## GOVERNORS NOTABLY


**Corey Gipson** returns for his second year as the Austin Peay head basketball coach. During his first season leading his alma mater, Gipson led the Governors to 19 wins and a trip to the 2024 Atlantic Sun Conference Championship game. The postseason run marked the Govs' first as a member of the conference, while the 10-win improvement marked the second-best turnaround in the Governors Division I Era. The 19 victories also were tied for the most by a head coach in their first season. Gipson's coaching staff features a pair of returners in associate head coach **Rodney Hamilton** and assistant coach/recruiting coordinator, **Tim Ward**. Gipson also made a pair of hires over the offseason in assistant coach **Dewayne Jackson** and Austin Peay alum and former director of basketball operations, **Dugan Lyne**. Additional offseason hires and promotions on the staff include **Matthew Morgan** as the program's Director of Player Development and the promotion of **Travis Allen** to Director of Basketball Operations. Allen previously was the special assistant to the head coach during the 2023-24 campaign.

The Governors return six players from the 2023-24 season. The group is highlighted by 2024 ASUN Sixth Man of the Year, **Sai Witt**. Witt averaged 12.8 points and 5.6 rebounds per game during his first season in Clarksville while shooting 53.6% from the field.

Other regular starters from last season's group returning this season include **Isaac Haney**, who started 18 games across his 23 appearances, while averaging 11.7 points per game. Clarksville native and grandson of Dave Loos - the winningest head coach in Austin Peay and OVC history - **Daniel Loos** returns to the Govs' frontcourt after starting in 12-of-30 games a season ago, in which he made 60.0% of his attempts from the field.

Fan-favorite **Hansel Enmanuel** and his "Dominican Dunks" (per Voice of the Govs, Brian Rives) returns to Clarksville after appearing in 30 games a season ago. The highlight-reel regular led the team with a 67.5 field-goal percentage and finished second on the team with 24 blocks and 35 offensive rebounds.

A mid-season freshman addition, **JaVar Daniel** prepares for his sophomore season after appearing in eight games and making four starts a season ago. Redshirt junior guard **Anton Brookshire** also looks for an increased role this season after redshirting in 2023-24.



The 2024-25 Governors' roster features a trio of freshman additions in **Tate McCubbin**, **Terrell Gaines**, and **Bowen Hammer**. McCubbin was a two-time All-State selection at Battle High School, while Gaines finished his prep career as the all-time scoring leading in Liberty High School history with over 2,300 career points. Hammer is the newest addition to the team, having joined the team Sept. 2 following a stellar career at Fairmont Prep Academy in which he averaged 25.0 points and 10.0 rebounds as a senior.

A familiar pipeline for the Governors over the past two seasons, two of Gipson's six veteran newcomers, **Tekao Carpenter** and **Akili Evans**, come by way of Moberly Area Community College. Carpenter was a 2023-24 NJCAA Division I Third Team All-American for the Greyhounds after averaging 13.6 points and 3.6 rebounds per game with 22 double-figure scoring performances and 11 20-point outings during his sophomore season. Evans averaged 10.6 points and 6.3 rebounds across 27 games during his redshirt sophomore season, while scoring in double figures 13 times with a trio of 20-point outings.

A North Carolina State transfer who played 42 games for the Wolfpack over the last two seasons, **LJ Thomas** comes to Clarksville for his junior season. A former four-star recruit out of Bull City Prep, Thomas made his collegiate debut against the Govs in Nov. 2022.

A 2023-24 Third Team All-South Atlantic Conference selection out of Lincoln Memorial, **Me'Kell Burries** spent the last five seasons with the Railsplitters, where he made 113 starts. After redshirting during his freshman season, Burries went on to average 11.1 points per game across 105 appearances for LUM.

**Darius Dawson** comes to Clarksville after spending last season at Missouri Southern, where he was a Second Team All-MIAA selection after averaging 14.0 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 11 blocks per game. The Sumter, South Carolina native scored 20-plus points six times, while shooting 53.9% from the field and 43.4 from three-point range.

A 2023-24 NAIA National Champion and First Team All-American by way of Freed-Hardeman, **Quan Lax** was a three-time Mid-South Conference Champion in as many years for the Lions. He led the MSC with 123 assists as a redshirt sophomore, with his 2.08 assist-turnover ratio and dropping at least six dimes seven times last season. He also shot 50.2% from the field and tallied a career-best 49 steals on the defensive end.

**Haney Named to ASUN Winter Winners for Life Team - June 5, 2024**

Isaac Haney was named to the 2023-24 Atlantic Sun Conference Winter Winners for Life Team.

The ASUN Winners For Life teams are composed of one student-athlete from each of the conference's 14 institutions who displays excellence on and off the playing surface.

