third round. Los Locos will not only go to Omaha to redeem last year's 2-0 loss, but also to record the club's historic first win in the tournament for a chance to face off against MLS opposition in the Round of 32.
