Keys to the Match

- HEADS UP: It hasn't been the greatest start to the season for Le Rouge who still have yet to pick up a win but City has led in two of the three matches, scoring first against Kalamazoo and Racing Louisville at Keyworth.
- FAITH IN DEFENSE: One of the highlights of this Detroit City FC team thus far has been its backline. The centerback trio of Gardner, Baeron and Tremonti looks like its firing on all cylinders and great performances out of Gabby Schriver and Bethany Kopel in net don't hurt, either.
- FRESH LEGS: After playing three matches in a week the Detroit City FC women's side has had some time off heading into their contest with Midwest United FC, Le Rouge will be looking to take advantage of this.

THE THIRD YEAR OF THIS MATCHUP

Detroit City FC is quite familiar with its opponents heading into this matchup as this is the fifth time that these two sides will have met in the span of three years. Midwest United FC has gotten the better of Le Rouge on all five occasions with the most exciting matchup between the two coming on June 19, 2021 at Keyworth Stadium where a late comeback by Detroit City FC fell just short and the visiting Midwest United FC took all three points by a score of 3-2. This match was highlighted by an inspired performance out of forward Ellie Pool who netted a hat trick for MUFC.

LAST TIME OUT

The last time that Le Rouge took the pitch was on 5/15 on the road against Racing Louisville FC. It was a very hot and humid day on the outskirts of downtown Louisville and the play on the pitch reflected the weather. It was an intense affair when both teams took the field just days after they had done previously against each other at Keyworth Stadium, that match

ending in a 0-0 draw. Early on both teams showed more attacking intent than they did a few days prior, it was #1 Bethany Kopel who would be called into action multiple times for Le Rouge when the score was locked at 0-0.

The score would remain knotted up at 0-0 until the 39th minute when Madison Duncan, off of a corner routine, picked out a genuine goal of the season contender to put Le Rouge up 1-0. This lead would last throughout the rest of the first half and most of the second but then the hosts began to pick up some steam.

This would lead to two quickfire goals from the hosts out of defender Emily Madril who found the back of the net in minutes 82 and 86 to give Racing Louisville all three points at home.

TIES TO DCFC YOUTH SYSTEM

There are currently 6 players on the women's roster who have played in the youth system or have coached in the youth system. There are 4 players that have come up through the DCFC West system including defender Alia Fredericks, goalkeeper Becca Przybylo, forward Kenna White and forward Syd Smith. Currently, there are also 2 players on the women's roster who are coaching including midfielder Megan Miles who coaches for DCFC West and defender Meyah Romeo who coaches for DCFC Select. Both of these women coach girls teams.

YOUTHFUL HISTORY

Midfielder Nicole Grimaldo made History on May 12, 2022 when she came on for Detroit City FC against Racing Louisville FC as the youngest ever player to see the field for Le Rouge at just fifteen years old. She played ten minutes in the 0-0 draw but was also on the field with her sister, Niomi who set the record for youngest ever player when she came onto the pitch twenty-six minutes earlier.

LOCAL FOES:

Flint City - Corktown previously was Corktown AFC. At the beginning of 2022, the Flint City Bucks acquired Corktown AFC's Women's team and relocated to Flint, Michigan. The team was then rebranded to Flint City AFC for this upcoming season.

Midwest United is a prominent name in youth soccer in the Grand Rapids area. The first ever match in the history of the Detroit City FC women's side was against Midwest United in a friendly ending in a 3-1 loss. Midwest United also won the Keyworth Showcase in 2020 against DCFC with the same score of 3-1.

Kalamazoo FC has history with the DCFC Men's team from back in the days of the National Premier Soccer League. Kalamazoo FC joined the NPSL in 2016 and competed against Le Rouge every season until 2019. Kalamazoo FC then went on to join USL League 2 at the beginning of the 2021 season, this is the first year that they have ever fielded a women's team.

AFC Ann Arbor has never played a game versus the DCFC Women but they have history with the Men's team. The first signing in club history for the AFC Ann Arbor for the women's team was midfielder Megan Miles, who is on Detroit's current roster.

