# QUBEIN CENTER FACTS

---



- Opened in September 2021 and a project cost of \$170 million
- The Qubein Center consists of the Arena (4,500 capacity), Conference Center (2,500 capacity) and Kahn Hotel (30 rooms)
- 350,000 square feet
- Largest collegiate video board in the state of North Carolina
- Quince Imaging floor projection system
- Daktronics Halo and LED Ribbon Boards
- Club Level consisting of 9 Box Suites, 4 Loge Premium Boxes, and a Club Lounge
- David & Amy Smith Courtside Hospitality Suite
- Basketball Practice Courts, Offices, Locker Rooms, Strength & Conditioning and Sports Medicine Facility

# DIRECTIONS TO HIGH POINT, NC

---

**From the North.** Travel south on I-85.

**Option 1:** At Greensboro, when I-85 South and I-40 West split, take I-85 South. Shortly thereafter, take Business 85 (Green Shield). Take the S. Main Street/High Point exit and turn right onto Main Street. Turn right onto College Drive. Turn left onto Lexington. Make first left into the campus on Panther Drive.

**Option 2:** At Greensboro, when I-85 South and I-40 West split, take I-40 West. When you see the airport signs, take Highway 68 South. Follow directions **From the Airport** below.

**Or...**Follow I-77 South to Fancy Gap, Va. To I-74 east to US 52 South. Take US 52 South to Winston-Salem. Take I-40 East to Highway 311 South (Exit 196). At High Point, take the N. Main Street exit (Exit 65). Turn left onto Hartley Drive (at Wal-Mart/Chick-fil-a). Hartley Drive becomes College Drive at Oak Hollow Mall. Continue and turn right onto Lexington. Make first left into campus on Panther Drive.

**From the Airport [Piedmont Triad/Greensboro-High Point].** Take 68 South to Oak Hollow Mall in High Point. At the mall, turn left onto College Drive. Turn right onto Lexington. Make first left into the campus on Panther Drive.

**From the South.** Travel north on I-85. Near Lexington, take Business 85 North (Green Shield).; When Business 85 North and US 52 split, remain on Business 85. Take the S. Main Street/Archdale Exit and turn left. Turn right onto College Drive. Turn left onto Lexington. Make first left into campus on Panther Drive.