Off the court, Haney has logged countless hours giving back to the Clarksville and Montgomery County communities in ways such as: reading stories and speaking at numerous local elementary and middle schools around Clarksville, coaching participants in the Buddy Ball program, painting pumpkins in the fall which were used to raise money for local nonprofit organizations assisting with breast cancer research. He also participated in "Peayple in the Community" which organized toys for children of all ages to be given to families for Christmas, welcoming fans to the new F&M Bank Arena Grand Opening, assisting in Manna Café by helping to bag non-perishable food items to be given to families in need, and much more.

**Gipson Announces Eight-Man Signing Class for 2024-25 Season - June 10, 2024**

The 2024-25 Austin Peay basketball roster has been established.

The 94th roster in program history welcomes six veteran newcomers and a pair of freshmen to Clarksville ahead of the Governors' upcoming campaign.

The six veteran newcomers have combined for 17 seasons, 418 career games played, 303 starts, 4,764 points, 1,795 rebounds, 796 assists, and 8,558 career minutes across their careers, which span across the Division I, Division II, and JUCO ranks of collegiate basket-

ball.

**Gipson Announces Three Additions to Coaching and Support Staff, Promotes Allen - June 25, 2024**

Austin Peay head basketball coach Corey Gipson announced the additions of Dewayne Jackson and two-time Austin Peay graduate Dugan Lyne to his coaching staff, while also adding Matthew Morgan as the Governors' director of player development. Additionally, Gipson promoted Travis Allen to director of basketball operations.

Lyne and Jackson come to Clarksville as assistant coaches after successful coaching careers across different levels of collegiate basketball, while Morgan joins the staff after spending last year as an assistant coach at Link Year Regional Prep. Travis enters his second season at Austin Peay and now takes the position of Director of Basketball Operations after previously serving as the special assistant to the head coach.

**Austin Peay, Gipson Agree on Contract Extension Through 2027-28 - July 10, 2024**

After orchestrating the greatest turnaround in the Atlantic Sun Conference and program history, while also leading the program to its first ASUN Conference Championship appearance, Austin Peay head basketball coach Corey Gipson has agreed to a contract extension through the 2027-28 season, Austin Peay Vice President and Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison announced.

With Gipson at the helm, the Governors earned 19 wins and a trip to the 2024 Atlantic Sun Conference Championship in their first postseason run as a member of the ASUN. The 10-win improvement from before Gipson's arrival was the best in the league and the second-best in the Governors' Division I Era – which dates back to 1963. The 19 wins also are tied for the most by a head coach in their first season.



**Dawson’s Ferocious Second Half Leads to First International win in 12 years- August 8, 2024**

Austin Peay’s basketball senior Darius Dawson scored 17 second-half points in a 21-point effort, as the Governors earned their first win outside the United States since 2012 in a 74-58 victory against Barcelona Team Select 2.

The international win is Austin Peay’s first since the 2012 Canadian Exhibition Tour Presented by Basketball Travelers Inc., in which the Govs won 2-of-3 games in Toronto in Aug. 2012.

**Six Reach Double Figures in Wire-to-Wire Win in Madrid - Aug. 10, 2024**

Led by LJ Thomas’ 16 points, six Austin Peay student-athletes reached double figures, as the Governors concluded their Spain International Tour with a 90-77 wire-to-wire victory against the Madrid Select Team at the Comunidad de Madrid.

Thomas was followed in scoring by double-figure scorers Akili Evans and Darius Dawson (13 points), Hansel Enmanuel and Anton Brookshire (12 points), and Quan Lax (10 points).

**Men’s Basketball Travel Log - Aug. 4-12, 2024**

**Gipson Finalized 2024-25 Roster with Freshman Addition, Bowen Hammer - Sept. 2, 2024**

The final piece of the Austin Peay State University basketball roster has been added, as head coach Corey Gipson announced the addition of freshman Bowen Hammer to the Governors’ roster head of the 2024-25 season.

Hammer comes to Clarksville from Fairmont Prep Academy where he averaged 25.0 points and 10.0 rebounds for head coach Joedy Gardner.

**Basketball Announces 13-Game Nonconference Schedule - Sept. 20, 2024**

Austin Peay head basketball coach Corey Gipson has announced the Governors’ 2024-25 nonconference schedule featuring four home games on Gary Mathews Court at F&M Bank Arena, a pair of Power Four foes, and the multiple historic rivalries.

**Basketball Returns to the Hardwood for First Day of Team Practice - Sept. 23, 2024**

With tipoff of the 2024-25 season just 42 days away, the APSU basketball team returned to the hardwood for the first day of practice, Sept. 23, at the F&M Bank Arena Practice Facility.

This preseason is unlike many others over the past decade, with the team playing just a month and a half ago as part of its 2024 International Tour in Spain. 

