BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Entering Tuesday's action, the Big Ten owns a nonconference record of 112-28, the best win percentage (.800) and third most wins of any conference in the country. Big Ten teams have defended home court to the tune of a 79-4 mark in nonconference action, winning games by more than 21 points per game. The league also owns nine victories over ranked opponents.
- Eight Big Ten teams have started the season 7-1 or better, tied with the ACC for most of any conference.
- The Big Ten was represented by 11 teams in this week's AP and USA Today Coaches Polls, released on Monday. Michigan leads the at No. 2 in this week's AP poll, followed by No. 6 Purdue, No. 9 Michigan State, No. 13 Illinois, No. 23 Nebraska, and No. 25 UCLA. According to the Coaches Poll, the Wolverines are the best team in the land, climbing to No. 1, with Purdue at No. 6, Michigan State at No. 9, Illinois at No. 13, Nebraska at No. 22, and Iowa at No. 23. Indiana, Ohio State, USC, and Washington also received votes in one or both polls. The Big Ten joins the Big 12 and SEC with six ranked teams each.
- The Big Ten will continue its short run of conference play this week with seven league games on this week's slate. UCLA claimed wins in both of its Big Ten games last week, while Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota, Ohio State, Purdue and Wisconsin also look to improve to 2-0 in the league standings this week. A total of 18 conference games will be played between Dec. 2-13 before conference play breaks until January 2026.
- This week's nonconference schedule includes a pair of contests against top 25 opposition. On Thursday, Iowa will head to Ames, Iowa to face No. 4 Iowa State in the annual Cy-Hawk Series (8 p.m./FS1). Saturday's 11-game schedule culminates in Seattle, as No. 25 UCLA faces No. 8 Gonzaga in the Seattle Hoops Showdown (11:30 p.m./ESPN). Among this week's Big Ten's games, No. 23 Nebraska will look to stay unbeaten as the Huskers visit No. 13 Illinois on Saturday (4 p.m./Peacock).
- On Monday, the Big Ten announced its weekly award winners. Wisconsin's John Blackwell was named Player of the Week after averaging 28.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in a pair of Badgers' wins. The junior guard paired 26 points and a career-best 11 rebounds in an 85-73 win over Northwestern for his first double-double of the season. In a 96-76 win over Marquette, Blackwell posted 30 points, shooting 6-for-12 from three-point range, notching his third 30+ point game of the year.
- Washington's Hannes Steinbach was named Freshman of the Week after returning from a three-game absence with 26.5 points, 13.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game, as the Huskies split a pair of games. For the week, Steinbach connected on 75 percent of his field goal attempts, converted 15-of-18 attempts from the free throw line, and grabbed 11 offensive rebounds over the two games. In an 82-80 loss to UCLA, the freshman shot 11-12 from the floor, posting 29 points and 10 rebounds. Steinbach then recorded 24 points and 16 boards, including 14 points and eight rebounds in the second half, as Washington scored an 84-76 win at No. 24 USC.
- Milestone Watch... Congratulations to Oregon's Jackson Shelstad and Wisconsin's Andrew Rohde, who recorded their 1,000th career points in games last week... Northwestern head coach Chris Collins stands just one win shy of 200 for his career. Collins would join Arthur Lonborg (1927-50) as the only Northwestern coaches with 200 victories.
- Through games on Monday, Dec. 8, the Big Ten boasts 13 teams in the top 75 spots in the NET Rankings, including five in the top 25, and 10 in the top 50. Michigan leads the Big Ten contingent at No. 1, followed by No. 9 Purdue, No. 10 Michigan State, No. 13 Illinois, and No. 23 Nebraska. Iowa, Indiana, USC, Ohio State, and UCLA also claimed spots in the top 50. No other conference in the country has more teams in the top 75 (ACC-13) or the top 50 (ACC, Big 12 - 8 each).
- The Big Ten boasts the two best assist men in the country in Michigan State's Jeremy Fears Jr. and Purdue's Braden Smith. Fears currently leads the nation with 9.8 assists per game and 88 total assists, while Smith ranks second in both categories with 8.8 assists per game and 79 total assists. Three other players from the Big Ten also rank in the top five nationally in other statistical categories. Minnesota's Cade Tyson ranks fourth in scoring at 21.8 points per game and third in free throws (70), while Maryland's Pharrel Payne leads the country with 92 free throw attempts and fifth in free throw makes (66). Iowa's Bennett Stirtz also sees 37:44 of action per game, third in Div. I.
- Eight Big Ten teams enter this week's action ranked in the nation's top 30 in total attendance. Indiana leads the league with 93,422 fans, good for sixth nationally. Michigan State (88,782), Wisconsin (87,806), Illinois (85,621) and Nebraska (84,567) hold spots 8-11, respectively, while Purdue (74,380), Iowa (61,411), and Ohio State (55,796) are included in the top 30. Eight teams also rank in the nation's top 30 in average attendance, with Indiana's 15,570 good for 10th in the country.
- The 29th annual TIAA Big Ten Tournament will be played at the United Center in Chicago, March 10th – 15th, 2026. For the first time, all 18 Big Ten teams will compete for the tournament title. The tournament will open with a pair of games on Tuesday, March 10 and culminate with championship on Sunday March 15.

