FC CINCINNATI MATCHUP NOTES

ROAD WARRIORS

FC Cincinnati defeated CF Montréal Wednesday night to earn a co-MLS leading sixth road win of 2025 (Philadelphia Union, Chicago Fire). FC Cincinnati's **24** road wins since the start of 2023 are the most in MLS over that span.

Cincinnati, Orlando City SC and Seattle Sounders FC were the only clubs to win seven road games in both 2023 and 2024 as FC Cincinnati seek to add a seventh road win again in 2025.

HOME STRETCH (LITERALLY)

Following Saturday night, nine of FC Cincinnati's 14 remaining MLS Regular Season matches in 2025 will be played at TQL Stadium.

Saturday marks the third of three-straight road matches for FC Cincinnati, and the conclusion of the club's second three-match road trip this season.

JUNE COOKING

FC Cincinnati's 3-1 win at CF Montréal on Wednesday improved an already strong record. Cincinnati are **11-3-3** in all competitions in June since the start of the 2021 season.

A QUICK START LAST YEAR

Last season in Orlando, FC Cincinnati earned a 1-0 win over the Lions in Central Florida. The lone goal, scored by **Luciano Acosta**, came just 17 seconds in - the fastest goal in FC Cincinnati's MLS history.

UNBEATEN IN CENTRAL FLORIDA UNDER NOONAN

FC Cincinnati are **2-0-1** in three matches in Orlando under Head Coach **Pat Noonan**. The Orange and Blue have held Orlando without a goal on their home field in the past two seasons as well.

SHORT REST KINGS

Historically, FC Cincinnati are strong in matches in quick succession. Under Head Coach **Pat Noonan**, since 2022, FC Cincinnati are **17-8-9** in 34 matches playing a game just three days following another, across all competitions.

TIGHT ONE-GOAL WINS

FC Cincinnati are **9-2** this season in one-goal games - leading MLS - and are **37-10 (.787)** in MLS matches decided by one goal since the start of the 2023 season. The next most wins in such games is **21**, by both Seattle Sounders FC (21-13, .617) and Austin FC (21-20, .512).

THE ALL-STARS

FC Cincinnati midfielder **Evander** and defender **Miles Robinson** were among the 26 players honored Wednesday as Major League Soccer unveiled the complete roster for the 2025 MLS All-Star Game. The 2025 MLS All-Star Game will be played on Wednesday, July 23, and features the MLS All-Stars taking on a team of All-Stars from Liga MX at Q2 Stadium in Austin, Texas. FC Cincinnati have had multiple All-Stars in each of the past four seasons.

THE ALL-STAR SHONE BRIGHT WEDNESDAY

And the recently named All-Star midfielder **Evander** had his strongest scoring output of the season Wednesday night, with three goal contributions (two goals, one assist), the most by an FC Cincinnati player in 2025 and most since July 6, 2024 vs Inter Miami CF (**Acosta**: 1G, 2A).

WITH THE STARS AND STRIPES

FC Cincinnati center back **Miles Robinson** remains with the U.S. Men's National Team for the Concacaf Gold Cup. Robinson and the USMNT advanced out of Group D and will face Costa Rica Sunday in Minneapolis. The center back made two appearances in the group stage.

FC CINCINNATI'S 10-YEAR ANNIVERSARY ON THIS DATE - MITCH SAYS NO

On June 28, 2017, then-USL side FC Cincinnati continued their historic U.S. Open Cup run and advanced past Chicago Fire FC in the Round of 16 in front of 32,287 fans at Nippert Stadium. After a scoreless 120 minutes, goalie **Mitch Hildebrandt** made three saves in the shootout to send FCC to a second 'cupset' win as part of the Open Cup run which gained FCC national and international attention for the authentic support, massive crowds and on-field success.

2025 FC CINCINNATI NOTES AND STORYLINES

10 YEARS OF FC CINCINNATI

It all started on August 12, 2015...