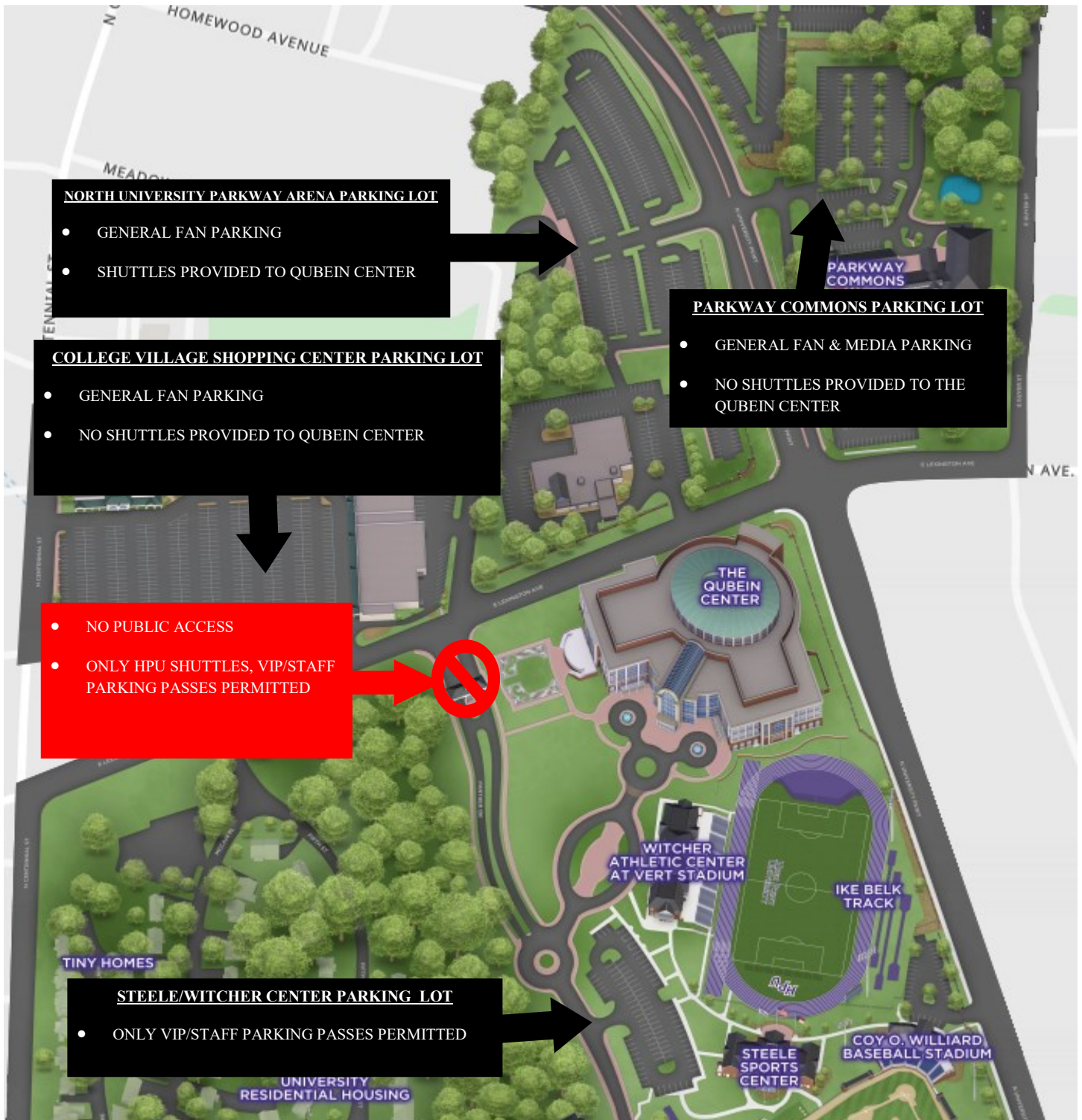
**From the West.** Travel east on I-40 past Winston-Salem to Highway 311 South (Exit 196). At High Point, take N. Main Street exit (Exit 65). Turn left onto Hartley Drive (at Wal-mart/Chick-fil-a). Hartley Drive becomes College Drive at Oak Hollow Mall. Continue and turn right onto Lexington. Make first left into campus on Panther Drive.

