

How to ITH Patch



Materials:
WOVEN Water Soluble Stabilizer (WSS)
(1) 4" x 4" patch fabric
(1) 4" x 4" Badge Magic

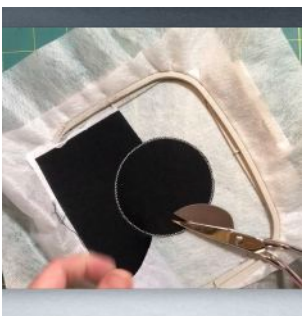
Step 1: Hoop 2 pieces of woven WSS so that the grain crisscrosses



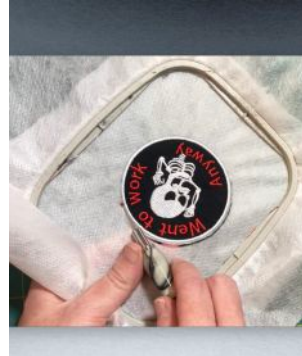
Step 2: run color stop 1. This is the die line for your patch fabric. Float your fabric so that it covers the die line and run color stop 2



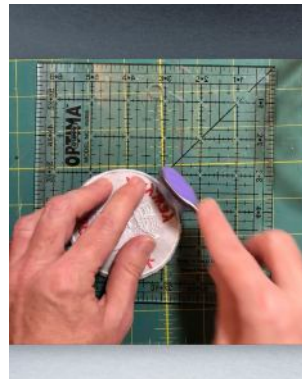
Step 3: Carefully applique trim the outside of the tack down stitch. Be careful NOT to clip the stitches OR perforate the WSS



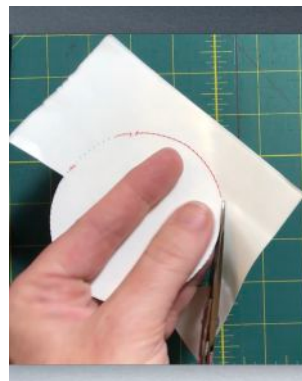
Step 4: Run all the rest of the color stops. You may want to match your bobbin thread to your top thread for color stop 3



Step 5: carefully trim away as much WSS as possible. **DO NOT CLIP YOUR SATIN STITCHES** – it will ruin your patch.



Step 6: With a toothbrush and water, carefully dissolve the rest of the WSS and allow the patch to dry before continuing.



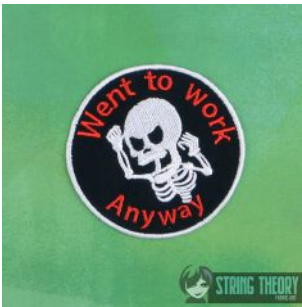
Step 7: cut a circle of Badge Magic SLIGHTLY smaller in diameter than your patch



Step 8: Peel back ONE side of the protective coating on your Badge Magic



Step 9: align with the BACK of your finished patch and PRESS all the way down



Step 10: When you are ready to apply the patch to a bag or jacket, peel off the other piece of Badge Magic protective coating, position and PRESS hard