FC Cincinnati became an instant sensation on and off the field, smashing ticket records and gaining national and international following, especially following the club's 2017 U.S. Open Cup run to the semifinals and record-setting, dominant 2018 USL Regular Season.

On May 29, 2018, FC Cincinnati became Major League Soccer's 24th franchise. Since then:

- The club has opened the global award-winning TQL Stadium, launched MLS NEXT Pro squad FC Cincinnati 2 and the FCC Academy.
- Established FC Cincinnati Foundation, aimed to improve the lives of children through the game of soccer and to create an inclusive community.
- Won the 2023 MLS Supporters' Shield along with several MLS individual Awards, qualified for Concacaf Champions Cup for two years in a row; and made the MLS Cup Playoffs for three consecutive years.

This August, FC Cincinnati will host a weekend full of activities in honor of the club's 10th anniversary. Fans and families are invited to help celebrate an incredible decade, featuring a home fixture against Charlotte FC on Sunday, August 10 and bookended with community events providing unique opportunities to support FC Cincinnati Foundation (FCCF), including:



- **Saturday, August 9:** The family-friendly run/walk FCCF
- **Sunday, August 10:** A special alumni match at TQL Stadium following the Charlotte game
- **Monday, August 11:** The club's first annual Celebrity Golf Classic raising funds for the new FCCF scholarship program, supporting students from the West End of Cincinnati attending the University of Cincinnati.

FC Cincinnati have signed **eight** all-time FC Cincinnati Academy products to first-team contracts, seven of whom have appeared in at least one match for FCC. **Gerardo Valenzuela** and **Stefan Chirila**, have both made numerous first team appearances in 2025.

Valenzuela, part of the FCC Academy's inaugural class, has broken on to the scene in 2025, scoring four times thus far.

AN AMBITIOUS CLUB

FC Cincinnati welcomed two new Designated Players in 2025 - **Kévin Denkey** and **Evander**. **Denkey**, the Togolese striker formerly playing for Cercle Brugge in the Belgian Jupiler Pro League, was acquired by FC Cincinnati in November 2024 after a league record transfer fee through 2028 with options for further years. Denkey made over 200 professional appearances in Europe, scoring 78 goals and adding 22 assists.



Evander was acquired in February from the Portland Timbers in the largest cash-for-player trade in league history. He was named a finalist for the 2024 Landon Donovan MLS Most Valuable Player award and was named to the MLS Best XI player. He notched 15 goals and finished tied for the league high with 19 assists, producing 34 goal contributions which was second-most in MLS last season only behind Lionel Messi.

KÉVIN GIVES BACK

On April 26, FCC forward **Kévin Denkey** scored the MLS Goal of the Matchday, a stunning game-winning bicycle kick goal against Sporting Kansas City.

Pat Noonan was hired as FC Cincinnati's Head Coach on December 14, 2021. The former player and longtime assistant coach came to the Queen City following nine years of domestic coaching experience, including the previous four (2018-2021) with Philadelphia Union under two-time Sigi Schmid MLS Coach of the Year Jim Curtin.

In 2024, Noonan's club navigated early schedule congestion with the club's first appearance in the Concacaf Champions Cup, 11 newcomers to the team and four season-ending injuries including to 2023 MLS Defender of the Year Matt Miazga. Despite the obstacles, Noonan's team finished third in the Eastern Conference, fifth in the Supporters' Shield, making Cincinnati one of only two clubs (LAFC) to have finished top-10 in the standings in each of the past three years.

In 2023, Noonan's FC Cincinnati soared to new heights, capturing the club's first trophy since joining MLS, the Supporters' Shield. With 69 points earned, Noonan's club secured the fourth-most points in a single season, ever. His club also featured the 2023 Landon Donovan MLS MVP Luciano Acosta and the 2023 Defender of the Year Matt Miazga.

