The WPSL is sanctioned by the United States Adult Soccer Association (USASA), which is an affiliate of the United States Soccer Federation (USSF).



# **MARQUEE ALUMNAE**

Entering its 23rd season, the Women's Premier Soccer League has provided thousands of elite female players with the opportunity to grow and continually develop their game to take them to the next level. As a result, the WPSL has produced an impressive resume of Marquee Alumnae who have gone on to play professionally both stateside and internationally, as well as earning National Team Honors on FIFA World Cup and Olympic stages.

As many still play in the National Women's Soccer League and internationally, those who have retired from the game have continued earning accomplishments such as turning to coaching, sports broadcasting, and even making the New York Times Best Sellers List. In 2019, Brandi Chastain and Leslie Osborne both joined the California Storm's Board of Directors - the team the duo both played for during their time in the WPSL.

Additional notable individual honors include Brandi Chastain's 2017 Hall of Fame induction and 2019 Ballon d'Or winner, Megan Rapinoe - only the second female to win the award.

### NWSL COLLEGE DRAFT BALTIMORE 2020

The 2020 NWSL College Draft featured 17 WPSL players among the 36 draft selections, including three WPSL standouts among the first 10 selections. Forward Morgan Weaver of the Seattle Sounders Women was the No. 2 pick by Portland Thorns FC, and was followed by two selections from the Orlando Pride, both Motor City FC products - No. 3 pick, midfielder Taylor Korneick, and with the No. 7 selection, Orlando selected defender Courtney Petersen. Eleven different WPSL clubs had players selected in the '19 Draft, as Motor City FC, the Seattle Sounders and Washington Spirit Reserves led the way with three former player's picked, respectively.

#### JERRY ZANELLI CUP

The Winner of the WPSL Championship is awarded The Jerry Zanelli Cup - named in honor of the League's Founder.



#### ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES

- » WPSL Annual Membership Dues for the 2021 Season are projected to be \$3,500 and are paid in two installments of \$1,000 on October 1, 2020 and January 10, 2021.
- » The WPSL has not had an Annual Dues increase in five years.

#### **EXPANSION**

- » Expansion prospects must remit a WPSL New Team Application and New Team Fee of \$3,250. (Team Fee not deposited unless Application is approved.)
- » Upon receipt, Executive Committee performs due diligence and forwards recommendation to Associate Commissioners.
- » Approved New Teams are notified and agreed-upon date is selected to publicly announce entry into WPSL for upcoming season.
- » Upon approval, New Teams are classified as a "Member in Good Standing".

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE: December 31, 2020

Expansion Applicants are highly encouraged to expedite Application as selected markets may be capped for new team entry and not be available at the December 31 Application deadline.

The WPSL's New Team Application-to-Approval process takes approximately 7-to-10 business days.







Murphy, who played collegiately at Saint Louis University, has spent the past dozen years putting her life on the line as a police officer.

Following a homicide investigation involving several at-risk teens, the KC Courage Captain founded her own inner-city club, the FC Jaguars, in an effort to keep kids off the streets and out of trouble. The non-profit has mentored hundred of kids through the program, fielded U14 and U15 teams and has partnered with the Police Athletic League of Kansas City (KC PAL).

Weekly tutoring emphasizes the importance of academics and affords opportunities to further their education through soccer, guiding her students toward college visits and assists them obtain scholarships
