BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Entering Tuesday's action, the Big Ten owns a record of 63-4, the most wins and best win percentage (.940) of any conference in the country. Included in the league's early success is a 51-1 mark on its home courts with an average margin of victory over 21 points.
- Eleven Big Ten teams were recognized in Monday's AP and USA Today Coaches Polls. The AP Top 25 includes No. 1 Purdue, No. 7 Michigan, No. 8 Illinois, No. 17 Michigan State, No. 19 UCLA, and No. 23 Wisconsin. Purdue remains No. 1 in this week's coaches poll, followed by No. 6 Michigan, No. 8 Illinois, No. 20 UCLA, No. 18 Michigan State, No. 21 Wisconsin, and No. 25 Indiana. Iowa, Ohio State, Oregon, and USC also received votes in both polls.
- This week's game schedule features several games against ranked opponents. Tonight, No. 17 Michigan State will face No. 12 Kentucky at 6:30 p.m. in New York City as part of the Champions Classic (ESPN). On Wednesday, the Big Ten will return to Chicago's United Center, as No. 8 Illinois meets No. 11 Alabama at 8 p.m. (FS1). Prior to the game, the Big Ten will unveil the logo for the 2026 Big Ten Tournament, which will also be held at the United Center. On Friday, No. 23 Wisconsin will visit Salt Lake City, where it will face No. 9 BYU. Tip is slated for 4 p.m. (Peacock). With a win over Memphis on Thursday, No. 1 Purdue could face its second ranked foe of the young season, as No. 15 Texas Tech could be the Boilermakers' opponent on Friday at the Baha Mar Championship in the Bahamas.
- On Monday, the Big Ten announced its weekly award winners. Purdue's Braden Smith averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 7.5 assists at Purdue scored a pair of wins. The senior guard scored 29 points, including 21 in the second half, in the Boilermakers' 87-80 win at No. 8 Alabama. Among his points were the game-winning field goal and with 1:00 left to go up 82-80 and a pair of free throws to go up 84-80 on the next possession. Smith performance made him the first player since Oklahoma's Buddy Hield in Jan. 2016 to have at least 29 points, seven rebounds and four assists in a top-10 road win. Smith then recorded his 19th career double-double with 16 points and 10 assists in a win over defending MAC champion and preseason favorite Akron.
- Illinois' David Mirkovic was named Freshman of the Week for the second consecutive week. The freshman averaged 19.0 points and 12.5 rebounds. Mirkovic posted the first 20-point, 20-rebound game by an Illini in 53 years with career highs of 27 points and 21 rebounds in the win over Colgate. His 21 boards also set the Illini freshman single-game rebounding record, breaking the previous mark of 17. Mirkovic also scored in double figures in the win over #11 Texas Tech, finishing with 11 points, four rebounds, two steals, and an assist.
- Milestone Watch... Congratulations to Purdue head coach Matt Painter, who earned his 500th career victory in Sunday's win over Akron. Painter is the 16th active coach to reach the milestone, doing so in the seventh-fewest games... Northwestern head coach Chris Collins stands just two wins shy of 200 for his career.
- Twelve Big Ten players representing 10 schools have been included on the John R. Wooden Award Top 50 Watch List, announced on Tuesday, launching the 50th anniversary season of college basketball's most prestigious individual honor. Indiana's Tucker DeVries, Iowa's Bennett Stirtz, Illinois' Andrej Stojakovic, Michigan's Yaxel Lendeborg, Northwestern's Nick Martinelli, Ohio State's Bruce Thornton, Oregon's Nate Bittle and Jackson Shelstad, Purdue's Trey Kaufman-Renn and Braden Smith, UCLA's Donovan Dent, and Wisconsin's John Blackwell are among the list of 50 student-athletes who are frontrunners for the most prestigious honors in college basketball: the Wooden Award All-American™ and the Wooden Award® Most Outstanding Player.
- The 29th annual TIAA Big Ten Tournament will be played at the United Center in Chicago, March 10th – 15th, 2026. For the first time, all 18 Big Ten teams will compete for the tournament title. The tournament will open with a pair of games on Tuesday, March 10 and culminate with championship on Sunday March 15.
- For the second consecutive year, Purdue's Braden Smith has been named the 2025-26 Big Ten Preseason Player of the Year, as chosen by a select media panel. The reigning Big Ten Player of the Year and consensus First Team All-American, Smith averaged 15.8 points, 8.7 rebounds, and 4.5 rebounds a season ago before being named the recipient of the Bob Cousy Award, given annually to the nation's top point guard by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. In addition to setting a Big Ten record with 175 assists in conference play, Smith became the only player in NCAA history to amass at least 550 points, 300 assists, 150 rebounds, and 75 steals in a season.
- The media panel also selected a 10-member Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Eight of the Big Ten's 18 teams are represented on the team, with Smith the lone unanimous selection. The Purdue guard is joined by teammate Trey Kaufman-Renn, Iowa's Bennett Stirtz, Michigan's Yaxel Lendeborg, Northwestern's Nick Martinelli, Ohio State's Bruce Thornton, Oregon duo Nate Bittle and Jackson Shelstad, UCLA's Donovan Dent, and Wisconsin's John Blackwell.

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span. The Big Ten set a record in 2024-25, winning 14 national championships.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 18 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 105 universities in the nation according to the 2025 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including 11 in the top 40.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 2,000 Academic All-Americans, including 94 honorees during the 2024-25 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct more than \$17 billion in funded research.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span. The Big Ten set a record in 2024-25, winning 14 national championships.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 128 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

Big Ten institutions support more than 14,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Nearly 2,000 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 98 total medals and 27 gold medals during the 17-day competition, surpassing the previous mark of 51 medals at the 2020 Summer Games in Tokyo, Japan. All 18 Big Ten member schools were represented at the 2024 Summer Games, competing for 64 nations in 17 sports.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 9.4 million alumni and nearly 823,000 students.

Big Ten men's and women's basketball combined for 4.9 million fans in their home arenas throughout the 2024-25 season and paced the nation in total attendance. All seven of the Big Ten ice hockey teams also ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance.

In 2024-25, the four most viewed college football games of the season featured Big Ten teams, as did seven of the top 10, and 12 of the top 20. Three broadcast television partners – CBS, FOX and NBC – had at least one Big Ten matchup with more than 9.5 million viewers. Twenty-one Big Ten football games had an audience of more than five million viewers.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, NBC, Peacock, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is carried by all major video distributors across the United States and Canada and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+, the network's subscription streaming services, provides access to more than 2,700 additional events each season.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Twenty years after adding instant replay in 2004, announced a state-of-the-art replay center, featuring 18 dedicated replay bays and six dedicated medical observation stations.

Championed new legislation for football permitting coach-to-player helmet communication and the use of sideline video by student-athletes, and coaches, both of which were introduced in the fall of 2024.

COMMUNITY & IMPACT

The Big Ten Conference Community & Impact team is dedicated to engaging, educating, and empowering student-athletes, coaches, administrators, alumni, and communities across the Big Ten footprint.

By fostering strong community partnerships, the conference has amplified its impact through local school programs and renovations, along with initiatives like Big Impact Reading Week.

Moving forward, the Big Ten is dedicated to go beyond the playing field by providing hands-on experiences that connect student-athletes to meaningful opportunities in journalism, broadcasting, leadership, and service.

Each initiative is designed with intentional community impact in mind—supporting local businesses, uplifting schools, and honoring student-athletes who embody service and leadership through recognitions like the Jackie Robinson Community & Impact Award.