**From the East.** Take I-40 West. At Greensboro, follow directions **From the North [Option 1 or Option 2]**.

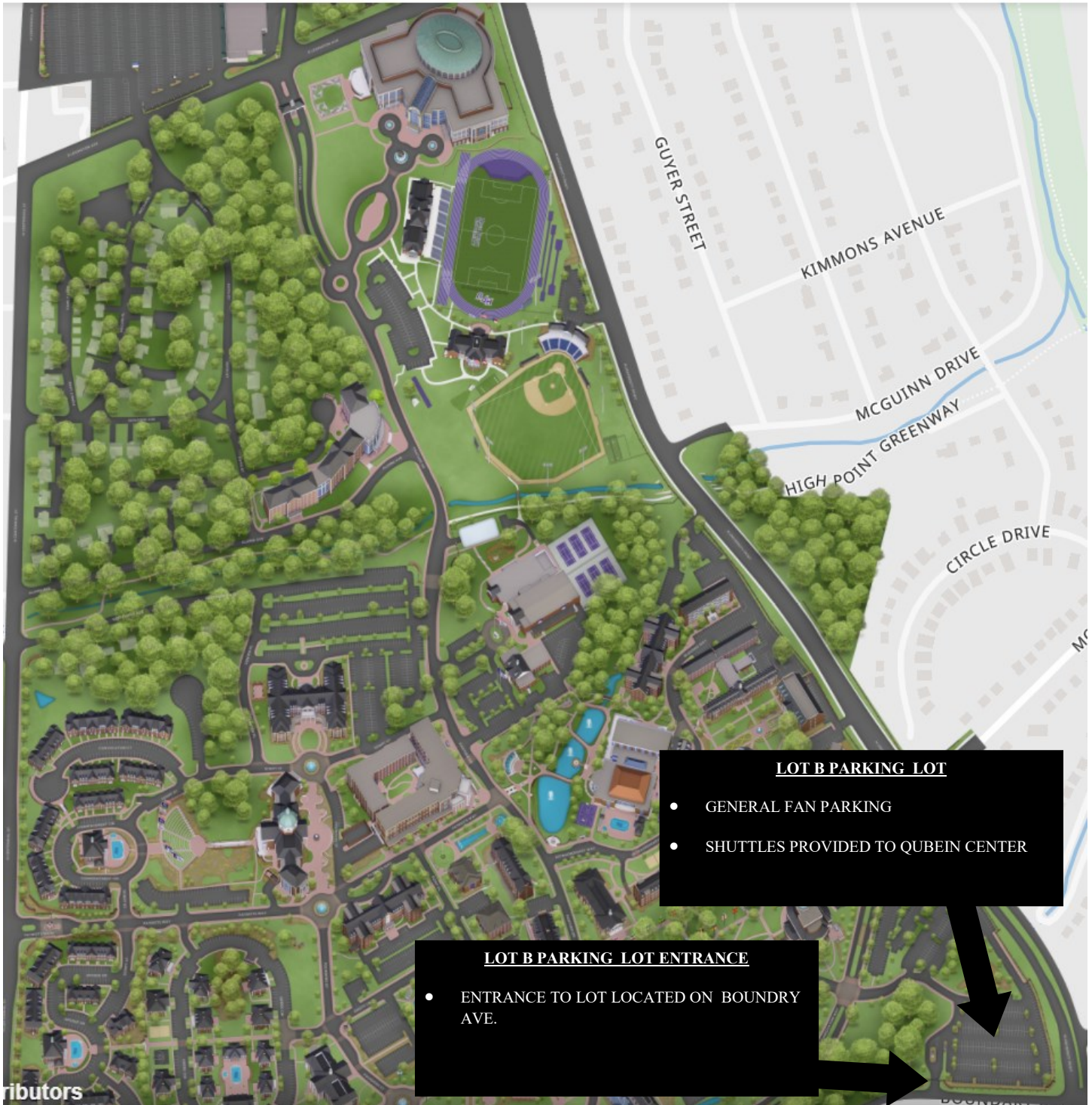
# PARKING MAP

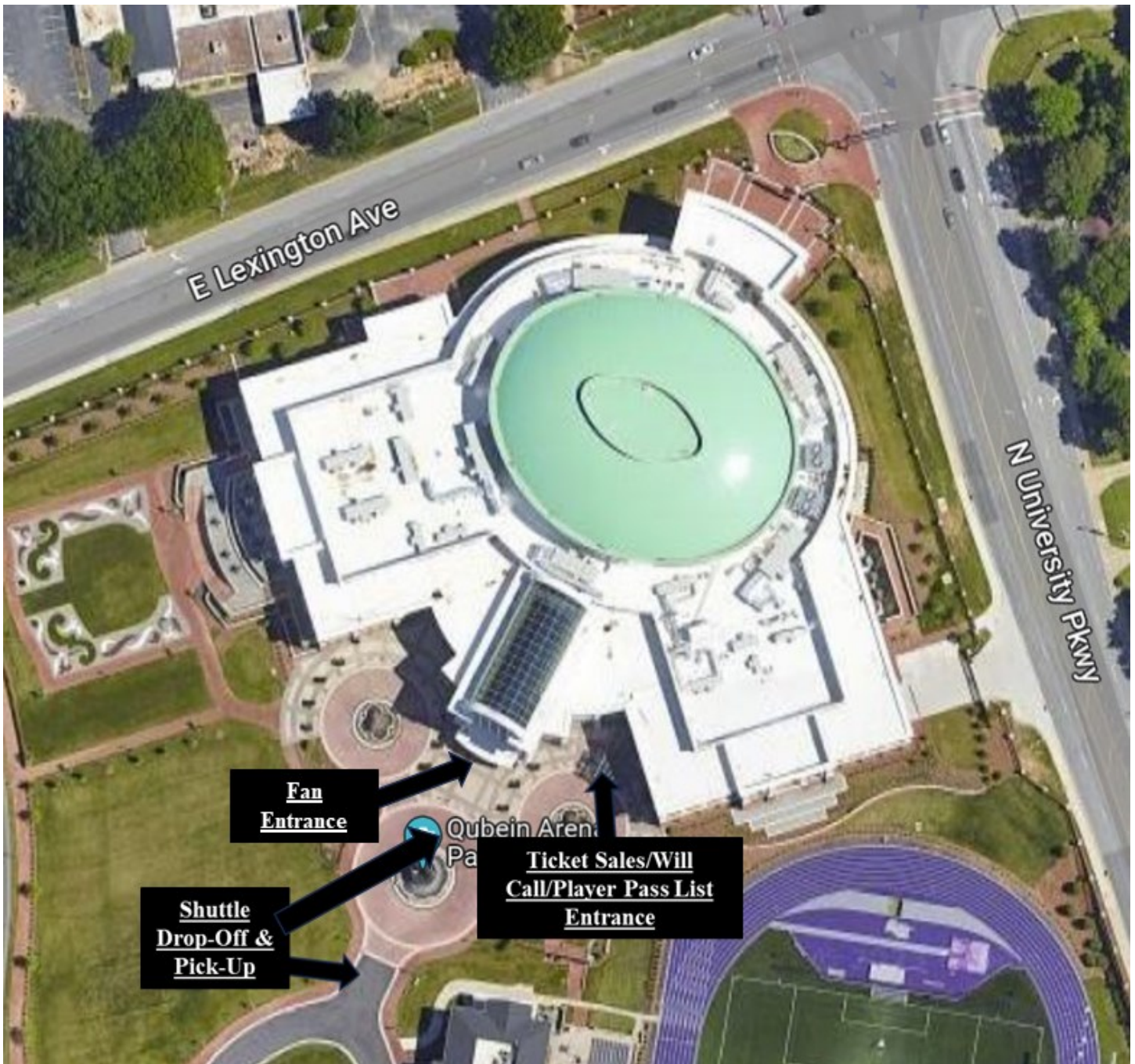


