### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- After two weeks of conference play, the Big Ten turns its attention to non-conference action until Jan. 2. Michigan, Michigan State, and UCLA opened the league slate at 2-0, with 12 teams set to enter the new year at 1-1 in Big Ten play. This week's schedule includes nine neutral site contests, with two coming against top five opposition on Saturday afternoon, as Purdue faces No. 2 Auburn and Ohio State meets No. 4 Kentucky. Nebraska will also head to Honolulu, Hawaii for the Diamond Head Classic for games on Sunday, Monday, and Christmas Day.
- The B1G enters this week's action having posted an 122-32 (.792) mark in non-conference play, which was the 2nd best winning percentage of any league in the nation. Among those wins, the B1G was 95-6 (.941) on their home courts with a +21.7 PPG average margin of victory. The conference's 122 wins and .792 win percentage are second most of any conference, behind only the SEC (144-20/.878).
- Ten different B1G teams were ranked or received votes in the Associated Press and/or USA Today Coaches Top 25 polls released on Dec. 9th. Oregon leads the way in the media poll at No. 10, followed by No. 16 Purdue, No. 18 UCLA, No. 20 Michigan State, and No. 24 Michigan. The coaches also ranked the Ducks at No. 10, with Purdue at No. 17, UCLA at No. 18, Michigan State at No. 19, and Michigan at No. 20. Illinois, Indiana, Maryland, Penn State, and Wisconsin also received votes in one or both polls.
- Six Big Ten teams were ranked in the top 25 and 11 in the top 50 in the NET Rankings through Monday's games. UCLA was the league's top ranked team at No. 13, followed by No. 14 Illinois, No. 15 Maryland, No. 17 Oregon, No. 21 Michigan State, and No. 25 Michigan. Penn State, Ohio State, Purdue, Wisconsin, and Iowa were also included in the top 50. Only the SEC has more teams in the top 50 (13) than the Big Ten.
- Eleven of the Big Ten's 18 teams rank in the top 50 of the Kenpom Ratings through Monday's games. UCLA leads the way at No. 13, followed by No. 16 Illinois, No. 17 Michigan State, No. 19 Oregon, No. 20 Maryland, No. 21 Purdue, No. 23 Michigan, No. 32 Penn State, No. 35 Wisconsin, No. 36 Ohio State, and No. 45 Iowa. Only the SEC has more teams in the Kenpom Top 50 (13) than the Big Ten.
- On Monday, the Big Ten announced its Player and Freshman of the Week honors. Nebraska's Brice Williams was named Player of the Week, while Illinois' Kasparas Jakucionis and Rutgers' Dylan Harper shared Freshman of the Week honors. Williams set season highs in points (30), field goals (10) and rebounds (six) along with a team-high five assists in Nebraska's 85-68 win over Indiana, becoming the only the second Husker in the Big Ten era (2011-12 to present) to have a game with at least 30 points and five assists. The senior scored nine of his 30 points in the final 6:30 after Indiana closed to within 68-67. The 30 points marked Williams' career-high at Nebraska and the first time a Husker scored 30-or-more points against Indiana. Williams was also named one of five US Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week.
- Jakucionis averaged 23.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 3.5 assists against a pair of top-20 teams. The rookie led the Illini to an 86-80 victory over No. 20 Wisconsin, scoring a career- and game-high 24 points before tallying a team-high 22 points in a 66-64 loss to No. 1 Tennessee. Harper claimed his third Freshman of the Week honor after averaging 24 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists as the Scarlet Knights scored a pair of wins. Harper posted his first career double-double with 24 points and a career-high 12 rebounds in an 80-76 win over Penn State, then added 24 points, including the game-winning three pointer at the buzzer, to top Seton Hall 66-63.
- Penn State's Ace Baldwin recorded a program-record 16 assists in the Nittany Lions' 99-51 win over Coppin State on Saturday, besting the previous school record of 15 that was set by Tom Doaty on Jan. 29, 1975 (vs. Syracuse). Baldwin now owns 714 career dimes and is one of just two active players with more than 700 career assists, joining Dajuan Harris Jr. of Kansas (734).
- The nation's top ranked scoring defense was on display on Saturday, as UCLA held Arizona to just five points, including one field goal over the game's final 10:49, en route to a 57-54 win at the Footprint Center in Phoenix. The Bruins closed the game on a 19-5 over that span to claim the victory.
- The 2025 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament will return to Gainbridge Fieldhouse on March 12-16. This will mark the 14th time the tournament has been held in Indianapolis. The tournament will be the first to feature a 15-team field and begin with three games on Wednesday, March 12. Peacock will televise the opening three games of the 2025 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament, with second-round and quarterfinal games on Thursday and Friday slated for Big Ten Network. For the 28th consecutive year, CBS Sports will broadcast the semifinals and championship game on CBS, with those games also streaming live on Paramount+.

**2025 BIG TEN MEN'S BASKETBALL TIEBREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING**

**Tiebreaker Procedures for Tournament Seeding**

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 15 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runnerup the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular-season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tiebreaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

**A. Ties Involving Two Teams:**

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
  - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
  - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET rankings that are released on the last Friday of the regular season will be utilized.

**B. Ties Involving more than Two Teams:**

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
  - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage head-to-head among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. Ties shall be considered separated when a team(s) emerges from the top, middle or bottom of the group and is awarded a seed(s).
  - b. Once a seed is awarded, all remaining tied teams shall restart the tiebreak process at the first criteria (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step a (head-to-head) and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
  - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
  - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET rankings that are released on the last Friday of the regular season will be utilized.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

### PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 18 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 90 universities in the nation according to the 2024 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including 10 in the top 40.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 80 honorees during the 2023-24 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$17 billion in funded research.

### A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 26 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 119 team national championships in 26 different sports.

### BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

Big Ten institutions support more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Nearly 2,000 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 98 total medals and 27 gold medals during the 17-day competition, surpassing the previous mark of 51 medals at the 2020 Summer Games in Tokyo, Japan. All 18 Big Ten member schools were represented at the 2024 Summer Games, competing for 64 nations in 17 sports.

### PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 9.4 million alumni and nearly 823,000 students.

Big Ten men's and women's basketball combined for 4.3 million fans in their home arenas throughout the 2023-24 season and paced the nation in total attendance. Volleyball Day in Nebraska attracted 92,003 fans, the largest attendance in women's sports history. All seven of the Big Ten ice hockey teams also ranked in the top 15 nationally in average attendance.

In 2023-24, Big Ten women's basketball programs set ratings records on seven different networks – BTN, FOX, FS1, NBC, Peacock, ESPN and CBS.

### LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Twenty years after adding instant replay in 2004, announced a state-of-the-art replay center, featuring 18 dedicated replay bays and six dedicated medical observation stations.

Championed new legislation for football permitting coach-to-player helmet communication and the use of sideline video by student-athletes, and coaches, both of which were introduced in the fall of 2024.

### EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, NBC, Peacock, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN reaches nearly 50 million homes and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams more than 2,000 additional events each season.

### COMMUNITY & IMPACT

The Big Ten Conference is dedicated to making a lasting impact on the communities where its major events are held. In recent years, the conference has hosted sports clinics, renovated recreation centers and given elementary-aged children the chance to experience major Big Ten events.

Around the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference focuses on creating meaningful improvements, aiming to leave each location better than it was found.

Moving forward, the Big Ten will continue to collaborate with the College Football Playoff Foundation, local sports organizations and school district foundations to enhance spaces for teachers and children and provide educational opportunities for youth.
