How to ITH Vax Card snap tab, eyelet, or slit version

Materials:

Medium to heavy weight cutaway stabilizer.
505 spray

Tapey tape

rapey tape

For Snap tab version

- (1) vinyl $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" for front (1) vinyl or oly fun $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x7" for back
- (1) Piece 16g or 18g clear vinyl 4½" x 5"

For eyelet version

- (1) vinyl 4 1/2" x 6" for front
- (1) vinyl or oly fun 4 ½" x6" for back
- (1) Piece 16g or 18g clear vinyl 4½" x 5"

Before we get start stitching, let's take a look at the Color Stop PDF that came in your zip file.



Run Color Stop 1 on your blank stabilizer only. This is going to give you the die line so you know where in the hoop to place your vinyl.

Step 1: Guess what



Yes! There are funny lines sticking out the sides, we'll use those later.







The next few colors are going to be detailed design

The 2nd to last color stop is your eyelet or snap tab hole die liner

The last color stop is your final outline. On the "slit" version, the satin rectangle is stitched with the final color stop.











Step 3: The design is now stitched and it's time to add the vinyl or oly fun to the back. Flip the hoop over and find those extra die lines we mentioned earlier and use a ruler and pen/pencil/marker to extend them. Tape your Pretty vinyl on so it's covering the main die line Next Take our clear vinyl and place the edge so they line up with those funny die lines sticking out on the sides. Tape everything down good and then place a piece of the clear plasticy WSS over the top of it all and tape that down. This will keep things from sticking to the machine bed and/or getting caught. Run the final 2 color stops for eyelet and snap versions; the last color stop for the "slit" version.







Step 4: Unhoop, remove the WSS, and Carefully cut out your vax card holder making sure that you are at least 1/8" away from your stitch lines.



Step 5: Use a leather punch to open the snap tab or eyelet holes



Step 6: Place your snaps or eyelet and set using your favorite setting tool.
