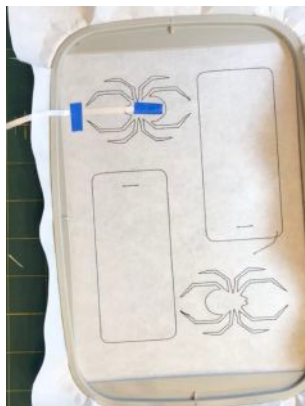


How to Web of Intrigue 2ITH bookmarks



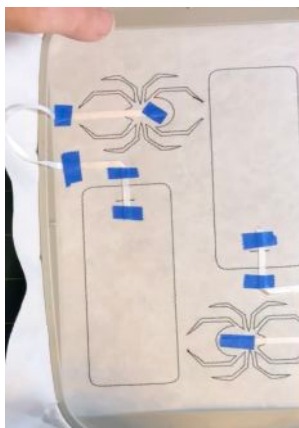
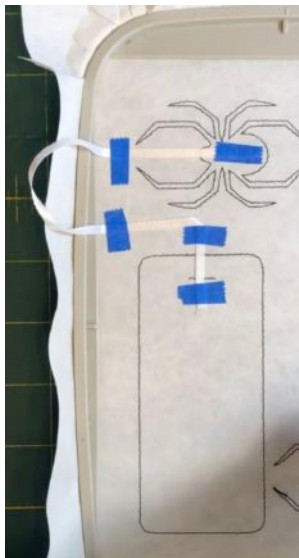
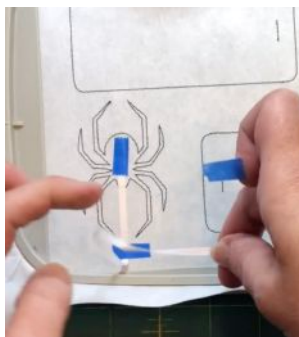
Materials:

Medium weight cut away
or tear away stabilizer
(2) 6" x 8" black marine
vinyl
(2) 1/8" white satin ribbon
(approximately 4-6")

Step 1: Hey, guess
what step 1 is? If you
guessed "hoop a piece
of stabilizer" YOU
WIN!

**Step 2: Run Color Stop
1** the die line for vinyl
and ribbon placement.

Step 3: Using the TEE-
NINE-EST piece of tape
possible, tape one end
INSIDE the spider
body, with the rest of
the ribbon coming out
his butt, clearing both
rear legs. Secure upper
ribbon in place.



Step 4: Now you need
to twist or turn the
ribbon 180 degrees so
what is the TOP of the
ribbon coming out of
the spider's butt is
actually the bottom of
the ribbon now.

Step 5: Using the TEE-
NINE-EST piece of tape
possible, tape one end
INSIDE the rectangle as
shown

Step 6: repeat steps 3,
4, and 5 for the OTHER
bookmark



Step 7: Float your first piece of marine vinyl on top of everything and re-insert in the machine



Step 8: Run Color Steps 2, 3, 4



Step 9: Tape your second piece of marine vinyl securely on the back of the hoop



Step 10: Run Color Steps 5 and 6



Step 11: "fussy cut" (this is just to get all the excess vinyl out of the way) around the spider and bookmark being sure **NOT TO CUT OFF THE RIBBON!!!**



Step 12: Cut the spider away from the bookmark **ONE LAYER AT A TIME** by first sliding your scissors between the top vinyl and the stabilizer, **AVOIDING THE RIBBON**



Step 13: Then pull back the top vinyl and cut the stabilizer and back vinyl **AVOIDING THE RIBBON**



Step 14: Trim the left, right, and bottom of the rectangle to 1/8" from the stitch line



Step 15: At the top of the rectangle, fold the back layer of vinyl, stabilizer, and ribbon to the back of the rectangle and trim the TOP VINYL ONLY avoiding the ribbon.



Step 16: At the top of the rectangle, fold the ribbon to the FRONT of the rectangle and trim the BACK VINYL AND STABILIZER avoiding the ribbon.



Step 17: “fussy cut” (this is just to get all the excess vinyl out of the way) around the spider being sure **NOT TO CUT OFF THE RIBBON!!!**

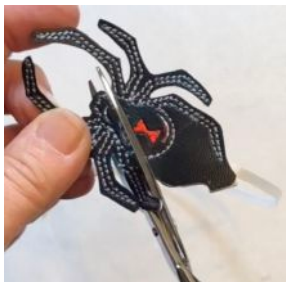




Step 18: CAREFULLY cut along the outside of all legs until you get to the spider butt.



Step 19: When you get to the rear legs, pull the ribbon to one side and carefully cut out the far side leg stopping short of where the ribbon is attached.



Step 20: Now pull the ribbon to the cut side and carefully cut out the other leg stopping short of where the ribbon is attached.



Step 21: Fold the back vinyl, stabilizer, and ribbon DOWN across the back of the spider and carefully trim ONLY the front vinyl across the ribbon attachment area



Step 22: Fold the ribbon to the FRONT of the spider and carefully trim the stabilizer and back vinyl across the ribbon attachment area.

Step 23: repeat steps 11-22 for the OTHER bookmark
