MATCH STORYLINES

2023 LOCOMOTIVE RECAP

El Paso's 2023 season was a rollercoaster of ups and downs. After opening the season with three consecutive home losses, El Paso would then beat Louisville City 3-0 on the road (LouCity's biggest loss at Lynn Family Stadium) to kickstart a club record 12-game unbeaten run to launch itself at the top of the Western Conference.

A 1-0 home loss to New Mexico United ended the undefeated streak and Locomotive would fail to pick up a win in its next eight (8) matches. The loss of several key players to mid-season transfers and injury were factors to Locomotive's winless streak, in which they conceded 24 goals and plummeted down well below the playoff line.

Locomotive bounced back with a 2-0 win against Hartford Athletic and in the final match of the regular season, El Paso would beat Oakland Roots SC 2-1 on the road to finish the season 7th in the Western Conference, securing its return to the USL Championship playoffs, the fourth time in the club's five year history. Locomotive traveled to Orange County SC for the Western Conference Quarterfinal but would fall 1-0.

REBUILDING THE ROSTER FOR 2024

The 2024 offseason saw a complete shakeup of the Locomotive roster. 14 players from the 2023 roster - which included historic club figures and fan-favorites like Lucho Solignac, Aaron Gomez, Chapa Herrera, Erik McCue, Marc Navarro and Benny Diaz - were set to not return for 2024, leaving Locomotive fans wondering what exactly Head Coach and Technical Director Brian Clarhaut had in store.

Clarhaut's response? Conducting arguably the best offseason business amongst teams in the league, building huge excitement for 2024. 13 new players have been brought in by Clarhaut so far and the players being brought in this year are highly recognized names across the league. Amongst those signings, standouts include Amando Moreno, Justin Dhillon, Bolu Akinyode, Joaquin Rivas and Jahmali Waite.

In addition, Clarhaut has brought in some notable loanees, including U.S. U-20 stalwart Brandan Craig from MLS' Philadelphia Union and three players from Liga MX sister club FC Juarez, continuing to strengthen the technical relationship between both clubs.

IT'S ALL ABOUT CONTROL

Since his arrival to El Paso, Clarhaut has instilled a philoshpy that revolves around control and that was evident throughout the 2023 season, especially during the first half of the season before they had to shift to a more defensive shape to secure a playoff berth.

At the end of the year, El Paso finished 10th in average possession (50.6%) and 6th in passing accuracy per match (83.3%).

With the offseason moves Locomotive made, El Paso ought to have a stonger backline that can play out of the back much more consistently, take greater ownership of the midfield and trigger faster transitions up top to gifted ball carriers and clinical goal scorers.

AMANDO'S SHOCK MOVE FROM NEW MEXICO UNITED

Perhaps no other Locomotive signing this season made a splash as big as Amando Moreno did when it was announced that he would be coming to El Paso after four seasons with bitter rival New Mexico United.

Fresh off the best season in his professional career, Moreno finished 2023 as New Mexico's leading scorer (10 goals) and joint-top assist leader (five assists) to aid the club to a second consecutive playoff berth, an incredible feat for the striker to bounce back after spending most of 2022 rehabbing an ACL injury. Moreno totaled 24 goals and 11 assists in 83 total matches for New Mexico. So, why did Moreno leave?

"I felt like I needed a change in my life," Moreno said. "I wanted to set new goals for myself... and I wanted to tackle a new objective with a new team."

USYNT STAR ARRIVES IN EL PASO

El Paso social channels blew up when the club announced it had acquired USYNT star Brandan Craig.

Craig (19) arrives on loan from Philadelphia Union hoping to find consistent first-team minutes and help El Paso strengthen its backline while fighting for a chance to be named to the USMNT squad for the Paris 2024 Summer Olympics.

SENIOR INTERNATIONALS

This year's Locomotive squad boasts four (4) senior international players:

El Salvador - Eric Calvillo, Amando Moreno, Joaquin Rivas Jamaica - Jahmali Waite

Should Brandan Craig make an appearance for the USMNT Olympic suqad, the number would jump up to five (5).

2024 PRESEASON RECAP

With lots of new faces on the team, the 2024 preseason was going to be critical for Clarhaut to integrate them into the squad and bring them up to speed on the team's match philosphy whilst assessing each player's fitness and determing the strongest possible starting lineup.

El Paso concluded its preseason schedule last weekend against New Mexico United at its training ground, a confidence-boosting 3-0 win that both Season Ticket Members and local media were invited to watch. El Paso closed the 2024 preseason with a 3-2-0 record.

BREAKING DOWN MATCH HISTORY AGAINST HARTFORD ATHLETIC

El Paso opens it sixth season in the USL Championship in El Paso at Southwest University Park against Hartford Athletic, an Eastern Conference opponent that El Paso will face for the third time ever.