# PARKING MAP

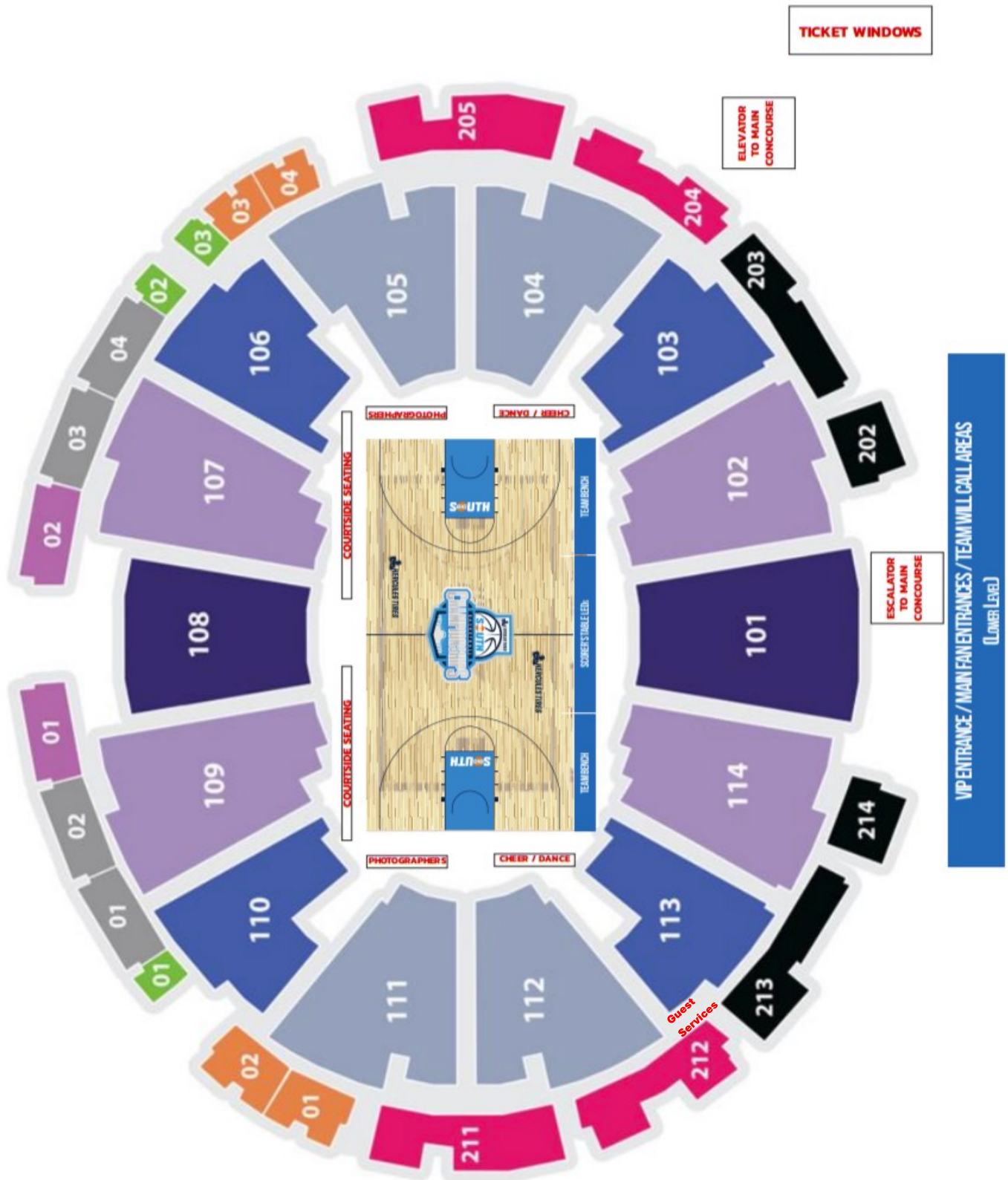
Fans are asked to park in the College Village Shopping Center, North University Parkway, and Parkway Commons Parking Lots first and use Lot B as overflow parking.

