FC CINCINNATI MATCHUP NOTES

CONTINUE THE RUN

FC Cincinnati are unbeaten against Atlanta United FC under Head Coach **Pat Noonan**. Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orange and Blue are **3-0-3** against the Five Stripes.

FC Cincinnati swept Atlanta last season, winning 2-1 in come-from-behind fashion at Mercedes-Benz Stadium in April, followed by a midweek 1-0 win in May at TQL Stadium. **Kevin Kelsy's** 7th minute goal was all that was needed in the win.

A RARE AFTERNOON IN THE QUEEN CITY

Saturday will mark a rare afternoon kickoff (4 p.m. or prior) for FC Cincinnati. It will be just FCC's **11th** home match in the Queen City with an early kickoff in the club's MLS era. FCC hold a **2-4-4** record at home in such games.

That of course excludes July 28, 2023 when FCC and Chivas resumed the final half hour of play in Leagues Cup 2023 at 2 p.m. after severe weather halted play in the 60th minute the night prior.

FINALLY SOME TIME!

Excluding the season opener at FC Motagua in the Concacaf Champions Cup, Saturday marks the first match FC Cincinnati have played this season on a full week of rest. The Orange and Blue had begun the season with eight matches in 25 days with MLS and Champions Cup play, going **3-3-2** in that stretch.

The Orange and Blue will focus solely on MLS Regular Season play until Leagues Cup action begins in late July. It will be nearly two months - on Wednesday, May 14 at Toronto FC - before Cincinnati will have to play a midweek match in addition to a weekend fixture.

AWAY ABROAD

As FC Cincinnati and Atlanta United take the field, two Orange and Blue players are with their respective national teams during the March FIFA International Window. **Kévin Denkey** joined the Togo National Team for 2026 FIFA World Cup Qualifiers while **Stefan Chirila** is with the U-18 Romanian National Team for a training camp.

HOME COOKING

FC Cincinnati seek a **3-0-0** home start in MLS play, and seek to become the first team to accomplish that in 2025. Only two other MLS clubs are 2-0-0 at home and host a match in Matchday 5 (Charlotte FC, Vancouver Whitecaps FC), both of whom play later Saturday.

Cincy have once before started 3-0-0 at home in MLS, in 2023 when the club started **10-0-0** - tied for the longest single-season home in streak in MLS history and tied for the third-longest home win streak in MLS history

CAPTAIN MILES

Miles Robinson has worn the captain's armband in all eight matches so far this season. He signed with FC Cincinnati ahead of the 2024 season after spending the entirety of his prior seven-year MLS career with Atlanta United.

With Atlanta, Robinson made 123 MLS regular season appearances - 111 starts - scoring three goals and two assists. He earned two MLS Best XI honors (2019, 2021), one All-Star honor (2021) and won two titles, including MLS Cup 2018.

BIRTHDAY, GAMEDAY

Saturday marks dynamic wingback **Luca Orellano's** 25th birthday. The 2024 MLS All-Star and Newcomer of the Year Finalist has 12 goals and eight assists in his time with FC Cincinnati, and signed a contract extension through 2029 on February 22.

G'DAY, BRAD!

Last Friday, FC Cincinnati signed Australian wingback **Brad Smith**, who brings to Cincinnati over 200 professional appearances, over half of which have come in MLS - most recently spending the past two seasons with Houston Dynamo FC. In addition to 10 Premier League appearances with Liverpool and Bournemouth earlier in his career, he has also earned 23 caps for the Australia National Team.

10 YEARS OF FC CINCINNATI

It all started on August 12, 2015. Three seasons in United Soccer League as FC Cincinnati smashed ticket records, lifted the 2018 USL Regular Season title, and quickly became an overnight sensation following the 2017 U.S. Open Cup run to the semifinals.



On May 29, 2018, FC Cincinnati became Major League Soccer's 24th franchise. Since then, the club has opened the global award-winning TQL Stadium; launched MLS NEXT Pro squad FC Cincinnati 2; established FC Cincinnati Foundation and numerous soccer camps, clinics and mini pitches; won the 2023 MLS Supporters' Shield along with several MLS individual Awards, qualified for Concacaf Champions Cup for two years in a

row; and made the MLS Cup Playoffs for three consecutive years.

THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY - OFF THE PITCH

Off the pitch, to celebrate the 10th anniversary of FC Cincinnati, the club is gearing up to celebrate with special events, merchandise and fan activations throughout the season.

- A special alumni match will take place following the August 10 match vs Charlotte FC, followed by the first celebrity golf outing the next day
- Special merchandise and fan gear available all season long at the Team Store
- The first-ever bobblehead night on March 8
- The FC Cincinnati Foundation will also open the 11th and 12th mini pitches at parks and recreation centers around Greater Cincinnati and will top \$700,000 in community building grants for the West End neighborhood since the start of the Foundation. Additionally, programming will reach over 60,000 children ensuring equal access to soccer and supporting education and character development.

THE ORANGE AND BLUE LEGACY KIT

New in 2025, the Orange and Blue Legacy Kit celebrates the club's rich history, growth, and deep connection with its fans and the community. The Orange and Blue Legacy Kit honors the team's journey throughout the years and the supporters who have been an integral part of its success. It serves as a symbol of pride and unity, reinforcing FC Cincinnati's commitment to excellence on and off the field.



The kit's design serves as a tribute to FC Cincinnati's roots, honoring the early days in the USL while simultaneously embracing our ongoing journey in the MLS. The kit celebrates the bond with our supporters, embraces the past and emphasizes future growth and prosperity.

The kit incorporates elements from our past, specifically the beloved 2016-17 USL jersey. It features the colors from the FC Cincinnati crest and a distinctive orange sash adorned with diamonds that pay tribute to our USL roots and reflect our identity as the "Gem of the Queen City."

THE NEW LOOK ORANGE AND BLUE

FC Cincinnati welcome two new Designated Players in 2025 - **Kévin Denkey** and **Evander**.



Denkey, the 24-year-old striker from Togo formerly playing for Cercle Brugge in the Belgian Jupiler Pro League, was acquired by FC Cincinnati in November 2024 after a league record transfer fee through 2028 with options for further years. A collection of the FC Cincinnati faithful were on the scene to celebrate him at Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport (CVG) when he arrived following MLS Media Days in January. Denkey made over 200 professional appearances

in Europe, scoring 78 goals and adding 22 assists.

Evander, 26, was acquired in February from the Portland Timbers in the largest cash-for-player trade in league history. He was named to a finalist for the 2024 Landon Donovan MLS Most Valuable Player award and was named an MLS Best XI player last season. He notched 15 goals and finished tied for the league high with 19 assists, producing 34 goal contributions which was second-most in MLS last season only behind Inter Miami's Lionel Messi.



WINNING TIGHT GAMES, WHAT FC CINCINNATI DO

FC Cincinnati went **14-6 (.700)** last season in regular season games decided by one goal. That many one-goal wins was tied for third-most in the MLS post-shootout era, and it came one season after FCC's also had 14 one-goal wins in 2023.

FROM THE FC CINCINNATI ACADEMY TO THE FIRST TEAM

FC Cincinnati have signed **eight** all-time FC Cincinnati Academy products to first-team contracts, five of whom have appeared in at least one match for FCC.

Gerardo Valenzuela took a massive step in 2024, appearing in 30 regular season matches, tied for sixth-most among all players. **Paul Walters** made his debut in Leagues Cup, recording seven saves in the comeback 4-2 win over NYCFC.

New to the mix in 2025 is **Stefan Chirila**, who begins his first season with the first team. He shined in the FC Cincinnati Academy system, scoring 41 goals across all youth competitions during the 2023-24 season and was named the U17 MLS NEXT Most Valuable Player in 2024. At the 2024 Generation adidas Cup, he led the FCC U17 side to 3-0-0 group stage record and advancement into the knockout stages for the first time in FC Cincinnati Academy history, scoring five goals, winning the U17 Golden Boot and was named to the GA Cup Best XI.

Pat Noonan was hired as FC Cincinnati's Head Coach on December 14, 2021. The former player and longtime assistant coach came to the Queen City following nine years of domestic coaching experience, including the previous four (2018-2021) with Philadelphia Union under two-time Sigi Schmid MLS Coach of the Year Jim Curtin.

