## Did You Know?

- U-M has four Big Ten Tournament titles (1998\*, 2017, 2018 & 2025)
- U-M is the lowest seed to win the Big Ten Tournament (No. 8 in 2017)
- U-M won four games in four days, twice to win back-to-back titles (2017 & 2018)
  - Iowa is the only other Big Ten team to accomplish this feat (2001, '22)
- U-M is one of six teams to win multiple Big Ten Tournament titles
- U-M is the third team to win back-to-back Big Ten Tournament titles (2017 & 2018)
- U-M holds the record for consecutive Big Ten Tournament wins at 10 (2017-19)
- U-M has earned the No. 1 seed twice (2014 & 2021)
- U-M has earned a single bye 15 times, including 10 straight years (2014-23)
- U-M has earned a double bye three times (2019, 2021, & 2025)

## Run to the 1998 Inaugural Title (NCAA Vacated)

### 1998 Big Ten Tournament (vacated)

In the inaugural Big Ten Tournament, Michigan earned the No. 4 seed and a first-round bye. In its opening half in Chicago, the Wolverines shot 63.0 percent and built a 10-point lead against No. 5 Iowa. With all five starters closing in double figures, including Robert Traylor's 10-point, 16-rebound effort, U-M was able to move on with a 76-66 victory. U-M's red-hot shooting continued in its semifinal win over No. 8 Minnesota. Shooting nearly 54 percent, draining 13 three-pointers and using a second straight game with all five starters in double figures, the Wolverines cruised to the title game with an 85-69 win. After trailing at the half, 33-31, Most Outstanding Player Traylor finished 12-for-16 for 24 points and added 13 rebounds as he guided the Wolverines to a second-half comeback and a 76-67 to capture the first-ever championship. The 1998 result was eventually vacated due to U-M's NCAA Sanctions.

# Run to the Inspirational 2017 Title

## 2017 Big Ten Tournament

In what could have been a near tragedy turned into triumph for Michigan in the 2017 Big Ten Tournament. After U-M's plane crashed off the runway during takeoff heading to Washington, D.C., the Wolverines held a team meeting and elected to travel the next morning to play in the tournament. In what turned out to be a fairy tale story, U-M became the lowest seed (No. 8) and first team to win four games in four days to capture the first of two straight Big Ten titles. After a mad-dash to the arena and wearing practice jerseys, U-M used its early energy as a spark and dominated Illinois with a 20-point victory, 75-55. A driving Zak Irvin layup in overtime helped the Wolverines gain the lead they would never relinquish again as they knocked off a No. 1 seed for a second straight year topping Purdue, 74-70, in the quarterfinal. Building a 10-point lead and shooting over 63 percent in the first half, U-M stymied Minnesota's second-half rally to reach the title game against Wisconsin with an 84-77 victory. After 29 points against the Gophers, Most Outstanding Player Derrick Walton Jr. added 22, with seven assists in the championship, helping the Wolverines bounce back from near disaster to hoisting a title with a 71-56 win over the Badgers.

# Run to Repeat as Champions in 2018

## 2018 Big Ten Tournament

Heading to New York and Madison Square Garden to defend its title, Michigan survived an opening overtime thriller with Iowa to win a second straight Big Ten Tournament title. Winning four games in four days for a second straight year, the Wolverines became the third Big Ten squad to repeat as champions of the conference tournament. Following a first-round bye, Iowa's Jordan Bohannon hit a three-pointer as time expired in regulation, sending the game to overtime. As U-M used the free throw line to outscore the Hawkeyes, who were 1-for-9, the Wolverines escaped with a 77-71 win. Avenging a regular-season loss, Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman went 5-for-5 from deep and U-M had 11 triples as it handled Nebraska, 77-58. In the semifinal, the Maize and Blue knocked off the No. 1 seed for a third straight year as U-M took down rival Michigan State, 75-64 -- Abdur-Rahkman, Moritz Wagner and Zavier Simpson all closed with 15 points. Shooting 50 percent and with 17 points from Wagner -- the Most Outstanding Player -- the Wolverines took home the title for a second straight year with a 75-66 victory over Purdue.

# Indianapolis Run to the 2025 Title

## 2025 Big Ten Tournament

Heading to Indianapolis, losing its last three regular-season games, the Maize and Blue earned the No. 3 seed and a double bye. With a No. 6-seed Purdue quarterfinal match-up, the Wolverines held a four-point lead at halftime. Outscoring Purdue, 46-32, shooting 65.4 percent and holding the Boilermakers to 33.3 percent in the second half, U-M advanced with an 86-68 win. A coast-to-coast, buzzer-beating layup by Tre Donaldson lifted U-M to a dramatic 81-80 semifinal victory over No. 2-seed Maryland. With 5.3 seconds remaining and without a timeout, Donaldson inbounded the ball after a pair of Maryland free throws. Getting it back, he sprinted the ball the length of the floor and made a running left-handed layup off the glass with 0.4 seconds remaining to give U-M a one-point lead. Maryland's inbounds pass was knocked away, securing U-M's thrilling win. In the title game, U-M overcame an 11-point second-half deficit to win the Big Ten Tournament, 59-53, over No. 5-seed Wisconsin. Tied at 53 and with 46 seconds remaining, Vladislav Goldin hit two free throws to give Michigan a 55-53 lead. Stopping the Badgers on their next two possessions, the Wolverines secured the title with free throws. Goldin was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, while Danny Wolf joined him on the All-Tournament team.