## TICKET INFORMATION

---

- Tickets for the 2024 Hercules Tires Big South Basketball Championships hosted by High Point University are now on sale, and can be purchased through the Qubein Center ticket office and at [bigsouthsports.com](http://bigsouthsports.com)
- All tickets will be reserved seating. Full Tournament ticket books (courtside seating and reserved seating), single-session tickets and group packages can be purchased at [bigsouthsports.com](http://bigsouthsports.com).
- Doors will open 60 minutes prior to all games expect championship games, which will open 90 minutes.
- Every seat is numbered and ticketed within the Qubein Center. All sections run right to left 101-114 and 202-213 (counter-clockwise), with seat #1 being the leftmost seat of every section.
  - Courtside Seating = \$650 (all 16 games, 9 sessions)
  - Women's Courtside Seats = \$350 (all 8 women's games, 5 sessions)
  - Men's Courtside Seats = \$350 (all 8 men's games, 5 sessions)
  - Reserved Seating = \$160 (all 16 games, 9 sessions)
  - Women's Reserved Seating = \$80 (all 8 women's games, 5 sessions)
  - Men's Reserved Seating = \$80 (all 8 men's games, 5 sessions)
  - SINGLE-SESSION TICKETS (on sale Feb. 5)
    - Courtside = \$75
    - Reserved = \$20
    - Students = \$5 (with valid Big South student ID - sold on game days only)
    - Group Tickets (15+) - \$15 per ticket

## PARKING/SHUTTLE INFORMATION

---

General fan parking is located in the North University Parkway Lot, College Village Shopping Center Parking Lot, Parkway Commons Parking Lot, and Lot B.

High Point University shuttles will provide transportation to and from the North University Parkway Lot and Lot B.