In 2024, Noonan's club navigated early schedule congestion with the club's first appearance in the Concacaf Champions Cup, 11 newcomers to the team and four season-ending injuries including to 2023 MLS Defender of the Year Matt Miazga. Despite the obstacles, Noonan's team finished third in the Eastern Conference, fifth in the Supporters' Shield, making Cincinnati one of only two clubs (LAFC) to have finished top-10 in the standings in each of the past three years.

In 2023, Noonan's FC Cincinnati soared to new heights, capturing the club's first trophy since joining MLS, the Supporters' Shield. With 69 points earned, Noonan's club secured the fourth-most points in a single season, ever. His club also featured the 2023 Landon Donovan MLS MVP Luciano Acosta and the 2023 Defender of the Year Matt Miazga.

Noonan was honored with the 2023 Sigi Schmid Coach of the Year. Noonan himself coached under two different MLS Coach of the Year honorees: Jim Curtin (2020, 2022) and Bruce Arena (1997, 2009, 2011, 2021) and he became the 10th former MLS player to take home Sigi Schmid MLS Coach of the Year accolades. He also played under the namesake of the Coach of the Year award – Sigi Schmid – while with the Columbus Crew (2008) and Seattle Sounders FC (2010-11).

Noonan's regular-season win percentage in his first two years as a head coach in MLS – **63.2% (32-14-22)** – was the second-best in league history and his **32** wins in his first two seasons was tied for the third-most ever in the post-shootout era for a coach in their first two seasons. In Noonan's first season in 2022, the Orange and Blue saw record growth on the field. FCC secured club-bests in nearly every statistical category, with 49 points earned, 15 wins and

72 goals in 39 games across all competitions. FCC earned a playoff spot for the first time in club history and advanced to the Eastern Conference Semifinals with a road win in Round One at the New York Red Bulls.

Success shouldn't have come as a surprise for Noonan. **in his 21 seasons in MLS either as a player or a coach, he has guided his club to a berth in the MLS Cup Playoffs in 20 of those seasons.**

Noonan spent four seasons in Philadelphia, appointed in January 2018 to coach alongside Jim Curtin, highlighted by the club's 2020 Supporters' Shield campaign. Before joining the staff in Philadelphia, Noonan served as an assistant coach with Bruce Arena and the USMNT from 2017 until 2018. After his playing retirement in 2013, he joined LA Galaxy's coaching staff under the four-time MLS Coach of the Year Arena.

His playing career began as a two-time All-American at Indiana University. He scored 48 goals in 91 college matches, and he was drafted ninth overall by the New England Revolution in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft. That began a 10-year playing career, where he was runner-up for Rookie of the Year in 2003, and in 2004, he finished in a tie for MLS Scoring Champion. He was named to the MLS All-Star team in 2004 as well. During his playing career, Noonan won MLS Cup twice, once with the Columbus Crew in 2008 and with the LA Galaxy in 2012. He won the Supporters' Shield with the Crew in 2008, and he lifted the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup three times - in 2007 with the Revs, and then in back-to-back seasons with Seattle Sounders FC in 2010 and 2011. Internationally, Noonan earned 15 caps for the USMNT, scoring one goal and winning the 2005 CONCACAF Gold Cup. He ended

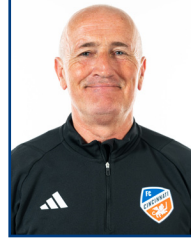
Assistant Coach - Fourth Season

Arena enters his third season with the Orange and Blue after four seasons as an assistant with Los Angeles FC. He joined LAFC in 2018 after one year as an assistant with the USMNT, coached by his father Bruce Arena.

He began his professional coaching career in 2014 with the LA Galaxy as an assistant under Bruce, where the Galaxy won an MLS Cup in his first season as an assistant. Prior to joining the coaching ranks in MLS, Arena was an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level with the Virginia Cavaliers, the George Mason Patriots, and the UCLA Bruins.

The Charlottesville, Virginia native played college soccer at UVA from 1999-2002. In that time, he also played for the United States U-20 Men's National Team, including at the 2001 FIFA World Youth Championship. He was selected in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft by the MetroStars, where he played for two seasons before playing his final season of soccer with D.C. United in 2005.

