KEYS TO THE MATCH

- **BACK LINE:** After allowing 27 shots last match, Le Rouge will look to bounce back against one of the more potent attacking duos this season in Indy Eleven's Soderstrom and Williams. Together they have scored 14 goals in nine games this season. Look for City to key in on the pairing in the defensive third.

- **THE FIRST 15:** This season, the first 15 minutes have been crucial for Le Rouge. The past three matches, the team that scored in the first 15 minutes has gone on to win the match and each of City's three wins has come after a goal in the first 15 minutes.

- **CHANCES:** With only four shots compared to Midwest United FC's 27 last time out, City will look to create more chances against Indy Eleven. If these chances can be created, and Le Rouge can be efficient in the final third, this will put the momentum in its favor.

FINAL GAME AT KEYWORTH FOR 2022

Friday will mark the end of the inaugural USL W League home campaign for Le Rouge, as after tonight the lone remaining fixture is a roadtrip to Indy Eleven on July 9. This season, City has provided a positive record at home, only surrendering one loss in front of the faithful Detroit City supporters with a mark of 1-3-1 at Keyworth Stadium.

NEW LOOK CITY

Detroit City FC will be wearing commemorative kits to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the founding of the city of Hamtramck. Hamtramck residents will be eligible for free tickets to the Friday night matchup and game-worn kits will be auctioned off after the match with all proceeds going to the Hamtramck Historical Museum. LAST TIME OUT

Le Rouge's second to last home match was played this past Tuesday at Keyworth where City faced Midwest United FC. The match started off strong for Midwest United FC as the visitors netted a momentum changer in the fourth minute. Then, in the 26th minute, Midwest was able to do it again to double DCFC's deficit. After a controversial call in front of goal, City was able to net a goal of its own from a corner sent in from defender Shannon McCarthy that found forward Kayla Addison in the box who tapped in through the Midwest United FC defense and found the back of the net. This brought the deficit to just one as the ladies headed to the locker room for halftime. The second half started off with both teams battling, but saw Midwest United FC coming away with a lot of shots in the attacking third. With the last minutes looming and Le Rouge sending everyone forward, Midwest United FC was able to capitalize on a counter attack in the 86th minute to bring the score to 3-1. The game would end this way as Midwest United FC claimed the three points at Keyworth Stadium and completed the double against Detroit City FC.

HOT STREAK

After a game tying header in the 90th minute of the game against King's Hammer, forward Kayla Addison has played in the ensuing three games, with two starts in the past two matches. In these four games, she has been incredibly efficient going forward, scoring three goals on only seven shots and moving herself into a tie for second on Detroit City FC's women's all-time goals standings. She will look to continue this streak against a stout Indy Eleven defense.

SHOTS SHOTS AND MORE SHOTS

This season Kenna White and Ellie Pool have led the team in shots with 25 and 24 respectively. They account for about 43% of City's shots. Twice this season Le Rouge has recorded 20+ shots, last time out v Kings Hammer (21) and on May 29 at Flint City (26).

DANGER FROM CORNERS

This season, Detroit City has scored four of its fifteen goals from corners, including Kayla Addison's intense game tying header v Kings Hammer.

UTILIZING ROSTER DEPTH

Le Rouge has played 30 different players this season through 10 matches, with different starting XI's every match. Twenty-five players have seen more than 100 minutes on the pitch this season - including three different keepers.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE

Through seven games this season, Le Rouge has only scored fifteen goals on 119 shots - an 12.6% conversion rate. Three of the four games where Le Rouge scores multiple goals have provided wins. City looks to net as many as they can against Indy Eleven this Friday.

TIES TO DCFC YOUTH SYSTEM

There are currently six players on the women's roster who have played in the youth system or have coached in the youth system. There are four players that have come up through the DCFC West system including defender Alia Fredericks, goalkeeper Becca Przybylo, forward Kenna White and forward Syd Smith. Currently, there are also two players on the women's roster who are coaching including midfielder Megan Miles who coaches for DCFC West and defender Meyah Romeo who coaches for DCFC Select. Both of these women coach girls teams.

YOUTHFUL HISTORY

Midfielder Nicole Grimaldo made History on May 12, 2022 when she came on for Detroit City FC against Racing Louisville FC as the youngest ever player to see the field for Le Rouge at just fifteen years old. She played ten minutes in the 0-0 draw but was also on the field with her sister, Niomi who set the record for youngest ever player when she came onto the pitch twenty-six minutes earlier.

LOCAL FOES:

Flint City - Corktown previously was Corktown AFC. At the beginning of 2022, the Flint City Bucks acquired Corktown AFC's Women's team and relocated to Flint, Michigan. The team was then rebranded to Flint City AFC for this upcoming season.

Midwest United is a prominent name in youth soccer in the Grand Rapids area. The first ever match in the history of the Detroit City FC women's side was against Midwest United in a friendly ending in a 3-1 loss. Midwest United also won the Keyworth Showcase in 2020 against DCFC with the same score of 3-1.