Noonan was honored with the 2023 Sigi Schmid Coach of the Year. Noonan himself coached under two different MLS Coach of the Year honorees: Jim Curtin (2020, 2022) and Bruce Arena (1997, 2009, 2011, 2021) and he became the 10th former MLS player to take home Sigi Schmid MLS Coach of the Year accolades. He also played under the namesake of the Coach of the Year award – Sigi Schmid – while with the Columbus Crew (2008) and Seattle Sounders FC (2010-11).

Noonan's regular-season win percentage in his first two years as a head coach in MLS – **63.2% (32-14-22)** – was the second-best in league history and his **32** wins in his first two seasons was tied for the third-most ever in the post-shootout era for a coach in their first two seasons. In Noonan's first season in 2022, the Orange and Blue saw record growth on the field. FCC secured club-bests in nearly every statistical category, with 49 points earned, 15 wins and

72 goals in 39 games across all competitions. FCC earned a playoff spot for the first time in club history and advanced to the Eastern Conference Semifinals with a road win in Round One at the New York Red Bulls.

Success shouldn't have come as a surprise for Noonan. **in his 21 seasons in MLS either as a player or a coach, he has guided his club to a berth in the MLS Cup Playoffs in 20 of those seasons.**

Noonan spent four seasons in Philadelphia, appointed in January 2018 to coach alongside Jim Curtin, highlighted by the club's 2020 Supporters' Shield campaign. Before joining the staff in Philadelphia, Noonan served as an assistant coach with Bruce Arena and the USMNT from 2017 until 2018. After his playing retirement in 2013, he joined LA Galaxy's coaching staff under the four-time MLS Coach of the Year Arena.

His playing career began as a two-time All-American at Indiana University. He scored 48 goals in 91 college matches, and he was drafted ninth overall by the New England Revolution in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft. That began a 10-year playing career, where he was runner-up for Rookie of the Year in 2003, and in 2004, he finished in a tie for MLS Scoring Champion. He was named to the MLS All-Star team in 2004 as well. During his playing career, Noonan won MLS Cup twice, once with the Columbus Crew in 2008 and with the LA Galaxy in 2012. He won the Supporters' Shield with the Crew in 2008, and he lifted the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup three times - in 2007 with the Revs, and then in back-to-back seasons with Seattle Sounders FC in 2010 and 2011. Internationally, Noonan earned 15 caps for the USMNT, scoring one goal and winning the 2005 CONCACAF Gold Cup. He ended

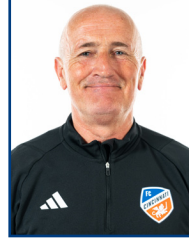
Assistant Coach - Fourth Season

Arena is in his fourth season with the Orange and Blue after four seasons as an assistant with Los Angeles FC. He joined LAFC in 2018 after one year as an assistant with the USMNT, coached by his father Bruce Arena.

He began his professional coaching career in 2014 with the LA Galaxy as an assistant under Bruce, where the Galaxy won an MLS Cup in his first season as an assistant. Prior to joining the coaching ranks in MLS, Arena was an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level with the Virginia Cavaliers, the George Mason Patriots, and the UCLA Bruins.

The Charlottesville, Virginia native played college soccer at UVA from 1999-2002. In that time, he also played for the United States U-20 Men's National Team, including at the 2001 FIFA World Youth Championship. He was selected in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft by the MetroStars, where he played for two seasons before playing his final season of soccer with D.C. United in 2005.

Assistant Coach - Fourth Season

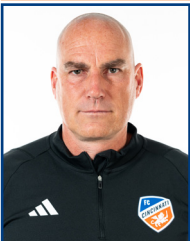

Prior to joining FCC, Kinnear previously spent 2017-20 with LA Galaxy, serving both as an assistant and as Interim Head Coach. Prior to joining the Galaxy, the Glasgow, Scotland native coached in two stints with the San Jose Earthquakes, from 2014-17 and from 2001-05.