Indy Eleven is brand new opponent to the Detroit City FC Women's Side, Indy Eleven and Detroit City FC's men's sides have faced off for three consecutive years in pre-season friendlies.

ROSTER INCLUDES HIGH SCHOOLERS

3 players on the roster this season will be finishing their high school career this spring. Goalkeeper Deighton Wamer, who plays club soccer for the Michigan Hawks, is committed to play at Northern Illinois University in the fall of 2022. Defenders Lauren Moraitis and Acadia Murphy also play for the Michigan Hawks, with Murphy committed to play



for Ball State University this coming fall. 3 other players on the roster this season are not graduating from high school until 2025. Midfielder Eleanor Klinger plays for the International SC and has been in the USYNT system. She was recently called up to the US U16 Women's Youth National team for friendlies. Midfielder Nicole Girmaldo plays with the Nationals SC and has received call ups in the USYNT system. Midfielder Niomi Girmaldo plays with the Nationals SC.

SECOND HALF BLUES

Detroit City FC have struggled early in the season in the second half with all three goals conceded for Le Rouge coming in the final 45' of play and zero goals being scored on the other side of halftime. The closest Le Rouge have come to finding a goal in the final 45' came against Kalamazoo FC in the season opener when #2 Faith Webber found the back of the net in stoppage time but saw her strike chalked off by the line judge on the far side who had their flag up.

ROSTERED SINCE 2020

7 players on DCFC have been rostered since the 2020 Inaugural Season; goalkeepers Becca Przybylo and Gabby Shriver, defenders Grace Philpotts and Meyah Romeo and forwards Morgan Reitano, Syd Smith and Kenna White.

MADISON DUNCAN - REIGNING MVP

Defender Madison Duncan is the Reigning MVP for the DCFC Women's team. She was voted by the fans as the Most Valuable Player last season.

LEAGUE WINNERS - DCFC WOMEN'S SECOND TEAM

Last season, the DCFC USW2 won the Great Lakes Conference finishing with 25 points, just 2 points above the 2nd place team, Corktown AFC 2. They went 8-1-1 with a goal difference of 25. There were a total of 11 teams in the Conference.

EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS LEAGUE

Shannon McCarthy played for BIIK Kazygurt in Kazakhstan who qualified to play in the UEFA Women's Championship League while she was there. She and her team made it to the Round of 16 twice (2019-2020 and 2020-2021 seasons), with both times playing powerhouse, FC Bayern Munich, in which they lost all four matches.

LEAGUE AWARDS FROM UWS

Last season players on both the UWS and UWS2 teams received league awards. Defender Madison Duncan received UWS All-Midwest Conference First Team and All-UWS Honorable Mention. Midfielder Grace Philpotts and forward Kenna White were awarded UWS All-Midwest Conference Second Team. Midfielder Brooke Sleeva and midfielder Bella Sabo were named to the USW2 All-Great Lake Conference First team.

ASSISTANT COACH DANNY DRAGOI - DCFC ALUMNI

Assistant Coach Danny Dragoi played with Le Rouge in the 2015-2016 season as midfielder, when they competed in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL). During his playing career overseas, Dragoi played for three clubs in the Albanian Superliga and with AS Varese Calcio in Italy's third division. He also currently a head coach with the DCFC Youth West.

A LOOK AT THE OPPOSITION: MIDWEST UNITED FC

Midwest United FC was originally a familiar foe known as Grand Rapids FC. GRFC was founded as a men's semi-professional team in 2014 and began play in 2015 in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL). They found success in the early years and averaged nearly 4,000 in attendance for their home matches at Houseman Field. In 2016 it was announced that Grand Rapids FC would be forming a women's team that would begin play the following season in the United Women's Soccer League. They found immediate success, winning the UWS National Championship in their first season.

In December of 2019 the brand known as Grand Rapids FC and its ownership went through a period of restructuring and the women's side was transferred to Midwest United FC and the name was switched to what we know it as today. The first ever match in Detroit City FC women's team history was against Midwest United FC in 2020.