Kalamazoo FC has history with the DCFC Men's team from back in the days of the National Premier Soccer League. Kalamazoo FC joined the NPSL in 2016 and competed against Le Rouge every season until 2019. Kalamazoo FC then went on to join USL League 2 at the beginning of the 2021 season, this is the first year that they have ever fielded a women's team.

AFC Ann Arbor has never played a game versus the DCFC Women but they have history with the Men's team. The first signing in club history for the AFC Ann Arbor for the women's team was midfielder Megan Miles, who is on Detroit's current roster.

Indy Eleven is brand new opponent to the Detroit City FC Women's Side, Indy Eleven and Detroit City FC's men's sides have faced off for three consecutive years in pre-season friendlies.

ROSTER INCLUDES HIGH SCHOOLERS

3 players on the roster this season will be finishing their high school career this spring. Goalkeeper Deighton Wamer, who plays club soccer for the Michigan Hawks, is committed to play at Northern Illinois University in the fall of 2022. Defenders Lauren Moraitis and Acadia Murphy also play for the Michigan Hawks, with Murphy committed to play for Ball State University this coming fall. 3 other players on the roster this season are not graduating from high school until 2025. Midfielder Eleanor Klinger plays for the International SC and has been in the USYNT system. She was recently called up to the US U16 Women's Youth National team for friendlies. Midfielder Nicole Girmaldo plays with the Nationals SC and has received call ups in the USYNT system. Midfielder Niomi Girmaldo plays with the Nationals SC.

ROSTERED SINCE 2020

7 players on DCFC have been rostered since the 2020 Inaugural Season; goalkeepers Becca Przybylo and Gabby Shriver, defenders Grace Philpotts and Meyah Romeo and forwards Morgan Reitano, Syd Smith and Kenna White.

MADISON DUNCAN - REIGNING MVP

Defender Madison Duncan is the Reigning MVP for the DCFC Women's team. She was voted by the fans as the Most Valuable Player last season.

LEAGUE WINNERS - DCFC WOMEN'S SECOND TEAM

Last season, the DCFC USW2 won the Great Lakes Conference finishing with 25 points, just 2 points above the 2nd place team, Corktown AFC 2. They went 8-1-1 with a goal difference of 25. There were a total of 11 teams in the Conference.

EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS LEAGUE

Shannon McCarthy played for BIK Kazygurt in Kazakhstan who qualified to play in the UEFA Women's Championship League while she was there. She and her team made it to the Round of 16 twice (2019-2020 and 2020-2021 seasons), with both times playing powerhouse, FC Bayern Munich, in which they lost all four matches.

ASSISTANT COACH DANNY DRAGOI - DCFC ALUMNI

Assistant Coach Danny Dragoi played with Le Rouge in the 2015-2016 season as midfielder, when they competed in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL). During his playing career overseas, Dragoi played for three clubs in the Albanian Superliga and with AS Varese Calcio in Italy's third division. He also currently a head coach with the DCFC Youth West.

MOVING THE CLUB FORWARD: JOINING THE USL

On November 9, 2021, Detroit City FC announced its intention to move from U.S. Soccer's third tier with NISA to the second division with the USL Championship. The move also included the women's team moving out of the UWS into the USL W League.

"It's clear that the time is right for Detroit City FC to move forward by joining the USL Championship," said Detroit City FC Co-Owner and Chief Executive Officer Sean Mann. "This puts us on track to accomplish many of our shared objectives such as fielding a professional women's side, enhancing our academy program, upgrading our facilities, and expanding our reach. Since 2012, our vision for Detroit City FC has been to become Detroit's soccer club for all time. We strive to be the most inclusive, community-focused, and supporter-driven club in the USA."

ABOUT DETROIT CITY FC

Founded in 2012, Detroit City FC has established itself as one of the most talked about soccer teams in North America. Our club motto, Passion for Our City, Passion for the Game, evokes the three ideas the grassroots organization was built upon: to satisfy the demand for soccer in downtown Detroit, represent the city in a positive light, and build community through "the beautiful game."

The seed of DCFC was planted in 2010, on the soccer pitch at Belle Isle in downtown Detroit. That grass – the very same that was transported from the Pontiac Silverdome after the 1994 World Cup – was the original home of the Detroit City Futbol League (DCFL), a co-ed, recreational league that pitted players from teams representing the many historic neighborhoods of Detroit.

Founded as a community organizing endeavor aiming to bring city residents together, the league was wildly successful, quickly drawing over 1000 players a week to the games and after parties at bars across the city. Inspired by the success, DCFL founder Sean Mann pitched four friends an idea to further tap into the growing interest in the sport by founding a minor league soccer team to play in downtown Detroit. Ten years later, Detroit City FC has climbed the U.S. Soccer pyramid from an amateur success story to the second division of professional soccer.

