

## KICKING OFF...

**LAST TIME OUT:** NCFC played Union Omaha to a 1-1 draw in a showdown of the two topranked teams in USL League One. NCFC struck first on a Rafa Mentzingen strike in the 12' before Luis Gil tied things up with a 40' goal.

**CLINCHED... SO FAR:** North Carolina FC has clinched at least a top-four seed in USL League One playoffs, guaranteeing at least a home quarterfinal matchup. The team still controls their own destiny for a top-two finish and a first-round bye.

**ON THE ATTACK:** North Carolina FC enters the matchweek leading all teams in goals [55] and total shots (427). NCFC is the only team with multiple players in the top-5 of the Golden Boot race in Oalex Anderson (2nd, 16) and Rafa (T-4th, 13).

**LEXINGTON AND CONQUERED:** North Carolina FC makes their first trip to expansion side Lexington this weekend, having hosted them twice this season. NCFC earned a win and draw in the first two meetings of 2023. This will be the first meeting in nearly four months, last playing on June 18.

**Lexington, Ky. (Oct. 6, 2023) –** North Carolina FC makes their final road trip of the 2023 USL League One regular season as they visit Lexington SC this Saturday, October 7, for a 7:00 p.m. ET kickoff at Toyota Stadium. North Carolina FC, sitting second in the current table at 18-6-6 (57 points) has already clinched a top-three seed in the playoffs and at least a home quarterfinal fixture, controlling their own destiny for a bye, while the league newcomer Lexington SC has been eliminated from playoff contention.

North Carolina played to a 1-1 draw in a critical home match against Union Omaha last Friday. NCFC struck early with a 12' finish from Rafa Mentzingen, but Luis Gil answered for the Owls at the tail end of the half. Both teams would probe in the second period, but neither side found themselves overly dangerous as the two league leaders split the points. For Mentzingen, the goal was a cap on a brilliant September in which the Brazilian midfielder registered six chances created, four goals and one assist. He added 39 duels won, 32 recoveries and nine shots on target to earn a nomination for USL League One September Player of the Month.

NCFC is the only team with multiple players in the top-5 of the Golden Boot race in Oalex Anderson (2nd, 16) and Rafa (T-4th, 13). Those two continue to drive the offensive machine that is North Carolina FC, who enters the penultimate match week of 2023 leading all of USL League One in goals (55) and total shots (427).

#### **Scouting Lexington SC**

Lexington was the latest team eliminated from playoff contention, dropping to 7W-13L-10D and now winless in their last five matches to fall out of the playoff race. As an expansion franchise in 2023, they set a strong foundation and have proven to be able to hold their own in USL League One for much of the season. The momentum will only continue to grow as they build a new professional stadium and grow roots in the heart of Kentucky. Despite playing at Georgetown's Toyota Stadium, they have had a significant home field advantage this season, getting a result in 12 of their 15 home matches (6W, 6D, 3L). They will look for some more home cooking to play spoiler for NCFC and get back on the upswing as the season comes to a close.

They have scored 45 goals on 243 shots this season while allowing 55 goals against. They are an aggressive side, winning 65% of their tackles but also committing 427 fouls and seeing 87 yellow cards and three red. Passing at 82% accuracy for the season, Lexington has shown the ability to build from the back and create line by line, forcing defenses into difficult decisions. Press and front line defending will be key for NCFC to avoid overloads in build-ups against their back line. In the third and final meeting of the season, NCFC will look to stay unbeaten agains the first-year opponent in what may be the only season these two line up on opposite sides in league competition.

#### Players to Watch

North Carolina FC - Defender Gustavo Fernandes

The centerback ahs been a key piece of the North Carolina defense all season, playing 2,388 minutes - which ranks second on the team - in the middle of the back line. He ranks second on the team with 72 clears, 14 blocks, and 48 aerial duels won while sitting fourth with 110 overall duels won and fifth with 24 tackles. At 25 years old, his blend of youthful energy and spirit with veteran savvy and temperment make him a key piece in the leadership and success of North Carolina FC.