MIDWEST UNITED FC PLAYERS TO WATCH

Lauren Kozal: Kozal is coming off of a career campaign between the posts for the Michigan State Spartans. The Ada, Michigan native put up an impressive 0.862 save percentage for the green and white and kept seven clean sheets in the process. These numbers were good enough for Kozal to be honored as the Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Year and has only gotten better under new Spartans head coach Jeff Hosler.

Elle Otto: Otto is a speedy, young and talented forward who can make defenses pay. Fans of Le Rouge should be familiar with Ellie

Otto as it was her hat trick at Keyworth Stadium in June of 2021 being the difference between Detroit City FC and Midwest United FC. Otto is fresh off of a freshman season at Mississippi State which saw her pick up 347 minutes of play on the field where she appeared in 14 matches while starting one.

MIDWEST UNITED FC HEAD COACH: LEWIS ROBINSON

Lewis Robinson is a native of Newcastle in the United Kingdom and he played as a midfielder for Davenport University and started 18 games in his senior season in 2008 where he registered two goals and eight assists. Robinson then went on to be the head coach of the Aquinas College Saints beginning in 2017 where he still holds the position.

While working for Aquinas College he was also named the head coach of the inaugural Grand Rapids FC women's team, this team won the UWS Championship under his leadership in 2017 and eventually became the head coach of the Grand Rapids FC men's side in 2019. While he is the head coach of the Midwest United FC USL W-League side, he also serves as the clubs Executive Director.

MOVING THE CLUB FORWARD: JOINING THE USL

On November 9, 2021, Detroit City FC announced its intention to move from U.S. Soccer's third tier with NISA to the second division with the USL Championship. The move also included the women's team moving out of the UWS into the USL W League.

"It's clear that the time is right for Detroit City FC to move forward by joining the USL Championship," said Detroit City FC Co-Owner and Chief Executive Officer Sean Mann. "This puts us on track to accomplish many of our shared objectives such as fielding a professional women's side, enhancing our academy program, upgrading our facilities, and expanding our reach. Since 2012, our vision for Detroit City FC has been to become Detroit's soccer club for all time. We strive to be the most inclusive, community-focused, and supporter-driven club in the USA."

ABOUT DETROIT CITY FC

Founded in 2012, Detroit City FC has established itself as one of the most talked about soccer teams in North America. Our club motto, Passion for Our City, Passion for the Game, evokes the three ideas the grassroots organization was built upon: to satisfy the demand for soccer in downtown Detroit, represent the city in a positive light, and build community through "the beautiful game."

The seed of DCFC was planted in 2010, on the soccer pitch at Belle Isle in downtown Detroit. That grass – the very same that was transported from the Pontiac Silverdome after the 1994 World Cup – was the original home of the Detroit City Futbol League (DCFL), a co-ed, recreational league that pitted players from teams representing the many historic neighborhoods of Detroit.

Founded as a community organizing endeavor aiming to bring city residents together, the league was wildly successful, quickly drawing over 1000 players a week to the games and after parties at bars across the city. Inspired by the success, DCFL founder Sean Mann pitched four friends an idea to further tap into the growing interest in the sport by founding a minor league soccer team to play in downtown Detroit. Ten years later, Detroit City FC has climbed the U.S. Soccer pyramid from an amateur success story to the second division of professional soccer.

USL W LEAGUE OVERVIEW

The USL W League is a pre-professional women's soccer league that commences in May 2022, to help the pipeline between women's college soccer and pro. The League aims to create a national platform for women's soccer and a force of good to increase opportunity, gender equity, and career development for women. All teams as well as the league commit to investing in women's soccer not only financially but also with resources to help grow the women's game. The league covers 20 states, including 44 teams in its inaugural season, bringing women's soccer to communities across the U.S., creating more opportunities to play, watch and work in the women's game.

USL W PLAYOFFS

The USL W League Playoff will begin on July 13 and ends on July 23. The Quarter Finals are on July 13, the Semifinals on July 17, and the USL W League Final on July 23. All seven division winners will qualify for the playoffs, while the final playoff spot is awarded as a wild-card to the second-place team with the best record from the Great Lakes or Metropolitan divisions. Locations of the games are based on bids that are completed by the league.