Assistant Coach - Fourth Season

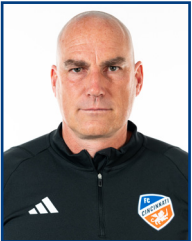
Birthplace: Glasgow, Scotland

Prior to joining FCC, Kinnear previously spent 2017-20 with LA Galaxy, serving both as an assistant and as Interim Head Coach. Prior to joining the Galaxy, the Glasgow, Scotland native coached in two stints with the San Jose Earthquakes, from 2014-17 and from 2001-05.

As an assistant with the Earthquakes from 2001-03, Kinnear and the Quakes won MLS Cup in 2001 and 2003. As Head Coach in 2005, Kinnear won the Supporters' Shield.

In 2006, Kinnear moved to Houston when the Earthquakes were relocated to Texas and named the Houston Dynamo. The expansion side won back-to-back MLS Cups under Kinnear's leadership in 2006 and 2007, reached the MLS Cup final twice more (2011 and 2012), and the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup semifinals twice (2006 and 2009).

As a player, Kinnear made 243 professional appearances as a defender, playing in Scotland, Mexico, and across the United States. Internationally, he earned 54 caps for the United States Men's National Team, scoring nine goals and winning the 1991 CONCACAF Gold Cup.



PAUL ROGERS

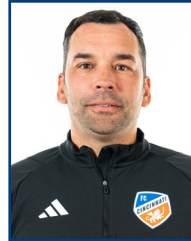
Director of Goalkeeping - Fourth Season

In his third season as FC Cincinnati's Director of Goalkeeping, Rogers spent the prior seven seasons with Houston Dynamo FC in the same role, having served under five different head coaches. He took part in the club's 2018 U.S. Open Cup title run when the club shutout Philadelphia Union 3-0 in the final, and in Houston's run to the 2017 Western Conference Finals and the 2019 Concacaf Champions League quarterfinals.

Before his time in Houston, the Brighton, England native spent six seasons with the U.S. Women's National Team as the goalkeeper coach and helped lead the USWNT to a gold medal at the 2012 Olympic Games. Prior to joining the national team, he also assisted as the goalkeeper coach with the Canada Women's National Team, St. Louis Athletica of Women's Professional Soccer in 2009 and 2010, and collegiately with Florida State University, the University of Louisville and Tulane University.

Rogers' playing career began at the youth level with Queens Park Rangers FC and then in college at the University of South Florida. as well as senior playing experience with Brighton & Hove Albion FC.

Prior to joining the FC Cincinnati Academy coaching staff, he coached in the Orlando City SC and Monteverde Academy (Fla.) organizations, as well as a stint as Head Coach of Miami United FC of the National Premier Soccer League in 2016.

In his playing career, the Venezuelan international earned 64 caps for his country, scoring six international goals including at the 2007 Copa América. He played professionally for nearly 20 years across Europe, South America and Mexico.

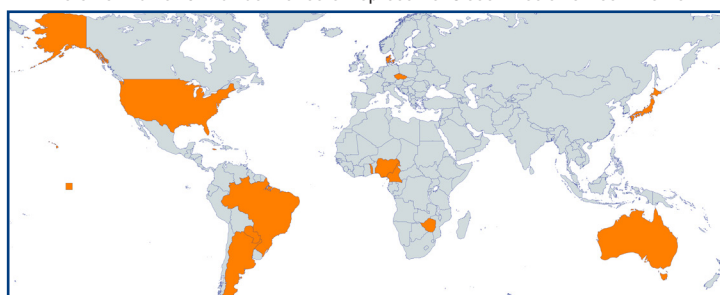

TQL STADIUM

Opened on May 1, 2021, TQL Stadium, home of FC Cincinnati, is one of the most ambitious soccer-specific stadiums in not only North America, but the world. Critically-acclaimed firm Populous designed an innovative and forward-thinking stadium that is one of the largest soccer-specific facilities in Major League Soccer. TQL Stadium has been named Best Venue at the 2022 World Football Summit in Madrid and the 2022 Prix Versailles World Title in the Sports Category in Paris, France.