Lexington SC - Alasanne Ates Diouf

The focal point of Lexington's offense is 23-year-old Senegalese forward Diouf. His 15 goals this season rank third in USL League One, netting a third of the team's scoring this season. He's had brief stints with three other USL clubs including Orlando City B, Austin Bold and San Antonio FC before becomming the second professional signing by the expansion club Lexington this past January. He's rattled off 62 shots this year, 22 more than any other member of the team and will be a consistent threat throughout the match. His ability to find dangerous pockets and get open looks hightens the importance of full field defense and consistency.

#### Next Up

North Carolina FC wrap up regular season play as they host One Knoxville on Saturday, October 14, for a 7:00 p.m. ET kickoff at WakeMed Soccer Park. Fan Appreciation Night and NCFC Youth Shield Night will bring a great crowd, so get tickets early. The match will also stream live on ESPN+.

HEAD COACH: JOHN BRADFORD (3rd Season)

Coaching Resume:

NCFC (Head Coach): 2021 - present NCFC (Asstistant Coach): 2019 - 2020 NCFC Youth Academy: 2013 - present

Hometown: Winston-Salem, NC

John Bradford is in his fifth season with NCFC and his third as the team's head coach. He is also in his 10th year as the director of the North Carolina FC Youth Academy. Prior to becoming head coach, Bradford served as NCFC's assistant coach for two seasons.

Holding a unique role that involves working with the club's first team while overseeing the development of the club's top youth players, Bradford is a true link in NCFC's youth-to-pro pipeline. In addition to serving as head coach, Bradford directs the NCFC Academy and serves as the technical director of North Carolina FC U-23 of USL League Two.

In his first season working with the NCFC first team in 2019, Bradford played a part in helping NCFC tie a regular-season club record with 16 wins, as the group qualified for the USL Championship Playoffs and posted the third-best home record in the league. In 2019, NCFC's squad featured nine current or former Academy standouts, including the likes of Manny Perez, DJ Taylor, Dre Fortune and Caleb Duvernay, each of whom worked closely with Bradford as youngsters. Collectively, the quartet of Perez, Taylor, Fortune and Duvernay made 106 appearances, played 7,588 minutes, scored 10 goals and recorded 13 assists across all competitions in 2019.

In 2020, Bradford assisted the team during the pandemic, helping NCFC earn 19 points during the shortened season while also coaching many of the same academy standouts from 2019.

Bradford began working with the NCFC Youth Academy over 14 years ago as a U-9 Youth Training Systems (YTS Assistant Director) and has since taken the organization to new heights since being named director in 2013.

In the last five years, the NCFC Youth Academy has had 33 players called into youth national team camps, 19 sign amateur contracts with the NCFC first team, nine sign professional contracts with MLS clubs and over 100 commit to play at the college level. Three players from the 2019 NCFC U-23 squad were recently selected in the 2020 MLS SuperDraft, including first-round selection Jeremy Kelly, a product of the NCFC Youth Academy and the NCFC first team.

A Winston-Salem native, Bradford played collegiately at Furman University.



A seasoned soccer mind with ties to North Carolina and experience coaching at the international level, Mike McGinty is entering his third season as an assistant coach on head coach John Bradford's staff at North Carolina FC.



Andrew Scheck

Andrew Scheck is beginning his second season on the NCFC staff, where he serves as an assistant coach. Prior to joining NCFC, Scheck worked at NC State as the Director of Sport Science and assistant coach with the men's soccer team.



Christopher Harrington

Christopher Harrington joined the NCFC staff in 2023, taking over as Head Coach for the U14 & U17 NCFC Academy teams and an assistant coach for the North Carolina FC first team.



Danny Cameron joined the NCFC staff in January, serving as an assistant coach and video analyst. Along with working with the first team. Cameron is the head coach for two NCFC Youth teams.
