In Memoriam



A Master Gardener who made incredible chocolate chip cookies and highlight videos at the end of each season for all of her kids' sports teams, Nancy Webber will be forever loved and celebrated by her husband Bill, son Jake, daughter Maya, daughter-in-law Jamie, grandson Jye, and granddaughter Janae.

Nancy was the first Executive Director of Eugene Civic Alliance. She was instrumental in founding the organization and leading the initial capital campaign to build a new recreational facility on the site of the historic 1938 Civic Stadium.

A former political campaign consultant and policy analyst, Nancy also had a strong background in media production. She previously worked as marketing director for Oregon Public Broadcasting and owned her own production company, Tzum Productions. She produced the documentary, Sagebrush Sailors for OPB and Peg's Legs for the Susan G. Komen Foundation about her Hood to Coast running team of breast cancer survivors, and still found time to hike the Pacific Crest Trail.

A graduate of Colorado College where she received a bachelors in political science, Nancy received her masters at the University of Oregon School of Journalism and Communication. She went on to serve on the boards of the Oregon Environmental Council and the Gilbert House Children's Museum. She was a published author and a volunteer grant evaluator for Oregon Community Foundation for 30 years.

Some of the many projects Nancy worked on during her illustrious career were the construction of Portland's Pioneer Courthouse Square, the Nuclear Safeguards campaign, the Northwest Power Planning and Conservation Act, the Endangered American Wilderness Act, and the Indian Tribal Restoration Act, restoring rights to the Siletz, Cow Creek Band of the Umpqua, Grande Ronde, Coos, Lower Umpqua, Siuslaw, Klamath, and Coquille tribes.

Nancy was Anishinaabe, a descendent of the Notawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi. Daughter of Don Green, granddaughter of Mabel and George Green, great-granddaughter of Anita Cawcawbe, great-great-granddaughter of William Cawcawbe, she was adopted and raised by Amos and Vesta Showalter in Lake Oswego, OR. She spent summers on the family ranch in Walla Walla, WA. After living and working all over, Nancy said her heart always felt most at peace in Oregon. She will be missed by all who enjoy this special place at Civic Park, and dearly so by those who knew her.

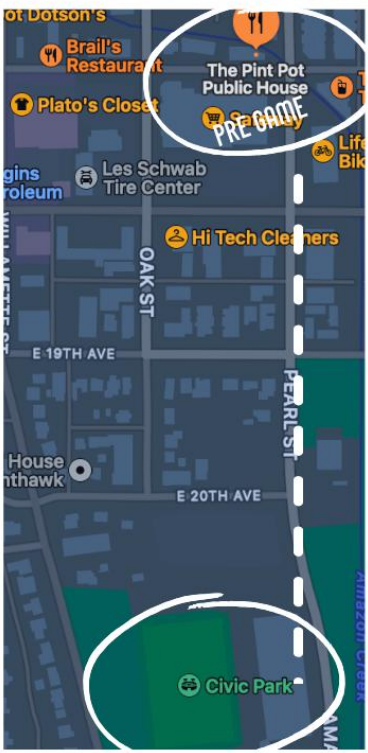

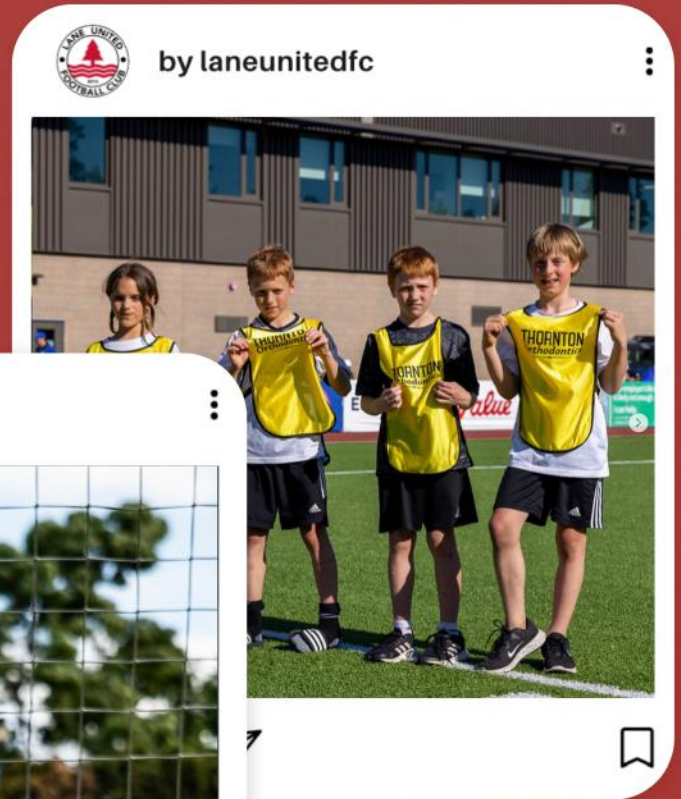
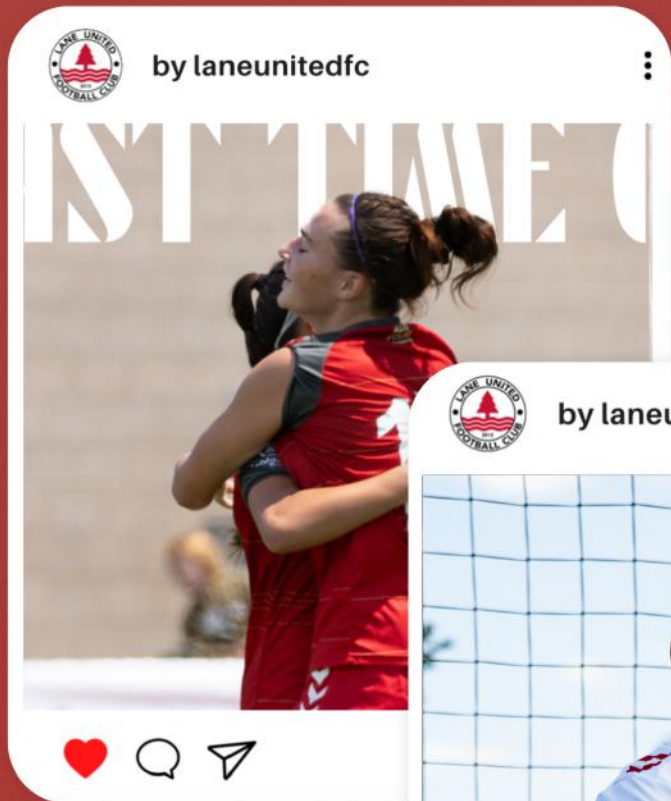