Corey Gipson enters his second year at the helm of his alma mater after being named the 14th Austin Peay head basketball coach, March 2023.

Gipson led the Governors to 19 wins and a trip to the 2024 Atlantic Sun Conference Championship in the Governors' first postseason run as a member of the ASUN during his inaugural season back in Clarksville.

A two-time Austin Peay graduate who won three Ohio Valley Conference titles during his two seasons as a playing for the Governors (2002-04) and worked as an assistant coach for Dave Loos for three seasons (2012-15).

During his first season back in Clarksville, Gipson orchestrated the greatest turnaround in the Atlantic Sun Conference and the second-best in the Governors' Division I Era – dating back to 1963 – after leading Austin Peay to a 10-win improvement with a 19-16 mark in 2023-24 season. The 19 wins also are tied for the most by a head coach in their first season.

Gipson brought an NCAA-best 13 newcomers to Clarksville during the 2023-24 season, including six from Northwestern State, where he served as head coach during the previous year.

The 13 newcomers were highlighted by DeMarcus Sharp's historic season in Clarksville, as the point guard became the first player in program history to earn All-ASUN honors – and the 100th overall all-conference selection in program history – with his Third Team All-ASUN recognition, in addition he was a ASUN Championship All-Tournament Team honoree and earned a league-best four ASUN Newcomer of the Week selections.

The Governors broke the single-season marks in three-pointers made (277) and attempted (768) during his first season, with the perimeter barrage being led by another newcomer from Northwestern State. Ja'Monta Black. During his lone season in Clarksville, Black broke Austin Peay's single-season records in three-pointers made (113) and attempted (286), as well as minutes played (1,251). Black's 113 triples tied for fourth in the NCAA, as the graduate student guard finished his college career 30th all-time in Division I history with 393 career triples.

During that 2023-24 season, Sai Witt also became the first Governor to earn ASUN Sixth Man of the Year honors, while Dezi Jones joined Sharp as an ASUN Championship All-Tournament selection.

Gipson was the head coach at Northwestern State during the 2022-23 season. In his head coaching debut, Gipson turned around a Demons program that won nine games the year prior his arrival. He led the Demons to a 22-9 record, a win at then-No. 15 TCU, and a No. 2 seed in the Southland Conference Tournament.

In his lone year at Northwestern State, Gipson is a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award, which is presented annually to the nation's top Division I minority coach. He also is a finalist for the Hugh Durham Coach of the Year Award, which is annually given to the top DI mid-major head coach, and the Joe B. Hall Award, which is annually presented to the top first-time head coach at the DI level.

Gipson led the Demons to their first 20-win season in a decade and became the first coach in program history to win 20 games during their debut season. Gipson's 64-63 win at TCU, Nov. 14, also was the program's first win against an Associated Press Top 25 team since the 2006 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

Gipson's squad made its mark on the defensive end during the 2022-23 season, leading the Southland in scoring defense (72.1 ppg). The Demons ranked 37th in the NCAA in steals per game (8.3) and turnovers forced per game (14.8) – ranking fourth in the Southland in both categories. Northwestern State also took care of the basketball better than any team in the Southland, leading the league in fewest turnovers per game (11.9) while ranking second in the conference and 34th in Division I in turnover margin (+2.9).

### Career Recap: Austin Peay

#### 2023-24

Became eligible to play due to the NCAA's new ruling of the multi-time transfer rule in mid-December, appearing in 23 games, and making all 18 of his starts to end the season... Averaged 11.7 points, 4.1 rebounds and 77.2 percent from the free throw line... After having his Austin Peay debut cut short due to a lower-body injury against Western Kentucky (Dec. 16), scored 14 points and grabbed five rebounds in a 26-minute outing against Ohio (Dec. 22) off the bench... Scored 13 points in both the Governors' first two games of ASUN Conference play against Bellarmine (Jan. 4) and Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 6), averaging three rebounds and 2.5 three-pointers per night across the conference-opening week... Earned his first start for the Red and White in a 22-minute game at Lipscomb (Jan. 13)... Tallied his first of four 20-point games in a 43-minute, 24-point, six-rebound, three-assist game against North Alabama (Jan. 18)... Hit the go-ahead three-pointer with under 90 seconds remaining in the Governors' 95-91 double overtime win against North Florida (Feb. 3)... Began a stretch of five-straight double-figure scoring performances in a 21-point game against Queens (Feb. 10), in which he matched his season-high with eight makes from the charity stripe on nine attempts... Repped his career-best scoring mark with 32 points on 10-of-18 from the field, 5-of-7 from beyond the arc, and 7-of-8 from the stripe. The win also clinched the program's first postseason berth as a member of the ASUN Conference... 