## ARENA INFORMATION

---

- There will be full concession stands located throughout the concourse and suite level. Concession Stands are located at sections 104, 106, 110, 111, 205, & 211. The concession stand will take both cash and credit/debit cards.
- Restrooms are located throughout the concourse and suite level. Women's Restrooms are located at sections 103, 107, 109, 112, 114, 205, & 211. Men's Restrooms are located at sections 103, 105, 113, 205, & 211. Family Restrooms are located in the vestibule of section 102-103 & 105-106.
- There is a first aid room located on the concourse across from section 104. Basic first aid supplies will be located in this room and will be staffed by emergency medical technicians (EMT).
- Guest Services can be found behind section 113. All lost and found will need to be given to HPU Security with all relevant information of where it was found and when it was found. Any items found will be taken

## CLEAR BAG POLICY

---

High Point University permits only clear bags for all athletic events. All other bags that are not clear will be searched before entry to the athletic event

## PETS/SERVICE ANIMALS

---

Service animals covered under Title II and Title III of the ADA are allowed in the Qubein Center. All other animals will not be permitted to enter the Qubein Center, this includes emotional support animals.

## METAL DETECTOR POLICY

---

All fans in attendance will be required to walk through metal detectors prior to entry of the Qubein Center. We ask all non-permitted items are left outside facility prior to entry and that you please communicate this policy to your fans and families.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

---

The following Items are prohibited in the Qubein Center:

- All Outside Food or Drink
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Pets (except service animals)
- Glass Containers
- Tobacco Products
- Illegal Drugs
- Artificial Noisemakers (i.e. air horns, megaphones)

# ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

---



Celebrating its 40th anniversary in 2023-24, the Big South Conference has been an exemplary leader in college athletics, dedicated to developing student-athletes through the pursuit of excellence in the classroom, community and field of play. The league's growing presence as an NCAA Division I athletic conference is made evident by its multitude of athletic accomplishments, innovative marketing and media partnerships, increased television packages and most importantly, its commitment to fostering the academic, personal, social, athletic and leadership development of its student-athletes. Comprised of nine member institutions sharing a common geographic region and similar academic values and purposes, the Big South's remarkable history of achievement is characterized by the league's 19 championship sports and the profound academic and life successes of its more than 3,400 student-athletes. This has evolved into the conference's "Where Winners Are Made" mantra as part of a strategic emphasis on becoming the premiere non-FBS conference in the Southeast through its six Core Values of Academic Centrality; Athletic Excellence; Equity, Diversity & Inclusion; Integrity; Sportsmanship & Fair Play; and Student-Athlete Welfare.

The Big South Conference has experienced numerous athletic and academic accomplishments since its founding in 1983, including the following in the last 20 years:

- NCAA Baseball National Champion in 2016
- Nine individual National Champions
- Two top 10 finishes in the NCAA Men's Golf Championship -- including fifth in 2007
- The No. 1 ranked team in the national polls in 2014 and 2015 (football)
- Reached the quarterfinals of the FCS Playoffs five times in a six-season span from 2013-18
- Multiple teams in the FCS playoffs five times since 2012
- Reached the NCAA "Sweet 16" in men's soccer, women's basketball, baseball and women's lacrosse
- Four NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament wins
- Reached the NCAA Softball Regional Championship game five times
- Three Top 24 finishes in the NCAA Women's Golf Championship since 2011
- The No. 1 seed in the NCAA Baseball Regionals four times, including the national No. 4 seed in 2010
- Three berths in the NCAA Baseball Super Regionals
- Multiple teams in the NCAA Baseball Regionals nine times
- Qualified three teams for NCAA postseason play in the same sport for the first time in 2016 (men's soccer, men's golf)
- Multiple postseason berths in at least four sports for five straight years from 2014-18
- First-ever appearance in the quarterfinals of the NCAA Women's Tennis Doubles Championship
- Appearances in the round of 32 in the NCAA Men's Singles Championship
- First All-Americans in men's and women's cross country, and men's tennis
- No. 1-ranked collegiate men's golfer (Dustin Johnson, 2007) and men's tennis doubles team (Henry Patten & Oli Nolan, 2019)
- The first-ever national finalist for NCAA Woman of the Year
- A Big South-record 45 All-Americans in 2021-22
- A Big South-record 13 Academic All-Americans in 2003-04 and 2013-14
- A Big South-record 32 NCAA Public Recognition Awards for APR Success in 2019 and 2020
- A Big South-record 90 percent Graduation Success Rate in 2021 – sixth consecutive year at or above 85 percent