As an assistant with the Earthquakes from 2001-03, Kinnear and the Quakes won MLS Cup in 2001 and 2003. As Head Coach in 2005, Kinnear won the Supporters' Shield.

In 2006, Kinnear moved to Houston when the Earthquakes were relocated to Texas and named the Houston Dynamo. The expansion side won back-to-back MLS Cups under Kinnear's leadership in 2006 and 2007, reached the MLS Cup final twice more (2011 and 2012), and the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup semifinals twice (2006 and 2009).

As a player, Kinnear made 243 professional appearances as a defender, playing in Scotland, Mexico, and across the United States. Internationally, he earned 54 caps for the United States Men's National Team, scoring nine goals and winning the 1991 CONCACAF Gold Cup.



PAUL ROGERS

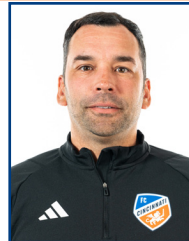
Director of Goalkeeping - Fourth Season

In his fourth season as FC Cincinnati's Director of Goalkeeping, Rogers spent the prior seven seasons with Houston Dynamo FC in the same role, having served under five different head coaches. He took part in the club's 2018 U.S. Open Cup title run when the club shutout Philadelphia Union 3-0 in the final, and in Houston's run to the 2017 Western Conference Finals and the 2019 Concacaf Champions League quarterfinals.

Before his time in Houston, the Brighton, England native spent six seasons with the U.S. Women's National Team as the goalkeeper coach and helped lead the USWNT to a gold medal at the 2012 Olympic Games. Prior to joining the national team, he also assisted as the goalkeeper coach with the Canada Women's National Team, St. Louis Athletica of Women's Professional Soccer in 2009 and 2010, and collegiately with Florida State University, the University of Louisville and Tulane University.

Rogers' playing career began at the youth level with Queens Park Rangers FC and then in college at the University of South Florida. as well as senior playing experience with Brighton & Hove Albion FC.

Páez served as an assistant on FC Cincinnati's interim coaching staff to close the 2021 season before remaining with the club on Noonan's staff. He joined the FC Cincinnati Academy coaching staff in July 2019, and he served as head coach of the Orange and Blue's U-17 squad until stepping in with the first team.

Prior to joining the FC Cincinnati Academy coaching staff, he coached in the Orlando City SC and Monteverde Academy (Fla.) organizations, as well as a stint as Head Coach of Miami United FC of the National Premier Soccer League in 2016.

In his playing career, the Venezuelan international earned 64 caps for his country, scoring six international goals including at the 2007 Copa América. He played professionally for nearly 20 years across Europe, South America and Mexico.

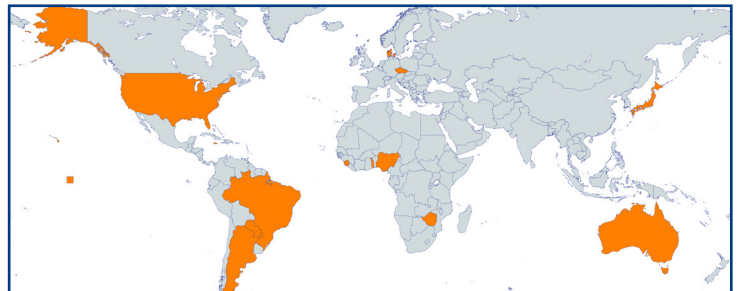

TQL STADIUM

Opened on May 1, 2021, TQL Stadium, home of FC Cincinnati, is one of the most ambitious soccer-specific stadiums in not only North America, but the world. Critically-acclaimed firm Populous designed an innovative and forward-thinking stadium that is one of the largest soccer-specific facilities in Major League Soccer. TQL Stadium has been named Best Venue at the 2022 World Football Summit in Madrid and the 2022 Prix Versailles World Title in the Sports Category in Paris, France.