- Both teams debuted in the USL Championship in 2019;
- El Paso is undefeated against Hartford in three matches, posting a 1-0-1 record;

- Both teams met for the first time at Southwest University Park on June 4, 2022, drawing 1-1. Locomotive's goal came from then 16-year-old Diego Abarca, a rocket from outside the box that would later appear on SportsCenter's Top 10 at #8;
- El Paso's 2-0 win at Hartford snapped its 10-match winless streak last season;
- Petar Petrovic and Aaron Gomez scored in that 2023 2-0 victory;
- Last year's win at Hartford saw the debut of Noah Dollenmayer for Locomotive, who put up a strong 90-minute display to secure a starting spot that would kickstart the turnaround of the 2023 season;
- Diego Abarca, Nick Hinds and Ricardo Zacarias are the only Locomotive players on the current roster who played in both matches.

LOOKING TO START ON THE RIGHT FOOT

Locomotive have yet to win a season opener. Should Locomotive win against Hartford Athletic, it would be the first time in club history that Los Locos open a season with three points.

In season openers, Locomotive posts a 0-3-2 record and have been outscored 8-3 by opponenets. Locomotive have also never scored more than one goal in a season opener. This is also the second time ever that Locomotive have opened a season with three or more consecutive home matches (First time in 2023).

BUSY MARCH

The 2024 Home Opener will kick off the start of a difficult March schedule for Locomotive.

Following the match against Hartford Athletic on Saturday, March 9, Locomotive face quick turnarounds at against Monterrey Bay F.C. on Wednesday, March 13 and Louisville City FC on Saturday, March 16. Los Locos will then play its inaugural Derby Paso Del Norte at home against FC Juarez on Wendesday, March 20 and hit the road for it's first regular season away match at Las Vegas Lights FC on Saturday, March 23.

To summarize, that's five matches in a two-week span! In addition to the on-field play, smart squad rotations as well as player recovery, fitness and well-being will be critical for Locomotive in that tough stretch and something that Clarhaut and his coaching staff will need to monitor heavily.

YOUNGEST SQUAD IN CLUB HISTORY

The average age of the 2024 Locomotive squad is 26.2, the youngest squad in Locomotive history. The top two youngest squads in club history were both under Brian Clarhaut.

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON WHAT HE SAW IN AMANDO MORENO

"I think he's a perfect fit. I think that he was the piece of the puzzle that we were maybe missing last year, a guy in between the lines that could unlock an opponent. He's been excellent. That's the guy that I saw in this league that I think could be the missing link."

AMANDO MORENO ON HIS CONVERSATIONS WITH BRIAN CLARHAUT TO MAKE THE CONTROVERSIAL MOVE TO EL PASO FROM NEW MEXICO UNITED

"Brian played a huge part in my decision of coming here. He was very relentless in trying to get me here, but just the way he wanted to see me improve in my career really made me open my eyes like 'hey, there's somebody else out there that really wants to push my career to somewhere I want to reach.""

LIAM ROSE ON BECOMING A FATHER AND HOW GRATEFUL HE IS FOR EL PASO

"I just want to provide for my family, my wife and my daughter. Having someone like [my daughter] who for the rest of her life is going to look up to me is massive. For myself, I want to be a really good role model and set a good example. I'm so grateful for everything this club and El Paso in general has done for us. We do love it here and it's like a second home to us."

YUMA ON RETURNING FOR HIS SIXTH SEASON WITH EL PASO (TRANSLATED)

"I said a long time ago that I did not want to leave this place and I've kept my word. I never left for another team; I always wanted to stay here in El Paso. Everytime I'm on the pitch, I'm going leave everything I got on the pitch for El Paso Locomotive."

BRANDAN CRAIG ON THE PHILADELPHIA ROOTS HE SHARES WITH BRIAN CLAR-HAUT AND WHY HE CHOSE EL PASO

"When I talked to [Brian Clarhaut], he asked me if I could bring him a little cheesesteak to-go from Philly. Obviously, him and I being local guys helped in my decision to come here and I can't wait to play under him. He talked about being a build-out-of-the-back team... which has a lot of the same qualities, same tactics as the [U.S.] National Team and I think it suits me a lot."

OUICK HITS

SIXTH SEASON: Debuting in 2019, El Paso Locomotive FC now enters its sixth season of play in the USL Championship.

LAST MEETING: Los Locos - who are undefeated against Hartford Athletic (1-0-1) - last met the Connecticut side on August 26, 2023, a 2-0 win on the road with goals from Aaron Gomez (14') and Petar Petrovic (69'). It was El Paso's first win ever against Hartford.

FIRST MEETING: The first ever meeting between the two was played in El Paso. That match ended in a 1-1 draw, with then 16-year-old Diego Abarca etching his name into Locomotive history books as the club's youngest ever scorer.

