VALUABLE POINT OR POINTS DROPPED?

You can look at El Paso's match on Wednesday from two perspectives.

On one hand, El Paso picked up its first point of the season and saw marquee signing **Amando Moreno** find the back of the net to open Locomotive's 2024 scoring account. On the other hand, Monterey Bay F.C. dominating the match to eventually find a late equalizer felt like a lost opportunity to pick up an important win.

Depending on its result against Louisville City FC, El Paso will look back on its first two matches wondering if it lost a chance to set the tone early or if the early setbacks provided enough motivation to get back on track.

AMANDO OPENS HIS ACCOUNT

Though the draw against Monterey Bay was not the desired result, one of the positives of the match came from forward **Amando Moreno**, who scored his first Locomotive goal four minutes into the match in what was an early display of his intention to be a difference-maker up top for El Paso in 2024.

As a reminder, Amando scored 10 goals and assisted another five in 2023 with rivals New Mexico. Coming off the best season in his professional career (especially one in which he was available for every match after spending most of 2022 rehabbing an ACL injury), Moreno is as dedicated as ever to surpass the heights he reached in Albuquerque.

WAITE SHOWS UP BIG

Goalkeeper **Jahmali Waite** came up big against Monterey Bay F.C. and demonstrated why Brian Clarhaut sought out after the Jamaican international. Waite registered three massive saves to deny the visitors from equalizing in the first half and came way out of his box in the second half to clear away a dangerous stray ball.

Waite's start to his Locomotive career has been huge, having already registered 7.11 goals prevented (GP) in his first 180 minutes!

FACTORING IN FATIGUE

Three games in one week is no joke. It provides players and coaches with insufficient amount of time to recover, prep and train. Locomotive had a tough start in 2023 when faced with the same exact schedule congestion, losing all three of matches and posting a -4 GD (2 GF, 6 GA).

Two matches into the 2024 season has already seen an improvement in points, but

with only Thursday and Friday left for recovery, Locomotive is already at a disadvantage fitness wise against a fully-rested LouCity side playing their first match of the 2024 season.

By the end of Saturday, El Paso will be the only team to have started the campaign with three games under their belt. Hopefully a win at home against title contender favorites can make those tired legs feel a little better.

UN NUEVO LOCO

To help prevent players going out early in the season due to injury, why not add more depth? Well, that's exactly what Locomotive did.

On Tuesday, March 12, El Paso Locomotive FC announced that it had acquired defensive midfielder **Jeremy Garay** on loan from D.C. United of Major League Soccer.

Garay, a 20-year-old Virginia native, is a product of the D.C. United Academy and was the 16th Homegrown Signing in the club's history. Garay has spent the better part of the past five years with USL Championship side and D.C. United affiliate Loudoun United FC, playing in 96 total matches across all competitions since making his professional debut in 2019 as a 16-year-old. In 6,345 minutes of play in the USL Championship, Garay has notched one (1) goal and five (5) assists.

In 2021 at 18-years-old, Garay made his El Salvador Men's National Team debut in a friendly against Costa Rica and has trained alongside current Locomotive players **Eric Calvillo** and **Joaquin Rivas** while on international team duty. Garay has also appeared for the El Salvador U-20s and the United States U-20s, where he played alongside former Locomotive star **Diego Luna**.

AWAITING LOCOMOTIVE DEBUTS

There are still six players waiting to make their Locomotive debuts in 2024: goalkeeper **Ramon Pasquel***, defenders **Elijah Martin**, **Javier Nevarez*** and **Gonzalo Pelua***, midfielder **Jeremy Garay**, and forward **Joaquin Rivas**.^

MATCH HISTORY AGAINST LOUISVILLE CITY FC

El Paso took the league by storm last season when it handed Louisville City FC a 3-0 defeat on the road to spark an eventual 12-match unbeaten run. Now, the Eastern Conference Finalists open their season at Southwest University Park and look to get one back on Los Locos to kickstart their 2024 campaign whereas El Paso will want to build off the positives of its first two matches to potentially chalk up its first three points at home.

The sides first met in El Paso during the 2022 season, a tightly contested match that finished 1-0 in favor of LouCity. Both recently met in preseason action last month, with Louisville picking up a 2-0 win over Los Locos in Tucson, Arizona for the 2024 Desert Friendlies Showcase.

