POWER OF THE ZERO: The Spartanburgers have won back-to-back 1-0 games to take a 2-1 series lead against Rome. Last season, then High-A Hickory won nine games via shutout, but lost 13, including three of them to Rome.

CURRIED PENGUIN: Hub City shut out Rome Wednesday behind a fantastic start from right-hander Aidan Curry. The 22-year-old tossed 5 scoreless innings, only allowed one hit and struck out 7. Four bullpen arms, including Larson Kindreich (W, 3-0) and Wilian Bormie (S, 2) posted zeros and combined with Curry for 12 total strikeouts.

TOP DOGS: The Spartanburgers' first trip to AdventHealth Stadium serves as a chance to prove themselves as the class of the SAL South. Rome matched Hub City last week win-for-win, taking four of six against Winston-Salem. Nine of the Emperors' 13 wins have come against the two teams at the bottom of the South Divison, W-S and Asheville.

DH SO GRAND: Hub City doubled down on grand slams Saturday. Keith Jones and Dylan Dreiling both hit their first professional bases-clearing homers. Jones' came on a two-out, two-strike cutter in the third, and Dreiling's brought four home in the sixth. For Dreiling, the blast was part of a torrid week, as he went 9-19 against the Drive with 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI.

DOUBLE DOWN DAVALILLO: David Davalillo earned his first win Friday after another fantastic performance at Fifth Third Park, tossing 5 innings and striking out seven Greenville hitters. The right-hander won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for April 15-20 after his dominant performance (5 IP. O H. O R. 9 K) v. BG.

LATE GAME LEADERS: The Spartanburgers are outscoring opponents 33-16 in the final three innings. 16 runs in the seventh, just four in the eighth, and a whopping 13 in the ninth. On the contrast, opponents have only scored six runs in the ninth.

2024 v. ROM: The Hickory Crawdads went 4-11 against the Rome Emperors, last season, including a 2-7 road record in GA. The 'Dads opened the season at AdventHealth Park, and were held to just one run in three games.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-Asaffiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