The closest seats are within 15 feet of the pitch at the \$250 million, privately funded stadium. The design includes 53 traditional suites and 4,500 premium seats throughout four premium club spaces. FCC's supporters' section, The Bailey, has grown to be more than 3,100 strong and loom over opponents at a 34-degree angle at the stadium's north end. A 360-degree canopy roof covers every seat in TQL Stadium, but still allows sufficient sun in to grow a natural grass field.

The stadium has five team locker rooms, including a comprehensive team suite for FC Cincinnati that features a dressing room, coach's office, lounge, equipment storage and the Mercy Health Center of Excellence for the team's medical and game day fitness needs. Within the 18 months of the stadium's completion, TQL Stadium featured both the U.S. Men's and Women's National Teams, including the USMNT's FIFA World Cup Qualification match vs. Mexico, and a concert by legendary rock band, *The Who*, on May 15, 2022. Three more booked concert followed, including Kenny Chesney's Sun Goes Down Tour in 2024.

The stadium has hosted seven international matches in total - and in 2025 - will add four FIFA Club World Cup matches to its résumé, including two matches featuring German giants Borussia Dortmund, Bayern Munich and more.

Since opening in May 2021, including 2025, FC Cincinnati have played in front of 41 sellout crowds at TQL Stadium

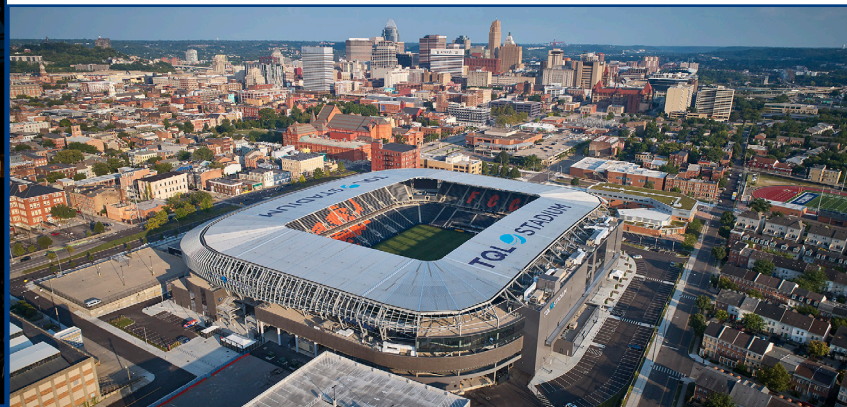

MERCYHEALTH TRAINING CENTER

In 2019, the club opened the state-of-the-art Mercy Health Training Center (MHTC) in Milford, Ohio. Designed by MSA Sport, the \$30 million, 24-acre facility includes three full-size, lighted soccer fields – including two stabilized natural grass surfaces and one synthetic turf surface – as well as a goalkeeper-specific training area. The MLS team is housed in a 30,000 sq. ft., multilevel building abutting the fields, including a separate, 4,000 sq. ft. wing of the building for the FC Cincinnati Academy.

Additionally, there is a 3,000 sq. ft. maintenance facility on the property. In the design process, the MSA Sport design team benchmarked training grounds across the world, including the best in Europe, South America, and Asia. The goal of the design meets the original goal to develop one of the premier and most progressive team facilities in Major League Soccer and North America.

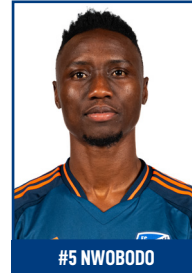

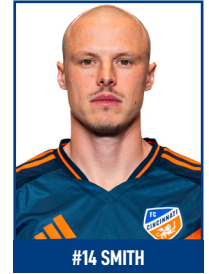

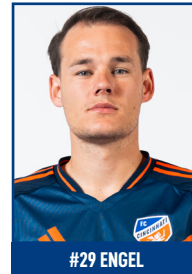