Postseason Awards

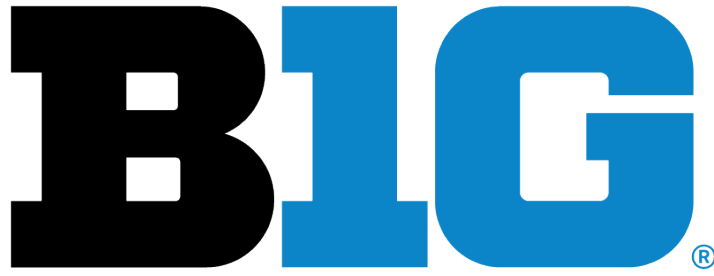

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 18 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 105 universities in the nation according to the 2025 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including 11 in the top 40.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 2,000 Academic All-Americans, including 94 honorees during the 2024-25 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct more than \$17 billion in funded research.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span. The Big Ten set a record in 2024-25, winning 14 national championships.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 128 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

Big Ten institutions support more than 14,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Nearly 2,000 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 98 total medals and 27 gold medals during the 17-day competition, surpassing the previous mark of 51 medals at the 2020 Summer Games in Tokyo, Japan. All 18 Big Ten member schools were represented at the 2024 Summer Games, competing for 64 nations in 17 sports.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 9.4 million alumni and nearly 823,000 students.

Big Ten men's and women's basketball combined for 4.9 million fans in their home arenas throughout the 2024-25 season and paced the nation in total attendance. All seven of the Big Ten ice hockey teams also ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance.

In 2024-25, the four most viewed college football games of the season featured Big Ten teams, as did seven of the top 10, and 12 of the top 20. Three broadcast television partners – CBS, FOX and NBC – had at least one Big Ten matchup with more than 9.5 million viewers. Twenty-one Big Ten football games had an audience of more than five million viewers.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, NBC, Peacock, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is carried by all major video distributors across the United States and Canada and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+, the network's subscription streaming services, provides access to more than 2,700 additional events each season.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Twenty years after adding instant replay in 2004, announced a state-of-the-art replay center, featuring 18 dedicated replay bays and six dedicated medical observation stations.

Championed new legislation for football permitting coach-to-player helmet communication and the use of sideline video by student-athletes, and coaches, both of which were introduced in the fall of 2024.

COMMUNITY & IMPACT

The Big Ten Conference Community & Impact team is dedicated to engaging, educating, and empowering student-athletes, coaches, administrators, alumni, and communities across the Big Ten footprint.

By fostering strong community partnerships, the conference has amplified its impact through local school programs and renovations, along with initiatives like Big Impact Reading Week.

Moving forward, the Big Ten is dedicated to go beyond the playing field by providing hands-on experiences that connect student-athletes to meaningful opportunities in journalism, broadcasting, leadership, and service.

Each initiative is designed with intentional community impact in mind—supporting local businesses, uplifting schools, and honoring student-athletes who embody service and leadership through recognitions like the Jackie Robinson Community & Impact Award.