MATCH STORYLINES

Some quick hits:

- El Paso are 1-1-0 against LouCity
- This is the third match between both sides, second in El Paso.
- El Paso's 3-0 win was the biggest loss for LouCity at Lynn Family Stadium and was the first home opener defeat for Louisville since 2020.
- El Paso's 3-0 win happened in front of a record LouCity home-opener crowd of 10,881.
- Petar Petrovic scored his first Locomotive goal against LouCity. Ricardo Zacarias and ex-Loco Marc Navarro also found the back of the net in that match.
- Yuma registered his 100th Locomotive appearance across all competitions last season at Louisville. If he comes into the match on Saturday, he'll register his 100th USL Championship appearance.
- Ex-goalkeeper Benny Diaz became the first goalkeeper in Locomotive history (19th goalkeeper in league history) to record an assist in the road win against Louisville.
- Before signing for Louisville for the 2023 season, midfielder Dylan Mares had been one of Locomotive's biggest difference-makers in attack. He left El Paso as the historic top-assister (17 assists across all comps) and third-top scorer (19 goals across all comps).

ABOUT LOUISVILLE CITY FC

Year in and year out, LouCity demonstrates why they've been as successful as they are. Despite finishing 2023 with the fewest points total since its inaugural 2015 season and not having a player score double-digit goals for the first time, Louisville still managed to reach the Eastern Conference Final for a ninth consecutive time.

In response to the "down season" they had, LouCity turned over a new leaf with the departure of club legends Cameron Lancaster and Paolo DelPiccolo as well as key pieces Oliver Semmler and Manny Perez. In to replace them? The reigning USL Championship Defender of the Year Arturo Ordóñez, reigning MLS NEXT Pro Goalkeeper of the Year Damian Las and All-League First Team midfielder Taylor Davila, as well as Adrien Perez and Sam Gleadle.

However, LouCity did take a massive hit when it was announced on Tuesday that star forward and all-time assist leader Brian Ownby was set to undergo leg surgery. Although the timeline on his return is unclear, it's expected he'll be absent for a long time. Joining LouCity in 2017, Ownby was set to captain the side for the club's 10th season but without him now on the frontlines, Louisville will be without a big-time player with 69 goal contributions (32 goals, 37 assists) under his name.

NOTABLE QUOTES

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON THE MATCH

"I think you could see the fatigue levels on our players. It's tough to get that Wednesday that early... I think we were sloppy on the ball and in a lot of areas. Unfortunately, we had to sub two forwards out early in the game, three if you count Tumi Moshobane. In the later stages of the game, I had [Arun Basuljevic] up there for a little bit with [Ricardo Zacarias] and then I had to switch [Diego Abarca] up there because I wanted pace at least in behind but we were limited in what we could do to be threatening. From the defensive side, we had to get pushed down to concede space because our legs couldn't get pressure on the ball, so we made that decision to try to be more compact at times because I thought in the first half, we would make a mistake, [Monterey Bay] would hit long balls and were very dangerous."

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON THE FIRST LOCOMOTIVE GOAL OF 2024

"I think it was a fantastic goal, fantastic link-up play and a fantastic individual effort. [It's] good to get [Amando Moreno] on the Locomotive score sheet in the second game of the season, so that's positive."

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON CURRENT PLAYER HEALTH

"We had Justin Dhillon coming off of food poisoning last night. He was questionable for today, [so] we were lucky he got through 45 minutes. Amando Moreno on a cramp at 55' and Tumi with a tight hamstring. We've got to be smart as well this early in the season, but I think fatigue played an extreme factor. [Joaquin Rivas] is dealing with a back issue, it's kind of day by day. Petrovic is dealing with a bit of inflammation in the Achilles area."

BRIAN CLARHAUT ON WHAT THE PRIORITY IS AHEAD OF LOUISVILLE CITY FC

"Just recover. I didn't think our organization was good defensively or offensively... I'll look at a few things and we'll take some subgroups and go through some more individual things. We've got to prepare for Louisville but it's not the result or the type of play that we wanted."

AMANDO MORENO ON HIS FIRST LOCOMOTIVE GOAL

"For me, my objective was to score as quickly as possible... when I'm at 100%, I know that's when I got to take advantage. Once the game starts to die down, it's harder to get a goal. I'm happy I went with my gut when I saw the goalie leaning way too much to the left and did my part to get in there."

