Tonight: The Revs play the middle game on opening weekend off their "Sweet 16" season and the 25th anniversary season of the Atlantic League, looking to even the series and notch their first victory in Lexington.

New Era: Rick Forney takes over the reigns as the fourth field manager in Revs history, bringing with him first-year pitching coach Joe Harris and first-year hitting coach Derek Wolfe. It marks the first complete coaching staff change for the Revs since Andy Etchebarren took over as manager in August, 2009 and hired a new coaching staff for the 2010 season.

Winning Pedigree: Forney comes to York after 26 seasons in Winnipeg, 17 as manager (887-753). He led the Goldeyes to 10 playoff appearances and 3 championships (2012, 2016-17), the most in American Association history. He was named Manager of the Year in 2011 and 2020, sold 44 players to MLB organizations, and his 17-year run as manager established the third-longest tenure in MLB Partner League history. WPG's .545 winning pct in the American Association (631-527 since 2011) is fourth-highest in league history, second-highest active.

Tidying Up: The 15 pitchers on York's staff have a combined career 2.99 walks per nine... 8 are under 3.0... 13 of the 15 have a career mark of 3.75 or fewer.

Pulling Rank: Nellie Rodriguez begins his third season in York. One of the top power hitters in Revs history, Rodriguez ranks T-6th in Revs history in HR (51, tied with Isaias Tejeda) and enters the year with 197 career HR including winter ball stats. Other notable Revs career rankings include: #1 in OBP (.427), #3 in walks (177 including league-record 108 last season), #5 in SLG (.531), #6 in HR at WellSpan Park (28), #2 in starts at 1B (184).

#900: Drew Mendoza's HR in the 6th inning last night was the Revs' first of the season, and the 900th road HR in Revs history.

Opening Night History: The Revs are now 10-6 all-time on Opening Night (5-3 on the road). York had won back-to-back season openers including a road win at Long Island last year, their 5th straight win in a season opener on the road dating to 2009. Last night marked the first ever Opening Night meeting between York and Lexington. It was York's first season-opening loss since 2019 vs Long Island and the first on the road since 2008 at Camden.

Counter Punch: The Revs will face some familiar faces this weekend. Lexington's roster includes three former Revs: RHP Josh Martin (2022), RHP Sam Burton (2019, 2022), and OF JC Encarnacion (2021-22) who is the Revs' all-time leader in pinch-hits (10) while ranking 2nd in triples (13) and 10th in SLG (.511). Hitting coach Enoshel Polanco served as hitting coach with York from 2010-22, marking the longest stint in the same role on the coaching staff in franchise history.

Tonight: Makes 50th start of Revs career and 398th appearance of pro career.

2023: 17th pro season, 4th in ALPB/York

Revs Rankings: T-5th in wins (23), 7th in IP (278.0), 7th in K (237), 7th in GS (49), 7th in QS (19), 9th in ERA (3.11)... is one of four in Revs history to lead team in wins in multiple seasons (along with Wayne Franklin, Chris Cody, Mitch Atkins) and one of four to lead in strikeouts in multiple seasons (Corey Thurman, Cody, Atkins) and is the only pitcher to do either in non-consecutive seasons (2014 and 2022)

2022: Went 9-5 with a 3.48 ERA in 18 starts for York... Struck out 121 (#6 single-season in Revs history) in just 103.1 innings... set ALPB record with 10.5 K/9... walked just 26 and allowed only 94 hits on the year... was a top candidate for Pitcher of the Year honors before going inactive in August... led league in WAR... set Revs career record with four 10+ strikeout performances, all last season... won 7 straight from mid-June to late-July... ERA was 8th-best in a single-season in Revs history (also has 6th-best set in 2014)... opponents average (.239) was 4th-lowest.

Man of Winter: Martinez went on to ring up a 2.68 ERA in 9GS for Gigantes in the Dominican Winter League this past off-season... he is now 37-22 with a 2.68 ERA in 104 career winter ball appearances... was Venezuelan Winter League Pitcher of the Year with Lara in 2018 (5-3, 2.26 in 12GS).

Career Notes: 37-year-old began pro career in native Cuba, spending 8 years pitching in the Cuban National Series with Matanzas... authored the 50th no-hitter in Cuban history... signed with York in 2014 for his first pro season in the United States and was one of the ALPB's top starters, going 11-8 with a 3.21 ERA for a playoff-bound squad... made 7GS for York in 2016 (3-2, 1.80)... has also pitched in the Mexican League, the Italian Baseball League, and the American Association over the course of a 17-year career... enters season 122-97 lifetime with a 3.88 ERA in 397G / 317GS.

#37 VICTOR CAPELLAN-RHP

- Returns to York... first pitched for Revs late in 2019 and for most of 2021.
- Dealt to SI prior to 2022 season... ranked 3rd in ALPB with 20 saves (7-3, 1.60 in 48G)... held opposing hitters to .176 average... went 21 straight outings without an earned run spanning nearly two months, 5/28-7/24
- Reacquired via trade on 1/24 for LHP Jim Fuller
- 16th year pro... one of most accomplished relievers in MLB Partner League history... began pro career with ARZ in 2008 and reached Triple-A Reno at age 22
- First acquired by Forney in Winnipeg in 2016... spent 5 seasons with Goldeyes... appeared in all 12 postseason victories during back-to-back championship runs in 2016-17... tied WPG franchise record with 22 saves in 2018 and set a new mark with 27 saves in 2019... set American Association's all-time career appearances record in 2019 and set the league's all-time saves mark the following year... 76 saves in AA eclipsed previous mark of 70 set by former Revs lefty Kris Regas
- Career 47-43, 112 saves, 3.61 ERA including 9 winter league seasons.

- 8th year pro... Career 4.71 ERA in 161G/43GS