DEPARTURES: 10 players from Locomotives roster at the end of the 2023 season are not returning: Jose Carrillo, Benny Diaz, Aaron Gomez, Chapa Herrera, Petur Knudsen, Denys Kostyshyn, Joel Maldonado, Erik McCue, Marc Navarro, and Emmanuel Sonupe. Christopher Garcia is out on loan to Austin FC II in MLS NEXT Pro.

ARRIVALS: El Paso signed 13 new players for the 2024 season: Bolu Akinyode (Miami FC), Tony Alfaro (LA Galaxy), Brandan Craig (Philadelphia Union-loan), Justin Dhillon (San Antonio FC), Elijah Martin (San Diego Loyal SC), Amando Moreno (New Mexico United), Tumi Moshobane (San Diego Loyal SC), Javier Nevarez (FC Juarez-loan), Ramon Pasquel (FC Juarez-loan), Gonzalo Pelua (FC Juarez-loan), Joaquin Rivas (Miami FC), Lucas Stauffer (Las Vegas Lights FC), Jahmali Waite (Pittsburgh Riverhounds SC)

BRIAN CLARHAUT: Head Coach and Technical Director Brian Clarhaut retruns for his second season in charge after securing El Paso's return to the USL Championship playoffs. In 36 matches across all competitions under Clarhaut, Los Locos are 13-15-8 with a -13 goal differential (41 goals for, 54 goals conceded).

YUMA: Defender Yuma is the longest-tenured player on the team, having been with Locomotive since the inaugural 2019 season. The 38-year-old is the last player remaining from the club's first year and has amassed 108 total appearances across 8,816 minutes in all competitions.

ERIC CALVILLO: Following the departures of Lucho Solignac and Aaron Gomez, Midfielder Eric Calvillo is now the top returning scorer with nine (9) goals. Midfielder Petar Petrovic sits behind him with seven (7).

EDER BORELLI: Defender Eder Borelli is the top returning assister with 12 assists to his name. Forward Ricardo Zacarias follows behind with 10.

REVITALIZED FRONTLINE: After struggling to consistently find the net last season, Locomotive went into the offseason in search of known difference-makers up top. Between the 2022-23 seasons, Justin Dhillon, Amando Moreno and Joaquin Rivas combined for 40 goals and 27 assists (for further context, Moreno missed a majority of the 2022 season recovering from an ACL injury). In that same time frame, El Paso forwards registered 41 goals and 25 assists.

DEFENSIVE REINFORCEMENT: Over the last two seasons, El Paso conceded more

than 100 goals and ranked second to last in possession recoveries in the middle and attacking thirds. Clarhaut's defensive additions will aim to lower the number of goals conceded in 2024 and raise pressing intensity to win back balls quicker to trigger offensive actions. In comparison to Locomotive's 2023 defenders - who all registered a total of 546 duels won and 144 tackles won -, the 2024 defensive additions alone registered 519 duels won and 158 tackles won.

BRANDAN CRAIG: One of the most notable defensive additions was 19-year-old Brandan Craig, a stalwart of the U.S. Youth National Team who played alongside former Loco Diego Luna at the 2023 FIFA U-20 World Cup in Argentina and won the Concacaf U-20 Championship in Honduras in 2022. Joining on loan from MLS' Philadelphia Union, Craig arrives with high expectations - from himself and both clubs involved - to aid Locomotive strive for more success and continue his professional development.

WAITE IN NET: Following the departure of Benny Diaz to FC Juarez, Locomotive made sure to bring in someone who could keep the consistency strong in goal. That someone was Jamaican international and 2023 Players' Shield Winner Jahmali Waite. In 2023 with Pittsburgh, Waite led the league in punches (19) and was joint-3rd overall in catches (39), displaying a strong ability to dominate his box. In addition, he was joint-6th in the league in clean sheets (10) and joint-3rd in for least goals conceded per 90 (1.0).

THE JUAREZ RELATIONSHIP: Three players on this year's Locomotive roster arrive on loan from Liga MX sister club, FC Juarez: GK Ramon Pasquel, DF Javier Nevarez, and DF Gonzalo Pelua. With the addition of these three, Locomotive has now rostered a total of six Bravos players over the years (Aaron Gomez, Eder Borelli, Leandro Carrijo are the other three players).

U.S. OPEN CUP - El Paso Locomotive FC and the United Soccer League announced that it will be participating in the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup (the 109th edition), despite having the option to decline. Per USL President Paul McDonough, the USL and its clubs "appreciate and share the fans' passion for our country's most historic and authentic competition." In three Open Cup appearances, El Paso had not advanced past the Second Round but will enter this year's tournament in the Third Round on April 16 or 17, opponent TBD.

HUMMEL YEAR ONE: Locomotive are in year one of its new kit partnership with hummel - announced in November 2023 - after three seasons with adidas. Locomotive's primary kit saw the return of the ever-popular cowcatcher on a navy base whereas the secondary kit offers a more subtle look, a white base with centered logos and embossed white chevrons.