USL W LEAGUE OVERVIEW

The USL W League is a pre-professional women's soccer league that commences in May 2022, to help the pipeline between women's college soccer and pro.

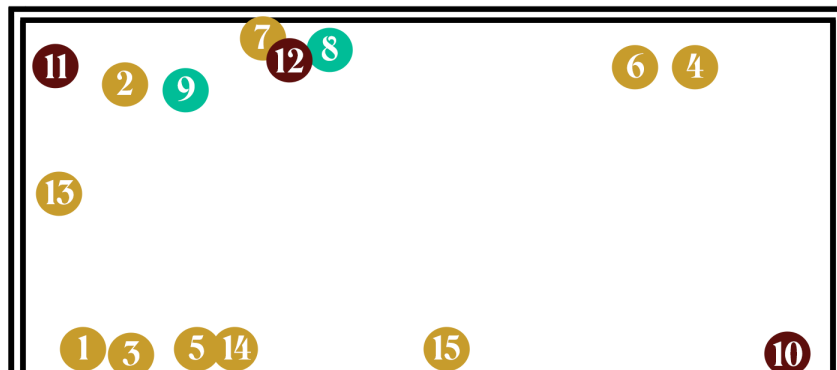

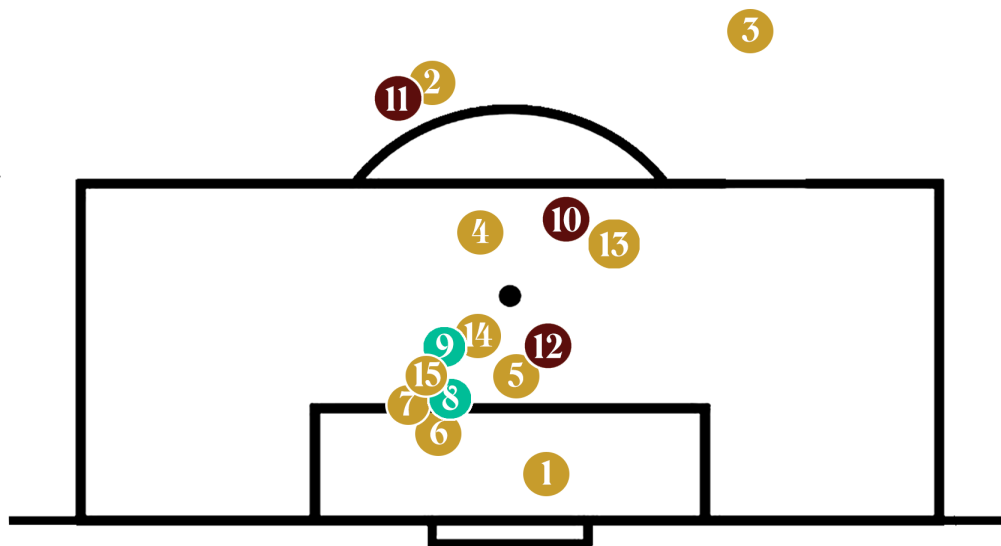

The League aims to create a national platform for women's soccer and a force of good to increase opportunity, gender equity, and career development for women. All teams as well as the league commit to investing in women's soccer not only financially but also with resources to help grow the women's game. The league covers 20 states, including 44 teams in its inaugural season, bringing women's soccer to communities across the U.S., creating more opportunities to play, watch and work in the women's game.

A LOOK AT THE OPPOSITION: INDY ELEVEN

Indy Eleven was founded in 2013 and began play the following year joining the North American Soccer League and would play in the NASL until joining the USL family in 2018.

The name 'Indy Eleven' stems from the team being based in Indianapolis, Indiana and while 'Eleven' is an obvious reference to how many players are on the field at full strength, it is also a reference to the world-renowned Indianapolis 500 as it was first held in 1911 and the start of the world famous sporting event also features 11 rows of cars on the starting grid.

While the Detroit City FC men's side has faced off against Indy Eleven before in friendlies dating back to 2019, this will be the first time these two clubs will meet in a competitive setting.

Indy Eleven announced on September 24, 2021 that they would be joining for the inaugural season of the USL W League and currently sit atop of the Great Lakes division, they have a five point gap to the team in second place while also having a game in hand.

INDY ELEVEN PLAYER TO WATCH

Katherine Soderstrom: As one of the most lethal attacking threats in all of the USL W League, Katherine Soderstrom is sure to cause headaches for the City backline in the final two matchups against Indy Eleven. Soderstrom has scored seven goals and picked up one assist so far in the USL W League season in only 659 minutes, averaging a goal contribution every 82 minutes. She played for Butler University for four seasons, in her time as a Bulldog she scored 28 goals and picked up 24 assists. Her most productive season was the most recent one where she found the back of the net 12 times and was the assist maker on eight occasions.