AMANDO MORENO ON HIS CHEMISTRY WITH JUSTIN DHILLON

"The connection I have with Justin Dhillon is fantastic. He's the kind of player that likes to play off whoever is with him and I need that kind of player to highlight what I do best. It's only the second game and I wish we could've won these first two games, but there's so much good that we have, especially the connection between me and Justin where we're both the forwards and I think that's where you need it. I've been in situations where that hasn't really clicked and it's hard to get going. Luckily, I have someone like JD and I know it's going to be very successful for both of us this season."

AMANDO MORENO ON LOCOMOTIVE'S NEXT STEPS

"I don't think we should get too much in our heads. The connection we've built with so little time, I think it's there. Sometimes we create these plays where I'm like 'Wow, you don't get this until midseason!' We have to close out these games, we have to keep those leads... those are just little details we have to fix."



MATCH PREVIEW

QUICK HITS

PREVIOUS MATCH RECAP - El Paso drew 1-1 with Monterey Bay F.C. in its second match of the 2024 season. Amando Moreno opened the scoring for El Paso in the 4' following beautiful link up play between Tumi Moshobane and Justin Dhillon.

Locomotive goalkeeper Jahmali Waite denied the visitors a goal in the first half, making three big saves to help El Paso retain its lead.

Monterey Bay would increase its attacking intensity in the second half and see its efforts pay off late into the match with an 87' equalizer from debutant Tristan Trager, spoiling the night for El Paso.

UP NEXT - Louisville City FC, two-time league champions (2017, 2018) and nine-time consecutive Eastern Conference finalists.

LAST MEETING - El Paso handed Louisville a 3-0 defeat at Lynn Family Stadium in front of a record crowd of 10,881. It was Louisville's biggest defeat at Lynn Family Stadium and the first home opener they lost since 2020. El Paso kickstarted its record-breaking 12-match unbeaten streak after the 3-0 win.

FIRST MEETING - Both sides met for the first time in El Paso in 2022, with Louisville's Jorge Gonzalez scoring the lone goal in the match.

HISTORIC DAY GAME - The match against Louisville will be the first ever Locomotive day game played at Southwest University Park.

FINAL SATURDAY - The match against Louisville will be the last Saturday home match El Paso plays until April 13 against Oakland Roots SC.

INTERNATIONAL CALL-UPS - Earlier this week, it had been announced that two Locomotive players had been called up for international duty.

Goalkeeper Jahmali Waite will join Jamaica at the Concacaf Nations League matches in Arlington, Texas at AT&T Stadium, hoping to lift the country's first-ever international trophy. They'll first need to get past the U.S. on Thursday, March 21 should they wish to make the championship match on Sunday, March 24 against either Mexico or Panama.

Forward Amando Moreno joins up with El Salvador for a number of international friendlies across the U.S., including a marquee matchup against 2022 FIFA World Cup winners Argentina and global soccer superstar Lionel Messi. The opponents are as follows: Bonaire (March 20, Washington D.C.), Argentina (March 22, Philadelphia) and Honduras (March 26, Houston).

ANOTHER SALVI JOINS LOS LOCOS - With the announcement of Jeremy Garay joining Locomotive on loan from MLS' D.C. United earlier this week, El Paso Locomotive now has four El Salvador senior internationals in its squad, the other three being Eric Calvillo, Amando Moreno and Joaquin Rivas.

ON THE NEW ADDITION - 20-year-old Jeremy Garay is Locomotive's newest arrival, announced on Tuesday that he had joined Los Locos on loan from Major League Soccer's D.C. United. He's spent the better part of five seasons on loan with Loudoun United FC and across all competitions, Garay has registered one (1) goal and five (5) assists in 6,435 minutes played and 96 matches played. He made his professional debut in 2019 as a 16-year-old.

YUMA NEARS MILESTONE - Though he has yet to make an appearance in 2024, defender Yuma will register his 100th league appearance the next time he steps into a match. The following Locos have more than 100+ league appearances: Eric Calvillo (109), Arun Basuljevic (110), Amando Moreno (110), Tumi Moshobane (112), Justin Dhillon (140), Elijah Martin (144), Nick Hinds (151), Joaquin Rivas (173) and Bolu Akinyode (217).

OLD STOMPING GROUNDS - Midfielder Dylan Mares returns to El Paso for the first time since his departure to Louisville ahead of the 2023 season. In his three seasons with El Paso, Mares became El Paso's all-time leading assister with 17 across all comps and top-third goalscorer with 19 to his name across all comps. He finished the 2020 season as Locomotive's Golden Boot Winner alongside Aaron Gomez with five goals and was voted by the fans as the Locomotive Midfielder of the Year in 2022.