The closest seats are within 15 feet of the pitch at the \$250 million, privately funded stadium. The design includes 53 traditional suites and 4,500 premium seats throughout four premium club spaces. FCC's supporters' section, The Bailey, has grown to be more than 3,100 strong and loom over opponents at a 34-degree angle at the stadium's north end. A 360-degree canopy roof covers every seat in TQL Stadium, but still allows sufficient sun in to grow a natural grass field.

The stadium has five team locker rooms, including a comprehensive team suite for FC Cincinnati that features a dressing room, coach's office, lounge, equipment storage and the Mercy Health Center of Excellence for the team's medical and game day fitness needs. Within the 18 months of the stadium's completion, TQL Stadium featured both the U.S. Men's and Women's National Teams, including the USMNT's FIFA World Cup Qualification match vs. Mexico, and a concert by legendary rock band, *The Who*, on May 15, 2022. Two more booked concert followed, including Kenny Chesney's Sun Goes Down Tour in 2024 and in 2025, *Zac Brown Band* featuring special guest Brantley Gilbert will take the stage.

The stadium has hosted seven international matches in total – and in 2025 – will add four FIFA Club World Cup matches to its résumé, including two matches featuring Borussia Dortmund, German giants Bayern Munich and more.

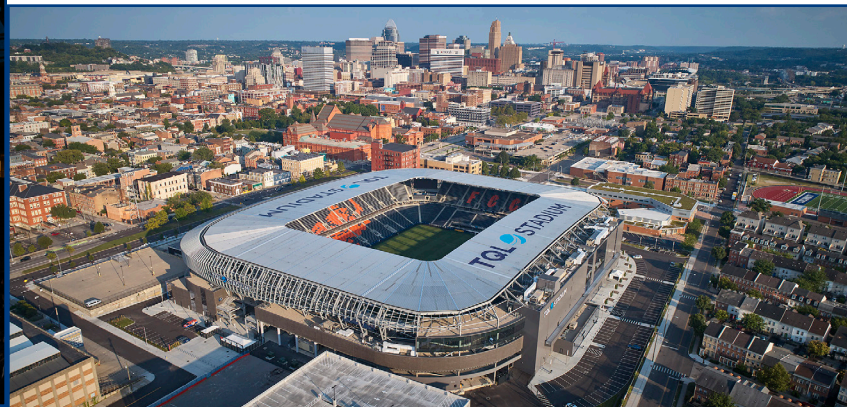

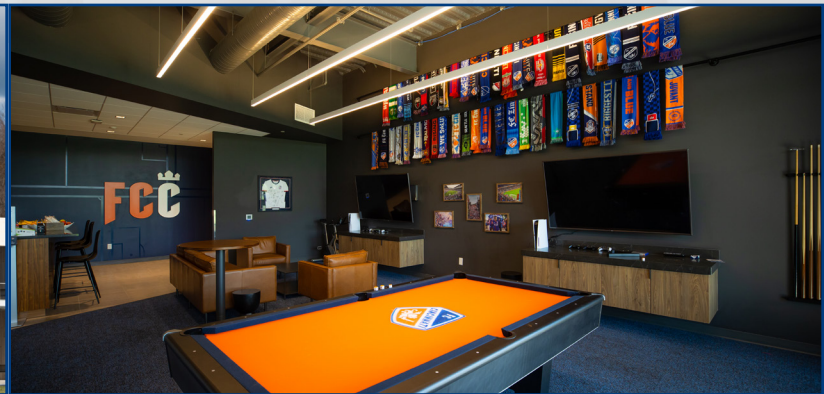




MERCYHEALTH TRAINING CENTER

In 2019, the club opened the state-of-the-art Mercy Health Training Center (MHTC) in Milford, Ohio. Designed by MSA Sport, the \$30 million, 24-acre facility includes three full-size, lighted soccer fields – including two stabilized natural grass surfaces and one synthetic turf surface – as well as a goalkeeper-specific training area. The MLS team is housed in a 30,000 sq. ft., multilevel building abutting the fields, including a separate, 4,000 sq. ft. wing of the building for the FC Cincinnati Academy.

Additionally, there is a 3,000 sq. ft. maintenance facility on the property. In the design process, the MSA Sport design team benchmarked training grounds across the world, including the best in Europe, South America, and Asia. The goal of the design meets the original goal to develop one of the premier and most progressive team facilities in Major League Soccer and North America.
